#### LAST TIME OUT

The Lobos put on a solid performance on Saturday night at Bradley, perhaps the most solid so far this season. Not only was the offense on fire with senior Anthony Mathis shooting seven 3-pointers and totaling 23 points, but the Lobo press and defense was hot. The Lobos turned Bradley over 15 times in the match including four within a two-minute span during UNM's first-half comeback.

Offensively, Mathis went 7-for-14 from Mathis currently has 608 career points. behind the arc and was one of three Lobos to score in double figures including senior Dane LOBOS IN THE NATION Kuiper with 15 points (6-for-10) and junior Corey Manigault who scored 18 including 10 free throws. Manigault also registered his second double-double of the season with 11 rebounds.

#### HALL OF FAMER

Lobo assistant coach Jerome Robinson was -13th - Scoring Offense (88.0) inducted in to the Bradley Athletics Hall of Fame during UNM's game against the Braves.

#### TURNOVERS? NO PROBLEM.

While the Lobos have not done the best job protecting the basketball this season, posting 17.2 turnovers per game for a -2.2 turnover margin, it does not appear to be holding the Lobos back. UNM is 3-1 this season when having more turnovers than its opponent.

#### AND THEN THERE WERE NONE ...

Sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk started the first four games for the Lobos and was the only consistent starter - until Saturday. Saturday's lineup against Bradley featured three freshman, senior Dane Kuiper and sophomore Makuach Maluach. The Lobos officially no longer have a single player that has started in all of their games.

In addition, senior Dane Kuiper marks the lone starter to return from last season and Saturday's game was his first time starting this season.

#### PERCY'S FIRST START

Freshman Tavian Percy earned his first career start on Saturday night against Bradley and racked up a career-high 13 minutes on the court.

#### MATHIS IST IN THE NATION

The NCAA has Lobo senior Anthony Mathis ranked first in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage after Saturday's game at Bradley. Criteria for the statistic includes that a player must have a minimum of 2.5 per game (Mathis has 4.6) and must have competed in 75 percent of the team's games.

Mathis is currently shooting 60.5 percent (23-38) from behind the arc.

#### COUNTDOWN TO 1.000

With 392 points to go, it may seem a bit premature to begin counting down to 1,000 points for senior Anthony Mathis, but consider this: he has scored 89 points in just his first five games of the season. Last year, he finished his junior campaign scoring 433 at 12.7 per game, so far this season he is averaging 17.8 points per game.

The Lobos are trending in national statistical data, as a team and individually. Below are some of the highlights:

#### SATURDAY'S CAREER HIGHS

Mathis' seven 3-pointers ties his career high, which he last accomplished against Utah State at home on Feb. 14, 2018. He also

set a new career-high in 3-point field goals **SHOOTING BETTER** attempted with 14. Prior to Saturday, the most three attempts Mathis had fired off in a game was 10.

Sophomore Makuach Maluach tied his career-high rebounds with six on Saturday against Bradley. The last time he pulled down six boards was on Jan. 31 on the road at Utah State.

#### Comeback Lobos can trail

Saturday night's game against Bradley marked the first time all season that UNM had been leading at the half. So far this season, UNM has been tied at the break twice and been trailing twice. In three of those four games, the Lobos found a way to pull ahead or come back for the victory.

#### BREAKOUT KUIPER

In his past three seasons, senior Dane Kuiper has averaged 6.4, 6.0 and 1.5 points per game, respectively. Last season, as a junior, he served as the squad's most consistent defender. As the lone returning starter from last year's squad, Kuiper is now averaging 10.4 points per game over the first five contests of the season. He is shooting 54.3 percent (19-35) from the floor and 47.4 percent (9-19) from 3-point range.

#### **MAGNIFICENT MANIGAULT**

Junior Corey Manigault continued his series of dominant performances on Tuesday night at Bradley. After sitting most of the game against UTEP on Nov. 24, Manigault burst off the bench with his second double-double of the season (18 points, 11 rebounds) and his fourth game out of five scoring in double **REMEMBERING LAST SEASON** figures.

#### SPEAKING OF OFF THE BENCH

Anthony Mathis' 23 points on Saturday at Bradley ties him for 13th in program history for most points off the bench.

UNM has outshot each of its five opponents from 3-point range so far this season, including NMSU in the loss at home on Nov. 17.

#### ABOUT THE 2018-19 LOBOS

The 2018-19 Lobos have just four returning letterwinners from the 2017-18 squad, including leading-scorer Anthony Mathis (12.7 ppg) who finished fourth in the nation in 3-point percentage and broke the UNM record for most 3-point field goals in a conference season (66) as a junior. The squad also adds nine newcomers and returns a pair of sitting transfers to the team that finished third in Mountain West regular-season play last season.

In addition to Mathis, UNM's returners include senior Dane Kuiper, who is the lone returning starter, and sophomores Makuach Maluach and Vladimir Pinchuk. Maluach finished his inaugural season averaging 9.6 points per game and ranks fourth all-time on the Lobo freshman single-season scoring list.

"The Pit" has also been consistently recognized nationally as one of the nation's top basketball venues. Sports Illustrated has ranked it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. Saturday's game also marked the finale of the 2018 Mountain West / Missouri Valley Challenge. Prior to the game, the Mountain West was down 5-4, but the Lobo victory made it 5-5 and marked the third consecutive season that the challenge resulted in a tie.

Also of note on the night, Lobo assistant coach and Bradley alum Jerome Robinson was officially inducted into the Braves' Hall of Fame for his outstanding accomplishments during his time at Bradley.

Mathis led UNM with his 23 points, 18 of which came on six 3-pointers in the first half, to finish just two points short of his career high (25). He was followed by junior Corey Manigault who scored 18 and fellow senior Dane Kuiper who tallied 15. Manigault registered the only double-double on the floor for the night with 18 points and 11 rebounds. He went 4-for-9 from the floor and 10-for-11 from the free throw line. Kuiper was 6-for-10 from the floor, 2-for-5 from behind the arc and 1-for-1 from the stripe.

Much like the first few games of the season, the Lobos started out slow on Saturday and even got behind by as much as 11 points before roaring back to take the lead and claim the victory.

"You have to tip your cap to Bradley, I thought the first five or so minutes of the game was terrific and I thought the last 8-10 minutes was a very good basketball team working to get back," head coach Paul Weir said. "Fortunately that 20-25 minutes or so in the middle, we were really able to establish our style of play and do it in such a way that it overcame that last 15 minutes that we still have to improve upon."

Bradley opened the contest on an 11-0 run over the first 2:34 on a starting lineup that consisted of a trio of freshmen, Tavian Percy, Drue Drinnon and Jordan Arroyo, along

with Kuiper and sophomore Makuach Maluach. A jumper from sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk, who until Saturday night was UNM's lone consistent starter, at the 16:44 mark started the scoring for UNM.

The Lobos were quick to get back in it, however, taking a 10-point Brave lead (14-4) down to two (16-14) within 2:56 on a 10-2 run. The run included a pair of threes from Mathis.

A three from Bradley's Nate Kennell at the 8:28 mark put the Braves up by four, 22-18, but a Mathis 3-pointer just 38 seconds later brought the Lobos within one, 22-21.

Mathis followed with another less than a minute later to give the Lobos their first lead of the game, 24-22. Bradley's Dwayne Lautier-Ogunleye made a jumper to tie it at 24-24 before Mathis followed with yet another from behind the arc, his fifth of the game to take a three-point lead that the Lobos never again relinquished.

UNM extended the first-half lead to eight with 2:46 left on a jumper and a dunk by Manigault before Bradley whittled it back to four, 36-32.

The Lobo seniors closed the first half in style as Dane Kuiper dunked with 46 seconds left and Mathis hit his sixth three of the night with nine seconds on the clock for a nine-point lead at the half, 41-32.

UNM held onto a double-digit advantage for most of the second half en route to the 85-75 victory. It was Kuiper and Manigault that led the Lobos in the second frame. Kuiper scored 11 points including a pair of 3-pointers while Manigault scored twice from the floor and added eight free throws for 12 second-half points.

The Lobos turned Bradley over 15 times, including four in a two-minute span during UNM's first-half run.

For just the second time this season, UNM outrebounded its opponent, 40-33. The Lobos also outshot their opponent in every category. UNM was 43.3 percent (26-60) from the field, 37.5 percent (12-32) from 3-point range and 87.5 percent (21-24) from the free throw line.

UNM held Bradley to 43.1 percent from the floor (25-58), 35 percent from three (35 percent) and Bradley shot 62.1 percent from the free throw line.

Bradley outscored the Lobos in the paint 32-24 and off of turnovers 17-15, but UNM held the advantage in second-half points, 16-11, and in points off of the bench, 60-11. Mathis' 23 points ranks him tied for 13th in program history with most points off the bench.

Both the Braves and the Lobos had three players score in double figures. Mathis led all players on the night but the other 20-point scorer on the floor was Bradley's Darrell Brown, who posted 20 on 7-for-15 from the field and 3-for-6 from behind the arc. Lautier-Ogunleye followed with 16 and standout Elijah Childs was held to 13.

The Lobos return to action on Tuesday, Dec. 4 when they take on New Mexico State in Las Cruces. Tipoff is set for 7 p.m.

#### Late Comeback Falls Short, Three score 20+ Points

**ALBUQUERQUE, N.M.** --- After falling behind by as much as 19 points with just 9:08 left to play, The University of New Mexico men's basketball team put on an impressive show in a comeback attempt that saw the Lobos rack up a 13-0 second-half run in front of over 14,000 fans inside Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit. The run fell short however, as UNM eventually suffered a four-point loss, 98-94, to the Aggies in the Rio Grande Rivalry matchup.

A trio of Lobos racked up 20 points or more including redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson (27), senior Anthony Mathis (22) and junior Corey Manigault (20). The game marks Manigault's second straight in which he has netted 20 points. The fourth Lobo to score in double figures was senior Dane Kuiper, who posted 10.

Jackson added a team-high six rebounds to his 27 points and drew nine fouls on the night. He was also one of six Lobos to accumulate four or more fouls.

The Lobos outshot NMSU in every category including 59.6 - 56.6 percent from the field, 55.0 - 52.2 percent from behind the arc and 70.0 - 66.7 percent from the foul line, but the Aggies' redshirt-junior AJ Harris went an unstoppable 9-for-11 from the field, 6-for-6 from 3-point range and 7-for-10 from the free throw line to total 31 points, leading NMSU to victory. NMSU also knocked in 26 free throws compared to 21 for UNM, accounting for the four-point differential.

"First, thank you so much to all of the fans that came out today," head coach Paul Weir said in a press conference. "It was an exceptional sign of how far I think we've grown and where our program is hopefully headed. Unfortunately, the result is not what we wanted. It's incredibly disappointing, and inevitably that falls on me."

The teams remained within three points over the first five minutes until the Lobos began to pull ahead on a Mathis three and a jumper by sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk, making the score 13-5 for an eight-point lead, the most for UNM of the day.

The Aggies closed the gap and claimed a one-point advantage, 14-13, with 9:46 left in the first half and extended it to six at the break, 44-38. It was the first time the Lobos have been down at the half so far this season as UNM has tied its opponents heading into the break in both of its first two regular-season games.

Mathis cut the six-point deficit to three within the first 12 seconds of the second half (44-41) to set the tone, but NMSU took off on a 16-3 run over the ensuing 4:34 to get back out to a commanding 16-point lead, 60-44.

It was then that Manigault took the game into his own hands, scoring the next 10 points for the Lobos on three field goals and four free throws. Manigault scored eight points in 56 seconds including a 5-0 run to reduce the deficit to 11, 49-60, before he was substituted at the 13:02 mark with NMSU leading by 13, 65-52.

Manigault was off the floor for 1:42 during which the Lobos endured a scoring drought and allowed the Aggies to pull back ahead by 19. Manigault re-entered and hit a jumper at the 10:36 mark to cut it back to 17 as UNM continued to battle.

With the Aggies up by 19 for the third time in the contest, the Lobos erupted for a 16-5 run over 3:15 to cut the score back to single digits, 80-72, with 5:12 on the clock. After suffering another barrage of Aggie points, UNM cut another 14-point deficit down to eight over 1:15 on a pair of threes by Mathis and Jackson as well as a pair of Mathis free throws with 1:10 left, 92-84.

The score was 96-89 with just 34 seconds left on the clock and the game looked over until Jackson hit a huge three to make it a four-point game followed by a Weir timeout.

Mathis notched a layup out of the timeout to make it a two-point game with seven seconds left but with little time left on the clock, the Lobos were forced to play the foul game, allowing for a pair of free throws from NMSU for the 98-94 final.

The Lobos caused 14 turnovers, committing 15, and collected eight steals to six for NMSU. The Aggies capitalized on turnovers for 23 points compared to 18 for UNM while the Lobos outscored NMSU 32-30 in the paint.

UNM has a week to recuperate before returning to action on Saturday, Nov. 24 when it hosts UTEP at 5:30 p.m. on the Mountain West Network.

#### @NMStateMBB Topples Washington State at Home

**LAS CRUCES, N.M.** – Resiliency and key possessions on both ends of the floors led the New Mexico State men's basketball team to its first victory over a Power-5 opponent in 16 years Saturday night when it defeated Washington State out of the Pac-12 Conference 69-63 in the Pan American Center.

The win was NM State's first win over a Power-5 opponent at home since it defeated Colorado 75-71 at home on Nov. 27, 2002. It was also the third-consecutive year the Aggies have taken down a Power-5 foe.

"You know, again, proud of my guys," Aggie head coach Chris Jans said postgame. "They found a way to win. That's what you got to do against good competition. Two games in a row, we're more of a defensive minded team and the score has been more like what I'm used to. Gave up 58 in our last road game and then tonight against a Pac-12 team that's averaging 85 we gave up 63 points."

NM State (6-1) got off to a nice start thanks to an 8-2 run on a pair of 3-pointers from C.J. Bobbitt and AJ Harris before the first round of subs came in.

After taking a commanding 24-12 lead over Wazzu (4-2), the Aggies saw their lead cut to 24-18 after a 6-0 run from the Cougars heading into the 7:54 media break. The Cougars added a pair of buckets out of the media break and cut NM State's lead to 28-25 before a steal from Shunn Buchanan led to a JoJo Zamora fastbreak layup that broke a 5:09 minute scoring drought for NM State. A 12th turnover by WSU gave way to 3-ball from Bobbitt that gave the Aggies a 33-25 cushion heading into the locker room.

The cog to New Mexico State's lead at the break was converting those 12 WSU turnovers into a 12-0 advantage in points off turnovers.

New Mexico State saw its lead dwindle to just 38-35 at the 14:47 media break in the second half after a 10-5 run from Washington State. Viont'E Daniels then hit a 3-pointer for the Cougars at the 14:11 mark to tie it up at 38-38.

WSU had a chance to take its first lead of the game when Robert Franks got fouled in the paint. However, the Cougars' leading scorer missed both free-throws that led to a quick 5-2 run from NM State – which was capped off by a corner three from Terrell Brown for the 43-40 lead with 11:26 remaining in the game.

Jabari Rice pushed the Aggie lead to 45-42 after knocking down a pair of free-throws before Washington State tied things up once again – this time on a three from Robinson 45-45. Ivan Aurrecoechea then knocked a pair of shots from the charity stripe to make it 47-45 with 9:08 on the clock.

Washington State continued to chip away at the Aggie lead every time NM State would extend its lead. But, a solid night from the free-throw line (16-of-21). During the final 10 minutes of play, the Aggies wound up hitting 14-consecutive shots from the foul line before missing their second shot down the stretch. Those free-throws allowed New Mexico State to push its lead to 64-56 with 1:53 left in the game.

The Cougars brought it within 68-63 with 29 seconds left in the game on a jumper from Carter Skaggs, but there wasn't enough time on the clock or timeouts for WSU as NM State walked away with the 69-63 victory at home.

Bobbitt finished with a team-high 15 points with seven boards on 5-of-6 shooting. The 15 points was just two shy of his career-high of 17 from his time at Denver. Brown added 14 points of his own with five boards and pair of assists in the win, including a 6-of-6 night from the line. Harris rounded out the double-digit scorers for NM State with a dozen points while Buchanan dished out a season-high seven assists with three steals and three points.

#### BY THE NUMBERS

NM State forced 19 turnovers and converted them into 20 points on the night...Aggies won once again despite losing the battle of the boards, 34-31...NM State also outscored WSU 17-5 in fastbreak points...the last time the Aggies had three players reach double-figures in a game was against Grand Canyon in the WAC Tournament Championship game.

#### UP NEXT

New Mexico State's celebration over a Power-5 team at home will be short-lived as it turns its focus towards Battle of I-25 rival New Mexico. The Aggies and Lobos are set to square off next Tuesday, Dec. 4, at 7 p.m. (MT) inside the Pan American Center. Adam Young (@youngpbp) will have the call while former Neil McCarthy assistant Rus Bradburd serves as the analyst on the broadcast.

## THE GREATEST GAME EVER PLAYED

The Pit was the site of one of the greatest college basketball games ever played. It hosted the 1983 national championship game that saw the NC State Wolfpack upset Hakeem Olajuwon, Clyde Drexler and the Houston Cougars. Coach Jimmy Valvano and the Wolfpack downed the Cougars on a last second put back by Lorenzo Charles. The iconic shot of the late Valvano running onto the court looking for a hug is one of the lasting images in college basketball history.

- Less than 30 of 345 NCAA Division I basketball programs play in a college-only arena named after a business or organization founded or headquartered in its home state.
- The Lobos have averaged an astounding 15,410 fans the past 49 years, an amazing 95% of capacity
- The Pit has ranked in the top 25 in attendance nationally nearly every season since the 1966-67 season with 35 seasons in the top ten in the NCAA in attendance
- Led the Mountain West in attendance in 10 of the conference's 15 years of existence
- The floor is named Bob King Court in honor of the former head coach who led the Lobos from 1963 to 1972.






