TUESDAY'S OPPONENT

New Mexico is 4-0 after defeating McNeese State, 90-80, on Nov. 16. Like the Miners and UTEP coach Rodney Terry, UNM Head Coach Paul Weir has multiple transfers on his roster who are making serious contributions early in the season. During UNM's 10-point victory over McNeese State, senior transfer Corey Manigault led the Lobos with 24 points on 12-of-16 shooting from the free-throw line. JaQuan Lyle, a transfer from Ohio State, tallied 18 points as he shot 3-for-5 from downtown. Carlton Bragg, a 6-10 transfer from Kansas, ripped down 18 boards and snagged five steals. Lyle leads the Lobos at 19.0 points per game, while Manigault (15.8 ppg), Makauch Maluach (12.3 ppg), Bragg (11.8 ppg) and Zane Martin (11.8) are all averaging double-digit figures. Martin is also a transfer (Towson). Bragg is averaging 11.0 rebounds per game and JJ Caldwell, a transfer from Texas A&M, leads the way with 23 assists.

LOCKING DOWN ON DEFENSE

UTEP is ranked no. 1 in Conference USA with field goal defense, as opponents are only shooting 35.9 percent from the field. The Miners have also allowed only 59.0 points per game, ranking second in C-USA behind North Texas (55.3 ppg allowed). Nationally, the Miners rank 43rd in field goal percentage defense and 44th in scoring defense.

GOING TO BACK NM STATE GAME

The Miners defeated NM State, 65-50, on Nov. 12 and ending a nine-game losing streak to their bitter rival. The 50 points allowed against the Aggies were the least since Nov. 29, 1983 when the Aggies only mustered up 49 points in a 13-point loss to UTEP.

BOXING OUT

The Miners are averaging over 40 rebounds per game. Their plus-10.3 rebound margin ranks third in Conference USA and 39th nationally. On the defensive boards, UTEP averages 31.0 per game, ranking second in C-USA and 37th nationally. Recently, UTEP outrebounded ENMU 46-23.

BRYSON'S SOLID START

Bryson Williams is averaging 16.5 points per game, a career high for the redshirt junior. He ranks eighth in Conference USA in that department. Williams's 65.4 percent from the field ranks fourth in C-USA. Williams averaged just under 14 points his sophomore season at Fresno State and just over seven points per game his freshman year.

BRYSON FROM DOWNTOWN

Bryson Williams is 2-for-3 from the three-point line in his first three games as a Miner. He worked on his outside game after sitting out last season due to NCAA transfer rules. While at Fresno State, Williams didn't attempt a trey in his freshman season, while going 1-for-4 in his sophomore campaign.

DISHING DIMES

Jordan Lathon loves to distribute. The sophomore, after leading UTEP in assists a season ago, once again leads in that department. Lathon is averaging 4.0 assists per game, ranking seventh in Conference USA. More importantly, Lathon's plus-3 in assist-to-turnover-ratio ranks fifth in C-USA and 72nd nationally.

MINER MINUTES

UTEP Head Coach **Rodney Terry** finally has a bench with great depth. Against Eastern New Mexico on Nov. 15, not one player tallied over 30 minutes as Terry used nine guys off the bench. Last season, seven players averaged over 21.0 minutes per game, while this season five players are averaging over 20.0 a game. **Daryl Edwards** leads at 33.7 minutes per game, while ranking seventh in Conference USA. **Souley Boun** (31.7 mpg) ranks second on the team, while **Jordan Lathon** (30.0) ranked third. **Eric Vila** averages 28.0 minutes per game and **Bryson Williams** plays 20.3 per game. **Efe Odigie** (18.0 mpg), **Nigel Hawkins** (17.0 mpg) and **Deon Stroud** (16.5 mpg) average double-figure minutes.

VIVA VILA

Eric Vila opened his UTEP career with a double-double and one solid stat line. The redshirt junior transfer from Northwest Florida State College scored 11 points, grabbed 11 rebounds and dished out six assists. Against NM State, Vila's stat line help the Miners end a nine-game losing streak against their bitter rivals. Vila scored seven points, recorded six rebounds and tallied three assists.

OTHER TIDBITS IN UTEP-UNM RIVALRY

The two programs were in the WAC from the 1969-70 season through 1998-99. The Lobos own a 33-27 mark in WAC regular season games, while UTEP beat them in the 1990 and 1992 WAC Tourney. Lobos won 8 in a row (1975-1979). Miners won five in a row (1979-1982), and went 13-1 during a stretch from 1980-1986. Lobos dominated the 90's, going 15-5 before departing for the Mountain West Conference. The two programs met on multiple occasions throughout the 20's, 30's, 40's, 50's and 60's. They played consistently as nonconference opponents from the 1933-34 season through the 1969-70 season before joining the Western Athletic Conference. The two programs first met during the 1928-29 season (no date indicated) - Lobos won 46-27.
