LAST TIME OUT

Nevada split its conference-opening two-game series against Air Force Dec. 18 and 20, picking up a 74-57 victory in the opener before dropping the finale, 68-66, at Lawlor Events Center.

Desmond Cambridge, Jr., and Zane Meeks paced the Pack averaging 16.0 points apiece over the two-game series, with Cambridge, Jr., scoring 23 in the opener. Meeks matched his career high with 18 points, on 5-for-11 shooting, in the finale, and grabbed eight rebounds in each contest.

SCOUTING THE LOBOS

New Mexico (3-2, 0-2 MW) had its season-opening three-game winning streak snapped as it was swept in its two-game series at Boise State, Dec. 21 and 23. The Lobos were outscored by an average of 30.5 points over the two losses to the Broncos, dropping the opener, 77-53, then falling, 89-52, in the finale.

Makuach Maluach leads the Lobos with 15.2 points per game and five 3-pointers, while Rod Brown is also averaging double digits in scoring, going for 10.0 points per game.

STRONG STARTS

The Pack has shown this season that it can start games well, leading its opponents at halftime in eight of nine games, and by an average margin of 5.4 points.

The only contest in which Nevada trailed at the break was Dec. 2 against San Francisco, when it faced a 40-32 deficit.

Nevada, however, is 6-2 in the games which it led at halftime, most recently dropping its Dec. 20 series finale against Air Force after holding a 33-24 lead after the opening 20 minutes.

CAMBRIDGE, JR., NAMED MOUNTAIN WEST PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Redshirt junior guard Desmond Cambridge, Jr., became the first member of the Pack to grab a Mountain West weekly honor, being named player of the week for Dec. 14-20.

Cambridge, Jr., averaged 19.7 points and twice hit the 20-point mark as Nevada went 2-1, including a 1-1 start to Mountain West play. From the field, the Nashville, Tenn., native shot 42.6 percent (20-for-47), including 41.4 percent (12-for-29) from 3-point range and a perfect 7-for-7 showing from the line.

He put up a Nevada career-best 27 points on 9-of-19 shooting, including a 7-for-11 effort from behind the arc, in Dec. 14's 79-72 victory at San Diego, and followed that with 23 points in the Mountain West opener against Air Force, Dec. 18.

HEATING UP

Cambridge, Jr., will aim to keep his high-scoring ways going as the Pack returns to action after an 11-day break. Over the past four contests, the Nashville, Tenn., native has shot 43.5 percent from the field (27-for-62) and 42.9 percent (18-for-42) from 3-point range while averaging 20.8 points.

It has been an impressive stretch for the redshirt junior guard, especially after the first five games of the campaign, in which he averaged 9.4 points with FG/3FG percentages of 33.9/18.2.

ON THE AIR

Head coach Steve Alford will make appearances on the Wolf Pack Coaches Show throughout the season. The Wolf Pack Coaches Show airs Monday nights live in Northern Nevada on ESPN Radio 94.5 FM. The show runs from 6-7 p.m. and features Wolf Pack men's and women's basketball coaches and select appearances from student-athletes.

University of Nevada athletics are also featured each week on "Wolf Pack All Access" on KRNV Channel 4 every Sunday night. The show generally airs at 6:30 p.m. (check listings weekly) and is also available later in the week.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Nevada's locker room is closed to the media. Interview requests should be directed to director of communications Aaron Juarez. Head coach Steve Alford and selected players will be available to the media following a 10-minute cooling off period. All postgame interviews will be conducted virtually for the 2020-21 season.

Sophomore forward Zane Meeks picked up his offensive production in the series against Air Force, averaging 16.0 points and posting his first double digit-scoring performances since joining the starting lineup Dec. 7.

Meeks matched his career high with 18 points in the Dec. 20 finale, going 5-for-11 from the field, and grabbed eight rebounds in each game of the series. He also forced his way to the line, going 14-for-17 (.824) for the series.

Over five games as a starter, Meeks is averaging 10.8 points and 5.8 rebounds, while shooting 50.0 percent (17-for-34) from the field.

WASHINGTON CLAIMING THE PAINT

Redshirt sophomore forward Warren Washington was a force in the paint for the Pack in its series against Air Force, nearly averaging a double-double with 12.0 points and 9.5 rebounds. In Dec. 20's series finale, he grabbed a career-best 12 rebounds.

The transfer from Oregon State, who sat out last season due to NCAA transfer rules, shot 90.9 percent (10-for-11) from the field, highlighted by going 6-for-7 in the opener for 16 points. It's continued a nice rise for Washington, who has scored in double figures in four of the past six contests.

RUNNING THE POINT

Sophomore point guard Grant Sherfield had his streak of scoring in double digits in each of the Pack's first seven games snapped in Dec. 18's conference opener against Air Force, but bounced back with 10 points in the series finale.

Sherfield, a transfer from Wichita State who was granted immediate eligibility for the 2020-21 season, has been a boon to the Pack offense, leading the team in scoring (15.7 ppg) and assists (5.44 apg), a figure which is second in the Mountain West. Sherfield has posted at least six assists in five of the Pack's nine games this season.

STRONG TRANSFER CONTRIBUTION

The Pack has been bolstered this season by the contributions of a trio of transfers, as sophomore guard Grant Sherfield (previously of Wichita State), redshirt junior guard Desmond Cambridge, Jr. (Brown), and redshirt sophomore forward Warren Washington (Oregon State) are three of the team's top four scorers.

All three players have started every game this season for the Pack, and are scoring in double figures. Sherfield leads the way at 17.6 points per game, with Cambridge, Jr., at 14.0 per game and Washington scoring 7.7 per game.

Sherfield, who transferred to Nevada from Wichita State and was granted immediate eligibility ahead of the 2020-21 campaign, needed just two games to create a memorable moment for Wolf Pack fans, pulling up and hitting the game-winning 3-pointer from the top of the arc with six seconds remaining in Nov. 26's 69-66 win at Nebraska.

SEVEN NON-CONFERENCE GAMES WAS KEY

The 2020-21 non-conference campaign had a number of cancellations and postponements across the nation due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, forcing teams to adjust and schedule on the fly, in many cases.

Nevada was able to get seven non-conference games played, with only one being canceled (Dec. 6 at San Francisco). That contest was not canceled due to COVID issues with either team, but due to safety measures put in place by the local health department, barring athletic events.

The Pack went 5-2 in non-conference play, including a key road win at Nebraska Nov. 26. For a team that was breaking in four new starters, and with only one senior on the roster, being able to play seven games gave the Pack the chance to gel and find its identity ahead of the start of Mountain West play Dec. 18 and 20 against Air Force.

TWO FOR 20

For the first time this season, Nevada had teammates each go for at least 20 points in a single game, as Desmond Cambridge, Jr., and Grant Sherfield went for 27 and 25 points, respectively, in the 79-72 win at San Diego on Dec. 14.

Cambridge, Jr.'s 27 was his Nevada career best, and Sherfield's 25 his overall career best.

NEW LOOK PACK

Head coach Steve Alford is transitioning in nearly a whole new starting five in 2020-21, as the Pack returned just one starter from a season ago, junior forward Robby Robinson.

Robinson started all 31 games last year, finishing third on the team with 5.1 rebounds per game and scoring 2.7 points per game.

Eligible transfers are expected to play a significant role in the Pack's fortunes in 2020-21, with a trio of such players ready to step in. This trio features redshirt junior guard Desmond Cambridge, Jr., the 2017-18 Ivy League Rookie of the Year and Brown's leading scorer that season (17.3 ppg) and in 2018-19 (15.7 ppg), and redshirt sophomore forward Warren Washington (1.3 ppg, 1.4 rpg in 27 games at Oregon State in 2018-19), both of whom sat out last season due to NCAA transfer rules.

Rounding out this group is sophomore point guard Grant Sherfield, who averaged 8.1 points and 2.9 assists over 30 games (12 starts) at Wichita State in 2019-20. Sherfield transferred to Nevada following the campaign, and was granted immediate eligibility for 2020-21, allowing to him jump right into the Pack's rotation.

Adding depth to the Pack this season will be returners in sophomore forward Zane Meeks (6.4 ppg, 3.7 rpg, 43.1 FG pct. in 2019-20), redshirt sophomore forward K.J. Hymes (2019-20 Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year, 31 blocks over 31 games last season),

and guard Kane Millings (2.3 ppg in 31 games last year).

THE NEW CLASS

Along with the returners and transfers, the Pack will also be bolstered by a four-man freshman class of forward Tre Coleman (Jeffersonville, Ind. / Jeffersonville HS), guard Daniel Foster (Melbourne, Australia / Golden State Preparatory School), forward DeAndre Henry (Phoenix, Ariz. / PHHoenix Prep), and guard Alem Huseinovic (Bosnia and Herzegovina / PHHoenix Prep).

Coleman, like head coach Steve Alford and associate head coach Craig Neal, was named an Indiana All-Star in 2019-20. As a senior, he led Jeffersonville High School in scoring (15.4 ppg) and blocks (2.3 bpg).

Henry and Huseinovic each come from PHHoenix Prep in Arizona, helping The Fire qualify as one of 20 teams for the Grind Session World Championships. Henry was named to the All Grind Session First Team, and was selected to play in the Grind Session All-Star Game, averaging a double-double of 17.4 points and 11.3 rebounds per game as a senior. Huseinovic, meanwhile, averaged 14.5 points, 3.3 rebounds and 3.4 assists his senior season, shooting 43 percent from 3-point range and 91 percent from the line.

CONFERENCE PLAY CHANGES

Due to adjustments caused by the current COVID-19 pandemic, the 2020-21 Mountain West slate will go from 18 games to 20 games with Nevada playing each team in the league twice. In order to cut down on travel, teams will play one another in a two-game series in the same city.

The Nevada men's basketball team was picked for sixth place in a preseason poll of media members covering Mountain West basketball, the conference announced Nov. 11.

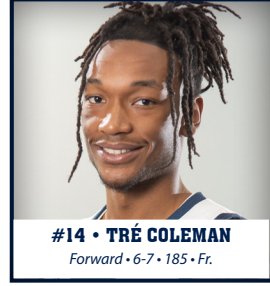
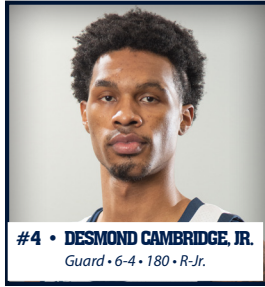

In the 1921-22 athletic season, a local writer described the spirited play of a Nevada team as a 'pack of wolves'. The name stuck and soon almost every reference to the athletic teams was the Nevada Wolves. In 1923, the students officially designated 'Wolves' as the school's mascot.

Since all teams are a group of players, the word pack followed quickly. In 1928-29, the Nevada student handbook referred to the athletic teams as Wolf Pack and two school songs were adopted, entitled 'The Wolf Pack' and 'Here Comes the Wolf Pack.'

Nevada head coach Steve Alford just completed his first season leading the Wolf Pack in 2019-20 and guided the team to a 19-12 record. The Pack posted a 12-6 mark in Mountain West play to finish in a tie for second in the conference standings.

On Jan. 25, 2020 Alford won his 600th career game when Nevada defeated New Mexico 96-74 at Lawlor Events Center. Alford coached the Lobos for six seasons and won 155 games. He is the 16th active NCAA I coach to reach the 600 win mark.

In his 30th season, Alford's career record stands at 612-313, a winning percentage of 66.2, and at 534-283 (.654) in his 26th season as a Division I head coach. With previous Division I stops at Missouri State, Iowa, New Mexico and UCLA, his teams have averaged 21 wins per year with only two losing seasons.

Alford became the first coach to win two Paradise Jam titles as the Pack swept the field winning all three games by double figures in the U.S. Virgin Islands. In 2012 he led his then New Mexico squad to the title. Junior Jalen Harris was the MVP and was joined on the all-tournament team by Jazz Johnson.

Four members of Alford's first Nevada team garnered post-season honors led by Harris. Harris was named to the NABC and USBWA all-district teams after leading the MW in scoring at 21.6 points per game. He was also a MW coaches and media first team selection. Three times he was named the MW Player of the Week and on Feb. 9 was the Oscar Robertson Player of the Week. He scored 30 or more points six times including becoming the first Pack player with four consecutive games of 30 or more points.

Johnson was named to the MW coaches second team and media third team. Senior Nizre Zouzoua was the MW Sixth Man of the Year as selected by the coaches and media. Johnson earned the Sixth Man of the Year honor in 2019. Another of the Pack seniors Lindsey Drew was named the MW coaches defensive team for the second time in his career and was an honorable mention pick by the coaches and media. He was named the MW Player of the Week the first week of the season.

On April 11, 2019, University of Nevada director of athletics Doug Knuth announced the hiring of Alford as the head coach of the nationally ranked Wolf Pack men's basketball program.

Alford, a highly successful coach with 11 NCAA Tournament berths and four Sweet 16 appearances, signed a 10-year deal to lead Nevada.

Alford is no stranger to the Mountain West, having coached New Mexico to four MW regular season titles and two MW tournament championships with six postseason appearances in his

six seasons in Albuquerque. With Alford now coaching the Wolf Pack, seven of the last 12 Mountain West championships have been won by Nevada, or Nevada's current coach.

Alford joined the Wolf Pack after five plus seasons at UCLA where he led the Bruins to four NCAA Tournament appearances advancing to the Sweet 16 three times in a four-year span in 2014, 2015 and 2017. The Bruins won the 2014 Pac-12 Tournament. During his tenure at UCLA he posted a record of 124-63.

Nevada will be Alford's fifth Division I head coaching job after making stops at Missouri State (1995-1999), Iowa (1999-2007), New Mexico (2007-2013) and UCLA (2013-2018). He began his collegiate coaching career at Division III Manchester College (1991-1995) and led the team to a runner-up finish in 1995 as the squad ended the year 31-1. The only loss came in the NCAA Division III title game.

In each of his previous coaching jobs he led his team's to NCAA Tournament victories. In 14 seasons his squads advanced to the NCAA Tournament, 11 at the Division I level and three at Division III. In addition to leading UCLA to three Sweet 16 appearances he guided Missouri State to its first Sweet 16 in 1999. Seven times he led squads to the National Invitation Tournament.

A proven winner Alford's teams have won eight conference tournaments, the Big 10 twice (2001, 2006), the Mountain West twice (2012, 2013), Pac-12 (2014) and the Indiana Collegiate Conference (1993, 1994, 1995) three times during his time at Manchester.

No stranger to the MW, Alford led New Mexico to four regular season and two tournament titles in six seasons as the Lobos head coach. In 2009, 2010 and 2013 he was named the MW Coach of the Year. He posted a record of 155-52 at UNM and was 68-26 in conference play. Three of his UNM players; JR Giddens (2008), Darrington Hobson (2010) and Kendal Williams (2013) were named MW Player of the Year. The Lobos 30 wins in 2012 and 29 in 2013 are the two highest win totals in program history. The 2012 and 2013 team secured No. 3 seeds in the NCAA Tournament which tied UNM's record for highest seeded team.

In 15 seasons he had led his teams to 20 or more wins and three times 30 or more victories. His 2016-17 UCLA squad posted a 31-5 record with the 28 regular season victories tying the Bruins record for wins.

During his time at UCLA he coached 11 NBA draft selections, seven were chosen in the first round. In 2015 (Kevon Looney), 2014 (Zach Lavine, Jordan Adams, Kyle Anderson), 2017 (Lonzo

Ball, TJ Leaf) and 2018 (Aaron Holiday) were all first round selections. While at UNM, JR Giddens and Tony Snell were first round NBA selections.

At Manchester College he earned conference coach of the year honors three times. The 1994-95 team was inducted into the school's hall of fame and in 1999 Alford was inducted into the Manchester Hall of Fame.

As a college senior Alford led Indiana to the 1987 NCAA Championship. The 1983 Indiana Mr. Basketball was a two-time consensus NCAA first-team All-America selection in 1986 and 1987. A three-time first-team Big 10 selection, he was the conference MVP his senior year. He ended his college career as the leading scorer at Indiana and currently ranks second. He played for Hall of Fame coach Bob Knight at Indiana. In 1984 Alford earned an Olympic gold medal playing for the United States in Los Angeles for a team coached by Knight. It was the last United States' amateur team to win Olympic Gold.

In 1997 he was inducted into the Indiana University Hall of Fame and in 2001 was one of 15 players named to Indiana's All-Century team.

Following his career at Indiana he was selected 26th overall in 1987 NBA Draft by the Dallas Mavericks. He played four years from 1987-1991 in the NBA for Dallas and Golden State.

He is married to the former Tanya Frost. The couple has two sons Kory and Bryce and a daughter Kayla.
