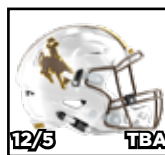

Media At Practice

Thanks COVID. All practices are closed. Contact Frank Mercogiano for procuring footage or photos.

Danny Gonzales Interview Opportunities

Coach Gonzales is available via Zoom at the opportunities listed in the weekly schedule, but its generally Monday through Wednesday.

Schedules for the two short weeks (two Friday games) will be announced at a later date.

New Mexico Media Luncheon

In the fall, the New Mexico Media Luncheons are Tuesdays from noon to 1 p.m. Coach Danny Gonzales is available at 12:30 p.m. and he will be followed at the podium by offensive coordinator Derek Warehime and defensive coordinator Rocky Long. Audio and video clips from the UNM communications office, and also at www.golobos.com. The press conferences are also streamed on GoLobos.com by LoboTV. Please note that the Mountain West no longer conducts a football coaches teleconference. The luncheon is on the Zia II level of the West press box. So COVID 19 changed all of that. There will not be any media luncheons in 2020. COVID willing, they will return for the 2021 season. Marty Watts should have built up a few stories in the interim.

New Mexico Player Interview Opportunities

All player interviews must be arranged through the UNM athletics communications office. The main time for interviews is after practice. Wednesday is the last day for player interviews. For lengthier interviews, please call the communications office to arrange, which we are happy to do, working around class schedules. These will normally take place in the communications suite in the Maloof Center. See the above schedule. Players are available Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday after practice, either via Zoom for TV or phone for print/digital.

Postgame: The UNM locker room is closed. Requested players will be brought to the football classroom on the second floor of the Tow Diehm football building and outside the locker room for road games. UNM communications will have coach Gonzales and two players address the media, and other players that are needed for one-on-ones may be requested. The student athletes will be available in the football classroom after the press conferences for one-on-one opportunities. Thanks COVID. It's all ZOOM and media will have links regardless if the game is home or away. For UNM media that isn't in the stadium, the ZOOM pressers will still be accessible for your coverage.

Wireless in the Press Box

The press box at University Stadium is fully equipped for wireless connections. Access is free, but those wanting access need their own internal or external wireless cards. Phone lines are available. There won't be a lot of media there this season, so it should be a very strong signal.

On Game Day, the northeast box office at University Stadium opens four hours prior to kickoff, and the Lobo Ticket Office at University Arena opens three hours before game time. The northwest University Stadium box office opens 90 minutes before kickoff.

Game Credentials

Regular UNM media will receive game credentials prior to the start of the season. Media members with season credentials will also serve as a parking pass for the Baseball South lot across from the stadium (the Baseball East lot is no longer a media lot)

Visiting team media should request single-game credentials through their team's media relations office. Media passes work as parking passes for the Baseball South lots:

Media members not associated directly with a team can email requests to fmercog@unm.edu. Please have these Wednesday of game week (Tuesday for the Friday night home game):

For media members picking up credentials at will call without parking passes, it is located in the Northeast corner of the stadium by Gate 7 or 8. With parking passes credentials will be located at the University Drive entrance to the Baseball South lot with the parking attendant. This should allow you to get your credential without having to wait in line or deal with parking on the north side of the stadium. Finally a COVID benefit. Media will be able to park in Stadium West right by the media entrance which is Gate 3. The media level this year will be Zia I, which is outside, so dress accordingly. There is an inside area to work from for print, photo and digital on that level.

Parking

Media parking is located across and just south of the stadium off University Drive. Media members can park in the Baseball South lot which is located next to University Drive. The Baseball South lot entrance is off University Drive south of the new R.D. and Dale Hubbard Clubhouse. Just kidding it's Stadium West and just show your credential.

Visiting Radio

The visiting radio booth is located on the fourth level of the main press box, next to the main media area.

It took a long time to get to this point, plus an extra week, but the New Mexico Lobos will finally open the 2020 season, doing so this Saturday against San José State in the head coaching debut of Danny Gonzales. Gonzales, who lettered at Valley High School in Albuquerque and then played at UNM from 1995-98, is one of 16 FBS head coaches that is leading his alma mater. Gonzales however is the only one whose first game in this season (Shawn Clark coached in App State's bowl game last season). Gonzales is UNM's first graduate to lead the squad since Rocky Long from 1998-2008. The list of 16 head coaches leading their alma maters is the subject of our long overdue Opening List.

Welcome Back Gang!

When the game with San José State kicks off, it will have been 336 days between Lobo football games, and that is the longest time between games in over a century.

The 336 span is the longest since UNM once went 693 days between games. That was caused by a small little military conflict called World War I, which back then wasn't ever called World War I because there hadn't been a second one (it was referred to as the Great World War). UNM completed the 1917 season by losing to New Mexico State on November 24, 1917.

Due to the decimation of the roster due to the war (the 1917 season was just two games, two of which were against high schools) and where have we heard this before, a global pandemic (the 1918 Influenza Epidemic), UNM didn't play at all in 1918. The next game was after the war, on October 18, 1919 over New Mexico Mines.

Better Late Than Never

The opening date of October 31 is the latest opening date for a New Mexico season since 1912. That year UNM went 0-4 and opened the season with a 20-0 loss to New Mexico Military. Additionally, the December 12 home finale against Fresno State is the latest scheduled home finale since the 1893 season, when the finale was so late it actually occurred in 1894. That year UNM beat New Mexico State 18-6 in the first meeting between the two teams on January 1, 1894. That was so long ago touchdowns were five points, a point after was one point, a field goal was four and a safety was two, and there were no two-point attempts.

Switch 'Em Up

Brandt Hughes opened the 2019 season as UNM's starting quarterback, but he lasted all of one half before leaving with a labrum issue which ended his season. After tearing it in 2019, he tore it again in 2020, meaning UNM will have a different starter to open the season, but that shouldn't be a shocker. In the last 11 seasons, only one time has UNM had the season opening game starter in back-to-back seasons, and that was in 2013 and 2014, when Cole Gautsche started both openers.

UNM is expected to start either Tevaka Tuioti, who took the opening snap in 2017, or Trae Hall, who took the opening snap in the season finale last year against Utah State.

It may feel odd to open a season with a conference game, and this entire season may very well feel odd, opening a season with a conference game isn't that weird. The 2011 season saw UNM open the year on September 3 by hosting Colorado State. UNM lost that game 14-10. UNM has never opened with San José State, but it ended the 2006 season with it, losing in the first New Mexico Bowl 20-12.

Just One More in a Weird Year

No Lobo coach has ever had an opening year like Danny Gonzales has had, and now along with COVID and everything else, he can add one more to the list. Gonzales is the only Lobo coach to not just have his debut game canceled once, but it's now twice.

UNM originally was opening on August 29 against Idaho State at University Stadium, and the Mountain West announced just a 10-game season (this was back on August 5). Five days later the fall season was postponed (August 10). A month and a half later we were back on (September 25) and on October 1, it was announced that UNM would open the Gonzales era on October 24 against Colorado State (that's take two).

Last Tuesday, through no fault of UNM's own doing, the game with CSU was canceled and declared a no contest, and now Gonzales' opening game is against San José State (that's take three). That opener on Monday was moved from Albuquerque to San José.

What's Back, and What's Not

As a part of National Mentorship Day on Tuesday, October 27, two members of the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team will be interviewed by Tim Tebow via Instagram live on Tebow's account to talk about the importance of mentorship and how mentorship has affected them. One of the members of the team selected for the interview was UNM's own Teton Saltes. The Instagram live will take place on Tuesday at 1:40 p.m. Mountain Time.

I Mean it is Sort of Fitting He has the Same Name as a Mountain Range

The Teton Mountains are a 40-mile range located in Wyoming (but let's face it, the best view is from Eastern Idaho). The mountains are big, rugged and tower over the landscape at 13,775 feet at their peak. The exact same sentence really could be stated about UNM's mountain of a man, Teton Saltes.

Saltes, who is entering his senior season, has 24 consecutive starts at tackle (he is tied for the team lead in that category) and Saturday will be his 29th game at tackle for UNM. Saltes has been one of UNM's most honored players in the preseason.

Saltes was selected to the Outland Trophy Watch List for lineman, one of 32 tackles in the nation to make the list. The list also includes, 21 offensive guards, 17 defensive tackles and 15 centers.

The recipient of the 75th Outland Trophy will be announced in early December. The official presentation to the winner will be made in Omaha, Neb., at the Outland Trophy Awards Dinner sponsored by Werner Enterprises and produced by the Greater Omaha Sports Committee, scheduled for Jan. 13, 2021.

The preseason honor is one of several garnered by the senior from Valley High School in Albuquerque. Saltes, who was also a semifinalist for the Wuerffel Trophy for community service last season, was honored over the summer as a Lobo Hero for his work on the front lines of the COVID-19 crisis, working with his native Oglala Lakota tribe to distribute needed supplies to those on his home reservation, which was hit particularly hard. Saltes also has worked in and is passionate about suicide prevention, about children's reading, and he has served with the Save The Children Action Network as an advocate for children, speaking in Washington in 2019.

Saltes was also on the initial watch list for the Wuerffel Trophy again in 2020, and he one of 22 student-athletes selected to the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team, and he was the only non-Power 5 conference player honored.

Can He Pick Out the Mike Backer if he Isn't Mooing?

Teton Saltes' 24 straight starts is tied for the most consecutive starts with center Kyle Stapley, who is for the second straight season on the Preseason Rimington Trophy Watch List. Stapley, who graded out as one of the top centers in the Mountain West according to PFF, will start his 25th straight game on Saturday.

Stapley, who grew up in Utah on a dairy farm, had a unique workout routine during the original lockdown and quarantine in Utah, lifting hay bales, dragging tractors and doing pull-ups on various tractors. However, he made the most waves on social media by lining up dairy cows as a make-shift defense, calling out various protections and snapping the ball to his father.

Not Dyer Straits in the Punting Game

For those that like punting, we apologize that a massive punting matchup got canceled. CSU's Ryan Stonehouse and UNM's Tyson Dyer are first and fourth among all active punters in net yardage. Well ... they would be if they had played, but since they haven't, we had to manually add them in, but here are the correct active top-10 punters in the FBS.

Last year Dyer was the Mountain West's lone semifinalist for the Ray Guy Award, although he only earned Second Team All-Mountain West honors. Dyer led the nation with a 59.3% punter pin percentage, hitting 35 of 59 punts inside the 20-yard line. He twice had perfect games last year, going 7-for-7 against Colorado State and 5-for-5 against Liberty.

Only once last season in 12 games did Dyer not average at least 43.3 yards per punt, and that was against Wyoming, when he averaged just 37.8 yards per punt, but he hit three of four inside the 20 in that game.

The Old Man, Down the Road

Let's stay with Dyer a second. The senior, who theoretically could return to UNM next year, is 28-years old this season, and if you are thinking that seems old, you are correct.

Dyer is the oldest student-athlete in the Mountain West, and he is the sixth-oldest student-athlete in the FBS this season. Shocker, most of these guys are from Australia, but Dyer wasn't playing Aussie Rules Football...

Dyer is actually older than 17 of the 32 punters currently in the NFL, including Buffalo Bills punter Corey Bojorquez, whom he replaced as the starting punter at New Mexico in the 2018 season.

Throwing a Rock at Last Year's Defense

The 3,857 yards passing allowed by UNM in 2019 was the most in school history. The 2012 edition of the Lobos allowed 3,500 yards passing, albeit in 13 games that season. The 1986 team allowed 291.5 yards per game through the air, the previous high before the 2019 team allowed a school record 321.4 yards per game. That total is what had UNM in the bottom five in several defensive categories in 2019:

Jamie Christian, the Clock Is Still Ticking

In 2018, The University of New Mexico finally got a punt return touchdown, breaking the second-longest drought in the FBS. However, new special teams coach Jamie Christian has a different streak to try and break, as UNM has not blocked a punt since, well, exactly 11 years ago. The last blocked punt for UNM was on October 31, 2009 when Victor James did it against San Diego State.

That was so long ago Roy Disney, Brittany Murphy and Oral Roberts were all still alive, Windows 7 was nine days old, then Cowboys Stadium was about two months old and the New York Yankees took a 2-1 World Series lead with an 8-5 win over the Philadelphia Phillies.

UNM's opponents have attempted 519 punts since UNM's last blocked punt.

UNM did block three placements last year, which were the most blocked kicks for the Lobos since the 2009 season when UNM recorded our blocked kicks.

Rocky Knows What He Needs to Do

Last year, UNM was one of the worst defenses in the nation in causing turnovers, getting just 11 on the year with seven fumble recoveries and four interceptions. Those four picks were the third-lowest total in school history, behind the three passes intercepted in 1995 (on 282 attempts) and in 2011 (on 336 attempts). Last year opponents attempted 412 passes.

Overall, the 11 takeaways was the second-lowest total in school history behind the 10 garnered in 2013 (that season saw UNM get four interceptions and six fumble recoveries).

How were UNM's totals for takeaways under Rocky Long? Forget fumble recoveries, if you want to just talk interceptions, UNM had at least 11 in each of the final nine seasons under Long. The lowest total number of takeaways under long with 20, which happened twice, in his first season of 1998 and then again in 2005. The highest total takeaway number under Long during his 11 seasons was 29 in 2003. UNM's best interception total was 15, accomplished four times (2000, 2001, 2002 and 2005) and the best fumble recovery total was 16 in 2003.

It Took World War II the Last Time

With New Mexico going to a conference only schedule in 2020, it will end a very, very long streak. Now in all fairness, New Mexico State might be OK with it. New Mexico and New Mexico State have played 110 times, but the two teams, located approximately three hours from each other, will not play this season.

The Aggies, an independent, will attempt a short spring schedule. New Mexico has dominated the all-time series, leading 72-33-5, but the two teams have played for 74 consecutive years, a streak that will end this year. The last time the two teams did not play in a season was in 1945, when a little thing called World War II meant the two teams didn't play in 1943, 1944 or 1945. At that time, UNM was in the middle of an 18-game winning streak against that team to the south, a streak that saw UNM allow more than 13 points just once, and allow double digits just three times.

Shelley Officially On the List

Andrew Shelley's last field goal of 2019 was his 24th career attempt, making him eligible for the Lobo career accuracy charts, and he officially is fourth in career accuracy at UNM.

University Stadium, the home of the Lobos, was opened in 1960, and of the 130 FBS stadiums, it's pretty much right in the middle in terms of age. There are 65 stadiums newer, 62 older, and two others that also opened in 1960. Last year UNM traveled to Notre Dame Stadium, and it's 30 years older than University Stadium. That game continued a trend of UNM playing in historic stadiums that were built before FDR became President in 1933.

Looking ahead to what UNM has scheduled out, the Lobos will have seven such contests into 2027, including three at Kyle Field, home of Texas A&M, which was originally built in 1910 and then redone in 1927.

And You Thought the 80s were the Only Time Period Where You Could Wear Two Redshirts

Traditionally, you can only redshirt once. However, you can now redshirt twice, and three Lobos are now double redshirts. All three Lobos were able to utilize a rule that allows for an injury redshirt after redshirting as an academically eligible freshman. Daevon Vigilant earned his second redshirt for his 2017 season in which he was injured for the season in the opening game of the year.

Andrew Erickson redshirted in 2018 and then got hurt just before the season opener in 2019, earning a second redshirt.

However, the weirdest one is going to be Tevaka Tuioti. In 2018, Tuioti was able to get a second redshirt despite playing three games. Tuioti, who was injured against Wisconsin, missed the New Mexico State game and then suffered a season-ending injury in the fourth game of the season (his third) against Liberty. Since he also redshirted as an academically eligible freshman in 2016, he earned a second redshirt. Tuioti was a redshirt freshman when he played against Coach Gonzales in the 2017 season finale against San Diego State. Tuioti still amazingly has two more years after this one, despite this being his fifth year with the program. Because this year doesn't count, Tuioti will be the first player potentially in school history to have two freshman seasons (2016 and 2017), two sophomore seasons (2018 and 2019), and two junior seasons (2020 and 2021).

The only players still remaining from the 2016 season are Tuioti, Anselem Umeh, Kameron Miller, Corey Hightower, Daevon Vigilant and Teton Saltes.

Opening Game Stats

The Lobos are putting a five-game winning streak in season openers on the line, as UNM hasn't lost a season opener since the 2014 when a late fumble spoiled a thrilling comeback as UNM lost to UTEP 31-24. UNM's current five-game winning streak is tied for the second-longest winning streak in season openers, behind the seven straight wins from 1971-77.

While UNM has been very good in season openers, going 69-49-3 overall (a .583 winning percentage), ~~UNM is even better at home, going 58-23-2 when opening the season at home, a .711 mark~~ UNM is just 11-26-1 when opening the season on the road, a .303 mark. UNM's last season opening win that came on the road was when coach Danny Gonzales was a player, as UNM beat New Mexico State 28-7 on August 29, 1996. Since then UNM has lost six straight season openers that were on the road.

Danny Gonzales, a native of Albuquerque who played football at Valley High School before playing for UNM and then serving as an assistant coach, has come home.

Gonzales, who has taken part in bowl games in 14 of the past 16 seasons, enters his first season as the head coach of The University of New Mexico. Gonzales was hired on December 17, 2019. The announcement was made by Director of Athletics Eddie Nuñez at halftime of a Lobo men's basketball game, and then he was formally introduced at a press conference the next day at University Arena.

The new Lobo head coach is certainly familiar with UNM, as a player, staff member and as a Lobo assistant coach, as well as through his time coaching against UNM. He joined his mentor and former coach Rocky Long as Lobo football players returning to coach their alma mater. In a 2006 article in the Albuquerque Journal, Long predicted that Gonzales would one day be the head coach of the Lobos.

Gonzales came to UNM after spending the past two seasons at Arizona State as defensive coordinator, and the previous seven before that as safeties coach and defensive coordinator at San Diego State. In 2018, he was a nominee for the Broyles Award, given to the most outstanding assistant coach in college football.

Gonzales came to UNM as a walk-on safety and punter after playing for the Valley Vikings. Gonzales lettered three times with the Lobos and was the 1998 winner of the Chuck Cummings Memorial Award, which is given for morale and spirit, and was the Lobo Club First Team Award winner for unselfish devotion to the team. At UNM, Gonzales played under Dennis Franchione and the aforementioned Long. Gonzales was a part of UNM's 1997 WAC division championship team that went 9-4 and played in the 1997 Insight.com Bowl against Arizona.

After his playing career, he served as a graduate assistant for Long, helping UNM start a school-record seven consecutive bowl eligible seasons from 2001-07. In 2003, Gonzales moved over a few offices to become video coordinator, a role he held from 2003-05. From 2006-08, he coached safeties and special teams, and he was a part of the coaching staff for UNM's 2007 squad that went 9-4 and won the New Mexico Bowl 23-0 over the Colin Kaepernick-led Nevada Wolf Pack. That win ended a 46-year bowl victory drought for the university.

Under Gonzales' watch in 2007, former walk-on placekicker John Sullivan became UNM's third consensus All-America selection, hitting a school-record 29 field goals. Sullivan did that despite a torn ACL. Sullivan was just one of many specialists that excelled under the tutelage of Gonzales, a former punter and defensive back. In addition, placekicker Kenny Byrd was a first team All-MW pick, punter Jordan Scott was honorable mention, and kicker James Aho was named a Freshman All-America.

Future NFL draft picks Glover Quin (Houston Texans) and Quincy Black (Tampa Bay Buccaneers) also earned all-conference honors at safety under Gonzales.

Overall, Lobo safeties had 55 pass breakups over the 2007-08 seasons, and the 2007 New Mexico squad ranked 13th nationally in total defense, 14th in scoring defense and 20th in passing defense.
