ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- The Lobos will open their 2020-21 season on Sunday against Rice.
- Rice enters the contest 4-0 on the season, all four games were won by double figures.
- Sunday's game marks the first time since 1992-93 that the Lobos have started their season in December.
- Last time the Lobos opened their season on the road was 2018-19 when UNM traveled to take on CSUN in Northridge, Calif..
- This marks just the second time UNM has opened on the road in the last 12 seasons (prior to 2018-19, the last road opener was in 2007-08).
- New Mexico leads the series with Rice 5-2 including a 1-0 margin in Houston.
- Last time the Lobos traveled to play the Owls in Houston was on Jan. 18, 1997 in which UNM claimed a 69-61 victory.
- All of the meetings with the Owls have been in Albuquerque except one road trip and one postseason contest in Las Vegas, Nev.
- Last time the Lobos took on Rice was in Paul Weir's first season in which New Mexico earned a 78-69 victory on Dec. 19, 2017 in The Pit. It marked Weir's fourth win at the helm of the Lobos.
- The last victory for Rice in the series was on Dec. 19, 2015 when the Owls edged the Lobos by just one point, 90-89 in The Pit.
- The team's first meeting came on Dec. 22, 1958.
- Four of the teams' seven meetings have been in December.
- Rice is led by four players averaging scoring in double figures including sophomores Quincy Olivari (14.3), Travis Evee (13.3) and Max Fiedler (13.0) as well as junior Chris Mullins (12.0).

Olivari's Career Day Leads Rice in 86-64 Victory

HOUSTON — Quincy Olivari scored a career-high 27 points and tied the second-most three-pointers in school history with seven as Rice defeated Houston Baptist, 86-64, Saturday night from Sharp Gym.

The Story

Rice came out firing. After scoring the first five points, HBU scored the next four. But back-to-back baskets by Cavit Ege Havsa sent Rice on an 8-0 run. The teams then traded baskets, going back-and-forth over the next five minutes. With Rice leading 27-19, the Owls stepped up its defense, forcing five Husky turnovers as an Olivari three-pointer sent the Owls on a 15-0 run to take a 42-19 lead with five minutes remaining in the first half. After an HBU basket, Chris Mullins hit a three-pointer and Rice closed the half scoring seven of the final 10 points to finish the last 10 minutes on a 22-5 run and take a 49-24 lead into halftime.

HBU scored the first six points of the second half, forcing a Rice timeout. Back-to-back three-pointers by Travis Evee and Olivari pushed the lead back to 25. However, the Owls went cold, making just two of its next 12 shots as Houston Baptist went on a 17-5 run to cut Rice's lead to 60-47 with 8:03 remaining. However, Olivari scored half of Rice's points in 22-4 run to put the game away.

The Stats

Rice connected on 47.7% from the field, including 36.8% from three. Rice also connected on 71.4% from the free throw line. Houston Baptist connected on 50.0% from the floor, but was held to just 25.0% from three. Rice was outrebounded 36-to-30 and had 21 assists.

Notes

- Rice started 4-0 for the first time since starting 4-0 in 2011-12.
- This was the second straight year the teams have met and the 13th time overall. The Owls lead the series 10-3.
- At HBU, the series is tied at two.
- Rice is 42-34 all-time against the Southland Conference.
- Rice set or tied season-highs with 14 three-pointers, 21 assists and nine steals.
- Rice placed five players in double-figures for the third straight game.
- Quincy Olivari set career-highs with 27 points and seven three-pointers.
- The seven three-pointers tied the second-most in school history.
- Cavit Ege Havsa set season-highs with 11 points, five assists and three steals.
- Travis Evee scored 10 points and had a career-high eight assists.
- Max Fiedler scored 10 points and had four rebounds.
- Payton Moore scored 10 points and tied a season-high with five rebounds.
- Tre Clark led all players with six rebounds and two blocks.

Next Up

Rice will take a week off before playing its second straight road game in Houston when it faces crosstown rival and No. 10 Houston next Saturday, Dec. 12. Tip-off is scheduled for 1 p.m. The game will be livestreamed at ESPN+.

Lobos Snap Loss Streak with Victory over Rice

ALBUQUERQUE, NM — Senior Joe Furstinger recorded his first career double-double (17 points, 12 rebounds) and four other Lobos scored in double digits to lead The University of New Mexico men's basketball team past Rice 78-69 in Dreamstyle Arena – The Pit on Tuesday night.

Furstinger, in his first game of the season off the bench, set career-highs in points and rebounds, breaking his previous bests of 11 in each. His double-double was the first in points and rebounds for the Lobos since senior Sam Logwood recorded 12 points and 11 rebounds last season on Feb. 25 against Wyoming, making it the first for UNM this season.

Tuesday night also marked the third time this season that the Lobos had five players score in double digits. Furstinger led the way with his 17, followed by Logwood (15), juniors Troy Simons (15), Chris McNeal (13) and Dane Kuiper (10). Kuiper also posted a game-high six assists for a new career high.

"I think we all wanted a huge, blowout win – or whatever that may be – to say that we're back and all that, but it's Division I basketball and you have to earn the right to win," head coach Paul Weir said. "I feel like we are earning the right to win, these guys work really hard.

"We spend a lot of time on the court. We spend a lot of time in the film room. We're trying to fix our weaknesses, and so far, these kids have bought in. There's not a lot of kids, at 3-8, that would look at a first-year coach and buy in, but they're still buying in and I'm thankful for that."

The Lobos (4-8) controlled the majority of the game, never trailing past the 16:34 mark of the first half.

Junior Anthony Mathis and freshman Vladimir Pinchuk got their first career starts against the Owls (3-9), and Pinchuk quickly put the Lobos on the board with a layup in the first 40 seconds of play.

The Lobos fell behind three, 10-7 at the 17:16 mark but went on a 5-0 run to take a two-point lead, 12-10, with 16:34 remaining in the half. After being tied at 14, Simons and McNeal hit back-to-back threes to put the Lobos up six, 20-14, with 11:53 on the clock.

UNM widened its lead to nine, 27-18, with a layup from Logwood with 9:12 left to play in the half. The Owls closed the lead to three, 31-28, on a series of layups with six minutes to go. A minute later, the Lobos extended the margin back to eight, 36-28, on a Furstinger layup and Simons three, but Rice went on an 8-0 run to tie the game at 36 with 4:12 on the clock.

New Mexico answered with a 7-2 run to end the half leading 43-38, holding Rice to just two points on a pair of free throws in the last four minutes of play.

The Lobos shot 46.9 percent from the field in the first half, including 27.8 percent from behind the arc and 88.9 percent from the free throw line. New Mexico outrebounded Rice 17-13 in the first half.

Simons opened the second half with a dunk to put New Mexico up seven, 45-38, with 18:48 to go. McNeal drilled a three with 13:56 on the clock to give the Lobos a 10-point lead, 54-44, their largest of the night. They extended that lead to 12, 56-44, on a pair of Furstinger free throws. After Rice closed the Lobo margin to six, 61-55, Simons nailed back-to-back threes within 16 seconds to widen the lead back to 12, 67-55, with 8:41 on the clock.

The Owls continued to edge back into the game, cutting the lead to five, 68-63, but a Furstinger three-point play put the Lobos back up eight, 71-63 with 5:08 to play. Logwood hit a pair of free throws to widen the margin back to ten, 73-63.

Kuiper's two free throws with 28 seconds remaining made him the fifth Lobo to score in double figures, and made the score 78-66. The Owls scored off a free throw and a layup as time expired to make the final 78-69.

New Mexico shot 40.3 percent and finished with 40 rebounds for the first time since the season opener against Northern New Mexico. The Lobos outrebounded the Owls 40-36, marking the third time this season and the first time since Omaha that UNM has outrebounded its opponent. The Lobo bench outscored Rice's 62-28.

The Lobos continue a five-game home stretch as they face Prairie View A&M on Friday, Dec. 22 in Dreamstyle Arena – The Pit at 7 p.m.


