MATADORS HOST LOBOS FOR FIRST TIME IN TEAM HISTORY

CSUN Men's Basketball opens up its 61st season on the hardwood on Tuesday evening. For the first time in program history, the Matadors host New Mexico on The Blacktop @ The Matadome at 7 p.m in both teams' season opener. The game will stream live on the CSUN Sports Network presented by Dignity Health and courtesy of Big West.TV. Ghizal Hasan and Alan Zinsmeister are on the call for the home opener.

The Matadors are coming off a pair of exhibition victories over the past two weeks. CSUN kicked off the Mark Gottfried era with a near wire-to-wire win over Antelope Valley, 88-77. Freshman Lamine Diane posted a double-double in his first ever game with the Matadors, scoring 30 points and collecting 17 rebounds off the bench. Sophomore Terrell Gomez found his stroke from outside range as he knocked down four 3-pointers and finished with 19 points.

Last Thursday, the Matadors held on for a narrow win over Cal State LA by the score of 89-87. The Matadors again enjoyed a double-digit lead, this time by 18 points before Cal State LA trimmed the deficit to two points with a minute to play. However, the Matadors would prevail behind late free throws from Gomez. Diane again led all scorers, finishing with 23 points and 14 rebounds while sophomore Alex Sokol came off the bench to tally 21 points including five 3-pointers.

The Matadors' sixth head coach in team history, Gottfried enters his first season at CSUN. Gottfried brings an amazing track record of success with him including 20 years of head coaching experience at the Division I level. With stops at Murray State, Alabama and NC State, Gottfried has led 11 teams to the NCAA Tournament in his career. Prior to his head coaching days, Gottfried served as an assistant to Jim Harrick at UCLA where he would go on to win the 1995 National Championship. Gottfried has assembled an experienced coaching staff this season, which includes Harrick, Jeff Dunlap and Mo Williams.

CSUN sports one of the youngest rosters in the country this season. The Matadors return four letterwinners from last season and bring aboard eight newcomers along with two redshirt freshmen from last's season's squad. CSUN has eight freshmen on its team, two sophomores, two juniors and just two seniors, one of which is a graduate transfer.

Last season's Big West Freshman of the Year, Gomez returns to the Matadors this season along with senior Blair Orr, junior Mahamadou Kaba-Camara and sophomore Alex Sokol. Gomez led the Big West in 3-point percentage (46.1) and minutes per game (34.1) last season to go with 11.7 points. In all, the Matador returners only played in 21.3 percent of the team's total minutes last season. After sitting out last season, Diane (Findlay Prep) and Jared Pearre (McKinney North High School) return to the squad as redshirt freshmen this season.

The team signed six true freshmen during the offseason, which include Elijah Harkless (Etiwanda High School), Darius Brown II (Pasadena High School), Brendan Harrick (Esperanza High School), Teddy Ochieng (Cantwell-Sacred Heart of Mary High School), Avery Martinez (Cantwell-Sacred Heart of Mary High School) and Michael Ou (Menaul School).

Rounding out the roster, the Matadors also added junior college transfer Rodney Henderson Jr. and graduate transfer Cameron Gottfried. Henderson Jr. played last season at Santiago Canyon College where he averaged 27 points per game. Gottfried, who is the son of head coach Mark Gottfried, spent two seasons at Siena College before transferring to NC State in 2016 where he stayed for the next two seasons.

The Matadors seek their first ever victory over New Mexico on Tuesday night. The Lobos have won five all-time meetings including four games in Albuquerque. The teams last met in Nov. 2016 with the Lobos pulling off a 105-89 win in a game played at Cal State Fullerton. Only two players, one of from each team, played in that game as Kaba-Camara saw five minutes for CSUN, picking up a block while UNM's senior Dane Kuiper played two minutes.

A CLOSER LOOK AT NEW MEXICO

The Lobos finished last season 19-15 and 12-6 in the Mountain West for a third-place finish in the league. UNM would advance to the Mountain West Tournament Championship game before falling to San Diego State. In the conference's preseason media poll, New Mexico was picked to finish third. The team though sports a new look this season with only four letterwinners returning from the 2017-18 squad.

Senior Anthony Mathis posted the fourth-best 3-point shooting percentage in the nation last season, hitting on 47.3 of his shots from long range. Mathis averaged 12.7 points and also shot 85.9 percent from the free throw line. Also returning this season, sophomore Makuach Maluach scored 9.6 points in over 19 minutes per game. Earning Preseason Mountain West Newcomer of the Year accolades, sophomore Vance Jackson played his freshman season at UConn where he averaged 8.1 points.

MATADOR NOTEBOOK

- CSUN boasts one of the youngest rosters in the country. The Matadors have eight freshmen, two sophomores, two juniors and two seniors this season. As a group, only four returners are on this season's roster.
- The Matadors have nine players that played at Southern California high schools.
- The team sports five international players: **Teddy Ochieng** (Kenya), **Avery Martinez** (Costa Rica), **Michael Ou** (China), **Mahamadou Kaba-Camara** (Guinea) and **Lamine Diane** (Senegal).
- CSUN hosts 16 games at The Matadome this season, which ties a school record.
- The Matadors host New Mexico on opening night for the first time in team history. CSUN has not hosted a Mountain West Conference team since 2000-01 (Wyoming).
- This season, the Matadors will leave California just four times. The team stays home until the end of the month when the Matadors travel to Washington State on November 27. CSUN also visits New Mexico State (Dec. 19) and Hawai'i (March 2) this season.
- CSUN participates in the Las Vegas Classic for the first time this season. After road games at San Diego (Dec. 9) and New Mexico State (Dec. 19), the Matadors head to Las Vegas to take on SIUE on Dec. 22. A day later, the Matadors will either face Northern Colorado or Rider.

GOMEZ COMING OFF FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR CAMPAIGN

Freshman Terrell Gomez became the third Matador in history to be named Big West Freshman of the Year

- Led the Big West in minutes per game (34.1) and 3-point percentage (46.1) last season
- Placed seventh in the conference in assists per game (3.6)
- Finished third on the team in scoring with 11.7 points per game
- Also hit 80.0 percent of his free throws for the year
- Knocked down at least one 3-pointer in 29 of 30 games in 2017-18
- Posted first career double-double with 10 points and a career-high 10 assists vs. UC Davis (2/1/18)
- Picked up 20 points on 7-of-11 shooting to go with four assists vs. Cal Poly (1/20/18)
- Registered a season-high 24 points and six 3-pointers at Long Beach State (1/10/18)
- Recorded 20 points on 9-of-14 shooting to go with five assists and four rebounds at California (11/28/17)
- Prepped at Inglewood High School before playing post-grad basketball at Middlebrooks Academy

RETURNING FOR THE MATADORS...

Senior center Blair Orr, **junior center Mahamadou Kaba-Camara** and **sophomore guard Alex Sokol** are among the returning letterwinners this season while two redshirt freshmen, forward **Lamine Diane** and **Jared Pearre**, also return to the team.

- A two-year letterwinner, Orr saw action in 10 games and averaged 1.2 points in 3.8 minutes last season.
- Kaba-Camara averaged 9.4 minutes per game last season, averaging 1.5 points and 2.0 rebounds.
- Sokol competed in seven games last season, averaging 1.7 minutes per game.
- Diane played two seasons with national power Findlay Prep in Las Vegas, Nev. where he helped the Pilots earn a trip to the semifinals of the Dick's Sporting Goods High School Nationals in 2016-17.
- Pearre earned three all-district first team honors along with Newcomer of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year awards in his high school career at McKinney North High School (Texas).

EIGHT NEWCOMERS ADDED TO ROSTER

- A 6-foot-1 guard, **Darius Brown II** guided his hometown Pasadena High School to the CIF Southern Section Division I-AA Finals this past season. A two-time Pasadena Star News All-Area Selection, Brown averaged 15 points, 11 assists, five steals and five rebounds per game for the Bulldogs last season.
- **Elijah Harkless** hails from Rialto, Calif., and is a 6-foot-3 versatile guard who prepped at Etiwanda High School. Harkless averaged over 10 points and five assists per game last season as he was named to the All-Baseline First Team and to the Sun/Daily Bulletin All-Area squad.
- An Anaheim native, **Brendan Harrick** averaged over 21 points and nine rebounds as a senior for Esperanza High School. Harrick helped lead the Aztecs to the CIF State Division II Championship.
- **Rodney "Rocket" Henderson Jr.** played last season at Santiago Canyon College where he averaged 27 points and nine rebounds. Originally from Carson, Calif., Henderson prepped at St. John Bosco High School and led the Braves to a CIF and state championship.
- Originally from Heredia, Costa Rica, 6-foot-5 guard **Avery Martinez** was named to the Whittier Daily News All-Area Team twice for Cantwell-Sacred Heart of Mary High School in Montebello, Calif.
- Teammate of Martinez, **Teddy Ochieng** (Nairobi, Kenya) played for his country's U-18 team before spending one season at Cantwell. A 6-foot-8 forward, Ochieng helped his team post 20 victories last season.
- A 6-foot-9 center from Guangdong, China, **Michael Ou** averaged over 19 points and 11 rebounds for Menaul School in Albuquerque, N.M. last season. Ou helped Menaul finish 26-6 on the year.
- Graduate transfer **Cameron Gottfried** spent two seasons at Siena from 2014-16 before moving on to NC State in 2016. Son of head coach Mark Gottfried, the 6-foot-3 guard earned his degree in business administration at NC State.

EXPERIENCED COACHING STAFF LEADING THE MATADORS

- **Mark Gottfried** has 11 NCAA Tournament appearances in his 20-year head coaching career. He spent six seasons at NC State, helping the Wolfpack advance to a pair of Sweet Sixteens. Gottfried also guided Alabama to five NCAA Tournament trips including an Elite Eight appearance in 2004. In his career, Gottfried won a National Championship as an assistant coach under **Jim Harrick** at UCLA.
- Assistant coach **Jim Harrick** has led four programs to the NCAA Tournament in his head coaching career, which spans three decades. A former National Coach of the Year, Harrick guided UCLA to its first National Championship in 20 years in 1995. He also served as head coach at Pepperdine, Rhode Island and Georgia.
- A 30-year coaching veteran, assistant coach **Jeff Dunlap** served last season as a head coach and general manager of the St. John's Edge of the National Basketball League of Canada. He previously worked as an assistant to Gottfried and Harrick in his extensive career.
- After an outstanding 13-year NBA career, **Mo Williams** joined the CSUN coaching staff this season. Williams won an NBA Championship with the Cleveland Cavaliers in his last season in the league. A former Sporting News National Freshman of the Year, Williams played for Gottfried for two seasons at Alabama.

HEAD COACH MARK GOTTFRIED

First Season • Alabama, 1987 • 401-241 Overall Division I Record



An 11-time NCAA Tournament coach, Mark Gottfried became the sixth head basketball coach in team history on March 13, 2018.

Coaching in the Power Five Atlantic Coast and Southeastern Conferences, Gottfried brings an amazing track record of success to the Matadors after coaching

stops at Alabama, NC State and Murray State. Most recently, he worked as an assistant coach and scout for the Dallas Mavericks.

Gottfried has led three programs to a total of 15 national tournaments including an NCAA Tournament Elite Eight appearance and three Sweet Sixteen trips.

Gottfried comes to the Matadors after six seasons with NC State from 2011-17 where he led the Wolfpack to four NCAA Tournament appearances. He coached NC State to the Sweet Sixteen in his first season and back-to-back 24-win seasons in 2011-12 and 2012-13. In his second season at the helm, Gottfried guided NC State to a victory over top-ranked Duke, 84-76. He would lead the team to another Sweet Sixteen trip in 2014-15 after eliminating No. 1 seed Villanova.

Prior to NC State, he coached his alma-mater Alabama for 11 seasons as the Crimson Tide won two SEC championships and advanced to five NCAA Tournaments over that time. After coaching Alabama to an NIT runner-up finish in 2000-01, Gottfried led the team to a 27-win season and a conference championship. For his efforts, Gottfried was named 2002 SEC Coach of the Year. The next season, Alabama earned a No. 1 ranking in the AP poll for the first time in school history. In the 2003-04 campaign, Alabama upset top-ranked and top-seeded Stanford in the second round of the NCAA Tournament, and then defeated national champion Syracuse to reach the school's first-ever Elite Eight.

He began his head coaching career at Murray State where he became the first coach to win three Ohio Valley Conference titles in only three years. The Racers advanced to the NIT in his first season and the NCAA Tournament in back-to-back years in 1997 and 1998. Murray State ranked 25th in the final AP poll with a record of 29-4 in 1997-98.

Gottfried's time on the sidelines began at UCLA where he served as an assistant on Jim Harrick's coaching staff for seven seasons. After making six-straight trips to the Big Dance, the Bruins won the 1995 National Championship in Gottfried's final season in Westwood. He also helped coach UCLA to the Elite Eight in 1992 and the Sweet Sixteen in 1990.

Gottfried began his collegiate playing career at Oral Roberts in 1983. In his only season with the Golden Eagles, Gottfried earned freshman All-American honors. He transferred to Alabama, where he started 98 consecutive games and helped the Crimson Tide advance to Sweet Sixteen three-straight seasons. Gottfried currently holds the school record for the most 3-point field goals in a single game (8) and is the school's all-time leader in 3-point field goal percentage (.485). After his collegiate career, Gottfried was selected in the seventh round by the Detroit Pistons in the 1987 NBA Draft.

He earned a degree in communications from Alabama in 1987. Gottfried received the Hayden Riley Top Scholar Award

and the Bryant Award as the school's top scholar-athlete in his senior campaign.

Gottfried has four sons, Brandon, Cameron, Aaron and Dillon, and one daughter, Mary Layson. His father, Joe is a former Director of Athletics at South Alabama. His uncle, Mike, was a former college football coach and ESPN analyst.
