ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- The Lobos enter Tuesday's game a perfect 12-0 inside Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit this season.
- UNM is coming off of a pair of tough road losses at Colorado State (105-72) and at UNLV (99-78).
- SJSU also most recently played UNLV prior to their bye weekend. The Spartans fell to the Runnin' Rebels by 11 points (98-87).
- The Lobos lead the series with the Spartans 14-3 overall including an 8-1 advantage in Albuquerque dating back to Dec. 21, 1961.
- SJSU has won the last two meetings between the teams, both in San Jose.
- The last time the two teams met was on New Year's Day when the Spartans claimed a three-point victory.
- The Lobos are led by a pair of active players in double figures on the season including redshirt-senior JaQuan Lyle (17.1) and senior Corey Manigault (11.5).
- In Mountain West play, Lyle boasts 18.9 points per game followed by Manigault (13.4) and redshirt-junior Vance Jackson (12.3).
- The Spartans are led by just one player averaging in double figures, sophomore Seneca Knight (14.6). In MW play however, Knight leads with 18.6 points per game, followed by senior Brae Ivey (12.9).

LAST TIME OUT

For the first time this season, UNM suffered its second-straight road loss with a 99-78 showing at UNLV on Saturday night. While the Lobos led for the majority of the first half, the Runnin' Rebels jumped ahead in the final minute with a halftime lead that they did not again relinquish.

The five Lobo starters played over 30 minutes of the 40-minute game including 35 or more from four of them: senior Corey Manigault (35), redshirt-sophomore Vante Hendrix (35), junior Makuach Maluach (37) and redshirt-senior JaQuan Lyle (39).

UNDEFEATED AT HOME

With the Lobos' victory over Air Force at home last Tuesday, UNM is now 12-0 in home contests inside Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit.

The last time the Lobos achieved a 12-0 record at home was in 2005-06.

The last time UNM was 13-0 at home was in the 1998-99 season in which the squad ultimately went 16-0 before falling to Utah.

LOBOS IN LATE-NIGHT MATCHUPS

UNM has competed in just two contests at 8 p.m. or later (local time) this season, both of which have been in MW play.

The Lobos are 1-1 in 8 p.m. or later games, with the loss coming against SJSU in San Jose on Jan. 1.

LOBOS WITH LONG MINUTES

Recent roster struggles have caused the remaining Lobos to play some long minutes. In UNM's most recent contest against UNLV, all five starters saw over 30 minutes and in the second half, the Runnin' Rebels ran through the Lobos as the squad ran out of energy.

UNM headed into the halftime break down by just three before being outscored by 18 in the final 20 minutes.

CONTROLLING THE BALL

UNM has worked hard this season on ball control and through 18 games had allowed less than 10 steals in 15 of them. In the last two however, UNM has struggled to hang onto the ball, allowing 12 steals at Colorado State followed immediately by 10 at UNLV.

KUAC BREAKS OUT

In Wednesday's game against CSU, the Lobos allowed some new talent to play some minutes and develop. Freshman Emmanuel Kuac burst off the bench with energy and in 12 minutes went

3-for-4 from the floor including 2-for-2 from 3-point range for eight points, three rebounds and one steal. His points also included his first career dunk.

Kuacsaw a career-high 13 minutes against UNLV Saturday, sinking a 3-pointer just 12 seconds after entering the game.

RECEIVING VOTES CURSE?

The Lobos have suffered a trio of large-margin defeats this season in now No. 16 Auburn (25 points) and, most recently, against Colorado State (33 points) and UNLV (21 points). What do these contests have in common? Immediately before the contests, the Lobos began receiving votes in the national polls.

LOBO BOUNCEBACK

Head coach Paul Weir has talked about the resiliency of this year's Lobo squad throughout the season and the numbers are there to back it up. UNM has battled back after its losses and is not to be counted out - even after a big one. The Lobos are 3-1 after losses this season. One of those wins was a victory over (RV) Wisconsin just hours after a 25-point defeat to now No. 16 Auburn.

LOBOS IN THE NATION

The Lobos are one of just 32 squads in the country to have

accumulated at least 14 victories over DI opponents so far this season.

TALES OF THE HALF

The Lobos are a perfect 11-0 this season when leading at halftime, 3-4 when trailing and 1-1 when tied. In conference play, UNM is 4-0 when leading or tied at the break but winless (0-3) when trailing.

LOBO DOUBLE-DOUBLE - ON THE ASSIST

Redshirt-senior JaQuan Lyle had a standout performance Jan. 7 against Fresno State, posting UNM's first double-double in points and assists since Antino Jackson did so on Feb. 10, 2018, two seasons ago. Lyle racked up 14 points and 10 assists to go along with three steals.

BEST SHOOTERS IN THE NATION

The Lobos are in the top 10 of the best shooting teams in the country, checking in at 7th shooting 49.4 percent from the floor. UNM also leads the Mountain West in FG%.

1,000 POINTS

Despite a tough defeat on the road at San José State on New Year's Day, redshirt-senior JaQuan Lyle provided a sparkling moment when he reached his 1,000th career point in the contest.

After accumulating 743 points in two seasons at Ohio State, he has added 342 in his brief career on the court as a Lobo to total 1,085 career points so far.

He netted 391 as a Buckeye freshman in 2015-16 followed by 352 as a sophomore in 2016-17 before his arrival at UNM.

MARTIN JOINS THE 1K CLUB

Redshirt-junior Zane Martin is the most recent Lobo to achieve the 1,000-point

career mark with his 10-point performance against UNLV. Martin racked up 815 during his time at Towson. He has so far collected 193 points as a Lobo in his junior season after totaling 180 as a freshman and an outstanding 635 as a sophomore at Towson.

SCORING RECORD WATCH

Redshirt-senior JaQuan Lyle has collected 342 points so far in 20 games at UNM and is on track to potentially crack the top 20 in UNM history for single-season scoring.

Charles Smith scored 577 points in the 1996-97 season (17.5 ppg) and ranks 20th in Lobo history. With 235 points to go to match it and at least 12 games left of the season, Lyle could make his mark in the record book in single-season scoring this year.

JACKSON BACK ON TOP

Redshirt-junior Vance Jackson has come back out of his shell in recent games after finishing last season earning a spot on the Mountain West All-Tournament Team.

After starting the first 12 games of the season averaging just 6.2 points per game, Jackson is averaging 14.4 points over the last seven contests.

On Jan. 1 at San José State, he registered a season-high 25 points and his first double-double of the season with 13. His 13 rebounds also marked a UNM career high.

He followed up that outstanding performance Jan. 7 vs Fresno State with a new season-high 29 points and 13 rebounds, marking his second straight double-double this season.

JACKSON FOR THREE

Not only did redshirt-junior Vance Jackson register his second straight

double-double of the season against Fresno State, igniting fans who have been waiting for him to rise back to the top, he also racked up a career-high six 3-pointers as he went a near-perfect 6-for-7 from behind the arc.

His 29 points fell just one shy of his career-high 30, which he also achieved against Fresno State last season.

JACKSON INJURY UPDATE

Redshirt-junior Vance Jackson left the game on Wednesday against Colorado State with an apparent knee injury. While the rest of the team stayed on the road, Jackson returned to Albuquerque for an MRI. The following is Paul Weir's statement regarding the MRI and Jackson's status:

"Vance's MRI on his left knee came back clean of anything serious. In the meantime, he will rest and rehab to bring down the swelling and hopefully return to action at some point soon. We are so happy it was nothing serious and wish for a speedy recovery."

NEW PLAYER - BIG ENERGY

Since he was cleared to play prior to UNM's contest against Grand Canyon on Dec. 17, redshirt-sophomore Vante Hendrix has displayed some huge energy on the court.

In the absence of redshirt-junior Vance Jackson on Saturday at UNLV, Hendrix earned his first start of the season.

In seven games, Hendrix has scored 77 points, averaging 9.6 per game, to go along with a total of 36 rebounds (4.5 per game). He has also posted nine assists and seven steals.

Hendrix' breakout game came on Dec. 29 at home against UC Davis when

he slammed four dunks in the second half for several key plays that put the Lobos back on top and pushed the momentum in favor of New Mexico. He also collected seven rebounds, two assists and two steals on the day.

Perhaps his most important play of the day was the steal and dunk with four seconds left that sealed the Lobo win.

MISSING PLAYER

Redshirt-junior JJ Caldwell is expected to remain out of the lineup this week. Per a media statement released Dec. 22 by the UNM Athletic Department, he is being "withheld from competition and team activity until further notice."

CLOSE GAME CURSE?

In games decided by five or more points, the Lobos are 13-3 overall. However, in close matchups with final scores that are between 1-4 points, UNM is 2-2.

The Lobos' Jan. 1 contest against San José State is the most recent example in which UNM fell by a score of 88-85.

LOBO PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

A pair of Lobos have collected a trio of the weekly honors bestowed by the Mountain West this season. Redshirt-senior JaQuan Lyle has earned the nod twice while UNM's most recent recipient was redshirt-senior Carlton Bragg.

LYLE ON FIRE

Redshirt-senior JaQuan Lyle is officially on fire as he has worked to get back into the groove after missing a pair of seasons on the court. He has steadily improved his scoring production from nine points in game one of the season to 18 in game two and a career-high 31 in games three and 10.

Lyle has registered double figures in 16 of UNM's 20 games. He has amassed 342 points registering 20 or more points in seven.

LOW THREES? NO PROBLEM.

Head coach Paul Weir in his first two seasons has had a squad that has lived and died by the three. Last season, UNM posted 15 games in which the Lobos scored 10 3-pointers or more.

With a 15-5 record, UNM has reached the 10-three threshold just twice this season, scoring 14 against Grand Canyon

on Dec. 17 and most recently racking up 10 at UNLV. The Lobos have been outscored from behind the arc in all but four games this season ((RV) Wisconsin, Grand Canyon, Fresno State and UNLV).

LOBOS DOWN A POWER 5

The Lobos topped (RV) Wisconsin on Tuesday, Nov. 26 marking the first time UNM earned a win over a Power 5 school since Dec. 5, 2012 when New Mexico topped USC 75-67 in Albuquerque.

4 STRAIGHT GAMES OF 90+

The Lobos registered at least 90 points in each of their first four wins this season. The last time the Lobos scored in the 90s in four straight games was in Paul Weir's first year toward the end of the season during the Lobos' exciting, unexpected 7-0 run en route to a loss in the Mountain West title contest.

In that run, UNM topped Wyoming 119-114, UNLV 91-90, Colorado State 108-87 and Fresno State 95-86.

The Lobos registered their fifth 90+ point game of the season on Dec. 17 against Grand Canyon followed by their sixth 90+ point victory against Houston Baptist on Dec. 22.

UNDEFEATED DECEMBER

The Lobos officially finished December undefeated with a perfect 7-0 record. The last time UNM posted a 7-0 record in December was 2011-12.

LONG NOVEMBER

The Lobos had a long, action-packed November this season. Last season, UNM competed in just five contests in Turkey Month while this season, the Lobos took on eight different regular-season opponents, including 2019 Final Four participant Auburn. Four of those contests were at home while the other four were on a pair of road trips. UNM completed its lengthy November with a 6-2 record.

ABOUT THE 2019-20 LOBOS

Prior to the start of the 2019-20 season, the Lobos featured eight returning letter-winners including three starters. Starters included redshirt-junior Vance Jackson, junior Makuach Maluach and redshirt-senior Carlton Bragg Jr. Joining the trio are senior Corey Manigault, redshirt-junior Keith McGee, sophomore Tavian Percy, redshirt-

Shorthanded Lobos Run Out of Energy at UNLV

LAS VEGAS, Nev. --- For the first time this season, The University of New Mexico men's basketball team (15-5, 4-3 MW) suffered its second-straight road loss with a 99-78 showing at UNLV (11-9, 6-1 MW) on Saturday night. While the Lobos led for the majority of the first half, the Runnin' Rebels jumped ahead in the final minute with a halftime lead that they did not again relinquish.

The five Lobo starters played over 30 minutes of the 40-minute game including 35 or more from four of them: senior Corey Manigault (35), redshirt-sophomore Vante Hendrix (35), junior Makuach Maluach (37) and redshirt-senior JaQuan Lyle (39).

"Unfortunately, we ran out of gas," head coach Paul Weir said. "We turned the ball over 12 times in the second half, three times in the first half. I thought our guys actually competed and played hard and rallied and responded to where we were at, but you've got to give it to UNLV, it just was a better team – it is the better team right now."

Despite the lengthy minutes and obvious wearing down of the Lobo personnel, UNM was behind by single digits with just 4:26 left on the clock. Redshirt-junior Zane Martin made a pair of free throws to make it an eight-point game, 76-68 before the Runnin' Rebels followed with a 9-0 run to extend the UNLV lead to 17, 85-68.

Lyle hit a pair of free throws and a three, broken up by a UNLV dunk, to make it a 14-point game with 2:27 left in a last-ditch effort at some energy from the Lobo squad. The energy burst wasn't quite enough however, as UNLV closed on a 12-5 run over the final 2:27 for the 21-point Runnin' Rebel win.

UNLV collected six dunks in the second half as the Lobo defense grew visibly tired, including three in the final two and a half minutes.

Despite the struggles of the Lobo defense on the night, the Lobo offense hit 10 3-pointers for just the second time this season en route to its 78 points. Lyle led the charge with four on the night followed by Hendrix (3-7). Manigault even registered two from deep, marking a new career-high for the big man.

The final three came from freshman Emmanuel Kuac, who saw 13 minutes on the court, which he registered just 12 seconds after entering the contest.

The Lobos were led on the night by Lyle, who registered his seventh 20+ point game of the season with an even 20 points. He has scored at least 20 in three of the Lobos' last five games.

Finishing just behind Lyle was Manigault who posted his second double-double of the season with 19 points and 11 boards. All five starters finished in double figures.

UNLV was led by a massive effort from sophomore Bryce Hamilton who put up a career-high 35 points going 14-for-19 from the floor. Another outstanding performance on the night was Runnin' Rebel sophomore Marvin Coleman who posted a triple-double with 11 points, 11 assists and 12 rebounds.

Coleman's triple-double marks the first in the Mountain West since 2016.

On the night, the Lobos were outshot 50.7 – 41.3 percent from the floor but fired at a clip of 38.5 percent from behind the arc compared to 30.8 percent for UNLV.

UNM was outrebounded 47-31 including 15-8 in offensive boards while turning the ball over 15 times compared to 10 for the Runnin' Rebels.

The Lobos are set to return to action on Tuesday, Jan. 21 when they host San José State inside Dreamstyle Arena – The Pit on AT&T SportsNet at 8 p.m. MT.

Late Energy Burst Too Late, Lobos Fall at SJSU

SAN JOSE, Calif. --- Despite a 14-point lead in the first half, The University of New Mexico men's basketball team (13-3, 2-1 MW) dropped a narrow, three-point final to the San José State Spartans (5-10, 1-2 MW) on the road on Wednesday. Despite the outcome, UNM had a pair of 25-point scorers including redshirt-senior JaQuan Lyle who registered his 1,000th career point in the contest.

The loss marks just the third to the Spartans in program history and the second straight on the road in the series. It also marks just the third Lobo New Year's Day loss in program history and snaps an eight-win streak that started Nov. 26 against Wisconsin.

It was Lyle and redshirt-junior Vance Jackson who led UNM with 25 points apiece while Jackson also posted a UNM career-high 13 rebounds for his first double-double of the season, his sixth as a Lobo. The pair combined for 20 points over the final stretch as the Lobos nearly executed an 18-point comeback to win in the final seconds.

Lyle also nearly posted a double-double in points and assists as he dished eight on the night while collecting a team-high three steals. The pair were joined in the double-digit scoring club by senior Corey Manigault (15 pts, 7 rebs) and redshirt-sophomore Vante Hendrix (13 pts, 5 rebs).

After a close first five minutes of the matchup, the Lobos exploded on a 17-2 run over 4:12 that put UNM up 23-9 at the 13:09 mark, but the Spartans rallied back with a 17-3 run to tie it up just 3:43 later, 26-26, with 9:26 left to play in the half. The squads battled and with the score tied 33-33 with 5:14 left in the first frame, it was SJSU that again broke free, finishing the last five minutes on a 13-3 run for a 10-point Lobo halftime deficit.

The Spartans led 46-36 at the break marking just the second time this season UNM has trailed by 10 or more at the break, the first was against Auburn on Nov. 25.

Despite being down by 10 at the half, UNM was outshooting SJSU from the floor 48.3 - 45.9 percent however, the Spartans had capitalized on 10 Lobo turnovers, converting 20 points, compared to just three points on just two SJSU turnovers in the first half. UNM left seven points at the free throw line, shooting 41.7 percent (5-12) through the first half from the stripe.

San José State increased its lead to as much as 18 points with 12:46 left to play before the Lobos began chipping away at the Spartan lead. It was at the 8:03 mark that a Manigault dunk made it a single-digit game, 68-59, and the Lobos' fighting spirit returned.

A pair of Jackson free throws with just less than seven minutes on the clock again made it a single-digit game (eight points) and a Lyle layup made it seven (72-65) before SJSU jumped back out by 13 with 5:17 left.

It was in the final 2:17 that the Lobos really turned on the gas.

SJSU led by 10 points on a jumper by senior Brae Ivey before Jackson and Hendrix nailed back-to-back threes to make it a four-point game, 84-80, with 1:07 left, sparking the Lobo bench and Lobo fans in attendance.

The threes kicked off an eventual 11-0 run that included a pair of Lyle free throws with 1:01 on the clock and a Martin layup to tie it up at 84-84 with less than 15 seconds left, causing SJSU to call a timeout.

Martin drew a foul in the paint and was awarded the and-one, which he made to put UNM up for the first time since the 5:14 mark in the first half, 85-84.

The Lobo defense attempted to retain the lead, but the breakout shooter of the night, junior Richard Washington, who headed into the contest averaging 7.4 points per game, sunk his seventh 3-pointer of the night to put SJSU back up by two, 87-85, with eight seconds left and the Lobos took a full timeout.

UNM reclaimed possession and hoped to reclaim the lead, but a fast dribble down the court with three seconds left resulted in another UNM turnover, kicked out of bounds, and the ball was given back to the Spartans, up by two.

An intentional Lobo foul to stop the clock allowed Ivey to register one more from the stripe to make it 88-85 and the Spartans took their final timeout, followed by UNM's final timeout as the Lobos attempted to work up one final play to tie it.

With less than two seconds on the clock, the Lobos attempted to bring the ball in from under the opposite basket and Lyle took a pass at half court, turned and shot the long three, but the ball hit the rim for the 88-85 final as time expired.

On the night, the Lobos outshot from the floor (49.2 - 47.8), but fired just 6-for-24 from three-point range (25 percent) compared to 12-for-33 for the Spartans. UNM committed 18 turnovers compared to just 12 for SJSU that resulted in 29 points for the Spartans compared to just 15 for UNM.

The Lobos return home for a pair of conference contests, starting with Fresno State on Tuesday, Jan. 7 at 9 p.m. MT on ESPNU.

THE GREATEST GAME EVER PLAYED

The Pit was the site of one of the greatest college basketball games ever played. It hosted the 1983 national championship game that saw the NC State Wolfpack upset Hakeem Olajuwon, Clyde Drexler and the Houston Cougars. Coach Jimmy Valvano and the Wolfpack downed the Cougars on a last second put back by Lorenzo Charles. The iconic shot of the late Valvano running onto the court looking for a hug is one of the lasting images in college basketball history.

- Less than 30 of 345 NCAA Division I basketball programs play in a college-only arena named after a business or organization founded or headquartered in its home state.
- The Lobos have averaged an astounding 15,410 fans the past 49 years, an amazing 95% of capacity
- The Pit has ranked in the top 25 in attendance nationally nearly every season since the 1966-67 season with 35 seasons in the top ten in the NCAA in attendance
- Led the Mountain West in attendance in 10 of the conference's 15 years of existence
- The floor is named Bob King Court in honor of the former head coach who led the Lobos from 1963 to 1972.
