### STARTING FIVE

**1. THE GAME:** Boise State men's basketball opens Mountain West play Monday, starting a two-game home series against New Mexico at ExtraMile Arena. Tipoff is slated for 7:30 p.m. MT. The teams will meet again Wednesday, at 8 p.m.

**2. ABOUT THE LOBOS:** New Mexico made its season debut Dec. 13, at Rice, and is now 3-0 after adding a pair of wins against non-Division I opponents last week. The Lobos are averaging 58.7 rebounds per game, including 21.7 offensive boards, and outrebounding their opponents by an average of 31 per game. Makuach Maluach is averaging a double-double at 18.3 points and 10 rebounds per game, leading three Lobos scoring in double-figures on the season.

**3. SERIES HISTORY:** New Mexico leads the all-time series 12-6. The Broncos have won the last two meetings in Boise, including a 74-61 win last season on Senior Day. The two teams also met in the conference opener last season, playing Dec. 4 in Albuquerque. The Lobos came away with an 80-78 victory.

**4. REVISED SCHEDULE:** For this season, the Mountain West adopted a 20-game league schedule which features teams playing each other in two-game series at the same location. Each institution will have five home and five road series. The move reduces travel to help mitigate potential virus exposures. The schedule is a one-year model adopted to specifically address the unique challenges of the current COVID-19 pandemic.

**5. LET'S TRY THIS AGAIN:** Boise State and New Mexico were slated to face off Dec. 3 and 5, but the games were postponed on Nov. 30, and later rescheduled for Dec. 21 and 23. A public health order in the Lobos' home county bars New Mexico from practicing in Albuquerque. The team has temporarily relocated to west Texas in order to practice, arriving at its new home Nov. 20. After the initial series dates were scrapped, the Broncos set up a game against Montana Western for Dec. 4, but that contest was canceled less than 24 hours before tipoff. Boise State salvaged a game Dec. 4, against College of Idaho, finalizing the contract on game day.

IT STARTS AT THE TOP

## LEON RICE | HEAD COACH

**20 WINS IN EIGHT OF 10 YEARS:** Under head coach Leon Rice, Boise State has hit the 20-win plateau in eight of 10 seasons, including seven of the last eight and six-straight years from 2012-18. The aforementioned streak marked the first time in school history the Broncos won 20 games in six-consecutive seasons. Head coach Bobby Dye and guard Chris Childs led the Broncos to at least 20 wins in 1986-87, 1987-88 and 1988-89, the only previous three-year run. The Broncos had just seven 20-win campaigns since joining Division I before Rice took over.

**ELITE COMPANY:** During college basketball's most recent decade, starting with the 2010-11 campaign and running through the 2019-20 season, Boise State was one of 33 Division I schools (out of 353) to post at least eight seasons with 20 or more wins. Only 17 Division I schools nationwide posted eight 20-win seasons in the last decade with the same coach leading the program, putting Bronco head coach Leon Rice among college basketball royalty:

**SECOND IN WINS:** Leon Rice became the second head coach in Boise State history to amass 200 career wins. Rice now has 202 and trails only Bobby Dye (212) for the most wins in school history.

**MW COACH OF THE YEAR:** Leon Rice was named the 2014-15 Mountain West Coach of the Year, in a vote of fellow conference coaches. It was the sixth time a Boise State coach has been named conference coach of the year and Rice is the fourth different Bronco head man to earn the honor. He was also selected coach of the year in a separate vote by MW media members.

**DISTRICT HONOR:** The United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) named Leon Rice the 2014-15 District VIII Coach of the Year. District VIII encompasses all Division I schools in Wyoming, Utah, Idaho, New Mexico, Colorado, Nevada and Montana. Rice is the first Boise State head coach to earn the distinction from the USBWA. Greg Graham earned the NABC District 13 Coach of the Year Award in 2007-08. NABC districts are determined by conference.

**UPPING THE OFFENSE:** Boise State has been renowned for its offensive prowess ever since Leon Rice arrived. In Rice's first nine seasons, the Broncos have led their conference in scoring three times, including pacing the Mountain West twice. In 2013-14, the Broncos hit a Rice-era high with 76.2 points per game, the second-highest in the last 38 years at Boise State (81.4 in 2007-08).

**TAKING CHARITY:** Boise State has been a consistently strong free throw shooting team under Leon Rice. The Broncos have logged five of the top six single-season free throw percentages in school history during Rice's tenure as head coach. Last season's team set the program's all-time mark at 75.1 percent. That topped Rice's 2013-14 squad, which shot 74.9 percent from the stripe, which was just better than the mark set by his team the year before in 2012-13 at 74.7 percent.

**CHALLENGE ACCEPTED:** Boise State has played 34 games against top-25 opponents since Leon Rice took over as head coach. Prior to Rice's arrival, the Broncos played 30 ranked teams in the first 42 years of the program's history as a four-year institution.

**BRONCO 3-POINT BARRAGE:** With Leon Rice at the helm, Boise State has become one of the top three-point shooting teams in the country in both volume and percentage. The 2017-18 Broncos made a school-record 307 triples, shooting at a 38.4 percent clip. Boise State has made at least 225 three-pointers in each of Rice's 10 seasons, claiming nine of the top 10 single-season marks in school history.

**DEFENDING THE THREE:** Boise State held opponents to 29.9 percent shooting from three-point range last season, the best three-point field goal percentage defense in program history. The 29.9 percent mark ranked third in the Mountain West and 28th in Division I.

**GETTING DEFENSIVE:** Boise State held a school-record nine opponents to fewer than 50 points in 2014-15, including five in its last 11 games. The Broncos limited a school-record six conference foes to fewer than 50 points, including twice doing so to consecutive opponents. The last time the Broncos held consecutive conference opponents in the 40s was 1999. Boise State has held an opponent under 50 points 20 times in the Leon Rice era. The Broncos are 19-1 overall in those games.

**COACH RICE AT HOME:** With a 125-30 record (.806 winning percentage) in the friendly confines of ExtraMile Arena, Rice has the best home winning percentage for a Bronco head coach in the school's Division I era.

**'UNFINISHED BUSINESS':** Derrick Alston, Jr. announced he was removing his name from the 2020 NBA Draft and returning to Boise State for his redshirt senior season on July 8, with a tweet that told of his unfinished business and desire to lead the Broncos to a Mountain West Championship. He was voted the Preseason MW Player of the Year by media covering the league.

**NATIONAL ATTENTION:** Derrick Alston, Jr. is on the 2021 Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Award Watch List. Alston was one of 10 finalists for the honor last season, which is awarded by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. The annual honor recognizes the top small forwards in Division I men's college basketball.

**LEADING SCORER:** Derrick Alston, Jr. averaged 17.3 points per game last season, the No. 4 mark in the Mountain West, 107th nationally and tied for the 19th-highest single-season scoring average in Boise State history. Alston scored at least 20 points in 13 of Boise State's 32 games. He became the first Bronco in program history to score at least 20 points in each of the first four games of a season.

**FREEBIES:** Derrick Alston led the Broncos with 135 made free throws, third in the Mountain West and 68th nationally. Alston ranked second on the team, sixth in the league and 104th nationally with 167 free throw attempts. His 80.8 percent clip from the line ranked sixth in the league and 147th nationally, among players with at least 2.5 makes per game.

**DISHING IT OUT:** Derrick Alston has long been lauded for his high-level feel for the game and ability to make plays. After establishing himself as a scorer, Alston stepped up as a facilitator. He tallied a team-high 98 assists last season, dishing out a career-high seven helpers in Boise State's win against UNC Wilmington (Nov. 29), and nearly matching that the next time out with six at New Mexico (Dec. 4).

**ALL-TOURNAMENT:** Derrick Alston was named to the Diamond Head Classic All-Tournament Team. Alston led the Broncos to a 2-1 record at the tournament, averaging 23.7 points, 5.7 rebounds and 4.7 assists per game. He was one of five players named to the team. Alston led the tournament in scoring with 71 points in the three games. His 14 assists were the third most in the tournament.

**ALSTON'S BIG NIGHT:** Derrick Alston scored 28 points at No. 15 Oregon (Nov. 9), the most points by a Bronco against a ranked team since Derrick Marks poured in 35 in a Boise State win at No. 11 Creighton, Nov. 28, 2012.

**QUANTUM LEAP:** Derrick Alston, Jr. scored 995 points the last two seasons, but the elite productivity came after redshirting in 2016-17 and averaging 0.6 points in 11 games as a redshirt freshman in 2017-18. Alston's scoring average jumped to 13.4 ppg as a redshirt sophomore. The 12.8 points-per-game leap between 2017-18 and 2018-19 was the largest jump from one season to the next for any returning Boise State player in program history. His improvement was the second largest in terms of points per game for any returner in NCAA Division I that season.

**HUMBLE BEGINNINGS:** An all-district performer in high school, Derrick Alston arrived at Boise State as a walk-on in the summer of 2016, weighing 148 pounds. After redshirting the 2016-17 season, Alston was up to 170 pounds. He saw 26 total minutes of action and added another 15 pounds during the 2017-18 campaign before exploding onto the scene as a redshirt sophomore in 2018-19.

**RUNS IN THE FAMILY:** His father, Derrick, was drafted No. 33 overall by the Philadelphia 76ers in the 1994 NBA Draft, played two years in the NBA and 16 seasons overseas. He is now the head coach for the Westchester Knicks of the NBA G League.

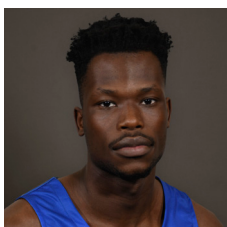

**EMMANUEL AKOT | G | 6-8 | 210 | RS-Jr.***Eligible fall 2020, with two seasons remaining*

Emmanuel Akot came to the Broncos after spending a year and a half at Arizona, as he played the entirety of the 2017-18 season and the first half of 2018-19.

Akot, from Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada, finished his prep career at Wasatch Academy in Mount Pleasant, Utah. 247Sports bestowed him with a five-star rating when he graduated in 2017, pegging him as the No. 24 overall prospect in their national rankings. Akot was also praised by ESPN.com and given a four-star rating with a scout grade of 88, making him the highest-rated prep player to ever join Boise State.

Armus was named to the Southern Conference All-Freshman Team in 2017-18, after averaging 6.3 points and 5.3 rebounds per game. He upped his production as a sophomore, registering 8.0 points, 7.7 rebounds and 1.0 blocks per game. Armus recorded seven games with double-figure rebounding and four double-doubles.

Prior to ETSU, Armus starred at Southwest Christian Academy in Little Rock, Ark. A native of Belgrade, Serbia, Armus came to the United States as a senior in high school and led Southwest Christian Academy to a 36-3 record en route to claiming the NACA National Championship. He was named a first-team NACA All-American. Before coming to the U.S., Armus played with the KK Partizan Junior Team in Serbia. He helped his home country to a bronze medal in the 2014 U17 World Championship and was invited to play in the U20 European Championship.

Former top-75 recruit Devonaire Doutrive (pronounced DEV-in-air / DO-treev) joined the Boise State men's basketball program in December 2019, and will enroll for the spring 2020 semester. The 6-foot-5 Doutrive played in 29 games at Arizona during his three semesters with the Wildcats. Doutrive, a Dallas, Texas native, averaged 3.3 points and 3.0 rebounds over 26 games as a freshman in 2018-19. He appeared in three games this season, averaging 6.3 points and 3.3 rebounds.

A consensus four-star prep prospect, Doutrive was ranked 67th nationally according to 247Sports, with a composite rating of .9732. He was ranked as the No. 72 player in the ESPN 100 for the class of 2018. His 85 scout grade from ESPN is the second-highest rating for a Boise State signee, behind only Doutrive's former Arizona teammate and current Bronco Emmanuel Akot.

**CLAMPS:** Boise State has forced 91 turnovers through five games, including 21 against Sam Houston State and 23 against College of Idaho in consecutive games. It was the first time the Broncos have forced back-to-back opponents into at least 20 turnovers since Dec. 5 and Dec. 8, 2010. Boise State is averaging 20 points per game off of opponent turnovers, equal to 26.7 percent of its total scoring output.

**LATE START:** Boise State's season opener on Nov. 27 marked the latest the Broncos have debuted since the 1992-93 campaign, which featured a start date of Dec. 1. The first home game was played Dec. 4, the latest home opener since 1995 (Dec. 7).

**LATE ADDITION:** Boise State's Dec. 4 game against College of Idaho, was finalized six hours before tipoff. The update came just hours after Boise State's game against Montana Western was wiped off the books. That game was scheduled just 30 hours before tip. The late addition came in response to the postponement of the Broncos' conference-opener against New Mexico. The games were initially scheduled for Dec. 3 and 5, and have since been rescheduled for Dec. 21 and 23.

**CRUSHED GLASS:** Boise State outrebounded Sam Houston State 50-28 on Nov. 29, including 21 offensive boards. It was the most offensive rebounds by a Bronco team since Nov. 22, 2011 (24 vs Cal State Northridge).

**WELCOME ABOARD:** Four Broncos made their team debuts in the season opener against No. 17 Houston, including redshirt juniors Marcus Shaver, Jr., and Mladen Armus who both started. Shaver and Armus sat out last season after transferring from Portland and East Tennessee State, respectively. The duo combined for 27 points and 13 rebounds. Shaver scored 16 points, while leading the Broncos with seven rebounds and three steals. Armus tallied 11 points and six boards.

**REVISED SCHEDULE:** For this season, the Mountain West adopted a 20-game league schedule which features teams playing each other in two-game series at the same location. Each institution will have five home and five road series. The move reduces travel to help mitigate potential virus exposures. The schedule is a one-year model adopted to specifically address the unique challenges of the current COVID-19 pandemic.

**400 CLUB, AGAIN:** Derrick Alston, Jr. reached the 400-point plateau for the second consecutive year in 2019-20. Alston has scored 995 points over the last two seasons, tallying 554 as a junior and 441 points as a sophomore. He is seeking to become the eighth Bronco in program history to score at least 400 points in three different seasons.

**TURNAROUND:** Boise State returned to its winning ways last season with a 20-12 record. The Broncos flipped the script on the 2018-19 season's 13-20 performance, becoming one of just seven Division I schools to win 20 games last year after losing 20 games in 2018-19.

**HOME-COURT ADVANTAGE:** Boise State was 13-2 at ExtraMile Arena last season, including an 8-1 mark in Mountain West play. The Broncos have won double-digit home games in nine of Leon Rice's 10 seasons as head coach and 29 of the 38 seasons the venue has served as Boise State's home facility. The Broncos have never finished a season with a losing record at home since the building opened in 1982.

**EARLY SIGNING DAY:** Boise State added two high school standouts to next year's roster during the early signing period, as Tyson Degenhart and RJ Keene inked their National Letters of Intent. Degenhart averaged 24.5 points per game last season and is the No. 4 prospect in Washington. Keene is a four-star recruit and the nation's No. 33 shooting guard, according to ESPN.

**WORD ON THE STREET**

College basketball reporters and analysts across the country have taken notice of Boise State's talent and potential this season. Below is a selection of the commentary.

"I had two Mountain West coaches tell me in the past two weeks that Boise State has the most talent of any team in that league, so keep an eye out for Leon Rice's team as it chases its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2015."

Norlander contributed to CBS Sports Top 101 players headed into the season, which ranked Derrick Alston, Jr., at No. 82. He said this of Alston:

"Worried a bit we've got him 30 spots too low because this enticing two-way wing is quite capable of winning Mountain West player of the year for the NCAA Tournament-contending Broncos."

"This is the season that Leon Rice has been waiting for. Anything less than a Mountain West regular season title and trip to the NCAA Tournament will feel like a disappointment for the Broncos in 2021."

Bennett also has Derrick Alston, Jr. pegged as the No. 4 player in the mid-major ranks, saying:

"He's a legitimate NBA Draft candidate who nearly went pro this offseason, but now he's the preseason Mountain West player of the year. If he totally blows up as a senior, don't say we didn't warn you."

After Derrick Alston, Jr., announced his return to school this summer, Goodman moved the Broncos into his preseason Top 50 rankings.

Murray ranked four Broncos in his preseason 'Top 25 Players in the Mountain West' list, the most for one team.

"Given Rice's consistent coaching — he's won 20 games in eight of his 10 seasons — returning two of last year's top four scorers and upgrading at positions of need, the Broncos should break through this year. Barring anything drastic, Boise State should be a postseason team."

## @BRONCOSPORTSMBB NOTES

**RAYJ DENNIS**

**STRONG START:** Sophomore guard RayJ Dennis is off to a quick start in his second season as a Bronco. Dennis led Boise State with 18 points in the season opener at No. 17 Houston, on 8-of-13 shooting, while matching the team lead with three assists in a career-high 38 minutes. He added 13 points, seven rebounds and seven assists the next time out against Sam Houston State, becoming just the fourth Bronco in the past decade to post at least 10 points, seven rebounds and seven assists in a game.

**COMEBACK KID:** RayJ Dennis led Boise State to a thrilling come-from-behind victory over Utah State, Jan. 18. The Broncos trailed by 18 with under four minutes to play, before Dennis scored 19 points in the final 3:27 of regulation and sparked a 27-9 run to force overtime. Dennis was 5-for-5 from the field, including a career-high four three-pointers, and 5-for-5 from the free throw line. He did not take a shot in the first 36 minutes of the game and finished with a career-high 19 points. The Broncos won 88-83 in the extra period.

**ABU KIGAB**

**NICE TO MEET YOU:** Abu Kigab made his home debut as a Bronco by posting 33 points and 11 rebounds in a 103-72 win against CSUN (Dec. 28). It was the 17th 30-point, 10-rebound game in Boise State history, the seventh in the past 25 years and the first since Chandler Hutchison scored 39 points and grabbed 14 rebound against Washington in the 2018 NIT (March 14, 2018). Kigab is believed to be the first Bronco to score 30 points in his home debut.

**ABU'S DEBUT:** Boise State welcomed Abu Kigab to the lineup for the first time Dec. 22, against Georgia Tech. Kigab started in his first game with the Broncos and led the team with a career-high 17 points. Kigab added three rebounds, two assists and two steals.

**THE MISSING PIECE:** Abu Kigab joined the Broncos in January 2019 as a transfer from Oregon. After sitting out the 2019 spring and fall semesters as his academic year in residence, Kigab made his Boise State debut Dec. 22, against Georgia Tech. Head coach Leon Rice said before the game, "If you could make a Christmas wish list and say, 'Here's what we want for Christmas to add to our team,' he'd pretty much look like Abu."

**MAX RICE**

**DOUBLE-DOUBLE:** Max Rice recorded the first double-double of his career against the College of Idaho (Dec. 4), with career highs of 16 points and 12 rebounds. Rice's performance helped the Broncos to an 86-49 win, the 200th career victory for Max's father, Boise State head coach Leon Rice.

**AT HIS BEST:** Max Rice was at his best when the Broncos needed him most last season. Rice played a key role in four crucial wins. He tallied seven points and three rebounds in Boise State's Quad 1 win against BYU. Rice saw a career-high 32 minutes of action in a triple-overtime win at Pacific, recording four points, three rebounds and two steals. He made play after play during the team's monumental comeback against Utah State, including five points, two steals and an assist. Rice's 12 points on four first-half three-pointers helped the Broncos to a road win over Wyoming and pushed their winning streak to five games.

**HOMEGROWN:** Max Rice was a two-time 4A Southern Idaho Conference Player of the Year for Bishop Kelly High School. He led the Knights to three-straight district titles and averaged 23.4 points and 7.9 rebounds per game as a senior.

## 2019-20 IN REVIEW

**CREAM OF THE CROP:** Boise State finished Mountain West play 11-7, tying for fifth in the league standings. The Broncos have won at least 11 conference games in five of the last six seasons. In the nine years Boise State has been a member of the Mountain West, San Diego State is the only other league school to record five seasons with at least 11 conference wins.

**FINISHING STRONG:** Boise State hit its stride in mid-January and played its best basketball down the stretch. Starting with its historic comeback win over Utah State Jan. 18, the Broncos won nine of its final 13 games, including four road wins and a victory in the Mountain West Championship. Over the last seven weeks of the season, Boise State jumped 30 spots in the NCAA Net Rankings and 36 spots in KenPom ratings.

**ALL-TIME LEADER:** Senior Justinian Jessup became the Boise State and Mountain West all-time three-point leader this season. Jessup made a single-season school record 98 triple to finish his career with 325, the most in school and conference history. He passed Anthony Drmic for the Boise State record at home against UNLV (Jan. 8), and became the league's all-time leader at Wyoming (Feb. 4), when he surpassed former BYU star Jimmer Fredette (296; 2007-11). Jessup became the first player in school and conference history to reach 300 career three-pointers.

**TWO ALL-DISTRICT PERFORMERS:** For the first time in program history, two Broncos were named to the NABC All-District Team. Derrick Alston, Jr. and Justinian Jessup each earned All-District 17 Second Team honors. Eight different Broncos have combined for nine all-district honors in the award's history.

**500 POINTS APIECE:** Derrick Alston, Jr. and Justinian Jessup both reached the 500-point plateau this season. Alston (554 points) and Jessup (512 points) notched the 22nd and 23rd 500-point seasons in program history. Alston's total ranks No. 11 in school history, while Jessup's is 20th. It is the fourth time in Boise State history two Broncos have scored at least 500 points in the same season. Anthony Drmic and Derrick Marks did so twice in 2012-13 and 2013-14. Reggie Larry and Matt Nelson both hit the 500-point mark in 2007-08.

**THREE WITH A THOUSAND:** The trio of Justinian Jessup, Alex Hobbs and Derrick Alston, Jr. all finished the season with at least 1,000 career points. It is the third time in school history three members of the same team have had 1,000 points to their name. Steve Connor, Danny Jones and Trent Johnson accomplished the feat in 1977-78, while Anthony Drmic, Derrick Marks and Ryan Watkins each reached 1,000 points during the 2013-14 season. Jessup joined the club in 2018-19, but climbed to No. 8 on the school's all-time scoring list this season and finished his career with 1,583 points. Hobbs hit the plateau in the final regular-season game of the year, at UNLV, and finished with 1,024 points. Alston became Boise State's 31st and newest member of the 1,000-point club in the last game of the year. He now has 1,002 career points, with 995 coming in the last two seasons. Alston was the 10th Bronco to score his 1,000th point during Leon Rice's 10 seasons as head coach.

**TURNAROUND:** Boise State returned to its winning ways this season with a 20-12 record. The Broncos flipped the script on last year's 13-20 performance, becoming one of just seven Division I schools to win 20 games this year after losing 20 games in 2018-19.

**DEPARTMENT SUCCESS:** Boise State was one of five schools nationally to win at least 10 football games and 20 games in both men's and women's basketball this academic year.

**DEFENDING THE THREE:** Boise State held opponents to 29.9 percent shooting from three-point range this season, the all-time best three-point field goal percentage defense in program history. The 29.9 percent mark ranked third in the Mountain West and 28th in Division I.

**SUCCESS AT THE LINE:** Boise State shot 75.1 percent from the free throw line as a team this year, the best single-season percentage in school history. Justinian Jessup was 70-for-73 (95.9 percent) from the free throw line, the No. 1 single-season mark in school history (minimum two attempts per game). Derrick Alston shot 80.8 percent from the line, No. 6 in the Mountain West.

**SUCCESS FROM DEEP:** Boise State made 269 three-pointers this year, the No. 4 single-season mark in school history. Four of the top five and nine of the top 10 single-season performances have come during Leon Rice's 10 seasons at the helm. The Broncos finished the year fifth in the league and 57th nationally at 8.4 made triples per game.

**CONFERENCE WIN STREAK:** Boise State won five consecutive Mountain West games from Jan. 18-Feb. 4. It was the Broncos' first five-game winning streak in league play since 2015. The streak included wins over Utah State, Fresno State, San José State, Nevada and Wyoming, with two of the victories coming on the road.

**GOOD EVERYWHERE:** Boise State racked up five road wins this season, including Quad 2 road wins against Pacific and UNLV. The Broncos also went 13-2 at home, where they earned a top-10 (NCAA NET) win over BYU, and only suffered losses to league champions San Diego State and UC Irvine.

**NO BAD LOSSES:** Boise State's team sheet featured zero losses against Quad 4 opponents. Of the Broncos' Quad 3 losses, one came at the hands of the Big West Conference champion (UC Irvine). Another was Dec. 4, at New Mexico, which was one week removed from the Lobos defeating Big Ten champion Wisconsin, and prior to Boise State starter Abu Kigab becoming eligible.

**45TH PARALLEL:** Boise State went 16-1 last season when holding opponents under 45 percent shooting from the field and 4-11 when allowing opponents to shoot 45 percent or better. In Leon Rice's 10 seasons as head coach, the Broncos have won 80.2 percent of the games in which they have held opponents under 45 percent from the floor.

**FOUR IN DOUBLE FIGURES:** Boise State boasted four double-figure scorers for the first time since 2015-16. Derrick Alston, Jr. (17.3), Justinian Jessup (16.0), RJ Williams (12.2) and Abu Kigab (11.1) provided a consistent, balanced scoring attack for the Broncos.

**ELITE BALL MOVERS:** Boise State tallied 29 assists on 31 made field goals at San José State (Feb. 19). The 29 assists are the most by the Broncos since Nov. 21, 2007 (31).

**TAKING CARE OF THE ROCK:** Boise State committed 12.5 turnovers per game, fourth fewest in the Mountain West. Its +1.3 turnover margin ranked second in the league and 85th nationally.

**MIRACLE AT EXTRAMILE:** Boise State rallied for a thrilling overtime victory against Utah State, Jan. 18. The Aggies took an 18-point lead (66-48) with 4:10 remaining in regulation and had possession. The Broncos got a stop and RJ Williams sank a pair of free throws with 3:37 to play. Those free throws started a 27-9 run, including 19 points from freshman RayJ Dennis to close the period and tie the game. Utah State led 75-70 with 8.9 seconds left before Dennis stormed up the floor and made his fourth three-pointer of the spurt. Justinian Jessup stole the ensuing inbound pass and made a layup to tie the game with 1.9 seconds left and force overtime. The Broncos never led in regulation, but never trailed in the extra period, winning 88-83. It was just the second time in NCAA Division I history that a team won a game after trailing by 18 points with less than four minutes remaining.

**HISTORICALLY BIG WINS:** Boise State posted back-to-back emphatic wins to end the month of January. The Broncos recorded consecutive conference victories by at least 25 points for the first time since 1988. They claimed an 87-53 win at Fresno State (Jan. 25), for its largest margin of victory in a road conference game since 2004. Boise State then followed that with a 99-71 home victory over San José State (Jan. 29).

**TELL-TALE SIGN:** During Boise State's four-game win streak from Dec. 24-Jan. 1, the Broncos posted a combined rebounding margin of plus-47, outrebounding their opponent in each game. Last season, Boise State was 15-2 when grabbing more boards than the opposition.

**CENTURY CLUB:** Boise State scored at least 100 points three times this season, including doing so in consecutive home games against Alabama State (Dec. 14) and CSUN (Dec. 28). It is the first time Boise State has hit triple digits in consecutive home games against Division I opponents in program history. The only time Boise State has hit the century mark four times in one season is the 1974-75 campaign.

## EXTRAMILE ARENA



**HISTORY:** Boise State's ExtraMile Arena has been the home of Bronco basketball since 1982. Formerly known as the BSU Pavilion, Taco Bell Arena has provided Boise State fans with plenty of thrills for more than 30 years — from the exciting Big Sky Conference championship days of Chris Childs and Arnell Jones in the late 1980s to Derrick Marks and James Webb III clinching the 2015 Mountain West title under head coach Leon Rice.

**NEVER A LOSING RECORD:** Boise State has never had a losing home record since the arena's opening in 1982. The 12,480-seat facility has been a home-court advantage for the Broncos throughout the years.

**NCAA TOURNAMENT SITE:** ExtraMile Arena was slated to play host to the first and second rounds of the 2021 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament, before the tournament was moved to a single site. It would have marked the 10th time the arena has been home to the tournament.
