Missouri State finishes its difficult non-conference schedule this weekend with a trip to the Husker Invite in Lincoln, Neb., where the Bears will take on New Mexico, Central Michigan, and defending national champion Nebraska.

The Bears (5-5) have never played a defending national champion, and have played the eventual national champion once, a 3-0 loss to Southern Cal in 2003. Nebraska, ranked fourth in this week's AVCA poll, will be the highest ranked MSU opponent since the Bears lost at No. 4 Wisconsin by a 3-1 final in 2014.

The Nebraska match also features programs ranked first (NU) and fourth (MSU) in NCAA volleyball history in total victories.

Missouri State begins Missouri Valley Conference play against Illinois State at home on Sept. 21, and head coach Melissa Stokes is closing in on 500 career wins, entering the Husker Invite with 497 victories.

THE OPPONENTS

New Mexico is 5-4 this season and predicted to finish fifth in the Mountain West Conference. The Lobos have already played four five-setters this season, and hit .207 as a team while averaging 12.35 kills, 13.32 digs, 2.03 blocks and 1.00 aces per set.

Central Michigan is 3-6 after a five-set win over Indiana State on Saturday. The Chippewas are picked to finish third in the Mid-American Conference West Division this season. CMU has allowed a .239 attack efficiency so far this year while hitting .169 as a offense and averaging 11.94 kills, 14.76 digs, 1.24 blocks and 1.15 aces per set.

Nebraska is 6-1 overall and ranked fourth in this week's AVCA poll. The Cornhuskers have won six straight after a season-opening loss to Florida, and have played all their matches in the state of Nebraska. Two-time NCAA Championship Most Outstanding Player Mikaela Foecke leads NU with 3.68 kills per set on .295 hitting, and the Huskers hit .254 as a team compared to .128 for opponents with averages of 12.8 kills, 14.88 digs, 2.24 blocks and 1.88 aces per set.

SERIES HISTORIES

MSU and New Mexico have split four previous meetings, the last a 3-1 UNM win in 1992 in Albuquerque.

The Bears have never played Central Michigan in volleyball, but are 16-8 all-time against current Mid-American Conference schools, including a victory against Ball State on Sept. 1.

Missouri State owns a 17-15 series lead over Nebraska, though the programs have not met since 1993. The Huskers have won the last nine meetings, with MSU's last win coming in 1981 in Denton, Texas.

LAST WEEK

Missouri State split four matches, falling at Kansas State on Tuesday before claiming a share of the Texas A&M Invitational with wins over Nicholls State and Texas A&M and a loss to Pepperdine.

Freshman Amelia Flynn piled up 15 kills in Tuesday's loss at KSU, and classmates Chloe Rear and Makina Wratten excelled in Thursday's victory over Nicholls. Wratten had eight blocks, while Rear added six kills, 22 assists, eight digs and six blocks.

The Bears were aced 13 times Friday against Pepperdine, but rebounded for a 3-2 win that evening against Texas A&M, using an 8-0 run to close the fourth set and a 6-0 run late in the fifth to secure the win.

COACH MELISSA STOKES

Head Coach Melissa Stokes is 497-232 (.682) in her 23rd season at Missouri State. She became the MVC's all-time winningest coach in league matches Sept. 30, 2011, when the Bears beat Bradley 3-1 for her 197th conference victory, and won her 400th career match against Miami (Fla.) on Sept. 13, 2014. A native of El Cajon, Calif., Stokes is a three-time MVC Coach of the Year and two-time AVCA Midwest Region Coach of the Year, and has guided Missouri State to an overall record of 420-173 (.708) and 250-74 (.772) mark in the Missouri Valley Conference since 2000. The Bears have won MVC regular season championships in 2003, 2016 and 2017 under Stokes, making NCAA Tournament appearances in 2003, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2010, 2011, 2015, 2016 and 2017. MSU's lone postseason victory came at Arkansas in 2006.

In MVC history, Stokes currently ranks third in total victories, first in MVC wins (289), sixth in win percentage and second among active coaches, and seventh in league win percentage (.732).

Stokes came to Missouri State from the University of Idaho, where she helped the Vandals to four straight NCAA Tournament berths. As a setter at San Diego State, Stokes played four seasons and helped the Aztecs to two NCAA appearances.

Stokes ranked 32nd among active Division I coaches in winning percentage and 34th in total victories entering 2018. Only three coaches ahead of Stokes on the wins list have coached fewer seasons.

QUICK SETS

- Missouri State is 50-13 in its last 63 matches, dating to Sept. 30, 2016, with win streaks of 17 and 21 matches during that time.
- Missouri State owns four victories over teams ranked 20th or higher in the AVCA Coaches Poll since the beginning of the 2016 season.
- The MSU defense has held opponents to a .100 or lower attack efficiency in 14 of 37 sets this season, and .000 or worse eight times.
- Freshmen have accounted for 46 percent of MSU's kills this season, 51 percent of blocks and 45 percent of total points. Rookies have owned a share of the team kill lead in eight matches this year, and have led in blocking seven times.
- Missouri State has won at least 20 matches in 18 of the last 19 seasons while posting winning records both overall and in Missouri Valley Conference play for 19 consecutive years.
- Missouri State ranks fourth all-time among Division I schools with 1,255 victories.
- Missouri State is 54-36 in five-set matches since the beginning of the 2006 season and has rallied from 0-2 deficits to win seven times since then as well.
- MSU is 233-39 since the beginning of 2006 when winning set two.

STREAKS

The Bears brought a number of notable winning streaks into the 2018 season, with several remaining intact:

- 34 consecutive MVC wins, the fifth-longest in league history. Last loss: Sept. 26, 2016 vs. Southern Illinois.
- 20 consecutive MVC road wins. Last loss: Oct. 24, 2015 at Illinois State.
- 17 straight October wins. Last loss: Oct. 31, 2015 vs. Wichita State.
- 13 straight home wins, two shy of the school record. Last loss: Sept. 16, 2017 vs. Illinois.
- MSU's streak of 22 straight road wins ended on Aug. 24, marking a school record and the NCAA's longest active streak at its completion.
- Missouri State won 19 consecutive sets at home over the course of seven matches from Oct. 30, 2017 to Sept. 1, 2018.
- The Bears went 56 consecutive regular season matches without being swept from Sept. 17, 2016 to Sept. 4, 2018.
- The Bears also own separate overall win streaks of 17 and 21 matches the last two seasons, and have 23 different streaks of at least six consecutive victories since 1999.

Missouri State received votes in the AVCA preseason poll to begin 2018, spent three weeks in the No. 25 spot last November, and was recognized in the poll on some level for 10 consecutive weeks from Oct. 9, 2017 to Aug. 25, 2018.

POWER FIVE WINS A REGULARITY

With a Sept. 7 win at Texas A&M, Missouri State now has 27 victories over schools from Power Five football schools under Melissa Stokes.

ALL-AMERICANS

Several players on the MSU roster can call themselves All-Americans at either the college or high school level. Senior Emily Butters earned honorable mention honors from the AVCA and VolleyMob last season, and is joined by Aubrey Cheffey, Amelia Flynn, Emelie Orlando, Chloe Rear and Cambree Villarreal as players who earned the distinction during their prep careers.

HOMECOMING

Missouri State has been dominant at home since 2000, compiling a record of 201-47 for an .810 winning percentage at Hammons Student Center.

The Bears are 3-0 in 2018 and have won at least 64 percent of their home matches in 18 consecutive seasons.

MSU's current 13-match home winning streak is two shy of the school record.

LOCAL FLAVOR

Missouri State boasts two players from Springfield on its 2018 roster (Gerri Idos and Leah Vokolek from Kickapoo High) and a total of seven players from southwest Missouri, including MacKenzie Irwin (Joplin), Laynie Dake (Mount Vernon), Ashley Ophoven (Ozark), Aubrey Cheffey (Nixa), and Chloe Rear (Strafford). In all, 10 of MSU's 18 players hail from the Show-Me State.

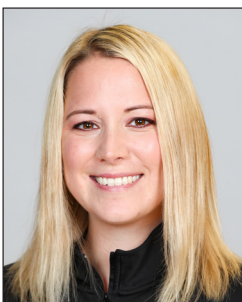
