NEW MEXICO HEADS TO BAKERSFIELD TO FACE 'RUNNERS

New Mexico beach volleyball, hot off a strong performance last weekend at home, looks to continue building momentum as it faces off against CSU Bakersfield on Friday.

Winners of three of their last four, the Lobos (5-10) have designs on adding another win in their only match of the week as they take on the Roadrunners (3-10) at the Barnes Beach Volleyball Complex in Bakersfield.

Although New Mexico is only slated to play one match this week, it's an important one as the Lobos aim for continued improvement.

After a solid showing last weekend in their only home tournament of the season, the youthful Lobos are rolling. Now, as they venture to California for just their seventh match all-time in the state, the key is maintaining that momentum.

Luckily for the Lobos, they've had some firstyear players step up in a big way over the past few weeks.

At the No. 1 position, newcomers **Maddie Irwin & Erin Martin** have provided steadfast leadership, winning five of their last six matches en route to an 8-7 overall record this season.

Over their last six matches, they logged a fourgame winning streak, the longest-ever by a tandem in the No. 1 slot.

Additionally, UNM's No. 2 duo of **Eastyn Baleto & Lauren Twitty** has been stellar, sweeping through the team's home tournament last week. They've won four straight and seven of their last nine to sit at 8-4 this season.

New Mexico also earned some more consistency down its lineup last weekend, with multiple pairs winning multiple matches.

Chloe Crappell & Yasmin Tan have won four of their last five matches at the No. 3 position, while Carly Beddingfield & Mercedes Pacheco have started clicking at the No. 4 spot.

The 5's was also a source of points in Albuquerque, with **Abbey Willison & Kayla Long** teaming up for two wins last weekend. Willison, playing primarily from the 5's, has gone 7-8 this year, tied for fifth-most individual wins this season.

THIS WEEK



60 And Counting...

Through the first three years of the program, one Lobo has stood above the rest as the winningest player for UNM.

Eastyn Baleto, a senior from Seattle, enters the final weeks of her collegiate beach volleyball career with exactly 60 career wins in the sand, easily tops in the team's record books.

A three-year alum of the program, Julia Warren, is second with 47 wins, while Marisa Doran and Lise Rugland both have 41.

The next closest active player is **Lauren Twitty** with 26 career wins.

Baleto's career record is 60-21 (.741), which stands second-best in program history with a minimum of 20 matches played. Only Doran (41-10, .803), her former partner, stands ahead of Baleto in regards to career winning percentage.

STREAKING

So far this season the Lobos have registered some strong results at the top of their lineup, with their Nos. 1 and 2 pairings both tallying four-match winning streaks over the last two weeks of competition.

At the No. 1 position, the tandem of **Maddie Irwin & Erin Martin** won four in row to set the program record for most consecutive wins out of the top-seeded position.

The duo started at the Stetson/Hickory Point Lake Bash with wins over UNC Wilmington and the College of Charleston and continued at the team's home tournament with wins over Colorado Mesa and Abilene Christian.

The duo didn't drop a point over the four matches, tying for the ninth-best set-winning streak in program history.

Also trying for that distinction was the partnership of **Eastyn Baleto & Lauren Twitty**, who have an active four-match winning streak. The tandem swept through the Lobos' home tournament, winning every contest in straight sets.

This winning streak gives Baleto six of the 15 longest pairs winning streaks in program history.

FIVE FOR FIGHTING

Over the course of the four-year history of New Mexico beach volleyball, only two players have managed to play at least one match in every position. Those players: **Chloe Crappell** and **Lauren Twitty**.

Crappell, a senior from Albuquerque, and Twitty, a sophomore from The Broadlands, Virginia, have seen action at the 1's, 2's, 3's, 4's and 5's positions for the Lobos.

For Crappell, she's played the bulk of her 41 career matches at the Nos. 2 and 3 courts, going 5-7 and 5-9, respectively. She is also 1-4 all-time at the 1's, and 4-2 at the 4's and 3-1 at the 5's.

For Twitty, the majority of her 35 career matches have come at the No. 5 position, where she's posted a 14-4 record. She's also gone 4-1 at the 2's, 4-3 at the 3's and 3-1 at the 4's.

Twitty achieved the feat of playing all five positions during the Lobos' only homestand of 2018 as she made her one and only appearance at the 1's, winning it to go 26-9 in her career.

The only other players who have come close to the platinum sombrero are current teammate **Eastyn Baleto** and alumnae Julia Warren and Lise Rugland, who played in four of the five positions during the first four years of the program.

THE 2016 GOLDEN STATE WARRIORS

No this isn't about the NBA team that set the best ever regular-season record of 73–9 and blew a 3-1 lead in the NBA Finals.

This is about the 2016 New Mexico women's beach volleyball team that won all six of the team's matches played in California ("The Golden State") that year.

In fact, that 6-0 run through Cali is the Lobos' only foray to the state over the 82-match history of the program.

As New Mexico gets set to play CSU Bakersfield in Bakersfield, California, this Friday, it's appropriate we take a look at the team's history in the state.

Admittedly, there isn't much history, as the Lobos didn't play in California in 2015 or 2017. The six matches UNM played in 2016 are the only so far.

But, New Mexico had great success in those six matches, winning 26 out of a possible 30 sets.

Of the seven states the Lobos have played in, California is just one of two (along with Alabama) were they haven't lost.

SUCH DICE DEIGHBORS

New Mexico is a bit of an island in the world of NCAA beach volleyball. The Lobos are the only

team in the state of New Mexico to sponsor beach volleyball as an NCAA varsity sport, so with the lack of in-state competition, UNM has to find nearby neighbors for games.

With multiple schools in Arizona sponsoring the sport, the Lobos can travel west for some matches, which means New Mexico has played its fair share of games against those schools.

In fact, of the 82 matches ever played in UNM history, 21 have come against Arizona schools. (That's just over 25 percent at 25.6 percent.)

The Lobos have played Arizona and Arizona State seven times each and Grand Canyon six times. The 21st match came in the team's 2017 opener vs. Benedictine University at Mesa.

UNM will get more opportunities to add to this list during the 2018 season as it plays Arizona twice and Arizona State, Grand Canyon and Benedictine once each.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME?

As noted above, the Lobos have played schools from Arizona a number of times, with 21 matches against Copper State schools through the first three seasons of the program.

However, New Mexico's affinity for the state of Arizona doesn't stop there.

Over the program's 82-match history, UNM has played 39 of its matches in the state of the Arizona, which is just under half of its total number of matches (47.6 percent).

This season, UNM will again venture west as it's scheduled to play nine of its 22 matches in Arizona.

HOME COOKING

New Mexico beach volleyball hosted its only home matches of the season to end March, picking up three wins as it hosted Colorado Mesa, Abilene Christian and Arizona State.

Despite playing relatively few matches at home, UNM continued its considerable home-court advantage in Albuquerque.

The Lobos have played 16 home matches over the program's first 82 matches, winning 13 for an all-time .813 winning percentage in Albuquerque.

New Mexico had a 12-game winning streak going for the better parts of four seasons as the team didn't lose a home match between its April 18, 2015 contest vs. Colorado State and its March 30, 2018 contest vs. Abilene Christian. Arizona State snapped the streak on March 31, 2018.

SCOUTING CSU BAKERSFIELD

The Roadrunners enter this week's tilt owners of a 3-10 record and losers of seven straight matches. CSU Bakersfield only has one Division I win (a first-year Missouri State team) and has been swept in five of its last seven contests.

That said, CSUB has played a challenging schedule. Playing in the Big West, the 'Runners have faced some of the top teams in the NCAA,

with five matches against top-10 teams and seven matches overall vs. ranked squads.

CSU Bakersfield has altered its lineup throughout the season, with only two pairs playing all 13 matches together. Emily Hansen/Sydney Haynes are 3-10 from the No. 1 court, while Mattison Degarmo/Emily Lopes have gone 4-9 primarily out of the No. 3 position. No pairing has more than four wins this season.

This will be the fourth meeting all-time between the two teams, with one matchup each season since 2015. CSUB won the first meeting 3-2 in 2015, but the Lobos have captured the last two. This is the first meeting between the two teams not at a neutral site.

BEACH VOLLEYBALL CONTINUES ACADEMIC SUCCESS IN FALL 2017

After posting another strong campaign in the sand last spring, the University of New Mexico beach volleyball team posted a superb semester in the classroom last fall.

The Lobos registered a team GPA of 3.84 for the Fall 2017 semester, the second-highest team GPA in the seven-semester history of the program. The Lobos' Fall 2017 GPA trails only their Spring 2017 GPA of 3.85.

This past semester was the sixth semester that the team registered a mark of at least 3.4.

The beach team combined with the rest of the women's sports at UNM for a 3.57 GPA. It's the 21st straight semester of at least a 3.3 GPA and the ninth straight semester with at least a 3.5 recorded by the combined women's teams, as well.

BEACH VOLLEYBALL EARNS AVCA TEAM ACADEMIC AWARD IN 2017

New Mexico beach volleyball was honored by the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) on Monday, July 24, as the Lobos earned the AVCA Team Academic Award for the 2016-17 academic year.

The team recorded team GPAs of 3.46 in both the Fall 2016 and Spring 2017 semesters.

The award, which was initiated in the 1992-93 academic year, honors collegiate and high school volleyball teams that displayed excellence in the classroom during the school year by maintaining at least a 3.30 cumulative team GPA on a 4.0 scale.

19 collegiate beach teams were recognized for the 2016-17 academic year.

This honor was the first such selection for the program, which wrapped up its third season of competition last spring. The Lobos logged back-to-back program records in GPA during the 2016-17 academic semesters.

A PRIMER ON BEACH VOLLEYBALL

Beach volleyball and court volleyball share many of the same basic rules. Each side gets three hits, there's rally scoring, and a team earns a points when the ball hits the ground or goes out of bounds. But there are some key difference between the two sports:

- Beach volleyball is a partner sport played during the spring. Court volleyball is a six-player sport played during the fall.
- Beach volleyball plays the best of three sets, with the first two sets played to 21 points, and a tiebreaker set played to 15 points, if necessary. A set must be won by at least two points.
- Open-handed tipping is prohibited in beach volleyball and the block touch counts as one of three permitted contacts.
- Coaches may only speak or give any kind of input to their players during timeouts or between sets.
- Beach volleyball players switch sides of the court every seven points during a 21-point set and every five points during a 15-point set.
- Beach volleyball is usually contested in dual matches, where the winning team is the school that wins three of five individual matches versus its opponent. Similar in format to tennis, each of those individual matches consist of a doubles — a pair of teammates ranked by ability — that are matched against their corresponding doubles from the opposing team.

BEACH VOLLEYBALL ENTERS 3RD SEASON AS 90TH NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

Before the 2016 season, the NCAA approved beach volleyball as the 90th NCAA Championship at the 2015 NCAA Convention, which allowed the sport to advance from the emerging sports for women list to a full-fledged NCAA championship.

The NCAA Beach Volleyball Committee also determined the sport will be officially referred to as "beach volleyball". When the sport was placed on the list of emerging sports for women in 2009, it was called sand volleyball. But because the sport is known as beach volleyball at all other levels of play throughout the world, the committee made its decision to refer to the sport as beach volleyball.

The third-annual NCAA Beach Volleyball Championships will take place May 4-6, 2018 at the Beach at Gulf Shores in Gulf Shore, Alabama. The championship will have an eight-team bracket that will be played in a double-elimination format.

USC has won the first two NCAA National Championships, 3-0 over Florida State in 2016 and 3-2 over Pepperdine in 2017.

Beach volleyball is the fastest-growing NCAA sport with 55 Division I colleges and universities sponsoring. NCAA rules require 40 sponsoring schools to request an NCAA championship. Data shows that on average, 60 percent of participants at a sponsoring school participate only in beach volleyball instead of playing both beach and indoor volleyball.
