ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- New Mexico enters Saturday's game 1-1 in its last two conference games including a 30-point victory over Wyoming and a 16-point loss on the road at UNLV.
- Utah State enters Saturday's contest on a three-game win streak including a 16-point win over Wyoming, an 18-point victory over San José State and a 15-point win over Colorado State.
- The Aggies also enter Saturday's game coming off of a bye week, the Lobos' first bye is this week.
- Utah State leads the overall series 23-11 and leads 10-8 in Albuquerque, including a 3-2 mark in The Pit.
- Last time the two teams faced off was in the 2018 Mountain West Championship Semifinals where the Lobos claimed an 83-68 victory to advance to the championship.
- The Lobos and the Aggies met three times last season, Utah State claimed the first meeting 89-80 in Logan before the Lobos won in Albuquerque and again in Las Vegas.
- Utah State is led by a pair of players scoring in double figures including junior Sam Merrill (18.7 ppg) and freshman Neemias Queta (11.0 ppg). Queta is also the leading rebounder for the Aggies with 8.2 rebounds per game.
- The Lobos are led by three players averaging scoring in double digits including senior Anthony Mathis (15.5), redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson (12.8) and redshirt-junior Carlton Bragg (10.7). Bragg and Jackson also lead the Lobo rebounding effort with 7.5 and 7.3 per game, respectively.

SCOUTING UTAH STATE

The Aggies kicked off the 2018-19 season on a five-win streak, including a 17-point win over Saint Mary's, before suffering their first loss against Arizona State on Nov. 21. Utah State's current three-win streak is the longest since its opening run.

The Aggies currently average 79.1 points per game while allowing just 65.5 of its opponents for a +13.5 scoring margin. Utah State currently leads the league in conference play in rebounding defense (30.0 rebounds per game), rebounding margin (+8.3) and in blocked shots (4.3 blocks per game).

LAST TIME OUT

Despite being outscored by just four points in the second half, the first-half deficit was too much on Tuesday night as the Lobos ultimately fell to UNLV by a final score of 74-58.

Redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson led the Lobos in scoring for the fourth time this season with 16 points while adding eight rebounds, three steals and an assist. Redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee and redshirt-junior Carlton Bragg each posted 12 points while Bragg registered his first double-double of the season adding 12 rebounds. Bragg also posted a trio of dunks.

Senior Anthony Mathis was held to just eight points on the night. The last time Mathis was held to single digits was on Jan. 8 against UNLV. The two games mark the only two in the last 12 games that the senior standout has been held below 10 points.

LOBOS AFTER DARK

UNM's loss to UNLV on Jan. 8 marked the first of five games this season that UNM will take on an opponent at 9 p.m. MT - some 9 p.m. (PT) times will actually be at 10 p.m. in Albuquerque. In addition, the Lobo schedule features four 8 p.m. (MT) games.

SUITS AND SNEAKERS

Saturday night's game will mark the second for the Lobos during Suits and Sneakers Week (Jan. 21-27). During Suits and Sneakers Week, college and high school coaches across the nation will wear sneakers with their suits during games to raise awareness for Coaches vs. Cancer and the fight against cancer.

Since its inception, Coaches vs. Cancer has raised over \$115 million to support the American Cancer Society.

ON TO THE PROS

Lobo basketball has a history of giving a great foundation for players to make it in the pros. On Thursday, Lobo junior Karim Ezzeddine informed coach Paul Weir of his decision to leave the program immediately and pursue professional basketball opportunities overseas. He will withdraw from classes this semester and intends to sign a contract as soon as possible.

MOUNTAIN WEST PLAYER OF THE WEEK

For his efforts against then-ranked No. 5/6 Nevada on Jan. 5 and against Air Force on Jan. 2, senior Anthony Mathis earned his first Mountain West Player of the Week honor. Mathis averaged 22.0 points per game going 12-for-31 (.387) from the field including 8-for-23 (.348) from behind the arc. He also went 12-for-14 from the free throw line.

MATHIS 10TH IN THE NATION

Lobo senior Anthony Mathis is currently 10th in the nation in 3-point field goals per game (3.63) and 15th in total 3-point field goals made (69).

He is also ranked 27th in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage (43.9).

1ST IN THE MW

The Lobos currently lead the Mountain West in several categories including steals per game (7.4), total 3-point field goals made (183) and total steals (141).

WELL-ROUNDED VANCE

Redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson leads the Lobos with the most double-doubles (4) and the most 10+ rebounding games of the season (4). He has scored in double figures in the last 10 games and has collected 19 assists in the last six games.

IT'S RAINING THREES

The Lobos are averaging 9.6 3-pointers per game and have racked up 10 or more in 12-of-19 games this season. Conversely, the Lobos have allowed opponents to shoot 10 threes or more just four times this season.

DEFENSIVE DANE

Senior Dane Kuiper has typically been known as a defensive specialist with flashes

of brilliance on offense but he has been on an offensive roll as of late. Saturday's game against Wyoming marked his third straight scoring in double figures. In the last three games prior to Tuesday at UNLV, he shot at least 44.4 percent from the floor while collecting a total of seven assists and six steals along with just four turnovers.

DUNK TRACKER

Redshirt-junior Carlton Bragg leads the Lobos in dunks on the season with eight, including six in Mountain West play. In fact, in Tuesday's contest at UNLV, Bragg posted not one, not two, but three second-half dunks.

BRAGG IS BACK

Redshirt-junior Carlton Bragg finally earned his debut as a Lobo on Sunday, Dec. 16 after a year and a half off the court. Bragg posted 16 points on 7-for-12 from the floor and tallied seven rebounds in his debut against Central Arkansas. He followed it up with a six-point, seven-rebound performance against North Texas to go along with three steals.

To date, he has accumulated 83 rebounds and 118 points in 11 games and has started the last nine.

STEALING LOBOS - 1ST IN THE MW

The Lobos currently lead the Mountain West on the season in steals per game with 7.4. UNM is led in the category by redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson (21) and senior Dane Kuiper (21), followed by senior Anthony Mathis (20).

20-POINT FEVER

Senior Anthony Mathis has exploded this season with six 20+ point games so far. Prior to his senior season, he had accumulated just three 20+ point games in his career.

He has also led the Lobos in scoring in nearly half of UNM's games so far this season (9).

MATHIS COUNTDOWN TO 1,000

Senior Anthony Mathis has accumulated 814 points in his career. With 186 points to go to reach the 1,000-point mark, it may seem premature to begin the countdown but consider this: Mathis has already netted 295 points this season and tallied 433 last season after essentially sitting the bench his first two as a Lobo (86 points total).

Mathis has scored in double figures in 15-of-19 games this season including six 20+ point games. With an average of 15.5 points per game and at least 12 games left this season he could make it before his career at UNM ends.

27TH IN ATTENDANCE

The Lobos are currently ranked 27th in the country in average attendance. Approximately 11,224 fans fill Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit to watch their Lobos per game so far this season. The Lobos also lead the conference in attendance this season:

ABOUT THE 2018-19 LOBOS

The 2018-19 Lobos have just four returning letterwinners from the 2017-18 squad, including leading-scorer Anthony Mathis (12.7 ppg) who finished fourth in the nation in 3-point percentage and broke the UNM record for most 3-point field goals in a conference season (66) as a junior. The squad also adds nine newcomers and returns a pair of sitting transfers to the team that finished third in Mountain West regular-season play last season.

advanced to the 2018 NCAA Tournament. Last season's Big Dance squads include New Mexico State, Iona, Penn, San Diego State and Nevada. With UNM facing NMSU, SDSU and Nevada twice apiece, that makes for eight games against NCAA post-season opponents, not to mention a matchup with last season's CBI tourney winner, North Texas.

UNDER THE RADAR

This offseason, the Lobos were ranked by the NCAA's Andy Katz as one of five "under the radar" teams to watch this season.

SHARP SHOOTER

Senior Anthony Mathis blew expectations out of the water last season after more than fiftuple his career point production as a junior - that's right, in two seasons at UNM, Mathis scored just 86 points in 228 minutes, and multiplied that total by five in his junior season. In 2017-18, Mathis took the term "breakout" to a whole new level, dropping 433 points in 760 minutes on the floor. His shot from 3-point range couldn't be stopped as he finished the season with a program-record 66 3-pointers in conference play. He also fired from behind the arc at a clip of 47.3%, ranking fourth in the nation among other NCAA DI players.

THE STUDENT BECOMES THE MASTER

After posting a breakout inaugural season of his own last year, sophomore Makuach Maluach is expected to be a high-profile returner for the Lobos this year. He's been ranked on several preseason lists and even made the cover of Lindy's Sports Magazine in August. Most recently, the soft-spoken sophomore was ranked 19th on the Mountain West Wire's Top 25.

CONSISTENCY IS OVERRATED

Last season, the Lobos debuted the most starting lineups in NCAA Division I with 21. Coach Weir made it clear in his first season that starting lineups would be determined by the numbers of deflections a player accumulated in the previous game, hence the sky-high number of lineup combos.

MW PRESEASON NEWCOMER OF THE YEAR

Redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson was

In addition to Mathis, UNM's returners include senior Dane Kuiper, who is the lone returning starter, and sophomores Makuach Maluach and Vladimir Pinchuk. Maluach finished his inaugural season averaging 9.6 points per game and ranks fourth all-time on the Lobo freshman single-season scoring list.

REMEMBERING LAST SEASON

The 2017-18 Lobos were picked to finish ninth in league play, but shocked everyone when they pulled off a third-place finish in regular-season play, earned the MW Tournament bye and took on San Diego State in the Championship game, falling by just seven points.

The Lobos also ranked 15th out of 351 NCAA Division I teams in turnover percentage last season.

RECORDS ARE MEANT TO BE BROKEN

En route to their first appearance in the league championship since 2014, the Lobos broke the program records for 3-pointers in a season (367), most 3-point field goals attempted (979) and highest free throw percentage (77.7%). For reference, the previous records were 301, 782 and 75.7%, respectively.

As a team, the Lobos also broke the record for most points in a game (147 vs Northern New Mexico), most points in a conference game (119 at Wyoming) and most points in a conference season (1,507). Old records for the above: 136, 113 and 1,373, respectively.

named 2018 Mountain West Preseason Newcomer of the Year following the league's media poll in October. Jackson transferred from UCONN where he shot 40.9 percent from the field, 39.7 from behind the arc as a freshman in 2016-17. He reached double figures in 13 games and led the team twice in scoring in his inaugural collegiate season.

WE'RE NOT IN KANSAS ANYMORE ...

The Lobos return a pair of transfers that sat out last year and also welcome five more, including the highly-anticipated Carlton Bragg (Kansas/ASU transfer) who is currently eligible for conference play. Joining Bragg will be Juco transfers Corey Manigault, Keith McGee and Karim Ezzeddine who are all set to play at the start of the season.

Redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson (UCONN) will finally get his chance to don the Cherry and Silver this season and was named 2018 MW Newcomer of the Year. Jackson's fellow bench-warmer last season, Ohio State transfer JaQuan Lyle, suffered an Achilles injury during practice in September and is expected to miss the 2018-19 season. Two more transfers of note include Towson's Zane Martin, who will be sitting out in 2018-19 due to NCAA transfer rules, and redshirt-freshman Clay Patterson. A native of Rio Rancho, N.M., Patterson transferred back home from NCAA DII Fort Lewis. He is eligible to compete in 2018-19.

BRINGING PEOPLE TOGETHER

The Lobo squad is as varied as it gets when it comes to hometown pride. Each player on the team is from not only a different town, but a different state or country entirely! With the late addition of walk-on Clay Patterson, the only exception is a pair of native New Mexicans. States and countries represented include: Pennsylvania, Maryland, California, New York, Florida, Australia, Indiana, Alaska, Germany, Georgia, France, Oregon, New Mexico and Ohio.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

The famous home of Lobo basketball enters its second year under the name "Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit" as part of an exciting renaming of both of UNM's largest-capacity athletic venues.

This July, "The Pit" was tabbed #17 on the top-30 list of best arena atmospheres in college hoops by the NCAA.

"The Pit" has also been consistently recognized nationally as one of the nation's top basketball venues. Sports Illustrated has ranked it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico men's basketball program. Since the Mountain West conference began in 1999-2000, New Mexico has ranked in the

top two in home attendance among MW teams in every year except one, including 12 seasons as the top-ranked MW team in overall attendance.

WHAT'S THAT SOUND?

The new name for The Pit instated in 2017 is not the only change to come for Dreamstyle Arena in the Paul Weir era. This season, after popular fan demand, the sound system in the historic arena has been updated to feature an entirely new fan experience for the 2018-19 season!

First Half Too Much, Lobos Fall at UNLV

LAS VEGAS, Nev. --- Despite being outscored by just four points in the second half, the first-half deficit was too much on Tuesday night as The University of New Mexico men's basketball team ultimately fell to UNLV by a final score of 74-58.

The loss comes after the Lobos claimed a 30-point victory over Wyoming on Saturday afternoon and marks the second time this season that the Runnin' Rebels have topped UNM immediately after a big win. The first was after UNM topped nationally-ranked Nevada by 27 points on Jan. 5.

With the loss, the Lobos slip to 9-10, 3-4 MW, while UNLV improves to 11-7, 5-1 in conference play.

Redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson led the Lobos in scoring for the fourth time this season with 16 points while adding eight rebounds, three steals and an assist. Redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee and redshirt-junior Carlton Bragg each posted 12 points while Bragg registered his first double-double of the season adding 12 rebounds. Bragg also posted a trio of dunks.

Senior Anthony Mathis was held to just eight points on the night. The last time Mathis was held to single digits was on Jan. 8 against UNLV. The two games mark the only two in the last 12 games that the senior standout has been held below 10 points.

On the night, UNM was outshot 43.9 percent (25-58) to 35.5 percent (22-62) from the field and 56.0 percent (14-25) to 26.1 percent (6-23) from 3-point range. The Lobos did, however, outrebound the Runnin' Rebels 42-41. Prior to Tuesday night's game, UNM boasted a record of 6-0 when outrebounding its opponent.

The Lobo defense started the contest on fire, allowing just five points through the first 8:30 while getting out to a six-point lead, 11-5.

At the 8:59 mark, a three from UNLV's Nick Blair put the home team up by two, 16-14 before a layup from Jackson gave the teams the first tie at 16-16. The squads tied again at 17 and 18 before UNLV took off on a 9-0 run on three straight 3-pointers, including two by Noah Robotham, to make it 27-18 Runnin' Rebels with 5:44 on the clock.

UNLV increased the run to 19-4 to take its largest lead of the first half, 15 points, at 37-22 with 1:26 left. Both teams registered a layup before McGee made a buzzer-beating three to make it a 12-point game at the break, 39-27.

Just 16 seconds into the second half, UNLV's Kris Clyburn hit a three to re-energize the Runnin' Rebel offense. Clyburn, who hit 25 points in the Lobos' last meeting with the Runnin' Rebels, was held to 14 points.

Trailing by 15 with 18:18 left, the Lobos went on a 7-0 run that included a pair of Bragg dunks and a Mathis three to cut the deficit to eight and get the Lobo fans going.

The teams kept it close over the next minute until a 5-0 UNLV run put the difference back to double figures at 13, 51-38 with 12:48 to play.

UNM cut it back to single digits just once more at the 9:35 mark on a Jackson three, 54-45, but Clyburn responded with a three of his own to make it a 12-point game and the Runnin' Rebels never looked back.

McGee finished the second half like he did the first, with a three in the final seconds, for the 74-58 final.

Fifty-eight points marks the least the Lobos have scored this season against any opponent. On the night, UNLV converted UNM's 14 turnovers into 23 points while the Lobos scored just two off of 11. UNM led in second-chance points (18-11), and in the paint (24-22) while the Runnin' Rebel bench outscored the Lobos' 31-22.

UNM led for 11:18 of the contest while UNLV led for 27:18.

The Lobos are set to return to action at home on Saturday as they host Utah State at 2 p.m. inside Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit.

Championship Bound! Lobos Down USU in Semis

LAS VEGAS, NEV. --- With an 83-68 victory over No. 7 seed Utah State on Friday night, The University of New Mexico men's basketball team earned its first trip to the Mountain West Championships since 2014. The Lobos are set to take on No. 5 San Diego State for the tournament title on Saturday, March 10, at 3 p.m. PT / 4 p.m. MT on CBS.

The last two times that the Lobos have faced SDSU in the title game, in 2012 and 2014, UNM came away with the victory.

With Friday night's victory, the Lobos extend their largest streak of the season to seven while San Diego State enters the matchup riding an eight-win streak. Last time UNM went on a seven-win streak was in 2012-13 when the squad opened the season 12-0 en route to a regular-season and tournament title.

Saturday will also mark the sixth time in program history that UNM has advanced to the championship, winning its last four appearances (2005, 2012, 2013, 2014). UNM is 4-1 all-time in the title contest.

The Lobos (19-14) used a 19-0 run in the first half on Friday night to take a commanding lead over the Utah State Aggies (21-10) and never looked back en route to the 15-point victory.

"I can't say enough about what I think about Coach Duryea and Utah State, they have a great team," head coach Paul Weir said. "They wouldn't go away tonight, they kept fighting, you have to give them a lot of credit.

"Right now, we're moving forward on to the next game. San Diego State is a tremendous team."

The first seven minutes were an all-out battle between the squads. Both were physical and playing tough defense as the score at the 13:06 mark was tied at just 12-12. After Utah State climbed out to an eight-point lead, 20-12, junior Troy Simons hit a clutch 3-pointer that sparked the Lobo offense. Twenty-two seconds later, senior Joe Furstinger hit a jump shot, 20-17 USU, and the Lobos were off and running.

Down by five with 8:51 left in the first half, 22-17, the Lobos exploded for a 19-0 run that lasted 6:31 to get out to a 24-point lead. Utah State scored just three more points on a free throw and a jumper for the lofty 37-25 final.

At the half, the Lobos were outshooting the Aggies 48.1 - 34.6 percent and were outrebounding 18-15.

The Lobos came out of the half with the first six points to extend their lead to 20, 45-25, forcing Utah State to call a timeout. UNM proceeded to jump out to the largest advantage of the game, 23-points, two and a half minutes later, 53-30.

The Aggies battled back, cutting the Lobo lead to as little as nine with 1:51 left, but UNM closed on a 6-0 run that included a trio of free throws and a 3-pointer with 18 seconds left on the clock from senior Antino Jackson to seal the victory.

On the night, the Lobos fired from the floor at a clip of 51.9 percent while the Aggies shot 42.1 percent from the floor. Both squads went 7-for-24 from behind the arc (29.2 percent) while UNM dominated in the paint, 36-28, off of turnovers, 23-13, and off the bench, 26-5.

The Lobos were led by four players scoring in double figures on the night including Simons (17), senior Sam Logwood (16), senior Joe Furstinger (16) and junior Chris McNeal. Logwood also grabbed a team-high seven rebounds while Jackson collected eight points and a game-high six assists.

No. 3 seed New Mexico takes on No. 7 seed San Diego State on Saturday at 3 p.m. PT / 4 p.m. MT in the Thomas & Mack Center in Las Vegas, Nev. in the battle for the 2018 Mountain West Championship.

Utah State Leads Wire-to-Wire in 87-72 Victory Over Colorado State

LOGAN, Utah – Utah State extended its winning streak to three and halted Colorado State's at two, as the Aggies led wire-to-wire in beating the Rams 87-72 in front of 7,509 fans Saturday night at the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum.

Freshman center Neemias Queta and redshirt freshman guard Brock Miller paced five Aggies in double figures with 18 points apiece. Queta recorded the third double-double of his career as he also grabbed 11 rebounds, to go along with three blocks, two assists and two steals.

All six of Miller's field goals came from beyond the arc as he matched his career high in made 3-pointers. Miller shot 6-for-11 from the field overall, but 6-for-9 from 3-point land. Queta shot an efficient 8-for-11 from the field.

Joining those two freshmen in double-figure scoring for the Aggies (14-5, 4-2 Mountain West) were junior guard Sam Merrill (16), senior forward Quinn Taylor (12) and junior guard Diogo Brito (12). Utah State shot 54.2 percent from the field (32-of-59), including 48.0 percent from beyond the arc (12-of-25), and 78.6 percent from the free throw line (11-of-14).

Of the 32 made baskets by Utah State, 23 of them were assisted, including eight from Merrill and five from Taylor. The Aggies also dominated around the glass and in the paint as they outrebounded CSU, 39-24, and outscored the visitors in the paint, 38-20.

Saturday was the 99th meeting between the Aggies and Rams. Utah State now leads the overall series 59-40.

Just like the Aggies, five Rams scored in double figures, led by J.D. Paige, who had 17 points. Hyron Edwards had 14 points, Adam Thistlewood and Nico Carvacho chipped in 12 points apiece, and Kris Martin scored 10.

Carvacho, who battled Queta all night long down on the blocks, also finished with a double-double for CSU (7-11, 2-3 MW) as he grabbed a team-high 10 boards.

The Rams shot 45.1 percent from the field on the night (23-of-51), including 41.7 from beyond the arc (10-of-24), and 61.5 percent from the charity stripe (16-of-26).

The Aggies wasted no time in jumping out to the early lead, as Utah State made five of its first seven shots of the game, including a steal and coast-to-coast dunk by Queta, to give USU a 14-2 lead with 15:43 remaining in the first half.

During that stretch, CSU missed four of its first five shots and turned it over three times.

Colorado State did find its offense, though, and trimmed the lead to four on a couple of occasions, including 21-17 at the 10:32 mark.

However, that's as close as the Rams would get the rest of the way. USU eventually pushed its lead out to as many as 16 in the first half, thanks in part to a 20-8 spurt after Colorado State pulled within four.

The Rams committed 10 turnovers in the first half and the Aggies parlayed those into 12 points. Utah State led at the break 44-35.

Utah State will now enjoy a week off before returning to the court on Saturday, Jan. 26, when the Aggies take on New Mexico (9-9, 3-3 MW) in Albuquerque, N.M. The game, which is scheduled to tip at 2 p.m., will be televised on CBS Sports Network.

THE GREATEST GAME EVER PLAYED

The Pit was the site of one of the greatest college basketball games ever played. It hosted the 1983 national championship game that saw the NC State Wolfpack upset Hakeem Olajuwon, Clyde Drexler and the Houston Cougars. Coach Jimmy Valvano and the Wolfpack downed the Cougars on a last second put back by Lorenzo Charles. The iconic shot of the late Valvano running onto the court looking for a hug is one of the lasting images in college basketball history.

- Less than 30 of 345 NCAA Division I basketball programs play in a college-only arena named after a business or organization founded or headquartered in its home state.
- The Lobos have averaged an astounding 15,410 fans the past 49 years, an amazing 95% of capacity
- The Pit has ranked in the top 25 in attendance nationally nearly every season since the 1966-67 season with 35 seasons in the top ten in the NCAA in attendance
- Led the Mountain West in attendance in 10 of the conference's 15 years of existence
- The floor is named Bob King Court in honor of the former head coach who led the Lobos from 1963 to 1972.

First Half Too Much, Lobos Fall at UNLV

LAS VEGAS, Nev. --- Despite being outscored by just four points in the second half, the first-half deficit was too much on Tuesday night as The University of New Mexico men's basketball team ultimately fell to UNLV by a final score of 74-58.

The loss comes after the Lobos claimed a 30-point victory over Wyoming on Saturday afternoon and marks the second time this season that the Runnin' Rebels have topped UNM immediately after a big win. The first was after UNM topped nationally-ranked Nevada by 27 points on Jan. 5.

With the loss, the Lobos slip to 9-10, 3-4 MW, while UNLV improves to 11-7, 5-1 in conference play.

Redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson led the Lobos in scoring for the fourth time this season with 16 points while adding eight rebounds, three steals and an assist. Redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee and redshirt-junior Carlton Bragg each posted 12 points while Bragg registered his first double-double of the season adding 12 rebounds. Bragg also posted a trio of dunks.

Senior Anthony Mathis was held to just eight points on the night. The last time Mathis was held to single digits was on Jan. 8 against UNLV. The two games mark the only two in the last 12 games that the senior standout has been held below 10 points.

On the night, UNM was outshot 43.9 percent (25-58) to 35.5 percent (22-62) from the field and 56.0 percent (14-25) to 26.1 percent (6-23) from 3-point range. The Lobos did, however, outrebound the Runnin' Rebels 42-41. Prior to Tuesday night's game, UNM boasted a record of 6-0 when outrebounding its opponent.

The Lobo defense started the contest on fire, allowing just five points through the first 8:30 while getting out to a six-point lead, 11-5.

At the 8:59 mark, a three from UNLV's Nick Blair put the home team up by two, 16-14 before a layup from Jackson gave the teams the first tie at 16-16. The squads tied again at 17 and 18 before UNLV took off on a 9-0 run on three straight 3-pointers, including two by Noah Robotham, to make it 27-18 Runnin' Rebels with 5:44 on the clock.

UNLV increased the run to 19-4 to take its largest lead of the first half, 15 points, at 37-22 with 1:26 left. Both teams registered a layup before McGee made a buzzer-beating three to make it a 12-point game at the break, 39-27.

Just 16 seconds into the second half, UNLV's Kris Clyburn hit a three to re-energize the Runnin' Rebel offense. Clyburn, who hit 25 points in the Lobos' last meeting with the Runnin' Rebels, was held to 14 points.

Trailing by 15 with 18:18 left, the Lobos went on a 7-0 run that included a pair of Bragg dunks and a Mathis three to cut the deficit to eight and get the Lobo fans going.

The teams kept it close over the next minute until a 5-0 UNLV run put the difference back to double figures at 13, 51-38 with 12:48 to play.

UNM cut it back to single digits just once more at the 9:35 mark on a Jackson three, 54-45, but Clyburn responded with a three of his own to make it a 12-point game and the Runnin' Rebels never looked back.

McGee finished the second half like he did the first, with a three in the final seconds, for the 74-58 final.

Fifty-eight points marks the least the Lobos have scored this season against any opponent. On the night, UNLV converted UNM's 14 turnovers into 23 points while the Lobos scored just two off of 11. UNM led in second-chance points (18-11), and in the paint (24-22) while the Runnin' Rebel bench outscored the Lobos' 31-22.

UNM led for 11:18 of the contest while UNLV led for 27:18.

The Lobos are set to return to action at home on Saturday as they host Utah State at 2 p.m. inside Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit.
