#### Lobos Look to continue HOME-WINNING STREAK

New Mexico beach volleyball returns to action for its only home matches of the season as it hosts Arizona State, Abilene Christian and Colorado Mesa this weekend at Lucky 66 Bowl.

After playing their first 11 matches of the season on the road, the Lobos (2-9) are searching for some good home cooking as they face off against the Sun Devils (4-10), the Wildcats (1-7) and Mavericks (2-8).

This week's slate is key for UNM after struggling against a challenging stretch of matches to open the season. Through their first 11 matches, the Lobos played eight against teams either ranked or receiving votes in the national polls.

The Lobos will add another such contest this weekend, with ASU receiving votes in both the AVCA Coaches Poll and DiG Magazine Poll.

Nonetheless, New Mexico put up solid results during that season-opening span, battling the ranked opponents and falling by 3-2 scores in four of their losses.

Now back at home, the Lobos are eyeing some more success as they look to continue their 10game winning streak in Albuquerque.

Leading the charge are New Mexico's top-seeded tandems of **Maddie Irwin & Erin** Martin at the No. 1 position and Eastyn Baleto & Lauren Twitty at the No. 2 position.

Those duos have tallied solid records this season, with Irwin & Martin sitting at 5-6 and Baleto & Twitty at 4-4. However both tandems haven't won in the same match during the eight games that both tandems have played in.

Elsewhere, New Mexico has received decent production from its other pairs, but more consistency will be key going forward.

Two weeks ago at the Hickory Point Lake Bash in Tavares, Florida, UNM's No. 3 partnership of Chloe Crappell & Yasmin Tan earned their first victories of the season together, moving to 2-6 on the season.

Carly Beddingfield & Mercedes Pacheco also teamed up for the first time at the 4's, while Abbey Willison & Kayla Long won a point against UNC Wilmington at the 5's.

#### HOME COOKING

New Mexico beach volleyball hosts its only home matches of the season this week as the Lobos welcome Colorado Mesa, Abilene Christian and Arizona State to the Duke City.

Despite playing relatively few matches at home, UNM has built some considerable home-court advantage in Albuquerque over the first three years of its program.

The Lobos have played 12 home matches over the program's first 78 matches, winning their last 10 for an all-time .833 winning percentage in Albuquerque.

UNM has only dropped two points (out of 50 total) during its home-winning streak that includes team victories over two of its opponents this weekend, Arizona State and Colorado Mesa.

#### NIFTY 50

Through the first three years of the program, one Lobo has stood above the rest as the winningest player for UNM.

Eastyn Baleto, a senior from Seattle, continues her final year in the sand with 56 career wins in the sand, easily tops in the team's record books.

A three-year alum of the program, Julia Warren, is second with 47 wins, while Marisa Doran and Lise Rugland both have 41.

The next closest active player is Lauren Twitty

with 22 career wins.

Baleto's career record is 56-21 (.727), which stands second-best in program history with a minimum of 20 matches played. Only Doran (41-10, .803), her former partner, stands ahead of Baleto in regards to career winning percentage.

#### SHE'S BEEN EVERYWHERE

Over the course of the four-year history of New Mexico beach volleyball, only one player has managed to play at least one match in every position. That player: **Chloe Crappell**.

Crappell, a senior from Albuquerque, has seen action at the 1's, 2's, 3's, 4's and 5's positions for the Lobos.

She's played the bulk of her 37 career matches at the Nos. 2 and 3 courts, going 5-7 and 2-8, respectively. She is also 1-4 all-time at the 1's, and 4-2 at the 4's and 3-1 at the 5's.

The only other players who have come close to the platinum sombrero are current teammate **Lauren Twitty** and alumnae Julia Warren and Lise Rugland, who played in four of the five positions during the first four years of the program.

#### **SUCH DICE DEIGHBORS**

New Mexico is a bit of an island in the world of NCAA beach volleyball. The Lobos are the only team in the state of New Mexico to sponsor beach volleyball as an NCAA varsity sport, so with the lack of in-state competition, UNM has to find nearby neighbors for games.

With multiple schools in Arizona sponsoring the sport, the Lobos can travel west for some matches, which means New Mexico has played its fair share of games against those schools.

In fact, of the 78 matches ever played in UNM history, 20 have come against Arizona schools. (That's just over 25 percent.)

The Lobos have played Arizona seven times, Arizona State and Grand Canyon six times each. The 20th match came in the team's 2017 opener vs. Benedictine University at Mesa.

UNM will get more opportunities to add to this list during the 2018 season as it plays Arizona twice and Arizona State, Grand Canyon and Benedictine once each.

### HOME AWAY FROM HOME?

As noted above, the Lobos have played schools from Arizona a number of times, with 20 matches against Copper State schools through the first three seasons of the program.

However, New Mexico's affinity for the state of Arizona doesn't stop there.

Over the program's 78-match history, UNM has played 39 of its matches in the state of the Arizona, which is exactly half of its total number of matches.

This season, UNM will again venture west as

it's scheduled to play nine of its 22 matches in Arizona.

#### SCOUTING COLORADO MESA

A familiar for the Lobos — the teams have faced off against each other six times, with UNM winning all six — Colorado Mesa enters this weekend with a 2-8 record.

The Mavericks have played a challenging schedule so far, with four matches against teams ranked or receiving votes in the national polls. But CMU has fared relatively well, earning points in seven of its 10 matches.

Colorado Mesa is led by its top-seeded pairing of Katie Scherr/Taylor Woods, which has gone 4-6 this season with a couple of wins over Missouri State on its resume.

But the Mavericks have struggled at other positions in the lineup, owning no more than three wins in another spot. CMU is just 1-9 from the 3's and 2-8 from both the 4's and 5's.

#### SCOUTING ABILENE CHRISTIAN

Abilene Christian heads into its third week of competition looking to improve the team's first few weeks of action.

A first-year team, ACU went winless to open is season at the Cactus Classic in Tucson, falling twice to San Jose State and once to Arizona and Benedictine at Mesa. Then, two weeks ago, the Wildcats dropped three of four — including a match vs. UNM — in Phoenix.

ACU's only win so far this season was a rematch against Benedictine at Mesa.

Nonetheless, the Wildcats have the capability to score. In the first meeting between Abilene Christian and New Mexico, ACU scored a point behind Katelyn Mueller & Eighmy Dobbins.

But they were the only players on ACU's 19-player roster to score more than once two weeks ago. The only duo with more than two wins on the season are Jacey Smith & Kendall Bosse, who are 3-5 from the No. 1 position.

### SCOUTING ARIZONA STATE

Arizona State enters the weekend having lost six of its last seven, but did earn a 4-1 win over a Washington team that swept New Mexico on the opening weekend of the season.

The Sun Devils, led by second-year coach Brad Keenan, are receiving votes in both of the national polls, with their four wins coming against UW, Nebraska, TCU and San Jose State.

Over the first four weeks of the season, ASU has notched a single win each weekend.

Arizona State is led by the back end of its lineup. The Sun Devils' No. 3 duo of Katelyn Carballo & Ellyson Lundberg is 8-4, while their No. 4 tandem of Katie Cross & Cierra Flood is 8-5 and their No. 5 pairing of Kate Baldwin & Samantha Plaster is 9-4.

Arizona State and New Mexico, with ASU holding a 4-2 advantage in the series. The Sun Devils won both matches in 2017, with the Lobos claiming two contests — including one in Albuquerque — in 2016.

#### BEACH VOLLEYBALL CONTINUES ACADEMIC SUCCESS IN FALL 2017

After posting another strong campaign in the sand last spring, the University of New Mexico beach volleyball team posted a superb semester in the classroom last fall.

The Lobos registered a team GPA of 3.84 for the Fall 2017 semester, the second-highest team GPA in the seven-semester history of the program. The Lobos' Fall 2017 GPA trails only their Spring 2017 GPA of 3.85.

This past semester was the sixth semester that the team registered a mark of at least 3.4.

The beach team combined with the rest of the women's sports at UNM for a 3.57 GPA. It's the 21st straight semester of at least a 3.3 GPA and the ninth straight semester with at least a 3.5 recorded by the combined women's teams, as well.

#### BEACH VOLLEYBALL EARNS AUCA TEAM ACADEMIC AWARD IN 2017

New Mexico beach volleyball was honored by the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) on Monday, July 24, as the Lobos earned the AVCA Team Academic Award for the 2016-17 academic year.

The team recorded team GPAs of 3.46 in both the Fall 2016 and Spring 2017 semesters.

The award, which was initiated in the 1992-93 academic year, honors collegiate and high school volleyball teams that displayed excellence in the classroom during the school year by maintaining at least a 3.30 cumulative team GPA on a 4.0 scale.

19 collegiate beach teams were recognized for the 2016-17 academic year.

This honor was the first such selection for the program, which wrapped up its third season of competition last spring. The Lobos logged back-to-back program records in GPA during the 2016-17 academic semesters.

#### A PRIMER ON BEACH VOLLEYBALL

Beach volleyball and court volleyball share many of the same basic rules. Each side gets three hits, there's rally scoring, and a team earns a points when the ball hits the ground or goes out of bounds. But there are some key difference between the two sports:

- Beach volleyball is a partner sport played during the spring. Court volleyball is a six-player sport played during the fall.
- Beach volleyball plays the best of three sets, with the first two sets played to 21 points, and a tiebreaker set played to 15 points, if necessary. A set must be won by at least two points.

- Open-handed tipping is prohibited in beach volleyball and the block touch counts as one of three permitted contacts.
- Coaches may only speak or give any kind of input to their players during timeouts or between sets.
- Beach volleyball players switch sides of the court every seven points during a 21-point set and every five points during a 15-point set.
- Beach volleyball is usually contested in dual matches, where the winning team is the school that wins three of five individual matches versus its opponent. Similar in format to tennis, each of those individual matches consist of a doubles — a pair of teammates ranked by ability — that are matched against their corresponding doubles from the opposing team.

### BEACH VOLLEYBALL ENTERS 3RD SEASON AS 90TH NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

Before the 2016 season, the NCAA approved beach volleyball as the 90th NCAA Championship at the 2015 NCAA Convention, which allowed the sport to advance from the emerging sports for women list to a full-fledged NCAA championship.

The NCAA Beach Volleyball Committee also determined the sport will be officially referred to as "beach volleyball". When the sport was placed on the list of emerging sports for women in 2009, it was called sand volleyball. But because the sport is known as beach volleyball at all other levels of play throughout the world, the committee made its decision to refer to the sport as beach volleyball.

The third-annual NCAA Beach Volleyball Championships will take place May 4-6, 2018 at the Beach at Gulf Shores in Gulf Shore, Alabama. The championship will have an eight-team bracket that will be played in a double-elimination format.

USC has won the first two NCAA National Championships, 3-0 over Florida State in 2016 and 3-2 over Pepperdine in 2017.

Beach volleyball is the fastest-growing NCAA sport with 55 Division I colleges and universities sponsoring. NCAA rules require 40 sponsoring schools to request an NCAA championship. Data shows that on average, 60 percent of participants at a sponsoring school participate only in beach volleyball instead of playing both beach and indoor volleyball.
