#### ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- The Lobos enter Saturday's game coming off of their 16th-straight home opening victory after topping Iona 90-83 on Tuesday night.
- UNM has kicked off the season 2-0 for the seventh straight season after also claiming an 87-84 victory over CSUN on the road on Nov. 6.
- The Aggies are 2-1 on the season after claiming a 73-56 win over North Dakota State and a 96-69 win over UTEP, both at home. NMSU's victory streak came to an end on Wednesday night however, when it suffered a 73-58 loss to Saint Mary's.
- The Aggies are one of UNM's longest opponents dating back to the first game in the series history on Dec. 22, 1904 (a 21-9 win for UNM in Las Cruces).
- New Mexico leads the Rio Grande Rivalry series 121-99 including a 74-39 advantage at home and a 38-15 lead in The Pit.
- NMSU has won the last three matchups after a five-game win streak for UNM.
- Saturday's game will be UNM's Nike N7 game in which the Lobos will don special Turquoise jerseys in support of American Indian Heritage Month in November.
- The Lobos are led on the season by six Lobos averaging scoring in double figures including Corey Manigault (18.0), Anthony Mathis (13.0), Vance Jackson (12.5), Makuach Maluach (10.5), Dane Kuiper (10.0) and Keith McGee (10.0).
- NMSU is led by three double-figure scorers including Ivan Aurrecochea (10.7), Terrell Brown (10.3) and A.J. Harris (10.0).

**SCOUTING NMSU**

The Aggies are returning just one starter and a total of five letterwinners from last year's squad that claimed the WAC Championship after a 12-2 league record and advanced to the 2018 NCAA Tournament. NMSU fell in the first round to Clemson.



NMSU started the season 2-0 under second-year head coach Chris Jans with wins over North Dakota State and UTEP in Las Cruces but fell on Wednesday night 73-58 to Saint Mary's. Saturday's game will mark NMSU's first away from the Pan American Center.

The Aggies are led by Indian Hills CC transfer Ivan Aurrecoechea who averages 10.7 points per game and 4.0 rebounds. Redshirt-senior Eli Chuha leads in rebounds with 5.7 per game.

**BREAKING THE STREAK**

The Aggies have won the last three straight meetings between the two squads, snapping a five-game Lobo win streak on Dec. 10, 2016 - the year Paul Weir spent as the head coach of the Aggies. That season, the Lobos and the Aggies split the series before NMSU swept UNM in 2017-18.

**TURQUOISE IS BACK! - NIKE N7 GAME**

Saturday's game will mark the Lobos' annual Nike N7 game in which the Lobos will wear Turquoise in support of American Indian Heritage Month in November. Turquoise is also the official alternate color of the Lobos.

The Lobos are proud to continue their partnership with Nike N7 as part of a celebration and recognition of American Indian Heritage Month. Nike N7 is a long-time commitment and mission to inspire

and enable two million Native American and Aboriginal youth in North America to participate in sport and physical activity.

Some special events that will take place in Saturday's game include a Turquoise jersey auction that will benefit the NB3 Foundation and UNM American Indian Student Services. In addition, UNM will recognize tribal leaders and Notah Begay III. The national anthem will also be sung in Navajo by Stacie Barney.

**LAST TIME OUT**

The Lobos took down Iona with an offensive surge in the last seven minutes of the game marking the second time that UNM has held the game close, but raced to the finish for the win this season. Seniors Anthony Mathis and Dane Kuiper scored the last 10 points for UNM for the 90-83 final while a pair of Lobos posted double-doubles. Junior Corey Manigault scored 20 points and racked up 10 rebounds while redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson added 18 points and led the Lobos with 12 rebounds.

**CONSISTENT LEADERS**

Junior Corey Manigault has led the Lobos in scoring in both of his first games at UNM with 16 points against CSUN and 20 against Iona for 18.0 points per game.

Redshirt-sophomore and MW Preseason Newcomer of the Year Vance Jackson has led UNM in rebounds in both of his first two games as a Lobo posting eight against CSUN and 12 against Iona for a team-best average of 10.0.

To reflect, the Lobos are 2-0 in the last two games with Manigault and Jackson leading on both ends of the floor. The pair have notched the first double-doubles for the Lobos this season.

**WE MEET AGAIN**

Saturday's clash between in-state foes UNM and NMSU will have two former teammates from Indian Hills Community College battling on different sides of the ball. UNM's Corey Manigault and NMSU's Ivan Aurrecoechea played together at the school before transferring to rival schools. Both Manigault and Aurrecoechea lead their team in points so far this year with 18.0 and 10.7, respectively.

**REBOUND, REBOUND, REBOUND**

Last season's lack of Lobo size limited UNM's rebounding ability, finishing last year -4.2 in rebounding margin. This season, UNM has

collected 36 and 41 rebounds, respectively in the last two games and is +1.0 through the first two competitions of the season.

**UNSTOPPABLE MATHIS**

Senior Anthony Mathis was unstoppable on Saturday night in UNM's exhibition against NNMC, going a perfect 5-for-5 from behind the arc and 10-for-10 from the free throw line for 25 points.

Through UNM's two regular-season games, Mathis is 9-for-18 from the floor (50%) and 8-for-15 from behind the arc (53.3%). He is averaging 4.5 3-pointers per game.

**DOUBLE FIGURE LOBOS**

In the first two regular-season games, the Lobos have had four and five players score in double figures, respectively.

UNM currently has six players averaging scoring in double digits including junior Corey Manigault (18.0), senior Anthony Mathis (13.0), redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson (12.5), sophomore Makuach Maluach (10.5), senior Dane Kuiper (10.0) and redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee (10.0).

Jackson is currently the only Lobo averaging a double-double with 12.5 points and 10.0 rebounds.

**PINCHUK EMERGING**

Sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk saw action in 31 games with 13 starts as a freshman and averaged 3.1 points per game and 2.5 rebounds. So far through the first two games of his sophomore campaign he is averaging 9.5 points and 6.0 rebounds per game. He collected a career-best (tied) two blocks and one steal in a career-most 30 minutes against Iona on Tuesday.

**ABOUT THE 2018-19 LOBOS**

The 2018-19 Lobos have just four returning letterwinners from the 2017-18 squad, including leading-scorer Anthony Mathis (12.7 ppg) who finished fourth in the nation in 3-point percentage and broke the UNM record for most 3-point field goals in a conference season (66) as a junior. The squad also adds nine newcomers and returns a pair of sitting transfers to the team that finished third in Mountain West regular-season play last season.

In addition to Mathis, UNM's returners include senior Dane Kuiper, who is the lone returning starter, and sophomores Makuach Maluach and Vladimir Pinchuk. Maluach finished his inaugural season averaging 9.6 points per game and ranks fourth all-time on the Lobo freshman single-season scoring list.

**REMEMBERING LAST SEASON**

The 2017-18 Lobos were picked to finish ninth in league play, but shocked everyone when they pulled off a third-place finish in regular-season play, earned the MW Tournament bye and took on San Diego State in the Championship game, falling by just seven points.

The Lobos also ranked 15th out of 351 NCAA Division I teams in turnover percentage last

### RECORDS ARE MEANT TO BE BROKEN

En route to their first appearance in the league championship since 2014, the Lobos broke the program records for 3-pointers in a season (367), most 3-point field goals attempted (979) and highest free throw percentage (77.7%). For reference, the previous records were 301, 782 and 75.7%, respectively.

As a team, the Lobos also broke the record for most points in a game (147 vs Northern New Mexico), most points in a conference game (119 at Wyoming) and most points in a conference season (1,507). Old records for the above: 136, 113 and 1,373, respectively.

### STELLAR SCHEDULE

The Lobos are taking on a field of top-notch teams this season including five squads that advanced to the 2018 NCAA Tournament. Last season's Big Dance squads include New Mexico State, Iona, Penn, San Diego State and Nevada. With UNM facing NMSU, SDSU and Nevada twice apiece, that makes for eight games against NCAA post-season opponents, not to mention a matchup with last season's CBI tourney winner, North Texas.

### UNDER THE RADAR

This offseason, the Lobos were ranked by the NCAA's Andy Katz as one of five "under the radar" teams to watch this season.

### SHARP SHOOTER

Senior Anthony Mathis blew expectations out of the water last season after more than fiftupleing his career point production as a junior - that's right, in two seasons at UNM, Mathis scored just 86 points in 228 minutes, and multiplied that total by five in his junior season. In 2017-18, Mathis took the term "breakout" to a whole new level, dropping 433 points in 760 minutes on the floor. His shot from 3-point range couldn't be stopped as he finished the season with a program-

record 66 3-pointers in conference play. He also fired from behind the arc at a clip of 47.3%, ranking fourth in the nation among other NCAA DI players.

### THE STUDENT BECOMES THE MASTER

After posting a breakout inaugural season of his own last year, sophomore Makuach Maluach is expected to be a high-profile returner for the Lobos this year. He's been ranked on several preseason lists and even made the cover of Lindy's Sports Magazine in August. Most recently, the soft-spoken sophomore was ranked 19th on the Mountain West Wire's Top 25.

### CONSISTENCY IS OVERRATED

Last season, the Lobos debuted the most starting lineups in NCAA Division I with 21. Coach Weir made it clear in his first season that starting lineups would be determined by the numbers of deflections a player accumulated in the previous game, hence the sky-high number of lineup combos.

### MW PRESEASON NEWCOMER OF THE YEAR

Redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson was named 2018 Mountain West Preseason Newcomer of the Year following the league's media poll in October. Jackson transferred from UCONN where he shot 40.9 percent from the field, 39.7 from behind the arc as a freshman in 2016-17. He reached double figures in 13 games and led the team twice in scoring in his inaugural collegiate season.

### WE'RE NOT IN KANSAS ANYMORE ...

The Lobos return a pair of transfers that sat out last year and also welcome five more, including the highly-anticipated Carlton Bragg (Kansas/ASU transfer) who is currently eligible for conference play. Joining Bragg will be Juco transfers Corey Manigault, Keith McGee and Karim Ezzeddine who are all set to play at the start of the season.

Redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson (UCONN) will finally get his chance to don

the Cherry and Silver this season and was named 2018 MW Newcomer of the Year. Jackson's fellow bench-warmer last season, Ohio State transfer JaQuan Lyle, suffered an Achilles injury during practice in September and is expected to miss the 2018-19 season. Two more transfers of note include Towson's Zane Martin, who will be sitting out in 2018-19 due to NCAA transfer rules, and redshirt-freshman Clay Patterson. A native of Rio Rancho, N.M., Patterson transferred back home from NCAA DII Fort Lewis. He is eligible to compete in 2018-19.

### BRINGING PEOPLE TOGETHER

The Lobo squad is as varied as it gets when it comes to hometown pride. Each player on the team is from not only a different town, but a different state or country entirely! With the late addition of walk-on Clay Patterson, the only exception is a pair of native New Mexicans. States and countries represented include: Pennsylvania, Maryland, California, New York, Florida, Australia, Indiana, Alaska, Germany, Georgia, France, Oregon, New Mexico and Ohio.

### THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

The famous home of Lobo basketball enters its second year under the name "Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit" as part of an exciting renaming of both of UNM's largest-capacity athletic venues.

This July, "The Pit" was tabbed #17 on the top-30 list of best arena atmospheres in college hoops by the NCAA.

"The Pit" has also been consistently recognized nationally as one of the nation's top basketball venues. Sports Illustrated has ranked it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico men's basketball program. Since the Mountain West conference began in 1999-2000, New Mexico has ranked in the top two in home attendance among MW teams in every year except one, including 12 seasons as the top-ranked MW team in overall attendance.

### WHAT'S THAT SOUND?

The new name for The Pit instated in 2017 is not the only change to come for Dreamstyle Arena in the Paul Weir era. This season, after popular fan demand, the sound system in the historic arena has been updated to feature an entirely new fan experience for the 2018-19 season!

## Lobos Open 2-0 With 90-83 Win over Iona

**ALBUQUERQUE, N.M.** --- Two Lobos racked up double-doubles on Tuesday night as The University of New Mexico men's basketball team earned a 90-83 win over the visiting Iona Gaels to start the 2018-19 season 2-0. Junior Corey Manigault and redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson led the Lobos with 20 and 18 points, respectively while collecting 10 and 12 boards apiece.

The victory marks the 16th straight season in which the Lobos came away with the win in their home opener.

After a slow start offensively, seniors Anthony Mathis and Dane Kuiper closed the game, combining for the thrilling final 10 points, including a pair of fast-break layups, to keep the Lobos on top throughout the final three minutes.

"The depth that we have, the way we spread our minutes and the style that we play allowed us to break away at the end and get a big win," head coach Paul Weir said. "It was a good basketball team that we beat, and we have come a long way in the last 12 months. We have not arrived and we have a lot of work to do the next few days in order to continue to get better, but just to get a win against a good basketball team early in the year shows our progression as a program."

The Lobos held the lead for 24:35 of the game that had nine lead changes and five ties. On the night, UNM outshot Iona from the floor 50.9 - 40.0 percent and 40.0 - 34.6 percent from behind the arc. Five Lobos scored in double figures including Manigault (20), Jackson (18), Mathis (14), redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee (13) and sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk (10).

Pinchuk's 10 points went along with seven rebounds, one steal, three assists and two blocks in a new career-high 30 minutes.

With just 7:05 left in the game and the Lobos down by one, 72-71, Manigault poked the ball out of the hands of Iona's Isaiah Still, raced to the other end of the court unguarded and slammed a crowd-pleasing dunk to put the Lobos back on top for the final time, 73-72.

When the Gaels reduced the Lobo lead back to one, 75-74, sophomore Makuach Maluach sunk a dagger of a three at 5:28 that put the Lobos back up by four, 78-74. Iona was able to take a five-point lead to just two, 80-78, at the 2:59 mark on a Still three before Mathis nailed his fourth 3-point-er of the night to put the Lobos back up by five, 83-78, and spark a Lobo offensive surge through the final minutes.

The Gaels would get no closer than three as Kuiper drilled his lone three of the night - a big one - with 1:52 left, 86-80, followed by a pair of fast-break layups from Mathis and Kuiper to keep the crowd of over 10,000 fans roaring through the end.

The Lobos forced 15 turnovers and posted five blocks, including two from Pinchuk. UNM also collected 19 assists to just 15 for Iona.

UNM went down by as much as five points in the back-and-forth first half that featured a 10-0 Iona run at the 13:43 mark. UNM battled back and responded with a 11-0 run with just 5:30 left in the first half to head into the locker room tied 39-39.

The Lobos came out of the halftime break with the first six points to take a commanding 45-39 lead before Iona whittled it back down to one with 16:20 on the clock.

Overall the teams finished relatively even in points off of turnovers (15-14 UNM), points in the paint (28 apiece), second-chance points (13-12 UNM), fast-break points (31-29 Iona) and bench points (29-20 UNM).

The Lobos return to action on Saturday, November 17 when they take on in-state rival New Mexico State for a 4 p.m. clash in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit. The game will be the Lobos' Nike N7 contest featuring the highly-anticipated turquoise uniforms and will be televised on AT&T SportsNet.

**Lobos Fall to NMSU in Last-Minute Heartbreaker**

**ALBUQUERQUE, N.M.** --- With 6:40 to go in one of the biggest and most intense rivalries in The University of New Mexico history, the Lobos led the New Mexico State Aggies by eight, 56-48, on Saturday night in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit before dropping a heartbreaker by a final score of 65-62. The Lobos missed a tough, last-second three-pointer that would have tied the game.

The Lobos (3-7) outshot the Aggies (7-2) from 3-point range 28.6 percent to 20.0 percent and from the free throw line (70.6-50.0) in the outstanding defensive effort while scoring 14 points off of 17 NMSU turnovers.

UNM was led by senior Antino Jackson who compiled 14 points, his second-highest total of the season, including three from behind the arc. Junior Troy Simons posted 13 points and a team-best seven rebounds.

"I think this was just a newer team trying to find its way against a veteran team that's won a lot of games," head coach Paul Weir said. "I think that NMSU knows how to win those (close) games and has the experience to do it, and we're still trying to figure that out.

"These guys are fighting and I can't say anything negative about them ... they are giving it all they've got, we just have to find a way to improve and find a way to win games like this before the season is over."

Despite being down their leading scorer in arguably one of the biggest games of the year, the Lobos battled and went up on the Aggies, who reached the NCAA Tournament last season as the WAC Champions, by as much as nine points with 10 minutes left in the game. Nine points was the largest lead of the game by either team.

Freshman Makuach Maluach earned his first career start on the night. At the 10-minute mark, Maluach slammed a crowd-pleasing, one-handed dunk with unmatched enthusiasm from an excited Lobo crowd.

NMSU responded with three points from the game's leading scorer Zach Lofton, who tallied a game-high 22 points on the night, to cut the Lobo lead to six and eventually whittle UNM's advantage to three, 56-53 with 5:21 left.

The Aggies cut the deficit to one, 57-58 on a Lofton jumper and overtook the Lobos at the 2:34 mark on a Lofton layup, holding on for the win.

Lobo junior Anthony Mathis, who has been hot from behind the arc as of late, got a good look with the seconds winding down, but was forced to shoot from deep at the last second and missed. Mathis is 48.2 percent (27-56) on the season from three. Senior Joe Furstinger nearly got the putback before time expired.

As a team, UNM shot 39.9 percent compared to 42.6 percent for NMSU. The game marked just the second time this season that UNM committed more turnovers than its opponent (19-17). NMSU outscored the Lobos in the paint, 36-20, but UNM collected more points on the fast break, 11-8. Both teams tallied 13 second-chance points on the night.

The Lobos will have seven days to recuperate from Saturday's game vs. NMSU before taking on Arizona on Saturday, Dec. 16 at Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit on CBS Sports Network at 6 p.m.

## Lobos Fall to NMSU in Last-Minute Heartbreaker

**LAS CRUCES, N.M.** – The New Mexico State men’s basketball team was able to pull within 55-48 of Saint Mary’s with 7:17 remaining, but ultimately fell to mid-major power Saint Mary’s 73-58 at home Wednesday night in the Pan American Center.

“I loved how we started the game,” NM State head basketball coach Chris Jans said. “I thought the game went exactly the way we wanted it until about ten, nine minutes left in the game and then in went South. AJ [Harris] got two fouls and we couldn’t afford that and obviously we didn’t shoot the ball very well in the first half.”

The Aggies kept pace with the Gaels early on in the first half, leading 15-12 at the second media break (11:17). However, it was all Saint Mary’s the rest of the half. Behind Jordan Ford’s game-high 28 points, the Gaels went on a 20-8 run to close the first half and put the Aggies behind 32-23.

The Gaels didn’t miss a beat coming out of the break and went on a 9-2 run, forcing a timeout by NM State at the 18:09 mark down 41-24.

A 15-7 run ensued for NM State after that timeout by Coach Jans and brought the Aggies within 50-40 before Eli Chuha knocked a pair of shots at the charity stripe to make it 50-42 with 10:25 remaining.

But, the veteran team from Saint Mary’s weathered that storm and another run by New Mexico State that brought the Aggies within 55-48 with 7:17 left to go. A huge layup by Harris made it 61-51 in favor of the bad guys was answered with corner three and was followed by 3-pointer from Harris back on the other end.

However, it proved to be not enough as the Gaels extended its lead near the end and handed the Aggies the 73-58 loss.

“In the second half, the crowd tried to get us back in the game and we couldn’t quite get it to where we were close enough to potentially make them nervous and they did what championship teams do and they closed us out,” Jans said.

New Mexico State was led by Harris, who had 15 points on 6-of-14 shooting while Aurrecochea chipped in with 12 points and six boards off the bench. Chuha also added nine points and six rebounds for NM State while Brown finished with seven points and four boards himself.

Another rivalry game is on the horizon for New Mexico State as it heads north to #Aggiequerque to take on Battle of I-25 rival New Mexico Saturday, Nov. 17, at 4 p.m. (MT). Saturday’s rivalry game will be broadcast on AT&T Sports Network.

### THE GREATEST GAME EVER PLAYED

The Pit was the site of one of the greatest college basketball games ever played. It hosted the 1983 national championship game that saw the NC State Wolfpack upset Hakeem Olajuwon, Clyde Drexler and the Houston Cougars. Coach Jimmy Valvano and the Wolfpack downed the Cougars on a last second put back by Lorenzo Charles. The iconic shot of the late Valvano running onto the court looking for a hug is one of the lasting images in college basketball history.

- Built in 1966 (\$1.4 million)
- Capacity of 15,411 (previously 18,018)
- \$60 million renovation was completed in 2010
- New floor installed before the 2017-18 season
- Seating includes 40 suites and a club area
- Officially named Dreamstyle Arena in 2017 after a \$10 million agreement for naming rights by the local New Mexico business. It is still referred to as The Pit, its officially-recognized nickname. As part of the exciting Dreamstyle changes, University Stadium, UNM's football stadium, officially became Dreamstyle Arena on the same date.
- Less than 30 of 345 NCAA Division I basketball programs play in a college-only arena named after a business or organization founded or headquartered in its home state.
- The Lobos have averaged an astounding 15,410 fans the past 49 years, an amazing 95% of capacity
- The Pit has ranked in the top 25 in attendance nationally nearly every season since the 1966-67 season with 35 seasons in the top ten in the NCAA in attendance
- Led the Mountain West in attendance in 10 of the conference's 15 years of existence
- The floor is named Bob King Court in honor of the former head coach who led the Lobos from 1963 to 1972.
