#### ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- The Lobos enter Sunday's contest coming off of a seven-win streak. The last two victories were by 20 and 19 points over Grand Canyon and Houston Baptist, respectively.
- UNM is currently undefeated at home with a 9-0 record inside Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit, matching the most recent 9-0 streak at home in the 2010-11 season.
- The Lobos are also 6-0 in the month of December for the first time since 2011-12.
- UC Davis enters the contest 5-9 including its most recent loss on the road at San Francisco on Saturday, 93-84.
- The Lobos hold a 2-0 advantage in the series with both victories coming in Albuquerque.
- The last time the two teams met was on Dec. 20, 1978 when UNM earned an 86-74 victory.
- The first meeting in the series was on Nov. 29, 1974.
- The Lobos are led by four players averaging in double figures including redshirt-senior JaQuan Lyle who averages 17.9 points per game.
- UC Davis has three players scoring in double figures on the season, led by senior Joe Mooney with 16.0 points per game.

**LAST TIME OUT**

The Lobos extended their win streak to seven on Sunday afternoon with a 19-point victory over the visiting Houston Baptist Huskies, 107-88. The contest marked the first time this season that UNM has reached triple figures.

UNM debuted a new starting lineup on Sunday after a pair of regular starters, redshirt-senior Carlton Bragg Jr. and redshirt-junior JJ Caldwell missed Sunday's contest, as announced prior to tipoff via media statement.

Senior Corey Manigault led UNM with 21 points going a near-perfect 9-for-10 from the floor.

**WE'RE STREAKING!**

The Lobos have won their last seven straight contests that started with UNM's win over Wisconsin in the Barclay's Center in New York on Nov. 26.

**UNDEFEATED AT HOME**

With the Lobos' victory over Houston Baptist at home on Sunday, UNM is now 9-0 in home contests inside Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit.

The last time the Lobos were 9-0 at home was the 2010-11 season, before UNM was 9-1 with a loss against Wyoming on Jan. 8, 2011.

A win against UC Davis on Sunday would make the Lobos 10-0 at home, which UNM last achieved in 2009-10 en route to a 30-5 overall record that included a Mountain West Championship and a pair of games in the NCAA Tournament.

**NCAA'S NET RANKINGS**

Prior to last Sunday's contest against Houston Baptist, UNM ranked 62nd among the nation's squads in the NCAA NET rankings with an 11-2 record as one of just 16 squads to reach 11 victories.

**BEST START SINCE 2012**

The Lobos' 12-2 start to the 2019-20 season marks the best 14-game start since the 2012-13 season when the Lobos went 12-0 through the first 12 contests of the season. The squad eventually went 13-2 through the first 15 contests and 17-2 over the first 19 games.

**90+ POINTS BEFORE THE NEW YEAR**

With Sunday's 107-88 win over Houston Baptist, the Lobos registered their sixth game of 90+ points this season.

The last time the Lobos registered six games scoring 90 points or more before the end of December was 21 seasons ago, in 1998-99.

**UNDEFEATED DECEMBER**

The Lobos have kicked off December a perfect 6-0 so far this season. The last time UNM started December 6-0 was in the 2011-12 season. That season was also the last time UNM went 7-0 in the final month of the year.

A win over UC Davis Sunday would make the Lobos finish December undefeated

**SIX AWAY FROM 1,000**

After spending a pair of seasons at Ohio State, redshirt-senior JaQuan Lyle has amassed a total of 994 points in his collegiate career, making him just six away from hitting the 1,000 point mark for his career.

251 of those points have come in just his first 14 games as a Lobo while he registered 391 as a freshman in 2015-16 and 352 as a sophomore in 2016-17.

**CONFERENCE OPENERS**

With UNM's win over Boise State on Dec. 4, the Lobos have now won nine straight conference openers including an 8-0 streak in home conference openers.

In addition, UNM's win over Wyoming marks the seventh time in the last eight seasons that the Lobos have kicked off conference play 2-0.

Youth grades K-6 can get FREE admission to Sunday's game by simply bringing a copy of their report card to the ticket office.

## MISSING PLAYERS

Redshirt-senior Carlton Bragg and redshirt-junior JJ Caldwell are expected to remain out of the lineup on Sunday vs UC Davis.

Per a media statement released last week by the UNM Athletic Department, the pair is being "withheld from competition and team activity until further notice."

## LOBO PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

A pair of Lobos have collected nearly half of the weekly honors bestowed by the Mountain West this season. Redshirt-senior JaQuan Lyle has earned the nod twice while UNM's most recent recipient was redshirt-senior Carlton Bragg.

## LYLE ON FIRE

Redshirt-senior JaQuan Lyle is officially on fire as he has worked to get back into the groove after missing a pair of seasons on the court. He has steadily improved his scoring production from nine points in game one of the season to 18 in game two and a career-high 31 in games three and 10.

Lyle has registered in double figures in 12 of UNM's 14 games. He has amassed 251

points in 14 games ranking 27th in the country.

## LOW THREES? NO PROBLEM.

Head coach Paul Weir in his first two seasons has had a squad that has lived and died by the three. Last season, UNM posted 15 games in which the Lobos scored 10 3-pointers or more.

UNM reached the 10-three threshold just once this season, scoring 14 against Grand Canyon on Tuesday. The Lobos have been outscored from behind the arc in all but two games this season (Wisconsin & Grand Canyon).

## LOBOS RECEIVING VOTES

Prior to UNM's loss against now No. 8 Auburn, the Lobos were receiving votes in the Associated Press poll for the first time in Paul Weir's tenure at UNM. In fact, the last time New Mexico received votes in the polls was on Nov. 23, 2015 with a vote in the USA Today Coaches Poll. Prior to that, the Lobos were ranked No. 17 in the final AP poll of 2014. Auburn remains unbeaten so far this season at 11-0.

Just two other MW teams have made appearances in the national polls this season including Utah State and San Diego State.

## LOBOS DOWN A POWER 5

The Lobos topped Wisconsin on Tuesday, Nov. 26 marking the first time UNM earned a win over a Power 5 school since Dec. 5, 2012 when New Mexico topped USC 75-67 in Albuquerque.

four straight games was in Paul Weir's first year toward the end of the season during the Lobos' exciting, unexpected 7-0 run en route to a loss in the Mountain West title contest.

In that run, UNM topped Wyoming 119-114, UNLV 91-90, Colorado State 108-87 and Fresno State 95-86.

The Lobos registered their fifth 90+ point game of the season last Tuesday against Grand Canyon followed by their sixth 90+ point victory against Houston Baptist on Sunday.

### LONG NOVEMBER

The Lobos had a long, action-packed November this season. Last season, UNM competed in just five contests in Turkey Month while this season, the Lobos took on eight different regular-season opponents, including 2019 Final Four participant Auburn. Four of those contests were at home while the other four were on a pair of road trips. UNM completed its lengthy November with a 6-2 record.

### ABOUT THE 2019-20 LOBOS

The 2019-20 Lobos feature eight returning letterwinners including three starters. Starters include redshirt-junior Vance Jackson, junior Makuach Maluach and redshirt-senior Carlton Bragg Jr. Joining the trio are senior Corey Manigault, redshirt-junior Keith McGee, sophomore Tavian Percy, redshirt-sophomore Clay Patterson and sophomore Jordan Arroyo.

### STARTER STATS

The trio of returning starters from the 2018-19 season return some impressive stats. Jackson collected 13.1 points per game last season to go along with 7.0 rebounds and a 40.5 percent shooting clip. Jackson saw action in all 32 games last season along with Maluach, who started 28 of them. Maluach registered 9.9 points per game while Bragg posted 10.5

points and 8.8 rebounds per contest to go along with shooting 49 percent from the floor.

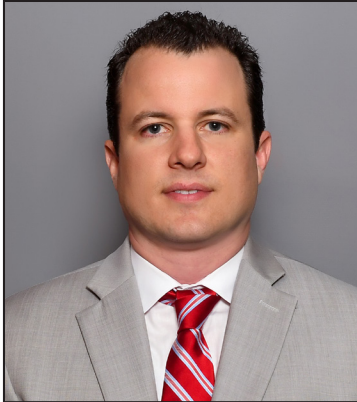

**Lobos Make it 9-0 at Home; Win Streak Now at Seven**

**ALBUQUERQUE, N.M.** --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team extended its win streak to seven on Sunday afternoon with a 19-point victory over the visiting Houston Baptist Huskies, 107-88. The contest marked the first time this season that UNM has reached triple figures.

Sunday's contest also marks the sixth time this season that UNM has scored 90+ points. The last time the Lobos (12-2) registered six games scoring 90 points or more before the end of December was 21 seasons ago, in 1998-99.

UNM is now 9-0 at home inside Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit this season marking the first time since the 2010-11 season that the Lobos have racked up nine consecutive wins in Albuquerque. UNM is also 6-0 in the month of December for the first time since 2011-12.

For the first time this season, UNM debuted a new starting lineup on Sunday afternoon after a pair of regular starters, redshirt-senior Carlton Bragg Jr. and redshirt-junior JJ Caldwell, missed Sunday's contest as announced prior to tipoff via media statement. In their place were redshirt-junior Zane Martin and senior Corey Manigault who combined for 40 points on the day.

It was Manigault who led the Lobos with 21 points going a near-perfect 9-for-10 from the floor followed by Martin with a season-high 19 points and six assists. Redshirt-senior JaQuan Lyle and junior Makuach Maluach also registered 19 points apiece. Redshirt-junior Vance Jackson posted a season-high 14 points to follow up his season best 12 points which he registered on Tuesday. All five starters scored in double figures on the day.

Houston Baptist (0-10), which boasts the third-toughest schedule in the nation according to KenPom ratings, was led by senior Jalon Gates who scored 30 points on the day. Gates is the first player this season to score 30 points against the Lobos.

Overall, UNM outshot HBU 64.1 to 51.5 percent from the floor and outrebounded 35-31 en route to the win. UNM also converted 14 Husky turnovers into 27 points compared to just 13 off of 10 for HBU.

The squads had seven lead changes through a close first half in which neither team was able to get ahead by more than six points before the Lobos went on a huge run in the second half to take the game. UNM had only trailed three times at the half this season, with a record of 2-1 when trailing at the break, but despite a two-point Lobo lead with 47 seconds left, HBU made a pair of layups in the final 31 seconds, including one at the buzzer, to take a two-point advantage at the break, 48-46.

HBU continued its run out of the break, extending it to 10-2 for a six-point lead (54-48) before the Lobos responded with a 16-0 run to take a 10-point lead at the 14:39 mark. The Lobos never trailed again.

The Lobo spurt included a big Maluach block followed by a Lyle-to-Manigault alley-oop that took the run to 11-0 and put UNM up 59-54, causing HBU to call a timeout.

Just 1:08 later, the Lobos extended the run to 16-0 on a Jackson steal that turned into a Martin fast-break layup on the other end. The play came just after a Manigault three from the left corner and the pair of plays caused the Huskies to call another timeout with 14:39 on the clock, when the Lobos led by 10 (64-54).

UNM got ahead by as many as 22 points with 2:11 left on the clock en route to the 19-point final.

The Lobos are set to return to action on Sunday, Dec. 29, when they host UC Davis at 2 p.m. in The Pit. The contest will mark the last of the four-game home stand before UNM returns to the road to re-open conference play at San José State on New Year's Day.

## Aggies pull within four late in Saturday's shootout at San Francisco

**SAN FRANCISCO** — Joe Mooney scored nine straight late in the second half of Saturday's non-conference game at War Memorial at the Sobrato Center, which pulled UC Davis within four points of San Francisco, but the Dons made their shots at the free throw line throughout the final two minutes — their final 14 points were earned at the stripe — to defeat the Aggies, 93-84.

Men's basketball will enter the holiday hiatus at 5-9, USF will continue its season at 10-3.

Mooney led a quartet of double-digit scorers by finishing with 22 points, a total that included 18 earned in the second half. Ezra Manjon ended his afternoon with 17 points; Elijah Pepper and Stefan Gonzalez added another 11 and 10 respectively.

Including Saturday's matchup, the third in a row for the Aggies against a West Coast Conference opponent, Mooney has scored double figures in each of his team's last seven games. Gonzalez posted 10 or more points in four of the Aggies last five.

Pepper led all Aggies with six rebounds; Gonzalez and Kennedy Koehler finished with five boards apiece.

UC Davis enjoyed a strong start by jumping out to a 16-6 lead through the first 9:30 of the game. However, San Francisco responded with a run of its own, and led 33-28 at the break.

"I loved the way we started the game — that was an emphasis — especially with the young guys who are making strides," said head coach Jim Les.

"I am encouraged with this group, with two more non-conference games to play. I like where this group is heading; we are better than we were three weeks ago, and I think we are going to be a better team two or three weeks from now," Les added.

Thanks to an unusual sequence of events early in the second half, which began with a foul called on UC Davis between San Francisco free throws, the Dons ended up leading by as many as 14 points with 12:45 remaining in the game.

UC Davis battled back by scoring 14 of the following 18 points, to pull within four points with 8:44 left to play. That run was fueled by a combination of four free throws and a layup from Damion Squire, a three from Gonzalez, another three a pair of free throws from Koehler, who finished with eight points.

San Francisco followed the Aggies' scoring outburst with a mini 8-4 run of its own until Mooney caught fire and generated a personal nine-point scoring run to pull UC Davis within four.

Also aiding the Aggies' second-half comeback was its success at the stripe. They connected on 22 of 24 attempts (.917) from the line for the game and hit all 21 shots taken throughout the second half.

"I told the guys in the locker room after the game to take a physical break, mental break, get their mind off basketball for a few days, enjoy their family, enjoy the blessings we have ... and prepare to get back to work when we return on the 26th. This break is well-deserved," said Les.

A road-heavy, and challenging non-conference schedule will continue for UC Davis on Dec. 29 when it visits The Pit to face New Mexico. Tipoff is schedule for 1 p.m. PT/2 p.m. MT.

"We didn't take it easy on these guys," said Coach Les regarding the non-conference schedule he and his staff created for this season's team. "We threw a tough schedule at them because we wanted to learn a lot about ourselves. I think we challenges this group, they continue to work hard and stay together, and we will continue to improve because everyone has the right attitude."

The Pit was the site of one of the greatest college basketball games ever played. Coach Jimmy Valvano and the Wolfpack downed the Cougars on a last second put back by Lorenzo Charles. - The Lobos have averaged an astounding 15,410 fans the past 49 years, an amazing 95% of capacity
- The Pit has ranked in the top 25 in attendance nationally nearly every season since the 1966-67 season with 35 seasons in the top ten in the NCAA in attendance
- Led the Mountain West in attendance in 10 of the conference's 15 years of existence
- The floor is named Bob King Court in honor of the former head coach who led the Lobos from 1963 to 1972.

## Game 13 - New Mexico 91, Grand Canyon 71 Dec. 17, 2019 | Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit

**Lobos Extend Win Streak to Six; Top GCU by 20**

**ALBUQUERQUE, N.M.** --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team extended its win streak to six on Tuesday evening with a 91-71 rout of the visiting Grand Canyon 'Lopes (4-8). The contest marked the fifth time this season that the Lobo offense has reached 90 points.

With the victory, the Lobos improve to 11-2 overall to continue UNM's best start to the season since the 2012-13 season. In addition, UNM is now 8-0 at home inside Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit and 5-0 to open December.

The Lobos were led by a pair of 20 point scorers marking the first time since Nov. 17, 2018 against NM State that the Lobos have had a pair of players score 20+ points. Tuesday night, it was redshirt-seniors JaQuan Lyle who led with 21 points, followed by classmate Carlton Bragg Jr. who registered 20 points and 14 rebounds for his fourth double-double in the last five games.

Bragg went 7-for-10 from the floor and a perfect 2-for-2 from behind the arc for just his second and third career 3-pointers. He also registered a perfect 4-for-4 mark from the free throw line and an assist while Lyle was 6-for-9 from the floor, 4-for-5 from three and a perfect 5-for-5 from the stripe with six assists and a pair of steals.

The Lobos also debuted a new weapon on Tuesday night in Vante Hendrix, the Utah transfer who was declared eligible to play prior to Tuesday evening's contest. Hendrix tallied 12 points, all in the second half and all from behind the arc. He finished 4-for-6 from 3-point range.

Hendrix marked the third of five Lobos to score in double figures Tuesday including redshirt-juniors Vance Jackson (12) and Zane Martin (11). Jackson's 12 points marked a season high.

Overall, the Lobos outshot the 'Lopes 55.4 - 48.3 from the floor and 53.8 - 18.2 percent from 3-point range. UNM went a season-best 14-for-26 from behind the arc marking the most threes UNM has fired this season and the second time this season that the Lobos have scored more from 3-point range than their opponent (Grand Canyon made just three on the night, 2-11).

The Lobos also outrebounded 36-24 and capitalized on 12 GCU turnovers for 20 points.

GCU led for just 1:18 of the contest in the early minutes of the game. UNM got out by as many as three before a 6-1 run put the 'Lopes on top by two, 10-8, at the 13:40 mark.

The Lobos quickly rebounded however, with a 12-0 run that was started by a Lyle three, included a pair of Bragg dunks and was capped by a Bragg three. Bragg netted seven points in the run that put UNM up by double digits for the first time, 20-10.

UNM continued its dominating performance throughout the remainder of the first half before an 11-point UNM advantage (31-20) was whittled down to a four-point lead with 52 seconds left in the first half. GCU used a 7-0 run to close the gap to 31-27 but UNM worked the lead back to six, 37-31, at the break.

The Lobos exploded out of the second half with a 6-0 run on a pair of threes from Lyle and Jackson to make it a 12-point game, 43-31.

GCU got the contest back within eight 3:29 later before the Lobos embarked on a massive 11-0 run that was sparked by a dunk from junior Makuach Maluach followed by a free throw and a trio of threes from Lyle, Martin and Hendrix within 3:46.

The spurt put the Lobos up to 20, 59-39 with 12:25 left to play.

UNM held at least a 13-point lead for the rest of the matchup en route to the 20-point victory.

The Lobos have two more home contests before heading back out on the road. UNM is set to take on Houston Baptist on Sunday, Dec. 22 at 12:30 p.m. inside Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit.

**Lobos Make it 9-0 at Home; Win Streak Now at Seven**

**ALBUQUERQUE, N.M.** --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team extended its win streak to seven on Sunday afternoon with a 19-point victory over the visiting Houston Baptist Huskies, 107-88. The contest marked the first time this season that UNM has reached triple figures.

Sunday's contest also marks the sixth time this season that UNM has scored 90+ points. The last time the Lobos (12-2) registered six games scoring 90 points or more before the end of December was 21 seasons ago, in 1998-99.

UNM is now 9-0 at home inside Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit this season marking the first time since the 2010-11 season that the Lobos have racked up nine consecutive wins in Albuquerque. UNM is also 6-0 in the month of December for the first time since 2011-12.

For the first time this season, UNM debuted a new starting lineup on Sunday afternoon after a pair of regular starters, redshirt-senior Carlton Bragg Jr. and redshirt-junior JJ Caldwell, missed Sunday's contest as announced prior to tipoff via media statement. In their place were redshirt-junior Zane Martin and senior Corey Manigault who combined for 40 points on a pair of

It was Manigault who led the Lobos with 21 points going a near-perfect 9-for-10 from the floor followed by Martin with a season-high 19 points and six assists. Redshirt-senior JaQuan Lyle and junior Makuach Maluach also registered 19 points apiece. Redshirt-junior Vance Jackson posted a season-high 14 points to follow up his season best 12 points which he registered on Tuesday. All five starters scored in double figures on the day.

Houston Baptist (0-10), which boasts the third-toughest schedule in the nation according to KenPom ratings, was led by senior Jalon Gates who scored 30 points on the day. Gates is the first player this season to score 30 points against the Lobos.

Overall, UNM outshot HBU 64.1 to 51.5 percent from the floor and outrebounded 35-31 en route to the win. UNM also converted 14 Husky turnovers into 27 points compared to just 13 off of 10 for HBU.

The squads had seven lead changes through a close first half in which neither team was able to get ahead by more than six points before the Lobos went on a huge run in the second half to take the game. UNM had only trailed three times at the half this season, with a record of 2-1 when trailing at the break, but despite a two-point Lobo lead with 47 seconds left, HBU made a pair of layups in the final 31 seconds, including one at the buzzer, to take a two-point advantage at the break, 48-46.

HBU continued its run out of the break, extending it to 10-2 for a six-point lead (54-48) before the Lobos responded with a 16-0 run to take a 10-point lead at the 14:39 mark. The Lobos never trailed again.

The Lobo spurt included a big Maluach block followed by a Lyle-to-Manigault alley-oop that took the run to 11-0 and put UNM up 59-54, causing HBU to call a timeout.

Just 1:08 later, the Lobos extended the run to 16-0 on a Jackson steal that turned into a Martin fast-break layup on the other end. The play came just after a Manigault three from the left corner and the pair of plays caused the Huskies to call another timeout with 14:39 on the clock, when the Lobos led by 10 (64-54).

UNM got ahead by as many as 22 points with 2:11 left on the clock en route to the 19-point final.

The Lobos are set to return to action on Sunday, Dec. 29, when they host UC Davis at 2 p.m. in The Pit. The contest will mark the last of the four-game home stand before UNM returns to the road to re-open conference play at San José State on New Year's Day.
