**Media At Practice**

Practice is only open for media for the first 30 minutes, and it is closed to the public. Contact Frank Mercogiano for more information about the class schedules for players needed for interviews (some players are not available due to class after practice, but we will make all efforts to get everyone the interviews they need). Thanks COVID. All practices are closed. Contact Frank Mercogiano for procuring footage or photos.

**Danny Gonzales Interview Opportunities**

Coach Gonzales is available via Zoom at the opportunities listed in the weekly schedule, but its generally Monday through Wednesday.

Schedules for the two short weeks (two Friday games) will be announced at a later date.

**New Mexico Media Luncheon**

In the fall, the New Mexico Media Luncheons are Tuesdays from noon to 1 p.m. Coach Danny Gonzales is available at 12:30 p.m. and he will be followed at the podium by offensive coordinator Derek Warehime and defensive coordinator Rocky Long. Audio and video clips from the UNM communications office, and also at www.golobos.com. The press conferences are also streamed on GoLobos.com by LoboTV. Please note that the Mountain West no longer conducts a football coaches teleconference. The luncheon is on the Zia II level of the West press box. So COVID 19 changed all of that. There will not be any media luncheons in 2020. COVID willing, they will return for the 2021 season. Marty Watts should have built up a few stories in the interim.

**New Mexico Player Interview Opportunities**

All player interviews must be arranged through the UNM athletics communications office. The main time for interviews is after practice. Wednesday is the last day for player interviews. For lengthier interviews, please call the communications office to arrange, which we are happy to do, working around class schedules. These will normally take place in the communications suite in the Maloof Center. See the above schedule. Players are available Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday after practice, either via Zoom for TV or phone for print/digital.

Postgame: The UNM locker room is closed. Requested players will be brought to the football classroom on the second floor of the Tow Diehm football building and outside the locker room for road games. UNM communications will have coach Gonzales and two players address the media, and other players that are needed for one-on-ones may be requested. The student athletes will be available in the football classroom after the press conferences for one-on-one opportunities. Thanks COVID. It's all ZOOM and media will have links regardless if the game is home or away. For UNM media that isn't in the stadium, the ZOOM pressers will still be accessible for your coverage.

**Wireless in the Press Box**

The press box at University Stadium is fully equipped for wireless connections. Access is free, but those wanting access need their own internal or external wireless cards. Phone lines are available. There won't be a lot of media there this season, so it should be a very strong signal.

**Game Credentials**

Regular UNM media will receive game credentials prior to the start of the season. Media members with season credentials will also serve as a parking pass for the Baseball South lot across from the stadium (the Baseball East lot is no longer a media lot)

Visiting team media should request single-game credentials through their team's media relations office. Media passes work as parking passes for the Baseball South lots:

Media members not associated directly with a team can email requests to fmercog@unm.edu. Please have these Wednesday of game week (Tuesday for the Friday night home game):

For media members picking up credentials at will call without parking passes, it is located in the Northeast corner of the stadium by Gate 7 or 8. With parking passes credentials will be located at the University Drive entrance to the Baseball South lot with the parking attendant. This should allow you to get your credential without having to wait in line or deal with parking on the north side of the stadium. Finally a COVID benefit. Media will be able to park in Stadium West right by the media entrance which is Gate 3. The media level this year will be Zia I, which is outside, so dress accordingly. There is an inside area to work from for print, photo and digital on that level.

**Parking**

Media parking is located across and just south of the stadium off University Drive. Media members can park in the Baseball South lot which is located next to University Drive. The Baseball South lot entrance is off University Drive south of the new R.D. and Dale Hubbard Clubhouse. Just kidding it's Stadium West and just show your credential.

**Visiting Radio**

The visiting radio booth is located on the fourth level of the main press box, next to the main media area.

Before we even get to the topic of this week's opening list, Game Notes holds the Danny Gonzales mantra of no excuses. With that, New Mexico's starting 22 was different, and different as in if you didn't check out the new digital program on GoLobos.com, you might not have known what is going on. New Mexico started a whopping 12 players that were starting their first Division I games on Saturday night, including three true freshmen. Seven of those twelve were on defense, including all three members of the defensive line and three of the five players in the secondary. ## We Are Going to Need A Nickname...

With the news that New Mexico will most likely not get to play it's next home game at home (that would be November 14 against Nevada) and the fact that UNM will set up shop in Las Vegas for the upcoming week and then take it week-by-week (as we all do in reality), the Lobos might need a nickname.

Road Warriors seems obvious, but Mountain West Wire writer Michael Kennedy came up with #Roadbos, which is pretty good. It did get us thinking since we can't even play a game at New Mexico State, UNM could very well play all seven games on the road and outside of its home state if the last two December home games are also moved, when was the last time a team has played at least a seven-game schedule with no home games?

Well, the answers are nearly 100 years apart. In 2005 due to Hurricane Katrina, the Tulane Green Wave couldn't play in New Orleans, and they had their six home games moved to, in order, Shreveport (Mississippi State), Baton Rouge (SE Louisiana), Lafayette (Houston), Ruston (UTEP), Mobile, Ala. (Marshall) and Monroe (Tulsa). Those all counted as home games for the Green Wave however and five of those were still home games in Louisiana, and they were at worst, neutral games although Tulane sold tickets and received ticket revenue.

The other answer is in Clemson in 1914. That year the Tigers went 5-3-1, playing nine true road games, although three were in the state of South Carolina (at Furman, at South Carolina and at The Citadel).

So it was 106 years ago that a team played an entire schedule of at least seven games all on the road, but no team to this point has ever played that large a schedule completely outside of its own state, as New Mexico might very well do. #Roadbos indeed.

## Uni-Watching

If you though it looked like 2007 on your TV screen, you are forgiven. UNM broke out silver helmets with a red-outlined side profile logo that the team last wore in the 2007-2009 seasons. New Mexico wore silver helmets for the first time since November 14, 2015 when UNM defeated Boise State 31-24 at Bronco Stadium. As for the side-profile logo, UNM wore that logo for the first time since the final game of the 2011 season, which was a 45-0 loss to Boise State at Bronco Stadium.

For the game UNM wore its home red uniforms and San Jose State wore its home blue. It's the first time that UNM played a color-on-color game since October 10, 2013, a 45-10 loss at home to Utah State (UNM wore red and Utah State wore dark grey). The game also marked the first time UNM wore its home uniforms on the road since September 18, 2015 a 34-10 loss at Arizona State.

## "A Year Ago Tavian Combs was Getting Ready for Homecoming"

That was head coach Danny Gonzales' comment about starting a true freshman on defense, that being Tavian Combs. Combs became the first true freshman to start a game on defense in over seven years. The last was Dakota Cox, who started at middle linebacker on September 28, 2013 vs. UNLV.

Offensively, UNM started two true freshmen in Elijah Queen and Bobby Wooden. They were the first true freshmen to start a game on offense since Cade Briggs started at left guard. Ironically that game was also at San José State, on October 4, 2019.

Overall, UNM played 10 true freshmen. Along with Combs, Queen and Wooden, UNM played Jace Taylor (WR), Conner Kinslow (TE), Ray Leutele (LB), Syaire Riley (LB), Dion Hunter (LB), Ian Shewell (DE) and Troy Sicaeros (LS).

## Missed It By 18 Feet

Tevaka Tuioti threw for 294 yards, meaning he missed his third career 300-yard game by just six yards. Tuioti, who was 20-for-35 on the night, had his most passing yards since throwing for 293 against Hawai'i last season. That game was also the last time that he threw a TD pass, throwing for two.

Tuioti also showed he can still run well, rushing for a game-high 69 yards. That total was the second-most in his career, following the 79 yards he picked up in his last game, against Air Force. Tuioti's rushing touchdown was also his first since the 2018 season opener when he scored on a 20-yard run on September 1, 2018.

## Progress

New Mexico posted 21 points on a team that had allowed just six in the opener. That was Air Force, who is averaging 35.0 points in their non-San José State games. More importantly, it's about when UNM scored that 21st point.

UNM took its opening drive of the second half and scored on a 1-yard sneak by Tuioti. The subsequent extra point by George Steinkamp made it 21-21, and that ended an ignominious run. Over the final nine games of the 2019 season, UNM never led and was never even tied in the second half of any of those games. The 21-21 tie was the first time UNM was even tied in the second half since the ending of the 55-52 win over New Mexico State on September 21, 2019.

## Albuquerque in the House

We think we've mentioned this once or twice, but Danny Gonzales is an Albuquerque native (he's so much of a native that on a Zoom press conference a week or so ago he sang the radio commercial theme for the Albuquerque Dukes). It should probably come as no surprise that New Mexico in general, and Albuquerque specifically, played a big part in the season opener.

Andrew Erickson, Teton Saltes and Marcus Williams all are from Albuquerque/Rio Rancho and started on offense, Kameron Miller from Las Cruces started on defense, and George Steinkamp of Los Alamos started at kicker. Erickson was the leading receiver with 72 yards and a touchdown, Williams had a pair of catches, Miller had five tackles and also was a captain along with Saltes and Steinkamp went 3-for-3 on extra points.

That wasn't it for the Duke City and Land of Enchantment connections. Albuquerque native Ben Bertram recorded his first career sack in his debut game and Josh Woisin got the start on almost all of UNM's special teams units.

## I Mean it is Sort of Fitting He has the Same Name as a Mountain Range

The Teton Mountains are a 40-mile range located in Wyoming (but let's face it, the best view is from Eastern Idaho). The mountains are big, rugged and tower over the landscape at 13,775 feet at their peak. The exact same sentence really could be stated about UNM's mountain of a man, Teton Saltes.

Saltes, who is entering his senior season, has 24 consecutive starts at tackle (he is tied for the team lead in that category) and Saturday will be his 29th game at tackle for UNM. Saltes has been one of UNM's most honored players in the preseason.

Saltes was selected to the Outland Trophy Watch List for lineman, one of 32 tackles in the nation to make the list. The list also includes, 21 offensive guards, 17 defensive tackles and 15 centers.

The recipient of the 75th Outland Trophy will be announced in early December. The official presentation to the winner will be made in Omaha, Neb., at the Outland Trophy Awards Dinner sponsored by Werner Enterprises and produced by the Greater Omaha Sports Committee, scheduled for Jan. 13, 2021.

The preseason honor is one of several garnered by the senior from Valley High School in Albuquerque. Saltes, who was also a semifinalist for the Wuerffel Trophy for community service last season, was honored over the summer as a Lobo Hero for his work on the front lines of the COVID-19 crisis, working with his native Oglala Lakota tribe to distribute needed supplies to those on his home reservation, which was hit particularly hard. Saltes also has worked in and is passionate about suicide prevention, about children's reading, and he has served with the Save The Children Action Network as an advocate for children, speaking in Washington in 2019.

Saltes was also on the initial watch list for the Wuerffel Trophy again in 2020, and he one of 22 student-athletes selected to the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team, and he was the only non-Power 5 conference player honored.

## Can He Pick Out the Mike Backer if he Isn't Mooing?

Teton Saltes' 24 straight starts is tied for the most consecutive starts with center Kyle Stapley, who is for the second straight season on the Preseason Rimington Trophy Watch List. Stapley, who graded out as one of the top centers in the Mountain West according to PFF, will start his 25th straight game on Saturday.

Stapley, who grew up in Utah on a dairy farm, had a unique workout routine during the original lockdown and quarantine in Utah, lifting hay bales, dragging tractors and doing pull-ups on various tractors. However, he made the most waves on social media by lining up dairy cows as a make-shift defense, calling out various protections and snapping the ball to his father.

## Gutierrez with a Marvelous Debut

Isaak Gutierrez, one of those 12 players making his first career FBS start, was basically perfect according to Pro Football Focus. The guard played 54 snaps (out of 78) and did not allow a sack, a hurry or a hit on quarterback Tevaka Tuoti, giving him a perfect 100.0 pass blocking efficiency.

## Receiving Praise

UNM played eight receivers on Saturday, with four of them freshmen, and three of those true freshmen. Despite that veritable lack of experience, the receiving crew was up to the FBS task. As a unit, the Lobo receivers were targeted 24 times and the unit recorded 13 catches with no drops. Emmanuel Logan-Green was the busy man of the group, getting targeted six times, and all six passes were caught. Tevaka Tuoti's quarterback rating when targeting Logan-Greene was 165.8 for the game.

## Reeding the Defense

New Mexico was down three starters on defense on Saturday (and in reality, it was more like four), but the one mainstay that would have started regardless of who was available was Jerrick Reed II, and while UNM's secondary struggled at times, Reed was as solid as a rock. The junior safety had one of UNM's two tackles for loss in the game, and he also had a quarterback hurry. He was targeted in coverage six times, and he allowed just two catches for six yards and no first downs or touchdowns. Nick Starkel, who had a quarterback rating of 190.9 in the game on Saturday, had just a minuscule rating of 41.7 when going after Reed.

## Not Dyer Straits in the Punting Game

It's finally happened! Tyson Dyer punted in a game so the NCAA considers him an active player again, meaning he is fourth in average among all active punters. Here are the active top-10 punters in the FBS.

Last year Dyer was the Mountain West's lone semifinalist for the Ray Guy Award, although he only earned Second Team All-Mountain West honors. Dyer led the nation with a 59.3% punter pin percentage, hitting 35 of 59 punts inside the 20-yard line. On Saturday he was five-for-six and in 12 of his last 13 games, he has put at least half of his punts inside the 20. Dyer's efforts earned him a spot in the week's Ray Guy Ray's 4 list.

Additionally, he averaged 44.8 yards per punt, meaning he has averaged at least 43.3 yards per punt in a game in 13 of his last 14 games.

## The Old Man, Down the Road

Let's stay with Dyer a second. The senior, who theoretically could return to UNM next year, is 28-years old this season, and if you are thinking that seems old, you are correct.

Dyer is the oldest student-athlete in the Mountain West, and he is the sixth-oldest student-athlete in the FBS this season. Shocker, most of these guys are from Australia, but Dyer wasn't playing Aussie Rules Football...

That was so long ago Roy Disney, Brittany Murphy and Oral Roberts were all still alive, Windows 7 was nine days old, then Cowboys Stadium was about two months old and the New York Yankees took a 2-1 World Series lead with an 8-5 win over the Philadelphia Phillies.

UNM's opponents have attempted 524 punts since UNM's last blocked punt.

### Rocky Knows What He Needs to Do

Last year, UNM was one of the worst defenses in the nation in causing turnovers, getting just 11 on the year with seven fumble recoveries and four interceptions. Those four picks were the third-lowest total in school history, behind the three passes intercepted in 1995 (on 282 attempts) and in 2011 (on 336 attempts). Last year opponents attempted 412 passes.

Overall, the 11 takeaways was the second-lowest total in school history behind the 10 garnered in 2013 (that season saw UNM get four interceptions and six fumble recoveries).

How were UNM's totals for takeaways under Rocky Long? Forget fumble recoveries, if you want to just talk interceptions, UNM had at least 11 in each of the final nine seasons under Long. The lowest total number of takeaways under long with 20, which happened twice, in his first season of 1998 and then again in 2005. The highest total takeaway number under Long during his 11 seasons was 29 in 2003. UNM's best interception total was 15, accomplished four times (2000, 2001, 2002 and 2005) and the best fumble recovery total was 16 in 2003.

### It Took World War II the Last Time

With New Mexico going to a conference only schedule in 2020, it will end a very, very long streak. Now in all fairness, New Mexico State might be OK with it. New Mexico and New Mexico State have played 110 times, but the two teams, located approximately three hours from each other, will not play this season.

The Aggies, an independent, will attempt a short spring schedule. New Mexico has dominated the all-time series, leading 72-33-5, but the two teams have played for 74 consecutive years, a streak that will end this year. The last time the two teams did not play in a season was in 1945, when a little thing called World War II meant the two teams didn't play in 1943, 1944 or 1945. At that time, UNM was in the middle of an 18-game winning streak against that team to the south, a streak that saw UNM allow more than 13 points just once, and allow double digits just three times.

### Pomp and Circumstance

The Lobo football team has many graduates on the current roster. Of the squad, eight already have their degrees, including Teton Saltes, who is in law school, and Cedric Patterson III, who is only a sophomore and in his third season with UNM.

### Ye Old Stadium Tour Continueth...

University Stadium, the home of the Lobos, was opened in 1960, and of the 130 FBS stadiums, it's pretty much right in the middle in terms of age. There are 65 stadiums newer, 62 older, and two others that also opened in 1960. Last year UNM traveled to Notre Dame Stadium, and it's 30 years older than University Stadium. That game continued a trend of UNM playing in historic stadiums that were built before FDR became President in 1933.

Looking ahead to what UNM has scheduled out, the Lobos will have seven such contests into 2027, including three at Kyle Field, home of Texas A&M, which was originally built in 1910 and then redone in 1927.

## And You Thought the 80s were the Only Time Period Where You Could Wear Two Redshirts

Traditionally, you can only redshirt once. However, you can now redshirt twice, and three Lobos are now double redshirts. All three Lobos were able to utilize a rule that allows for an injury redshirt after redshirting as an academically eligible freshman. Daevon Vigilant earned his second redshirt for his 2017 season in which he was injured for the season in the opening game of the year.

Andrew Erickson redshirted in 2018 and then got hurt just before the season opener in 2019, earning a second redshirt.

However, the weirdest one is going to be Tevaka Tuioti. In 2018, Tuioti was able to get a second redshirt despite playing three games. Tuioti, who was injured against Wisconsin, missed the New Mexico State game and then suffered a season-ending injury in the fourth game of the season (his third) against Liberty. Since he also redshirted as an academically eligible freshman in 2016, he earned a second redshirt. Tuioti was a redshirt freshman when he played against Coach Gonzales in the 2017 season finale against San Diego State. Tuioti still amazingly has two more years after this one, despite this being his fifth year with the program. Because this year doesn't count, Tuioti will be the first player potentially in school history to have two freshman seasons (2016 and 2017), two sophomore seasons (2018 and 2019), and two junior seasons (2020 and 2021).

The only players still remaining from the 2016 season are Tuioti, Anselem Umeh, Kameron Miller, Corey Hightower, Daevon Vigilant and Teton Saltes.

## Warehime Made His Debut Too You Know...

The Lobo offense had its debut with Derek Warehime as offensive coordinator, and the offense did quite well. We documented earlier that UNM's 21 points against a really good defense was, well, really good, but it's even better in this context. Against the Spartans, the Lobos picked up 443 yards of offense. In 2019, in UNM's six road games, the team never amassed more than 399 yards in any road game. Overall UNM averaged just 355.6 yards per game in 2019's road games.

In fact, the 443 yards by UNM was the third-most yards gained in a road game since October of 2016, a span of 22 games. The only two games where UNM had more yards was October 6, 2018 when UNM had 502 against UNLV in a 50-14 win, and September 23, 2017 when UNM picked up 446 yards in a 16-13 road win at Tulsa.

## You Are Going to Need a Program

If you are a fan of The University of New Mexico, might we suggest checking out the roster on GoLobos.com? You are going to want to look at it. Of the 103 players listed on the roster, 57 of them had never played in a game at UNM entering the season. Of those 57, 43 are newcomers to the team and the other 14 are either redshirts with no games played or squad members with no games played.

The total means that 55.3% of the roster has not seen the field for the Lobos (some have played JC).

Danny Gonzales, a native of Albuquerque who played football at Valley High School before playing for UNM and then serving as an assistant coach, has come home.

Gonzales, who has taken part in bowl games in 14 of the past 16 seasons, enters his first season as the head coach of The University of New Mexico. Gonzales was hired on December 17, 2019. The announcement was made by Director of Athletics Eddie Nuñez at halftime of a Lobo men's basketball game, and then he was formally introduced at a press conference the next day at University Arena.

The new Lobo head coach is certainly familiar with UNM, as a player, staff member and as a Lobo assistant coach, as well as through his time coaching against UNM. He joined his mentor and former coach Rocky Long as Lobo football players returning to coach their alma mater. In a 2006 article in the Albuquerque Journal, Long predicted that Gonzales would one day be the head coach of the Lobos.

Gonzales came to UNM after spending the past two seasons at Arizona State as defensive coordinator, and the previous seven before that as safeties coach and defensive coordinator at San Diego State. In 2018, he was a nominee for the Broyles Award, given to the most outstanding assistant coach in college football.

Gonzales came to UNM as a walk-on safety and punter after playing for the Valley Vikings. Gonzales lettered three times with the Lobos and was the 1998 winner of the Chuck Cummings Memorial Award, which is given for morale and spirit, and was the Lobo Club First Team Award winner for unselfish devotion to the team. At UNM, Gonzales played under Dennis Franchione and the aforementioned Long. Gonzales was a part of UNM's 1997 WAC division championship team that went 9-4 and played in the 1997 Insight.com Bowl against Arizona.

After his playing career, he served as a graduate assistant for Long, helping UNM start a school-record seven consecutive bowl eligible seasons from 2001-07. In 2003, Gonzales moved over a few offices to become video coordinator, a role he held from 2003-05. From 2006-08, he coached safeties and special teams, and he was a part of the coaching staff for UNM's 2007 squad that went 9-4 and won the New Mexico Bowl 23-0 over the Colin Kaepernick-led Nevada Wolf Pack. That win ended a 46-year bowl victory drought for the university.

Under Gonzales' watch in 2007, former walk-on placekicker John Sullivan became UNM's third consensus All-America selection, hitting a school-record 29 field goals. Sullivan did that despite a torn ACL. Sullivan was just one of many specialists that excelled under the tutelage of Gonzales, a former punter and defensive back. In addition, placekicker Kenny Byrd was a first team All-MW pick, punter Jordan Scott was honorable mention, and kicker James Aho was named a Freshman All-America.

Future NFL draft picks Glover Quin (Houston Texans) and Quincy Black (Tampa Bay Buccaneers) also earned all-conference honors at safety under Gonzales.

Overall, Lobo safeties had 55 pass breakups over the 2007-08 seasons, and the 2007 New Mexico squad ranked 13th nationally in total defense, 14th in scoring defense and 20th in passing defense.

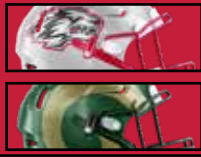

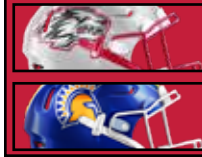

**FORT COLLINS, Colo.** — The season opener between The University of New Mexico and Colorado State, scheduled to be played at CSU's Canvas Stadium, was canceled due to the COVID numbers in Bernalillo County, where UNM's campus is located. The game was declared a no-contest by the Mountain West.

The game was not canceled due to any COVID-related concerns within UNM's program or Colorado State's program.

**CANCELED**

**SAN JOSE, Calif.** — New Mexico was down three starters in the defensive backfield and San José State was able to take advantage, scoring on four long passes as the Spartans were able to hold off the Lobos 38-21 and spoil the head coaching debut of Danny Gonzales. San José State scored the final 17 points of the game after UNM tied it at 21-11 in the third quarter.

While UNM allowed a few long scoring plays, the trademarks of a defense from years back was there. UNM laid plenty of hard hits, had a key first quarter fourth down stop and they allowed just 98 yards on the ground. The issue was Nick Starkel, who two schools ago was at Texas A&M when the Aggies defeated UNM in 2017. He was brilliant against UNM, going 34-for-47 for 467 yards and five touchdowns.

Down 21-14 at the break, UNM's defense held firm on the opening drive of the second half, and the Lobos were able to drive and tie the game. Bobby Cole had a long 19-yard gain on a third-and-1 at midfield to keep the drive alive, and it sure looked like Jordan Kress scored on a five-yard run extending the ball over the pylon. Amazingly in a game with nine replay reviews, that wasn't one of them, but it was no matter as Tuioti scored on the next play diving over from a half-yard out. Ironically that score stood after another lengthy review.

San José State answered and took the lead for good with a 35-yard field goal on the next drive, and both teams traded punts afterwards. However with just four seconds left in the quarter, SISU went for a home run and hit it when Bailey Gaither, who had 10 catches and 208 yards on the evening, got past everyone for a 69-yard backbreaking touchdown.

"I think after we tied it we took a bad penalty that gave them a free 15 yards and then they got that long touchdown right at the break, and that took the wind out of us a little bit, and we have to respond better," said Gonzales after the game. "We have to get tougher and meaner, but that will come."

SISU iced the game in the fourth quarter, converting on fourth-and-goal from the one with a rollout pass that accounted for the final score. UNM did drive inside the 25 in the final minute but Tuioti's pass to Erickson was incomplete on fourth down.

The Spartans led 21-14 at the break, but UNM never backed down. After a highlight-reel catch from Tre Walker for a late first quarter touchdown that was aided by a huge penalty on a punt that gave SISU a first down, UNM trailed 7-0 at the quarter.

After the Spartans made it 14-0, Tuioti and the Lobo offense came alive. UNM got on the board as Tuioti found an open Cedric Patterson III behind the defense for a 39-yard touchdown pass. That play capped a picture-perfect four-play, 84-yard drive, all through the air. Then after an amazing toe-tapping touchdown by Walker for his second touchdown, Tuioti led another drive. He found Andrew Erickson for a 46-yard catch inside the red zone, and then UNM ended up with fourth down at the Spartan four-yard line. Danny Gonzales opted to go for it, and Tuioti was able to scramble and find Erickson again, this time for a score to make it 21-14 at the half.
