Head Coach Paul Weir:

On missing shots:

"We missed our first six free-throws which put us in a tough place to start the game. As far as shots down the stretch, I thought we had some pretty good looks at the rim. We missed some layups and even though were getting to the free-throw line, we weren't making those plays."

On UNM's style of play:

"I thought we made a nice run in the middle of the second half and (Penn) responded very well to it. It was maybe just one of those nights where we had something on our minds that got in the way of us making any free throws."

On the zone defense:

"For two days, I thought it was pretty good. Based on a lot of the different things we were looking at, it was just something that we felt we needed to go to, and we did. It was great in the first half, at almost double the success rate of our man, but early in the second half they were scoring against our man. We probably stayed in the zone a little too long, and I thought Penn got into a little bit of a rhythm there towards the end of the second half."

On his technical in the first:

"At the end of the day, we don't have a margin for error. Every possession matters and when you see a play like that, you know the importance of it ... It was not the kind of behavior that I intend to do and not the kind of behavior I'm proud of."

On Drue Drinnon's time on the court:

"If you look at the totality of the season, our plus/minus is mostly stratified by experience. Our older guys are at the top while our younger guys are at the bottom. What we have been intending to do is just to get more experienced players on the court."

On the mental, physical, spiritual nature of the team:

"I really believe in this team even though there might not be many reasons to. We have enough. We did some things today that hinted at what I need to work on to piece the team together further. Bad stuff happens in life and bad stuff has happened to this team. There is nothing else we can do other than work and grind our way out of it."
