The Bradley basketball team returns to Carver Arena and hosts New Mexico in the final game of the Missouri Valley-Mountain West Challenge. Tipoff on Saturday is set for 7 p.m.

## KEY BRAVES NUMBERS

Bradley has had five different leading scorers in eight games this season.

Luuk van Bree has averaged 16.0 points in the last two games after starting the year with 2.2 points in the first five.
The Braves are averaging 32.0 bench points in the last two games after averaging just 9.8 in the season's first six games.

Darrell Brown is just 36 points shy of becoming the 47th Brave in school history with 1,000 career points.

BU is allowing 61.3 points in its six wins this season but surrendering 78.0 points in its two losses.

Bradley and New Mexico are facing each other for the first time since the 1964 NIT title game - an 86-54 BU win.

## ROBINSON INDUCTED IN HALL OF FAME

- At halftime of Saturday's game, former Brave standout and current New Mexico assistant coach Jerome Robinson will be inducted into the Bradley Athletics Hall of Fame.
- The 2001 Valley Defensive Player of the Year and first-team All-MVC honoree, Robinson finished as the league's third-leading scorer in 2000-01 with 16.9 points per game.
- Overall, Robinson appeared in 113 career games with 947 points, 356 rebounds and 206 assists.


## ABOUT THE BRAVES

- Bradley is coming off its second defeat of the season, falling at IUPUI on Wednesday, 85-73.
- The Braves are now 6-2 on the year but return to Carver Arena, where they are a perfect 4-0 this season and 17-2 in the last two years.
- Junior Darrell Brown leads the Braves with 14.5 points and 3.8 assists per game in 2018-19.
- The reigning MVC Player of the Week, Elijah Childs is second with 13.8 points and first on the team with 8.5 boards.
- Five Braves average at least nine points with Dwayne Lautier-Ogunleye (9.9), Koch Bar (9.8) and Nate Kennell (9.1) rounding out the top five.
- Bradley is scoring 72.4 points per game and also owns a top- 75 defense nationally at 65.5 points.


## SERIES HISTORY

- Bradley has won the only two meetings with New Mexico and the schools are playing for the first time in Peoria.
- After winning a road contest in 1938, Bradley also defeated the Lobos in the 1964 NIT Championship game, 86-54. The Braves, who shot 62 percent in the victory, were led by MVP Levern Tart (13 points, 8 rebounds) and Joe Strawder (21 points).


## BRAVES VERSUS MOUNTAIN WEST

- Bradley has never defeated a Mountain West school since the league's formation in 1999, losing all nine meetings with conference teams.
- Overall, Bradley is 11-11 against the league's current members in its history.


## MVC-MOUNTHIN WEST CHALLENGE

- Saturday's matchup is the last game of the 2018 Missouri Valley - Mountain West Challenge Series.
- The Valley currently leads the series, 5-3, with the San Diego State at Illinois State matchup earlier in the day on Saturday.
- The Braves are winless in six games in the series, falling to BYU (2009), Utah (2010), Wyoming (2011), Boise State (2015), Nevada (2016) and San Diego State (2017). Four of BU's six MWC opponents have finished either top three in the league or won the conference tournament.


## hBOUT THE LOBOS

- New Mexico enters the weekend with a 3-1 mark in 2018-19 and were last in action on Saturday with an 84-78 victory against UTEP.
- Anthony Mathis leads the team with 16.5 points - shooting 62.5 percent from the field and 66.7 percent from 3-point range.
- Vance Jackson is second on the team with 16.0 points and first with 7.8 rebounds, while Corey Manigault is third with 14.0 points.
- The Lobos are averaging 88.8 points per game and have scored at least 84 in all four games but are also allowing teams to score 85.8 points.


## BENCH CONTRIBUTIONS

- After a start to the season where the team's starting five led the Braves, the BU bench is coming off its two most productive games of the season.
- Bradley has scored 64 bench points in the last two games - 36 versus Chicago State and 28 versus IUPUI - after totaling 59 in its first six contests.
- Before the two-game run, Bradley had not scored more than 16 bench points in any game and was only averaging 9.8 points from its reserves.


## VAN BREE LERDS BENCH SURGE

- Senior Luuk van Bree has led the surge from the bench during the last two games.
- After suffering an injury and missing the entire preseason, van Bree is rounding into form and has scored 32 points in the last two contests - shooting 60.0 percent from the field and 55.6 percent from 3-point range.
- In his first five games (missed opener), van Bree totaled 11 points and averaged only 2.2 per game.


## BRLANCED SCORING

- Luuk van Bree's 18-point game on Wednesday continued BU's trend of balanced scoring.
- In eight games, five different Braves have led the team in scoring and no player more than twice.
- The Braves currently have five players averaging at least nine points per game.
- Seven different Braves have scored at least 20 points in a game during their career - including three this season for just the first (Koch Bar \& Elijah Childs) or second time (Dwayne Lautier-Ogunleye).

## DEFENSE KEYS VICTORY

- Through eight games, the Braves have only gone as far as their defense will take them.
- In its six wins, Bradley is allowing only 61.3 points per game and has surrendered more than 65 points only once.
- However, in its two losses, BU is allowing 78.0 points per game and teams are shooting more than 11 percent better from the field.

- Offensively, the Braves are averaging 72.7 points in their six wins and 71.5 in their two defeats


## 65 POINTS

- The defensive number the Braves need to aim for is to keep their opponent under 65 points.
- Since the beginning of the 2017-18 campaign, Bradley is 18-1 when its opponent scores fewer than 65 points.
- However, the Braves are just 8-14 when teams hit the mark and 4-10 when allowing 70 or more points (22-5 when allowing fewer than 70).


## FIRST HRLF LEAD CHANGES ONLY

- Fans should arrive early to Bradley games as the contests have been mostly decided in the first half.
- In BU's eight games in 2018-19, there has only been one lead change in the second half and one tie.
- In fact, the winning team has led for 157:23 of game action, while trailing for only 1:55 and tied for 0:42.


## CHILDS EARNS MVC WEEKLY HONOR

- Sophomore Elijah Childs was named the Missouri Valley Player of the Week on Monday after leading the Braves to a 3-0 week.
- The Cancun Challenge MVP, Childs averaged 17.0 points, 8.7 rebounds, 2.0 steals and 1.0 blocks during the week - including 19.5 points and 7.5 boards against SMU and Penn State in Mexico.
- Against the Mustangs, Childs set career highs with 21 points and 12 rebounds.
- The weekly honor is the first for Childs during his collegiate career.


## DOUBLE-DIGIT THRERT

- Junior Darrell Brown has proven during his career to be the team's most consistent offensive threat.
- Brown currently is first on the team with 14.5 points and 3.8 assists.
- The junior is the only Brave to score at least 10 points in all eight games this season - the longest streak to start a season since 2007-08 when Daniel Ruffin tallied at least 10 in the first nine games.
- In fact, Brown has scored at least 10 points in 58-of-73 career games and in 35-of-41 games since the beginning of the 2017-18 campaign.
- More than just a scorer, Brown has led BU in assists 47 times in his career (five times this season).


## MILESTONE WRTCH

- Darrell Brown is nearing the 1,000-point mark.
- Brown currently has 964 career points and the junior is just 36 points shy of becoming the 47th Brave in school history to reach 1,000.
- At his current average of 14.4 points, Brown would reach the mark on Dec. 15 versus Eastern Illinois.


## SOPHOMORE SURGE

- Sophomore Elijah Childs looks to take the next step during the 2018-19 season.
- Childs is second on the Braves with 13.8 points and first with 8.5 rebounds through eight games.
- No Brave has averaged at least eight rebounds a game since Patrick O'Bryant in 2005-06.
- Additionally, he is on pace to the be highest-scoring underclassmen since Marcellus Sommerville in 2003-04 ( 15.6 ppg ), while no underclassman has averaged 8.5 rebounds a game since Mitchell Anderson in 1979-80.


## CHILDS TAKES REBOUNDING LEAD

- While Braves have taken turns leading in scoring, it has been one main constant on the boards.
- Elijah Childs has led the team in rebounding in 7-of-8 games, ranking second in the Valley with 8.5 boards per game.
- Childs became the first Brave to lead the team on the glass in each of the season's first five games since Danny Granger did so in 2001-02.
- The sophomore also leads the Braves in steals (12), while ranking second in points (13.8) and blocks (9).


## SHOOTING TARGET

- If Koch Bar shoots, it's more than likely to go in.
- Bar has made 77.8 percent of his field goals this season (28-of-36).
- Bar's 77.8 percent shooting would rank tied for third nationally if he reached the minimum 5.0 makes per game (currently averaging 3.5).
- In the KenPom ratings, Bar ranks 28th nationally in two-point percentage versus Division I schools at 75.0 percent.


## CROSS-BAR

- Center Koch Bar has made a huge jump so far during his junior campaign.
- After averaging 4.6 points in 18 minutes of action as a sophomore, Bar has more than doubled his production - averaging 9.8 points this season.

## HERD COACH BRIAN WHRDLE

- Named the 14th head coach in Bradley men's basketball history on March 28, 2015.
- Has led the Braves to 30 victories in the last two years and is one of four programs nationally to increase its win total by at least five games in each of the last two seasons.
- Led Bradley to its highest MVC finish and first MVC Semifinal appearance since 2010 last year.
- Prior to joining the Braves, Wardle compiled a 95-65 (.594) overall record in his five seasons at Green Bay, which culminated with back-to-back 24-win seasons and three straight postseason appearances and included the 2013-14 Horizon League regular-season title.
- Wardle was the youngest head coach in NCAA Division I basketball when he took over the Green Bay program in 2010 at age 30 and he is second among all NCAA Division I head coaches younger than 40 with 139 career victories.
- Prior to taking over as head coach at Green Bay, Wardle spent the previous five seasons (2005-10) as a Phoenix assistant and two years (2003-05) as Director of Ops at Marquette.
- As a player, Wardle scored 1,690 career points at Marquette, still good for seventh on the school's career scoring list.
- Led the Golden Eagles in scoring in each of his final three seasons (1998-01).

## CANCUN CHALLENGE CHRMPIONS

- The Braves completed their most successful November tournament in decades this season.
- Bradley defeated SMU and Penn State to claim the Cancun Challenge title - the program's first regular-season tournament in 35 years (1983 River City Shootout) and first away from Peoria in 52 years (1966 Sugar Bowl Tournament).
- Elijah Childs was named Tournament MVP after posting 19.5 points and 7.5 boards per game, while Darrell Brown was named to the AllTournament Team with 15.0 points and 2.5 assists.
- The real MVP of the team was the Braves defense as Bradley held its AAC and Big Ten foes to just 59.0 points, 32.4 percent shooting and 21.6 from 3 -point range.


## SHARING THE BALL

- The Braves have done a much better job passing the ball for baskets this season.
- Bradley ranks 51st nationally by assisting on 61.0 percent of its field goals this season (national average is 58.7).
- In fact, Bradley ranks fifth in the Valley in assists per game (14.3) and third in turnovers (12.5). The Braves have not ranked in the top half of the league in both since 2006-07.


## CHRRITY STRIPE

- One area where the Braves have really excelled so far in 2018-19 is getting to the free throw line.
- Bradley ranks first in the Valley and 44th in the country with 123 made free throws this season.
- In fact, BU ranks 44th nationally with a free-throw rate of 42.8 percent (FTA/FGA), while placing 70th by scoring 22.2 percent of its points from the line.


## DRIVING TO THE LINE

- The one player that has really excelled at getting to the free-throw line is senior Dwayne LautierOgunleye.
- The senior ranks first in the Valley in free throws made (30) while placing second at free throws attempted (37).
- Lautier-Ogunleye also places fifth in the KenPom ratings for free-throw rate (102.9\%) and 118th in fouls drawn ( 6.4 per game). He is one of five players in the country with more free throw attempts than field goal attempts.
- A career 64.1 percent shooter from the line entering the year, Lautier-Ogunleye has made 81.1 percent in 2018-19.


## MILESTONE WATCH PART TWO

- Darrell Brown isn't the only Brave with his eye on 1,000 points this season as senior Dwayne Lautier-Ogunleye is also within reach.
- Lautier-Ogunleye has scored 828 points and needs 172 to reach the milestone ( 7.5 per game with at least 23 games left for BU).


## VHLLEY LEADERS

- The Braves feature a couple of players that rank among the active leaders in the MVC.
- Junior Darrell Brown is first in the Valley in assists and second in points, while senior Dwayne LautierOgunleye is third in assists and sixth in points.

## DLO EARNS MVC WEEKLY HONOR

- Dwayne Lautier-Ogunleye was the first Brave to be named MVC Player of the Week, earning the honor on Monday, Nov. 12.
- Lautier-Ogunleye led BU with 17.0 points per game in its first two contests, while also adding 6.5 boards, 3.0 assists and 2.5 steals.
- Lautier-Ogunleye and Elijah Childs are the first Bradley teammates to each win the award in the same season since 2010-11.


## DLO BECOMES OFFENSIVE WEAPON

- The offensive surge for Dwayne Lautier-Ogunleye shouldn't come as a surprise as he increased his output toward the end of last season.
- After averaging 5.4 points in the season's first 19 games last year, Lautier-Ogunleye finished strong before this year's start and has averaged 10.3 points in the 22 games since.

## A TRIPLE THREAT IN KENNELL

- Sophomore Nate Kennell has proven to be a dangerous threat from beyond the arc.
- Kennell led Bradley with 69 triples last season the most by a Brave since Andrew Warren had 76 in 2010-11.
- Kennell has connected on 12-of-39 3-point tries this season ( 30.8 percent), averaging 9.1 points and 1.5 triples per game.


## EUROPERN VACATION

- The Braves enjoyed a trip across the ocean this summer and spent time in the home countries of Dwayne Lautier-Ogunleye (England) and Luuk van Bree (Netherlands) during a foreign tour.
- In London, Bradley defeated the Surrey Scorchers of the British Basketball League, 73-66. Elijah Childs led the team with 20 points and nine rebounds in the victory.
- BU then defeated the Amsterdam Select to wrap up the trip, 74-48. Ari Boya and van Bree led the team with 15 points and 10 rebounds apiece.


## 2017-18 RECAP

- The Braves improved their win total by seven games during the 2017-18 campaign, posting a 20-13 overall record to go with a 9-9 MVC mark.
- Bradley reached the 20-win mark for the first time since 2009 last year.
- The Braves also placed fifth in the final Valley standings before advancing to the MVC Semifinals for the first time since 2010.


## TRENDING UPWRRD

- The seven-win increase from a season ago wasn't a one-year trend. The Braves also increased by eight wins from 2015-16 (5) to 2016-17 (13).
- Bradley is one of four schools nationally to improve its win total by at least five games in each of the last two seasons, joining Auburn, Utah Valley and UTSA.


## BRAVES RETURN 10

- Don't expect the trend of improved wins to slow down any time soon as the Braves return 10-of-13 letterwinners and 4-of-5 starters from last season.
- Overall, the Braves bring back 79.2 percent of points, 73.5 percent of rebounds and 89.0 percent of assists.
- The only significant contributor (and Brave averaging at least 3.0 points per game) to depart is the graduated Donte Thomas. He averaged 11.7 points and 7.2 rebounds last year en route to second-team All-Valley accolades.


## THE BEST UNDER 40

- One of the nation's top young head coaches, Brian Wardle ranks second nationally for most wins by a coach under the age of 40 .

- The ninth-ranked Canadian in the Class of 2018, Ja'Shon Henry averaged 28.5 points, 7.8 rebounds and 2.0 assists at Athol Murray College of Notre Dame in Wilcox, Saskatchewan last year.

## AN ERRLY LERDER IN BROWN

- Darrell Brown has proven to be a leader from the start at Bradley.
- Brown led the Braves in scoring as both a freshman (12.6 points per game) and as a sophomore (13.5).
- The Memphis native is one of only four Braves in school history to lead the team in scoring as both a freshman and sophomore, joining BU greats Paul Unruh (1947-48), Mitchell Anderson (1979-80) and Deon Jackson (1993-94).
- Unruh (5th-leading scorer in BU history) and Anderson (2nd) are the only two Braves to lead the team in scoring in each year through their junior campaign.


## BROWN PRESERSON RLL-MVC

- The team's leading scorer and facilitator in each of his first two seasons, Darrell Brown was named to the MVC Preseason Second Team.
- Brown led the Braves with 13.5 points and 4.3 assists per game during the 2017-18 campaign.


## BRAVES SLATED FOURTH

- In addition to Darrell Brown's individual preseason accolade, Bradley was selected fourth in the annual preseason poll by coaches, SIDs and media.
- It marks the Braves highest selection in the poll in 11 years since being picked second prior to the 2007-08 campaign.


## TRIO OF HONOREES RETURN

- The Braves return three players who collected Valley postseason honors last season.
- Darrell Brown was named to the All-MVC Third Team after leading the Braves in points (13.5 per game) and assists (4.3).
- Dwayne Lautier-Ogunleye was named to the Valley All-Defensive Team after anchoring the nation's 15th-ranked unit.
- Finally, Elijah Childs collected MVC All-Freshman Team honors after a rookie campaign where he averaged 8.4 points and 6.2 rebounds.

- The Bradley Basketball team's cumulative grade point average has remained better than 3.0 for each of the last 14 consecutive semesters.
- The Braves owned a record 3.334 cumulative grade point average following the 2017-18 academic year..
- Last season, Bradley matched a school record with three MVC Scholar-Athlete honorees - Nate Kennell, Dwayne Lautier-Ogunleye and Donte Thomas.


## FAN LOYALTY

- The Braves have ranked among the league's top three in average attendance in each of the past 25 seasons, peaking at 10,178 in 1999-00.
