ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- The Lobos enter Saturday's game coming off of a loss at Colorado on Wednesday.
- The Lobo defense thrived in the first 30 minutes against Colorado as the score was 49-48 with 10:57 on the clock, but the Buffs ran away with the game in the final 10.
- NMSU is coming off of their first home loss of the season on Wednesday against San Diego, 65-60.
- While NMSU is 6-2 overall, the Aggies have played six of their eight games with a home court advantage.
- The Lobos are 3-1 in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit on the season despite their 3-6 overall record that includes five games on the road.
- Last time the two teams met, the Aggies earned a 75-56 win in the Pan American Center in Las Cruces, N.M.
- The Lobos lead the series between the teams 121-98 including a 74-38 advantage at home. The Lobos are 38-14 over the Aggies in The Pit.
- The first meeting between the two squads was on December 22, 1904 and yielded a 21-9 victory for the Lobos in Las Cruces.
- The Lobos are led by three players scoring in double figures including Sam Logwood (14.9), Chris McNeal (14.3) and Anthony Mathis (11.1).
- The Aggies are also led by three players averaging double digits including Zach Lofton (17.6), Jemerrio Jones (11.1) and Sidy N'Dir (10.0).

SCOUTING NMSU

The Aggies are 6-2 heading into Saturday's game coming off of their first home loss of the season, a 65-60 final to San Diego.

Last time the two teams met resulted in UNM's first loss of the season in game three. Three Aggies scored in double figures against the Lobo offense in Las Cruces including Zach Lofton (28), Sidy N'Dir (14) and Eli Chuha (13). The Aggies outrebounded UNM 50-25.

Big rebounder to watch for NMSU is Jemerrio Jones who averages 11.8 boards per game, helping NMSU's 41.2 rebounds per game average compared to just 34.4 for the Lobos.

NMSU is ranked ninth in the nation with an 11.5 rebounding margin. Individually, Jones is averaging 4.63 offensive boards which is ranked fourth in the country.

SERIES HISTORY

The heat between the Lobos and the Aggies has been ongoing since the early 1900s with the first meeting between the two squads occurring on December 22, 1904. It was a 21-9 victory for UNM and was followed by seven consecutive victories for the Lobos. NMSU earned its first win over New Mexico on Feb. 11, 1916 and went on a 10-win streak before UNM reclaimed the crown with 19 straight. The squads have continued to battle it out.

Until last season, when UNM fell on December 10, the Lobos had won their last five straight meetings with the the Aggies. The Lobos also dropped their opener against the Aggies this season on the road in November.

IT'S LIT IN THE PIT

The Lobos are performing considerably better at home this season than on the road. In Dreamstyle Arena, UNM is 3-1 with six players averaging in double figures including Chris McNeal (18.8), Sam Logwood (16.8), Troy Simons (15.0), Anthony Mathis (11.5),

As a team, UNM outscores its opponents at home by a 28.5 margin, shoots 50.3 percent from the floor and posts a 43.1 percentage from 3-point range.

LOBOS IN THE NATION

ABOUT THE 2017-18 LOBOS

The 2017-18 Lobos have just five returning student-athletes from the 2016-17 squad and feature an outstanding nine newcomers. Under first-year head coach Paul Weir, the Lobos look to improve on their 17-14 overall record last season, 10-8 in Mountain West play.

Top returners for the Lobos include lone regular starter Sam Logwood who averaged 7.3 points per game for a .449 field goal percentage and a .671 percentage from the free throw line. All four other Lobos to return to UNM this season played in at least 10 games, including junior Dane Kuiper who started 13 games, averaging 6.0 points per game.

NEW COACH, NEW ERA

At the helm of the Lobos in the 2016-17 season will be head coach Paul Weir, officially named the 21st head coach in UNM men's basketball history on April 11, 2017. Weir spent the last season with New Mexico State where he finished 28-6 and led NMSU to a WAC Tournament Championship and an NCAA appearance. Weir is the first basketball coach to serve as the head coach for both New Mexico DI institutions.

and will don the Lobo Cherry & Silver this season include junior Chris McNeal (Indian Hills), senior Antino Jackson (Akron), junior Jachai Simmons (Midland College) and junior Troy Simons (Polk State). The pair of transfers that will not see action this season is JaQuan Lyle (Ohio State) and Vance Jackson (UCONN) due to NCAA transfer rules.

LOBOS ON TV

The 2017-18 schedule includes many national and regional broadcasts of New Mexico basketball. The Lobos are currently slated for TV 22 times, including 13 of 16 Mountain West games. UNM had 22 of 26 UNM and MW controlled games selected for TV while three non-conference road games, at New Mexico State, at UTEP and at Colorado are expected to be broadcast as well. The Lobos will be on ATT SportsNet/ROOT eight times, on CBS Sports Network five times, ESPN3 five times, and ESPNU and the Mountain West Network on Stadium once. Additionally, two games (at UNLV on January 17 and January 27 at home against Colorado State) are flex games that will be either on ESPNU or ESPN3.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

After two years as WisePies Arena - The Pit, the famous home of Lobo basketball has been given a new name. While it will still be referred to as "The Pit," this season will be the first that the Lobos will compete in "Dreamstyle Arena" as part of an exciting \$10 million agreement for naming rights by Dreamstyle Remodeling of both of UNM's largest-capacity athletic venues. In addition to the official renaming of the Lobo basketball arena, the UNM football stadium, formerly referred to as "University Stadium" is now officially named "Dreamstyle Stadium."

In conjunction with the new name, The Pit was given a new floor this season, featuring both "New Mexico" and "The Pit" on the baselines, the new university interlocking UNM logo, fresh Mountain West logos customized in the Lobo cherry and silver, cherry free throw lines and dual Dreamstyle Arena logos on both sides of center court.

"The Pit" is nationally recognized as one of the top basketball venues. Need more evidence? How about Sports Illustrated ranking it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico men's basketball program. Since the Mountain West conference began in 1999-2000, New Mexico has ranked in the top two in home attendance among MW teams in every year except one, including 12 seasons as the top-ranked MW team in overall attendance.

LOBOS FROM NEAR AND FAR

Just one Lobo on the 2017-18 roster hails from near as a New Mexico native, freshman Matt Vail. Of the remaining 13 players on the roster, two are from California (Joe Furstinger and Vance Jackson) and two more are from Indiana (Sam Logwood and JaQuan Lyle). That leaves nine players all from different states or countries.

Lobos Defeated at Colorado in Second Half

BOULDER, COLO. --- Despite a strong first-half performance, The University of New Mexico men's basketball team suffered a 75-57 loss on the road at Colorado on Wednesday night, letting a two-point halftime margin slip away over the final 10 minutes of the game.

Junior Anthony Mathis led the Lobos (3-6) with 15 points, just one shy of his career-high, as the only Lobo to score in double figures. Mathis went for 5-for-9 from the field including 3-for-6 from three and 2-for-3 from the free throw line.

The Lobos started out strong, turning the Buffalos (7-1) over three times in just the first three minutes, exhibiting an outstanding defense that burst on the scene with arguably the most energy and intensity it has had all season. UNM held the Buffs scoreless for the first two minutes of the game and eventually forced 23 turnovers.

"I think defensively, it was a little bit of a step forward for us tonight, particularly the first 28-29, actually 31-32 minutes," head coach Paul Weir said. "I thought our defensive energy was really good and man if we could just find a way to convert some layups and some free throws I really think it would put us over the top."

The Lobos struggled from the floor going 21-for-71 for a season-low 29.6 percent field-goal percentage while shooting 29.0 percent from three (9-31) on the night.

"We got a lot of really good looks I thought around the rim, (Colorado) just did a really good job of protecting the glass," Weir said. "When you get 20 more shots than your opponent, you usually feel really good about what you did, but we just weren't able to convert a lot of shots around the rim."

The Buffalos shot 50 percent from the floor (26-52) and 60 percent (9-15) from three, taking advantage of their opportunities. CU slowly gained an 11-point lead midway through the first half, but the resilient Lobos went on an 11-2 run to erase the advantage, cutting the Buffalo lead to one, 29-28 with 1:58 left in the first half. The run was capped by a Mathis three and a dunk by freshman Makuach Maluach.

A 3-pointer from junior Troy Simons tied it up at 33 apiece with 43 seconds on the clock and the Buffs put in one more to make it 35-33 at the half.

Maluach nearly tied it up again, attempting to toss in a layup just before the buzzer, but the clock expired just before the shot went in.

The Lobos kept the game close early in the second half, continuing the momentum from the first. A dunk by senior Joe Furstinger tied it up at 35-35 and UNM held the Buffs within six points until the 9:29 mark when Colorado's McKinley Wright hit a jumper to extend the CU lead to eight, 56-48.

Despite a follow-up three from Mathis to cut it back to five, the Buffs took off from there and finished 19-9 for the 18-point victory that included a last-second three from Dominique Collier.

Despite the loss, the Lobos led in several statistical categories including points in the paint (31-30), points off of turnovers (28-7), second-chance points (9-8), fast-break points (11-6) and bench points (36-35).

The Lobos, previously ranked 17th in the nation in free throw percentage, shot a season-low 37.5 percent from the stripe (6-16).

"I think we played with a lot of energy in both halves," Mathis said. "I just think it was a matter of shots going in (in the first half) and then shots not going in (in the second half). Overall I think we played really hard, we're taking steps, it's just one step at a time."

The Lobos look to rebound when they take on New Mexico State in the in-state rivalry rematch at Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit on Saturday night. Tip off is scheduled for 7:02 p.m. on ESPN3.

Lobos Suffer First Loss in Defeat at NMSU

LAS CRUCES, N.M. --- In an arena full of palpable tension and in front of a crowd of angry Aggie fans, The University of New Mexico Lobos suffered their first loss of the season on the road at New Mexico State Friday night. While the Lobos kept the score in reach for the first two-thirds of the game, the Aggies pulled away, doubling their lead in the last five minutes and eventually dominating with a final score of 75-56.

Junior Anthony Mathis led the Lobos with 14 points on the night, just two shy of his career high of 16. He went 4-for-5 from the field including 3-for-4 from behind the arc and 3-for-4 at the free throw line.

As a team, the Lobos (2-1) shot slightly under NMSU (2-1) at 38.5 percent to 39.1 percent while the Aggies dominated the boards, collecting 50 rebounds split evenly between offensive and defensive. In comparison, UNM collected a total of 25, including nine offensive rebounds.

“Their dominance of the offensive glass set a tone, gave them a lot of energy, and we just couldn’t overcome it,” head coach Paul Weir said. “You’ve got to give New Mexico State a lot of credit, they just never allowed us to ever implement and do what we wanted to do, it just took the wind out of our sails.

“I think your first road game of the season is always a good measuring stick, to see where you’re at, and now we have to learn and grow from it and just get better.”

The Lobos dominated the first five minutes of play, getting out to a 8-1 lead before allowing NMSU its first bucket from the floor at the 15:49 mark. At that point, the Lobos led 8-3 with senior Sam Logwood accounting for six points.

Junior Chris McNeal followed with a three to continue to build the Lobo lead to eight (11-3). A 2:10 scoring drought ensued, interrupted by an Aggie free throw.

A 3-pointer by Sidy N’Dir at the 12:51 mark sparked an NMSU comeback that included two jumpers and two dunks within 2:18 to make it just a one-point lead for the Lobos, 16-15 - and that was when the momentum turned. Another dunk 20 seconds later began a 6-0 run for NMSU.

The Lobos battled back and a layup by freshman Vladimir Pinchuk made it a three-point game headed into halftime.

The Aggies opened the second half with a pair of threes to take a nine-point lead, the largest of the game and began to run away but the Lobos battled. UNM chipped away at a 12-point deficit with back-to-back threes in less than a minute from Mathis and freshman Makuach Maluach but NMSU pushed the lead back out to 10.

With just six minutes left and the Lobos down by just seven, 54-47, junior Troy Simons was ejected due to technical foul accumulation (two). A Lobo bench technical followed four minutes later and the Aggies put the game out of reach for the win.

UNM entered the game averaging 17.5 3-pointers and 44.5 field goals per game but managed just six and 20, respectively, on the night.

The Lobos will return home to Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit on Tuesday, Nov. 21 when they take on Tennessee Tech in non-conference action at 7 p.m. The game will be available to watch live on the Mountain West Network and will be broadcast on 770 Kkob-AM.

Aggies Suffer First Loss at Home

LAS CRUCES, N.M. – The New Mexico State men's basketball team saw its five-game win-streak snapped on Wednesday at the hands of West Coast Conference foe San Diego 65-60 inside the Pan American Center.

NM State was slow to start the game and trailed San Diego by a point in each of the first three media timeouts. The Aggies finally took the 23-20 lead at the final TV break with 3:52 left in the first half.

The back-and-forth continued the remainder of the first-half with neither team able to find their rhythm. The Aggies shot just 34.5-percent from the floor while the Toreros were just 38.5-percent from the field as both teams headed into the locker room tied at 29-29.

As sluggish as both teams were in the first half, they were both just as hot in the second half. The Aggies (6-2) and Toreros each went 4-of-5 from the floor in the opening 4:15 minutes of action. After a pair of free-throws from Johnathon Wilkins, three-straight buckets from San Diego gave the visitors a 45-40 lead – which forced Aggie head coach Chris Jans to call a timeout – and never relinquished its lead.

After cutting the USD lead to 46-45, a pair 3-pointers by the Toreros (6-2) pushed their lead to 52-45 with 10:58 left to play in the game. New Mexico State slowly, but surely, clawed its way back into the game and tied things up for the 11th time, 56-56, with 4:23 left on the clock after AJ Harris went coast-to-coast on a steal and completed the and-1.

However, a third triple from USD's Tyler Williams gave the Toreros momentum once again. Three missed baskets followed by an untimely turnover put San Diego ahead by 61-56. A 15-footer from Sidy N'Dir, who finished with a team-high 16 points on 6-of-8 shooting, brought the Aggies within 61-58 with 1:46 left to play.

An offensive board by Eli Chuha saw the redshirt junior get the put-back and cut it within 61-60 with 28 seconds remaining. A foul on the other end of the floor saw Isaiah Pineiro knock both free-throws down and handed NM State its first home loss this season.

Jemerrio Jones was the only other Aggie to reach double-figures, scoring 14 points while pulling down 11 rebounds with three assists. The senior now has five double-doubles on the season.

"We had a couple chances to get the crowd behind us and get a little bit of a lead," Jans said postgame. "And we weren't able to do that. We switched our defense up there midway through the second half and I thought it helped us get back in the game. But, we were never able to get over that hump. The crowd was trying to get us over that hump. We couldn't make the critical play to get the lead."

BY THE NUMBERS

The loss also snapped a 17-game home non-conference win-streak...the last time NM State lost a home non-conference game was to Wyoming on Dec. 13, 2015, 62-59...this was the first time this season NM State lost a game where its opponents had more turnovers, it was 3-0 on the year prior to Wednesday's loss.

UP NEXT

The Aggies now turn their focus on Battle of I-25 rival New Mexico. The two rivals are slated to square off in Dreamstyle Arena this Saturday, Dec. 9, at 7 p.m. on ESPN3. UNM is 3-6 on the year after its 75-57 loss at Colorado Wednesday night.

THE GREATEST GAME EVER PLAYED

The Pit was the site of one of the greatest college basketball games ever played. It hosted the 1983 national championship game that saw the NC State Wolfpack upset Hakeem Olajuwon, Clyde Drexler and the Houston Cougars. Coach Jimmy Valvano and the Wolfpack downed the Cougars on a last second put back by Lorenzo Charles. The iconic shot of the late Valvano running onto the court looking for a hug is one of the lasting images in college basketball history.

- The Lobos have averaged an astounding 15,410 fans the past 49 years, an amazing 95% of capacity
- The Pit has ranked in the top 25 in attendance nationally nearly every season since the 1966-67 season with 35 seasons in the top ten in the NCAA in attendance
- Led the Mountain West in attendance in 10 of the conference's 15 years of existence
- The floor is named Bob King Court in honor of the former head coach who led the Lobos from 1963 to 1972.
