#### ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- The Lobos enter Saturday's game coming off of their 16th-straight home opening victory after topping Iona 90-83 on Tuesday night.
- UNM has kicked off the season 2-0 for the seventh straight season after also claiming an 87-84 victory over CSUN on the road on Nov. 6.
- The Aggies are 2-1 on the season after claiming a 73-56 win over North Dakota State and a 96-69 win over UTEP, both at home. NMSU's victory streak came to an end on Wednesday night however, when it suffered a 73-58 loss to Saint Mary's.
- The Aggies are one of UNM's longest opponents dating back to the first game in the series history on Dec. 22, 1904 (a 21-9 win for UNM in Las Cruces).
- New Mexico leads the Rio Grande Rivalry series 121-99 including a 74-39 advantage at home and a 38-15 lead in The Pit.
- NMSU has won the last three matchups after a five-game win streak for UNM.
- Saturday's game will be UNM's Nike N7 game in which the Lobos will don special Turquoise jerseys in support of American Indian Heritage Month in November.
- The Lobos are led on the season by six Lobos averaging scoring in double figures including Corey Manigault (18.0), Anthony Mathis (13.0), Vance Jackson (12.5), Makuach Maluach (10.5), Dane Kuiper (10.0) and Keith McGee (10.0).
- NMSU is led by three double-figure scorers including Ivan Aurrecoechea (10.7), Terrell Brown (10.3) and A.J. Harris (10.0).

#### SCOUTING NMSU

The Aggies are returning just one starter and a total of five letterwinners from last year's squad that claimed the WAC Championship after a 12-2 league record and advanced to the 2018 NCAA Tournament. NMSU fell in the first round to Clemson.

NMSU started the season 2-0 under secondvear head coach Chris Jans with wins over North Dakota State and UTEP in Las Cruces but fell on Wednesday night 73-58 to Saint Mary's. Saturday's game will mark NMSU's LAST TIME OUT first away from the Pan American Center.

The Aggies are led by Indian Hills CC transfer Ivan Aurrecoechea who averages 10.7 points per game and 4.0 rebounds. Redshirt-senior Eli Chuha leads in rebounds with 5.7 per game.

#### BREAKING THE STREAK

The Aggies have won the last three straight meetings between the two squads, snapping a five-game Lobo win streak on Dec. 10, 2016 - the year Paul Weir spent as the head coach of the Aggies. That season, the Lobos and the Aggies split the series before NMSU swept UNM in 2017-18.

#### TURQUOISE IS BACK! - NIKE N7 GAME

Saturday's game will mark the Lobos' annual Nike N7 game in which the Lobos will wear Turquoise in support of American Indian Heritage Month in November. Turquoise is also the official alternate color of the Lobos.

The Lobos are proud to continue their partnership with Nike N7 as part of a celebration and recognition of American Indian Heritage Month. Nike N7 is a longtime commitment and mission to inspire rebounding margin. This season, UNM has

and enable two million Native American and Aboriginal youth in North America to participate in sport and physical activity.

Some special events that will take place in Saturday's game include a Turquoise jersey auction that will benefit the NB3 Foundation and UNM American Indian Student Services. In addition, UNM will recognize tribal leaders and Notah Begay III. The national anthem will also be sung in Navajo by Stacie Barney.

The Lobos took down Iona with an offensive surge in the last seven minutes of the game marking the second time that UNM has held the game close, but raced to the finish for the win this season. Seniors Anthony Mathis and Dane Kuiper scored the last 10 points for UNM for the 90-83 final while a pair of Lobos posted double-doubles. Junior Corev Manigault scored 20 points and racked up 10 rebounds while redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson added 18 points and led the Lobos with 12 rebounds.

#### **CONSISTENT LEADERS**

Junior Corey Manigault has led the Lobos in scoring in both of his first games at UNM with 16 points against CSUN and 20 against Iona for 18.0 points per game.

Redshirt-sophomore and MW Preseason Newcomer of the Year Vance Jackson has led UNM in rebounds in both of his first two games as a Lobo posting eight against CSUN and 12 against Iona for a team-best average of 10.0.

To reflect, the Lobos are 2-0 in the last two games with Manigault and Jackson leading on both ends of the floor. The pair have notched the first double-doubles for the Lobos this season.

#### WE MEET AGAIN

Saturday's clash between in-state foes UNM and NMSU will have two former teammates from Indian Hills Community College battling on different sides of the ball. UNM's Corey Manigault and NMSU's Ivan Aurrecoechea played together at the school before transferring to rival schools. Both Manigault and Aurrecoechea lead their team in points so far this year with 18.0 and 10.7, respectively.

#### REBOUND, REBOUND, REBOUND

Last season's lack of Lobo size limited UNM's rebounding ability, finishing last year -4.2 in collected 36 and 41 rebounds, respectively in the last two games and is +1.0 through the first two competitions of the season.

#### **UNSTOPPABLE MATHIS**

Senior Anthony Mathis was unstoppable on Saturday night in UNM's exhibition against NNMC, going a perfect 5-for-5 from behind the arc and 10-for-10 from the free throw line for 25 points.

Through UNM's two regular-season games, Mathis is 9-for-18 from the floor (50%) and 8-for-15 from behind the arc (53.3%). He is averaging 4.5 3-pointers per game.

#### **DOUBLE FIGURE LOBOS**

In the first two regular-season games, the Lobos have had four and five players score in double figures, respectively.

UNM currently has six players averaging scoring in double digits including junior Corey Manigault (18.0), senior Anthony Mathis (13.0), redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson (12.5), sophomore Makuach Maluach (10.5), senior Dane Kuiper (10.0) and redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee (10.0).

Jackson is currently the only Lobo averaging a double-double with 12.5 points and 10.0 rebounds.

#### PINCHUK EMERGING

Sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk saw action in 31 games with 13 starts as a freshman and averaged 3.1 points per game and 2.5 rebounds. So far through the first two games of his sophomore campaign he is averaging 9.5 points and 6.0 rebounds per game. He collected a career-best (tied) two blocks and one steal in a career-most 30 minutes against lona on Tuesday.

#### ABOUT THE 2018-19 LOBOS

The 2018-19 Lobos have just four returning letterwinners from the 2017-18 squad, including leading-scorer Anthony Mathis (12.7 ppg) who finished fourth in the nation in 3-point percentage and broke the UNM record for most 3-point field goals in a conference season (66) as a junior. The squad also adds nine newcomers and returns a pair of sitting transfers to the team that finished third in Mountain West regular-season play last season.

In addition to Mathis, UNM's returners include senior Dane Kuiper, who is the lone returning starter, and sophomores Makuach Maluach and Vladimir Pinchuk. Maluach finished his inaugural season averaging 9.6 points per game and ranks fourth all-time on the Lobo freshman single-season scoring list.

The 2017-18 Lobos were picked to finish ninth in league play, but shocked everyone when they pulled off a third-place finish in regular-season play, earned the MW Tournament bye and took on San Diego State in the Championship game, falling by just seven points.

En route to their first appearance in the other NCAA DI players. league championship since 2014, the Lobos broke the program records for 3-pointers **THE STUDENT BECOMES THE MASTER** in a season (367), most 3-point field goals After posting a breakout inaugural season previous records were 301, 782 and 75.7%, respectively.

#### Lobos Open 2-0 With 90-83 Win over Iona

**ALBUQUERQUE, N.M.** --- Two Lobos racked up double-doubles on Tuesday night as The University of New Mexico men's basketball team earned a 90-83 win over the visiting Iona Gaels to start the 2018-19 season 2-0. Junior Corey Manigault and redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson led the Lobos with 20 and 18 points, respectively while collecting 10 and 12 boards apiece.

The victory marks the 16th straight season in which the Lobos came away with the win in their home opener.

After a slow start offensively, seniors Anthony Mathis and Dane Kuiper closed the game, combining for the thrilling final 10 points, including a pair of fast-break layups, to keep the Lobos on top throughout the final three minutes.

"The depth that we have, the way we spread our minutes and the style that we play allowed us to break away at the end and get a big win," head coach Paul Weir said. "It was a good basketball team that we beat, and we have come a long way in the last 12 months. We have not arrived and we have a lot of work to do the next few days in order to continue to get better, but just to get a win against a good basketball team early in the year shows our progression as a program."

The Lobos held the lead for 24:35 of the game that had nine lead changes and five ties. On the night, UNM outshot Iona from the floor 50.9 - 40.0 percent and 40.0 - 34.6 percent from behind the arc. Five Lobos scored in double figures including Manigault (20), Jackson (18), Mathis (14), redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee (13) and sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk (10).

Pinchuk's 10 points went along with seven rebounds, one steal, three assists and two blocks in a new career-high 30 minutes.

With just 7:05 left in the game and the Lobos down by one, 72-71, Manigault poked the ball out of the hands of lona's Isaiah Still, raced to the other end of the court unguarded and slammed a crowd-pleasing dunk to put the Lobos back on top for the final time, 73-72.

When the Gaels reduced the Lobo lead back to one, 75-74, sophomore Makuach Maluach sunk a dagger of a three at 5:28 that put the Lobos back up by four, 78-74. Iona was able to take a five-point lead to just two, 80-78, at the 2:59 mark on a Still three before Mathis nailed his fourth 3-pointer of the night to put the Lobos back up by five, 83-78, and spark a Lobo offensive surge through the final minutes.

The Gaels would get no closer than three as Kuiper drilled his lone three of the night - a big one - with 1:52 left, 86-80, followed by a pair of fast-break layups from Mathis and Kuiper to keep the crowd of over 10,000 fans roaring through the end.

The Lobos forced 15 turnovers and posted five blocks, including two from Pinchuk. UNM also collected 19 assists to just 15 for Iona.

UNM went down by as much as five points in the back-and-forth first half that featured a 10-0 lona run at the 13:43 mark. UNM battled back and responded with a 11-0 run with just 5:30 left in the first half to head into the locker room tied 39-39.

The Lobos came out of the halftime break with the first six points to take a commanding 45-39 lead before Iona whittled it back down to one with 16:20 on the clock.

Overall the teams finished relatively even in points off of turnovers (15-14 UNM), points in the paint (28 apiece), second-chance points (13-12 UNM), fast-break points (31-29 Iona) and bench points (29-20 UNM).

The Lobos return to action on Saturday, November 17 when they take on in-state rival New Mexico State for a 4 p.m. clash in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit. The game will be the Lobos' Nike N7 contest featuring the highly-anticipated turquoise uniforms and will be televised on AT&T SportsNet.

#### Lobos Fall to NMSU in Last-Minute Heartbreaker

**ALBUQUERQUE, N.M.** --- With 6:40 to go in one of the biggest and most intense rivalries in The University of New Mexico history, the Lobos led the New Mexico State Aggies by eight, 56-48, on Saturday night in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit before dropping a heartbreaker by a final score of 65-62. The Lobos missed a tough, last-second three-pointer that would have tied the game.

The Lobos (3-7) outshot the Aggies (7-2) from 3-point range 28.6 percent to 20.0 percent and from the free throw line (70.6-50.0) in the outstanding defensive effort while scoring 14 points off of 17 NMSU turnovers.

UNM was led by senior Antino Jackson who compiled 14 points, his second-highest total of the season, including three from behind the arc. Junior Troy Simons posted 13 points and a team-best seven rebounds.

"I think this was just a newer team trying to find its way against a veteran team that's won a lot of games," head coach Paul Weir said. "I think that NMSU knows how to win those (close) games and has the experience to do it, and we're still trying to figure that out.

"These guys are fighting and I can't say anything negative about them ... they are giving it all they've got, we just have to find a way to improve and find a way to win games like this before the season is over."

Despite being down their leading scorer in arguably one of the biggest games of the year, the Lobos battled and went up on the Aggies, who reached the NCAA Tournament last season as the WAC Champions, by as much as nine points with 10 minutes left in the game. Nine points was the largest lead of the game by either team.

Freshman Makuach Maluach earned his first career start on the night. At the 10-minute mark, Maluach slammed a crowd-pleasing, one-handed dunk with unmatched enthusiasm from an excited Lobo crowd.

NMSU responded with three points from the game's leading scorer Zach Lofton, who tallied a game-high 22 points on the night, to cut the Lobo lead to six and eventually whittle UNM's advantage to three, 56-53 with 5:21 left.

The Aggies cut the deficit to one, 57-58 on a Lofton jumper and overtook the Lobos at the 2:34 mark on a Lofton layup, holding on for the win.

Lobo junior Anthony Mathis, who has been hot from behind the arc as of late, got a good look with the seconds winding down, but was forced to shoot from deep at the last second and missed. Mathis is 48.2 percent (27-56) on the season from three. Senior Joe Furstinger nearly got the putback before time expired.

As a team, UNM shot 39.9 percent compared to 42.6 percent for NMSU. The game marked just the second time this season that UNM committed more turnovers than it's opponent (19-17). NMSU outscored the Lobos in the paint, 36-20, but UNM collected more points on the fast break, 11-8. Both teams tallied 13 second-chance points on the night.

The Lobos will have seven days to recuperate from Saturday's game vs. NMSU before taking on Arizona on Saturday, Dec. 16 at Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit on CBS Sports Network at 6 p.m.

A 15-7 run ensued for NM State after that timeout by Coach Jans and brought the Aggies within 50-40 before Eli Chuha knocked a pair of shots at the charity stripe to make it 50-42 with 10:25 remaining.

But, the veteran team from Saint Mary's weathered that storm and another run by New Mexico State that brought the Aggies within 55-48 with 7:17 left to go. A huge layup by Harris made it 61-51 in favor of the bad guys was answered with corner three and was followed by 3-pointer from Harris back on the other end.

However, it proved to be not enough as the Gaels extended its lead near the end and handed the Aggies the 73-58 loss.

Another rivalry game is on the horizon for New Mexico State as it heads north to #Aggiequerque to take on Battle of I-25 rival New Mexico Saturday, Nov. 17, at 4 p.m. (MT). Saturday's rivalry game will be broadcast on AT&T Sports Network.

- The floor is named Bob King Court in honor of the former head coach who led the Lobos from 1963 to 1972.



#### Lobos Win Opener on Mathis 3-Point Buzzer-Beater

NORTHRIDGE, Calif. --- Senior Anthony Mathis of The University of New Mexico men's basketball team hit a buzzer-beating three to lift the Lobos over the CSUN Matadors on Tuesday night, officially opening the 2018-19 season with an exciting 87-84 victory. Four Lobos scored in double figures on the night that saw UNM's new squad shoot 51.9 percent from the floor and 42.3 percent from 3-point range.

The Lobos (1-0) and the Matadors (0-1) battled throughout 40 minutes with 13 lead changes and six ties.

Despite a shaky start full of first-game-of-the-season-nerves, UNM outshot CSUN in every category including from the floor (51.9 - 45.8 percent) from behind the arc (42.3 - 35.0 percent) and from the free throw line (75.9 - 52.4 percent).

In his first game as a Lobo, junior Corey Manigault led the squad on the night with 16 points going 4-for-6 from the floor and 8-for-9 from the charity stripe. Senior Dane Kuiper and sophomore Makuach Maluach followed with 15 points apiece. Kuiper went 3-for-5 from behind the arc, 5-for-8 from the floor and Maluach was 5-for-9 from the floor with a three and four free throws.

Mathis was the fourth player to score in double figures, registering 12 points with a 4-for-7 performance from 3-point range.

CSUN freshman Lamine Diane led all players on the night with 34 points going 15-for-28 from the field. Diane scored 30 and 23 points in CSUN's exhibition matchups.

"Ball control was clearly an issue for us tonight," head coach Paul Weir said. "Our size was almost a problem tonight (because CSUN was so quick), but you've got to tip your cap to CSUN, they played their hearts out. Diane is a tremendous player, puts a lot of pressure on defenses, particularly on the glass, and they were able to go out and show that tonight."

The Lobos opened Tuesday night's contest with a 2:54 drought before sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk registered UNM's first points on a pair of free throws with 17:06 on the clock to make it 6-2 CSUN. A minute later, Manigault shot a pair of free throws to make it 6-4 but the Lobos did not score from the floor until 5:08 into the game when Kuiper hit a jumper to make it 8-6 Matadors.

Kuiper's jumper was followed by a three-pointer just 32 seconds later to spark a Lobo 10-0 run over 2:57, putting UNM on top 16-10.

Both teams continued to respond and with CSUN leading by one at the conclusion of the half, a foul was called at the buzzer that sent Maluach to the line. He hit the shot and tied it 42-42 heading into the locker room.

Over the first half, UNM was out-rebounded 21-15.

Once again it was Kuiper in the second half to give the Lobo offense life as he came out of the locker room with the first six points for UNM on a pair of threes split by a jumper by Diane, 48-44.

The fifth tie of the game occurred at the 4:07 mark when redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson hit a free throw to tie it up 77-77. The Lobos built a four-point lead, 84-80 before a layup by CSUN's Cameron Gottfried made it 84-82 with just 30 seconds left on the clock.

The Lobos attempted to keep the ball and run down the clock but a UNM turnover allowed the Matadors to have one more possession that ended in another jumper by Diane to make it 84-84 with 6.1 seconds left.

The Lobos gained possession with the clock winding down and took about 4.5 seconds to cross half-court. Mathis looked up, saw the clock and took a long three from the right wing and sunk it for the win, 87-84.

On the night, CSUN dominated in the paint, 44-24 and registered 25 points off of turnovers compared to 22 for UNM. CSUN also tallied 13 second-chance points to just four for the Lobos and 12 on the fast break.

The Lobos are set to return to action on Saturday, Nov. 10 when they take on Northern New Mexico in exhibition competition as part of the second-annual New Mexico Classic tournament hosted by UNM.

#### Game 2 - New Mexico 90, Iona 83 Nov. 13, 2018 | Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit

#### Lobos Open 2-0 With 90-83 Win over Iona

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- Two Lobos racked up double-doubles on Tuesday night as The University of New Mexico men's basketball team earned a 90-83 win over the visiting Iona Galest to start the 2018-19 season 2-0. Junior Corey Manigault and redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson led the Lobos with 20 and 18 points, respectively while collecting 10 and 12 boards apiece.

The victory marks the 16th straight season in which the Lobos came away with the win in their home opener.

After a slow start offensively, seniors Anthony Mathis and Dane Kuiper closed the game, combining for the thrilling final 10 points, including a pair of fast-break layups, to keep the Lobos on top throughout the final three minutes.

"The depth that we have, the way we spread our minutes and the style that we play allowed us to break away at the end and get a big win," head coach Paul Weir said. "It was a good basketball team that we beat, and we have come a long way in the last 12 months. We have not arrived and we have a lot of work to do the next few days in order to continue to get better, but just to get a win against a good basketball team early in the year shows our progression as a program."

The Lobos held the lead for 24:35 of the game that had nine lead changes and five ties. On the night, UNM outshot Iona from the floor 50.9-40.0 percent and 40.0- 34.6 percent from behind the arc. Five Lobos scored in double figures including Manigault (20), Jackson (18), Mathis (14), redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee (13) and sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk (10).

Pinchuk's 10 points went along with seven rebounds, one steal, three assists and two blocks in a new career-high 30 minutes.

With just 7:05 left in the game and the Lobos down by one, 72-71, Manigault poked the ball out of the hands of lona's Isaiah Still, raced to the other end of the court unguarded and slammed a crowd-pleasing dunk to put the Lobos back on top for the final time, 73-72.

When the Gaels reduced the Lobo lead back to one, 75-74, sophomore Makuach Maluach sunk a dagger of a three at 5:28 that put the Lobos back up by four, 78-74. Iona was able to take a five-point lead to just two, 80-78, at the 2:59 mark on a Still three before Mathis nailed his fourth 3-pointer of the night to put the Lobos back up by five, 83-78, and spark a Lobo offensive surge through the final minutes.

The Gaels would get no closer than three as Kuiper drilled his lone three of the night - a big one - with 1:52 left, 86-80, followed by a pair of fast-break layups from Mathis and Kuiper to keep the crowd of over 10,000 fans roaring through the end.

The Lobos forced 15 turnovers and posted five blocks, including two from Pinchuk. UNM also collected 19 assists to just 15 for Iona.

UNM went down by as much as five points in the back-and-forth first half that featured a 10-0 lona run at the 13:43 mark. UNM battled back and responded with a 11-0 run with just 5:30 left in the first half to head into the locker room tied 39-39.

The Lobos came out of the halftime break with the first six points to take a commanding 45-39 lead before Iona whittled it back down to one with 16:20 on the clock.

Overall the teams finished relatively even in points off of turnovers (15-14 UNM), points in the paint (28 apiece), second-chance points (13-12 UNM), fast-break points (31-29 Iona) and bench points (29-20 UNM).

The Lobos return to action on Saturday, November 17 when they take on instate rival New Mexico State for a 4 p.m. clash in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit. The game will be the Lobos' Nike N7 contest featuring the highly-anticipated turquoise uniforms and will be televised on AT&T SportsNet.
