### ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- The Lobos are coming off of a Tuesday loss to (RV) North Texas at home by a score of 74-65. UNM is 1-4 over its last five tough games after starting the season 4-1.
- UNM has fallen recently to North Texas, which is receiving votes in the USA Today Coaches Poll, Colorado, Saint Mary's and New Mexico State.
- Penn is riding a five-game win streak after dropping a pair of contests to then-No. 12 Kansas State and Oregon State. In their last contest, the Quakers pulled out a 78-75 victory over then-No. 17 Villanova on Dec. 11.
- By the time the teams hit the court Saturday, Penn will not have played a game in 11 days compared to just a four-game span for UNM.
- Saturday's meeting will mark just the second between the Lobos and the Quakers. UNM claimed the first in the Lobo Invitational by a score of 54-51 in the Championship game on Dec. 29, 1992 in The Pit.
- Penn is led by four players averaging scoring in double figures including junior Devon Goodman (14.8), junior AJ Brodeur (13.3), freshman Michael Wang (11.4) and senior Antonio Woods (10.9).
- The Lobos are powered by three Lobos in double digits including senior Anthony Mathis (15.4), redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson (10.8) and junior Corey Manigault (10.1).

**SCOUTING PENN**

Penn entered the 2018-19 season coming off of a 2018 NCAA Tournament appearance and picked up where it left off. The team has played a pair of ranked teams this season including then-No. 12 Kansas State (L, 64-48) and most recently No. 17 Villanova on Dec. 11 (W, 78-75). Villanova is now receiving votes in the national polls and Penn has not played since their meeting.

The Quakers are off to their best 11-game start since the 1994-95 team also started 9-2. Penn is 3-0 in true road games this season.

Penn allows just 67.5 points per game from its opponents and outrebounds at a rate of +2.3.

**LAST TIME OUT**

The Lobos dropped a nine-point contest to (RV) North Texas on Tuesday night, 74-65, inside Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit. Senior Anthony Mathis led the Lobos in scoring for the fourth time this season with 20 points, also marking the fourth time this season he has scored 20 or more. Redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee also performed well, going 3-for-5 from behind the arc en route to 11 points.

**IT'S RAINING THREES**

The Lobos are averaging 9.9 3-pointers per game and have racked up 10 or more in all but two games this season.

**BRAGG IS BACK**

Redshirt-junior Carlton Bragg finally earned his debut as a Lobo on Sunday afternoon after a year and a half off the court. Bragg posted 16 points on 7-for-12 from the floor and tallied seven rebounds in his debut against Central Arkansas. He followed it up with a six-point, seven-rebound performance against North Texas to go along with three steals.

**STEALING LOBOS**

The Lobos currently post 7.2 steals per game on the season led by senior Anthony Mathis who has collected 12, followed by redshirt-junior Vance Jackson with 11. In just two games, redshirt-junior Carlton Bragg has collected four, including three on Tuesday against (RV) North Texas.

UNM is second in the Mountain West in steals per game so far this season behind Fresno State which posts 7.6.

**OPPONENT PREPARATION**

The Lobo schedule is a threatening one this season with several quality opponents coming to The Pit. In addition to the level of competition coming to take on UNM, these strong teams have had plenty of time to prepare. North Texas took on UNM in Albuquerque Tuesday having had 10 days to prepare for the Lobos. On Saturday, Penn will have had 11.

**20-POINT FEVER**

Senior Anthony Mathis has posted four 20+ point games so far this season and has done so just seven times in his career. Mathis had three 20-point games in three seasons, and in the first 10 games of his senior year has already surpassed it.

Tuesday's game marked the fourth time this season that Mathis has led the Lobos in scoring, he has done so 13 times in his career.

**MALUACH EMERGES**

Sophomore Makuach Maluach led the Lobos in points for the first time this season on Sunday afternoon against Central Arkansas going 8-for-11 from the floor including 4-for-6 from behind the arc. He posted his first 20-point game on the season (22) marking the third time in his career that he has scored 20 or more points.

**REBOUND MACHINE**

It's no secret that the Lobos have struggled on the glass this season as they are currently being outrebounded by a -4.1 margin by their opponents. UNM has outrebounded its opponents just three times so far this season including Sunday's game against UCA (49-38), but one player has consistently led the Lobos at the boards. Redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson has led the Lobos in rebounding in six out of UNM's 10 games for a total of 68 rebounds (6.8 rpg) on the season.

**ROOKIE ASSIST LEADER**

True freshman Drue Drinnon has been lighting up the uncertain point guard spot for UNM this season. He has led the Lobos in assists in five games out of 10 despite not playing the first game and seeing just two

minutes in game two due to injury. He has seen a total of just 131 minutes and leads UNM with 25 assists. He also registered a season-high six against Colorado and followed it up with seven against Central Arkansas in his fifth start of the season.

**AND THEN THERE WERE NONE ...**

Sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk started the first four games for the Lobos and was the only consistent starter - until Dec. 1 against Bradley. That lineup featured three freshman, senior Dane Kuiper and sophomore Makuach Maluach. The Lobos officially no longer have a single player that has started in all of their games in coach Weir's system of starters determined by deflections.

**REPEATED STARTERS**

Through the first eight games of the season, the Lobos sported a new starting lineup in each game. For the first time this season, on Sunday afternoon, UNM had a repeat lineup. Sunday's lineup matched Tuesday's against Colorado in Drinnon, Mathis, Kuiper, Jackson and Pinchuk. The lineup remains the only duplicate of the season.

**MATHIS 16TH IN THE NATION**

Lobo senior Anthony Mathis is currently ranked 16th in the nation in 3-point field goals per game (3.60) and 42nd in 3-point field goal percentage (44.4). He is also ranked 38th in the nation in total 3-pointers with 36 on the season.

After hitting a career-high 11-of-11 free throws in Tuesday's game against (RV) North Texas, Mathis is now ranked 24th in the country in free-throw percentage (90.3).

**ABOUT THE 2018-19 LOBOS**

The 2018-19 Lobos have just four returning letterwinners from the 2017-18 squad, including leading-scorer Anthony Mathis (12.7 ppg) who finished fourth in the nation in 3-point percentage and broke the UNM record for most 3-point field goals in a conference season (66) as a junior. The squad also adds nine newcomers and returns a pair of sitting transfers to the team that finished third in Mountain West regular-season play last season.

In addition to Mathis, UNM's returners include senior Dane Kuiper, who is the lone returning starter, and sophomores Makuach Maluach and Vladimir Pinchuk. Maluach finished his inaugural season averaging 9.6

points per game and ranks fourth all-time on the Lobo freshman single-season scoring list.

### REMEMBERING LAST SEASON

The 2017-18 Lobos were picked to finish ninth in league play, but shocked everyone when they pulled off a third-place finish in regular-season play, earned the MW Tournament bye and took on San Diego State in the Championship game, falling by just seven points.

The Lobos also ranked 15th out of 351 NCAA Division I teams in turnover percentage last season.

### RECORDS ARE MEANT TO BE BROKEN

En route to their first appearance in the league championship since 2014, the Lobos broke the program records for 3-pointers in a season (367), most 3-point field goals attempted (979) and highest free throw percentage (77.7%). For reference, the previous records were 301, 782 and 75.7%, respectively.

As a team, the Lobos also broke the record for most points in a game (147 vs Northern New Mexico), most points in a conference game (119 at Wyoming) and most points in a conference season (1,507). Old records for the above: 136, 113 and 1,373, respectively.

### STELLAR SCHEDULE

The Lobos are taking on a field of top-notch teams this season including five squads that advanced to the 2018 NCAA Tournament. Last season's Big Dance squads include New Mexico State, Iona, Penn, San Diego State and Nevada. With UNM facing NMSU,

SDSU and Nevada twice apiece, that makes for eight games against NCAA post-season opponents, not to mention a matchup with last season's CBI tourney winner, North Texas.

### UNDER THE RADAR

This offseason, the Lobos were ranked by the NCAA's Andy Katz as one of five "under the radar" teams to watch this season.

### SHARP SHOOTER

Senior Anthony Mathis blew expectations out of the water last season after more than fiftupleing his career point production as a junior - that's right, in two seasons at UNM, Mathis scored just 86 points in 228 minutes, and multiplied that total by five in his junior season. In 2017-18, Mathis took the term "breakout" to a whole new level, dropping 433 points in 760 minutes on the floor. His shot from 3-point range couldn't be stopped as he finished the season with a program-record 66 3-pointers in conference play. He also fired from behind the arc at a clip of 47.3%, ranking fourth in the nation among other NCAA DI players.

### THE STUDENT BECOMES THE MASTER

After posting a breakout inaugural season of his own last year, sophomore Makuach Maluach is expected to be a high-profile returner for the Lobos this year. He's been ranked on several preseason lists and even made the cover of Lindy's Sports Magazine in August. Most recently, the soft-spoken sophomore was ranked 19th on the Mountain West Wire's Top 25.

### CONSISTENCY IS OVERRATED

Last season, the Lobos debuted the most starting lineups in NCAA Division I with 21. Coach Weir made it clear in his first season that starting lineups would be determined by the numbers of deflections a player accumulated in the previous game, hence the sky-high number of lineup combos.

Newcomer of the Year following the league's media poll in October. Jackson transferred from UCONN where he shot 40.9 percent from the field, 39.7 from behind the arc as a freshman in 2016-17. He reached double figures in 13 games and led the team twice in scoring in his inaugural collegiate season.

### **WE'RE NOT IN KANSAS ANYMORE ...**

The Lobos return a pair of transfers that sat out last year and also welcome five more, including the highly-anticipated Carlton Bragg (Kansas/ASU transfer) who is currently eligible for conference play. Joining Bragg will be Juco transfers Corey Manigault, Keith McGee and Karim Ezzeddine who are all set to play at the start of the season.

Redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson (UCONN) will finally get his chance to don the Cherry and Silver this season and was named 2018 MW Newcomer of the Year. Jackson's fellow bench-warmer last season, Ohio State transfer JaQuan Lyle, suffered an Achilles injury during practice in September and is expected to miss the 2018-19 season. Two more transfers of note include Towson's Zane Martin, who will be sitting out in 2018-19 due to NCAA transfer rules, and redshirt-freshman Clay Patterson. A native of Rio Rancho, N.M., Patterson transferred back home from NCAA DII Fort Lewis. He is eligible to compete in 2018-19.

### **BRINGING PEOPLE TOGETHER**

The Lobo squad is as varied as it gets when it comes to hometown pride. Each player on the team is from not only a different town, but a different state or country entirely! With the late addition of walk-on Clay Patterson, the only exception is a pair of native New Mexicans. States and countries represented include: Pennsylvania, Maryland, California, New York, Florida, Australia, Indiana, Alaska, Germany, Georgia, France, Oregon, New Mexico and Ohio.

### **THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME**

The famous home of Lobo basketball enters its second year under the name "Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit" as part of an exciting renaming of both of UNM's largest-capacity athletic venues.

This July, "The Pit" was tabbed #17 on the top-30 list of best arena atmospheres in college hoops by the NCAA.

"The Pit" has also been consistently recognized nationally as one of the nation's top basketball venues. Sports Illustrated has ranked it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for

the New Mexico men's basketball program. Since the Mountain West conference began in 1999-2000, New Mexico has ranked in the top two in home attendance among MW teams in every year except one, including 12 seasons as the top-ranked MW team in overall attendance.

### **WHAT'S THAT SOUND?**

The new name for The Pit instated in 2017 is not the only change to come for Dreamstyle Arena in the Paul Weir era. This season, after popular fan demand, the sound system in the historic arena has been updated to feature an entirely new fan experience for the 2018-19 season!

**Mathis Scores 20, Lobos Fall to (RV) North Texas**

**ALBUQUERQUE, N.M.** --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team dropped a nine-point contest to (RV) North Texas on Tuesday night, 74-65, inside Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit. Senior Anthony Mathis led the Lobos in scoring for the fourth time this season with 20 points, also marking the fourth time this season he has scored 20 or more.

The Mean Green (11-1) is currently receiving votes in the Top 25 USA Today Poll and jumped out to an early lead over the Lobos (5-5), putting UNM at a nine-point disadvantage within the first six minutes. UNM made its first five points off of free throws, but failed to score from the floor until sophomore Makuach Maluach hit a three at the 12:53 mark to make it 12-8 UNT.

Mathis went 4-for-8 from the floor, 1-for-5 from three and went a perfect 11-for-11 from the foul line for a new career-high. Tuesday night marks his fourth game this season shooting perfect from the stripe.

Redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee finished second on the squad with 11 points including a 3-for-5 showing from behind the arc. At the half, he was 3-for-3 in just 12:11 on the court. He was one of three Lobos to score in double figures including redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson who posted 10 on 4-for-6 from the floor and 2-for-4 from 3-point range.

Defensively, UNM was outrebounded 31-29, led by redshirt-junior Carlton Bragg with seven in his second game of the season. He was followed by junior Corey Manigault (6) and Jackson (5). Bragg also collected three steals on the night en route to UNM's season-high nine.

"I thought for parts of the game we did really well. Unfortunately, offensively we couldn't get going in the first half, and we couldn't get any momentum behind us," head coach Paul Weir said. "The turnovers really hurt us and gave them a lot of breakout opportunities ... (With) a team of that caliber, it's hard to overcome."

After North Texas built the early lead, the Lobos surged back to close a nine-point deficit in just 1:13 in the middle of the first half. Mathis was fouled on a three and hit all three from the stripe to make it 17-11 before McGee hit a fast-break three to close it to three points, 17-14.

A Mathis steal led to yet another three from Jackson to tie it 17-17, capping the 9-0 run. North Texas responded with a 10-0 run over 2:51 however, reclaiming the lead 27-17 with 5:41 left in the half. UNM went on a 10-2 run to close it back to a two-point game, 29-27, before UNT took off for a six-point differential at the half, 35-29.

UNM was held shooting at just 28.6 percent from the floor in the first frame but fired 41.7 percent from three and 92.3 percent from the free throw line. North Texas shot 46.7 from the floor in the first half but just 30.0 percent behind the arc and 57.1 percent from the stripe.

In the second half, the Lobo defense held UNT without a bucket for nearly three minutes before allowing the Mean Green to increase a five-point lead to 12 at the 15:37 mark (42-30). The Lobos would get no closer than four the rest of the way as North Texas posted its largest lead of 13 with 5:41 left on the clock.

While UNM posted its second-lowest point total on the season in the contest (65), North Texas's defensive unit entered Tuesday's game allowing just 58.7 points per game. UNM finished shooting 36.4 percent from the floor, 30.4 percent from three and 83.9 percent from the free throw line.

UNM was outscored in the paint 44-18 and in second-chance points 16-9. The Lobos forced 17 turnovers but committed 21.

New Mexico returns to action on Saturday night as it faces 2018 NCAA Tournament team Penn, continuing the competitive holiday home stand at Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit at 2 p.m.

## Men's Basketball Downs #17/16 Villanova in Big 5 Thriller, 78-75

**PHILADELPHIA** – The University of Pennsylvania men's basketball team played ahead of No. 17/16 Villanova nearly all night on Tuesday at The Palestra, and the Quakers held on at the end to defeat the defending NCAA champion Wildcats, 78-75. The win snapped Villanova's record 25-game win streak in Philadelphia Big 5 games, which extended back to December 5, 2012.

The win was Penn's fifth in a row and the Quakers improved to 9-2 on the season. Villanova fell to 8-3. Penn has now won two Big 5 games for the first time since the 2006-07 season and is 2-0 in Big 5 play for the first time since the 2002-03 campaign. As a result of Tuesday night's win, the Quakers now own the longest active winning streak in Big 5 games at three, dating back to a win over Saint Joseph's last January.

The win was Penn's first over Villanova in almost exactly 16 years; the first over an AP-ranked team since a 73-70 win over Temple on November 23, 1998; and the first win over a ranked Villanova squad since a 71-70 win over the 17th-ranked Wildcats on December 6, 1988.

### Notes

\*Penn improved to 4-6 all-time when playing a team ranked 17th in the Associated Press (AP) national poll, including a 2-1 mark over Villanova when the Cats are No. 17.

\*Penn has now won 12 in a row at The Palestra dating back to last season, 15 of its last 16 home games, and 18 of its last 20.

\*Tonight's game was Steve Donahue's 100th as Penn's head coach; he is 57-43 with the Quakers.

\*Penn is 9-2 through 11 games for the first time since the 1994-95 team also was 9-2 at this juncture.

\*Penn is 5-0 this season and 19-0 over the last two seasons when making more foul shots than its opponent; the Quakers made 25 free throws on Tuesday, a season high, while Villanova made 18.

\*Penn is 7-0 this season and 43-6 in the Donahue era when leading at halftime.

\*Penn is 9-0 this season when shooting a better field-goal percentage than its opponent; the Quakers shot 51.1 percent on Tuesday, while Villanova shot 50.0 percent.

\*Penn has shot better than 50 percent in eight of its nine wins this season.

\*Penn is 6-0 this season when outrebounding its opponent; the Quakers had 35 boards on Tuesday while Villanova had 22.

\*Villanova's 22 boards were an opponent low in the Donahue era.

\*For the first time this season, Penn put five different players in double figures.

\*Junior AJ Brodeur hit double digits in scoring for the fifth straight game and ninth time this season, with 16 points; Penn is 9-0 this season when Brodeur hits double figures.

\*Senior Antonio Woods finished with 16 points and four assists; both numbers were one shy of his season highs.

\*Freshman Michael Wang scored 14 points, giving him 55 in the last three games.

\*Junior Devon Goodman scored 11 points and tied his season high with five rebounds.

\*Senior Jake Silpe scored 11 points, his third double-figure scoring game this season.

### How It Happened

Penn started out red hot on Tuesday night, Bryce Washington opening the scoring with a pair of three-point baskets as the Quakers jumped out to a 14-2 lead. However, Villanova responded with the game's next 15 points and took a 17-14 lead.

That turned out to be the only time the Wildcats would lead all night. Penn scored 12 of the next 14 points for a 26-19 lead, powered by back-to-back treys by Michael Wang and Antonio Woods, and the Quakers were up 32-28 at halftime.

Penn never trailed in the second half, either, extending its lead to as many as 10 points. Villanova drew within three points several times in the final few minutes, but the Quakers continually found open looks when they needed them and converted to keep the Wildcats at bay.

### Up Next

Penn is off until Saturday, Dec. 22, when the Quakers are at New Mexico. That game will tip off at 2 p.m. (4 p.m. EST) in Albuquerque.

- Built in 1966 (\$1.4 million)

- Seating includes 40 suites and a club area
- Officially named Dreamstyle Arena in 2017 after a \$10 million agreement for naming rights by the local New Mexico business. It is still referred to as The Pit, its officially-recognized nickname. As part of the exciting Dreamstyle changes, University Stadium, UNM's football stadium, officially became Dreamstyle Arena on the same date.
- Less than 30 of 345 NCAA Division I basketball programs play in a college-only arena named after a business or organization founded or headquartered in its home state.
- The Lobos have averaged an astounding 15,410 fans the past 49 years, an amazing 95% of capacity
- The Pit has ranked in the top 25 in attendance nationally nearly every season since the 1966-67 season with 35 seasons in the top ten in the NCAA in attendance
- Led the Mountain West in attendance in 10 of the conference's 15 years of existence
- The floor is named Bob King Court in honor of the former head coach who led the Lobos from 1963 to 1972.

**Mathis Scores 20, Lobos Fall to (RV) North Texas**

**ALBUQUERQUE, N.M.** --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team dropped a nine-point contest to (RV) North Texas on Tuesday night, 74-65, inside Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit. Senior Anthony Mathis led the Lobos in scoring for the fourth time this season with 20 points, also marking the fourth time this season he has scored 20 or more.

The Mean Green (11-1) is currently receiving votes in the Top 25 USA Today Poll and jumped out to an early lead over the Lobos (5-5), putting UNM at a nine-point disadvantage within the first six minutes. UNM made its first five points off of free throws, but failed to score from the floor until sophomore Makuach Maluach hit a three at the 12:53 mark to make it 12-8 UNT.

Mathis went 4-for-8 from the floor, 1-for-5 from three and went a perfect 11-for-11 from the foul line for a new career-high. Tuesday night marks his fourth game this season shooting perfect from the stripe.

Redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee finished second on the squad with 11 points including a 3-for-5 showing from behind the arc. At the half, he was 3-for-3 in just 12:11 on the court. He was one of three Lobos to score in double figures including redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson who posted 10 on 4-for-6 from the floor and 2-for-4 from 3-point range.

Defensively, UNM was outrebounded 31-29, led by redshirt-junior Carlton Bragg with seven in his second game of the season. He was followed by junior Corey Manigault (6) and Jackson (5). Bragg also collected three steals on the night en route to UNM's season-high nine.

"I thought for parts of the game we did really well. Unfortunately, offensively we couldn't get going in the first half, and we couldn't get any momentum behind us," head coach Paul Weir said. "The turnovers really hurt us and gave them a lot of breakout opportunities ... (With) a team of that caliber, it's hard to overcome."

After North Texas built the early lead, the Lobos surged back to close a nine-point deficit in just 1:13 in the middle of the first half. Mathis was fouled on a three and hit all three from the stripe to make it 17-11 before McGee hit a fast-break three to close it to three points, 17-14.

A Mathis steal led to yet another three from Jackson to tie it 17-17, capping the 9-0 run. North Texas responded with a 10-0 run over 2:51 however, reclaiming the lead 27-17 with 5:41 left in the half. UNM went on a 10-2 run to close it back to a two-point game, 29-27, before UNT took off for a six-point differential at the half, 35-29.

UNM was held shooting at just 28.6 percent from the floor in the first frame but fired 41.7 percent from three and 92.3 percent from the free throw line. North Texas shot 46.7 from the floor in the first half but just 30.0 percent behind the arc and 57.1 percent from the stripe.

In the second half, the Lobo defense held UNT without a bucket for nearly three minutes before allowing the Mean Green to increase a five-point lead to 12 at the 15:37 mark (42-30). The Lobos would get no closer than four the rest of the way as North Texas posted its largest lead of 13 with 5:41 left on the clock.

While UNM posted its second-lowest point total on the season in the contest (65), North Texas's defensive unit entered Tuesday's game allowing just 58.7 points per game. UNM finished shooting 36.4 percent from the floor, 30.4 percent from three and 83.9 percent from the free throw line.

UNM was outscored in the paint 44-18 and in second-chance points 16-9. The Lobos forced 17 turnovers but committed 21.

New Mexico returns to action on Saturday night as it faces 2018 NCAA Tournament team Penn, continuing the competitive holiday home stand at Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit at 2 p.m.
