OPENING TIPS

• Utah State is undefeated in Mountain West play for the first time in school history, and is off to its best start in league play since the 2012-13 season, when the Aggies opened their final year in the WAC, 5-0.

• Utah State is 31-9 in MW play under head coach Craig Smith and is 4-1 against the Lobos during Smith's tenure. Overall, USU leads the all-time series 27-12 against New Mexico and has won four of the last five, including each of the last two on neutral courts.

• During its recent six-game winning streak, Utah State is shooting almost 50 percent from the floor (.491), averaging 83.3 points and 19.3 assists per game, and outscoring the opposition by almost 30 points per game (28.5). USU's defense is averaging 8.7 steals and 5.0 blocks per game over the same stretch, while holding teams to 54.8 points per game and limiting teams to 35.7 percent (38-of-136) shooting from the floor and 27.9 percent (61-of-91) from 3-point range. The Aggies also have a plus-14.2 rebound margin and a plus-5.8 turnover margin.

• Utah State has owned the glass this season, outrebounding every opponent this year and carrying a rebounding margin of plus-11.1 to rank No. 11 in the nation. The Aggies have pulled down double-digit offensive boards in all but two games this season.

• Junior forward **Justin Bean** is the current active leader in the Mountain West with 20 double-doubles in his career. Junior center **Neemias Queta** is just behind with 17. Bean has logged double-digit rebounds five times this season and ranks No. 8 in school history with 30 double-digit rebounding games in his career. Bean needs one more 10-plus rebounding performance to move to No. 7 in school history and tie Leo Cunningham (1979-82) with 31.

• Freshman guard **Rollie Worster** has logged more double-digit scoring games than any other rookie in Utah State history over their first 10 games. Worster currently leads the Aggies with seven double-digit scoring outings this season.

• In only nine games with the Aggies, redshirt junior guard **Marco Anthony** has already surpassed every statistic that he accumulated in two years at the University of Virginia - points (115/52), rebounds (33/24), assists (21/20), steals (7/2), minutes (262/222).

• Junior guard **Brock Miller** has found his shooting touch since the beginning of Mountain West play, averaging 13.3 points per game and shooting 48.8 percent (20-of-41) from the floor and 43.3 percent (13-of-30) from behind the arc. **Miller** opened the year averaging just 5.7 points per game and shooting 36.1 percent (13-of-36) from the floor and 41.2 percent (7-of-17) from behind the 3-point line.

• **Queta** ranks No. 11 in the nation with 26 total blocks, which is as much or more than 187 other teams in the nation. **Queta** is seven blocks away from tying the all-time school record of 155 set by Gilbert Pete (1986-89). **Queta** is the only player in the nation averaging more than 11 points, 8.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.5 blocks per game.

THROWN INTO THE FIRE

Utah State opened the year with its toughest schedule since the KenPom era began (2001-02), as each of its first opponents were ranked among the top-100 in the nation. The Aggies are one of just eight teams in the country to face four top-100 teams over the course of their first four games of the 2020-21 season.

Utah State's only losses this season have come against teams with an NCAA NET rating better than 100 - VCU (31), BYU (52), South Dakota State (98).

Utah State entered the 2020-21 season with seven players on its roster of 16 that had never played a single minute in Division I basketball.

20-POINT CLUB

Redshirt junior guard **Marco Anthony** and junior forward **Justin Bean** are the only two Aggies to log 20 or more points in a game this season, as Anthony scored a game-high 22 points against UNI on Nov. 27, while Bean scored a game-high 21 points against the College of Idaho on Dec. 8.

SHORT SCORING

Utah State has picked up each of its victories this season when its starting backcourt has outscored the opponent's starting guard line.

FOUR HORSEMEN SCORING

Utah State is one of just three teams in the Mountain West with four players averaging double-digit scoring numbers this season (Boise State, Wyoming).

The Aggies are undefeated this season when four players score in double figures during a game.

DOUBLE DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Juniors Neemias Queta and Justin Bean each recorded a double-double in the Aggies' 82-71 victory over Northern Iowa on Nov. 27. It marked the second time that the duo has each recorded a double-double in the same game.

RECORD BOOK RISER

Bean has proven to be one of the best rebounders in Utah State history and has logged double-digit rebounds in three games of the last four games to bring his career total to 30 games, tying him for No. 8 all-time in USU history.

BACK-TO-BACK 20'S

Utah State logged back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time since the 2011-12 and 2012-13 campaigns. Overall, it is the 30th time in school history that USU has won at least 20 games in a season.

BACK-TO-BACK CHAMPS

Utah State has won back-to-back Mountain West Tournament championships, making it just one of four teams in conference history to win back-to-back tournament titles (New Mexico, San Diego State, UNLV). The back-to-back tournament titles were the first for Utah State since capturing back-to-back Big West Tournament titles in 2000 and 2001.

BLOCK PARTY

Utah State recorded 10 blocks as a team in its 85-52 victory over San José State on Dec. 23, marking the most blocks by the Aggies in a game since the 2014-15 season.

The 10 blocks are tied for the third most in a single game in USU history.

ALL ABOUT THE BENJAMINS

In three years under head coach Craig Smith, USU has scored 100 or more points in a game six times. To find another six 100-point games prior to Coach Smith, you have to include a span of 20 years from 1997-98 to 2017-18.

SUCCEEDING IN THE CLASSROOM

Utah State led the nation with seven student-athletes named to the NABC Honor Roll during the 2019-20 season.

SCORING BIG WINS

- Utah State is 38-7 under head coach Craig Smith when its starting bigs outscore the opposition's frontcourt.

- Utah State's frontcourt has outscored its counterparts in all but one game this season.

BENCH SCORING

- Utah State is 46-8 under head coach Craig Smith when the Aggies' reserves outscore the opponent's bench.

- Utah State has played 15 players in three of its four conference games, outscoring the opponent's bench in each contest.

AROUND THE WORLD

Utah State is tied for third in the nation as it has players from seven different nations around the world, including Portugal, Russia, Ukraine, Poland, Canada, Australia and the United States.

WHITE SHIRTS/BLACK TAGS

Utah State has five players on its roster that served missions for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, covering three states in the U.S., and two countries worldwide.

Utah State is 7-3 all-time under head coach Craig Smith in games decided by three points or less.

SHOOTING TO VICTORIES

- Utah State is 45-9 under head coach Craig Smith when shooting better than 30 percent from behind the 3-point line.

- Utah State has shot better than 50 percent from the floor in each of the last two games.

STEALING THE VICTORIES

Utah State is 32-3 under head coach Craig Smith when recording more steals than its opponents.

70-POINT WINS

Utah State is 52-5 under head coach Craig Smith when scoring 70 or more points in a game.

DEFENSIVE VICTORIES

- Utah State is 43-5 under head coach Craig Smith when holding opponents to fewer than 69 points.

- The Aggies are 28-0 under Smith when holding opponents to fewer than 60 points.

WINNING AT THE HALF

Utah State is 52-7 under head coach Craig Smith when leading at the half.

DISTRIBUTING THE VICTORIES

Utah State is 55-5 under head coach Craig Smith when recording more assists than the opposition.

PROTECTING THE VICTORIES

Utah State is 28-4 under head coach Craig Smith when recording fewer turnovers than the opposition.

WE'RE GOING TO OVERTIME!

Utah State is 61-47 all-time in overtime games. The Aggies have won six of their last seven overtime contests.

AGGIES HAVE THE HEIGHT

- Utah State has the tallest team in the nation, on average, with an average height of 79.31 inches. The Aggies rank ahead of Stanford (79.06), Boise State (78.86), Florida (78.57) and Texas (78.57)

- Senior center **Kuba Karwowski** is the tallest player in Utah State history, standing at 7-foot-2. Karwowski is tied with three others in the NCAA as the fifth-tallest player in the nation.

- Utah State is one of only two schools in the nation with three players that stand seven feet or taller (Fresno State).

ABOUT CRAIG SMITH

- Smith was named the 2019 Mountain West Coach of the Year and the USBWA District VIII Coach of the Year, along with being named a finalist for the Jim Phelan Coach of the Year.

- Smith recorded his 200th head coaching victory in Utah State's 71-59 victory at Fresno State on Feb. 15, 2020, and his 50th head coaching victory at Utah State in the Aggies' 78-58 victory over Wyoming on Feb. 19, 2020.

- Smith hit the 50-win mark at Utah State faster than any other head coach in school history, accomplishing the feat in 64 games.

- Entering the season, Smith is second in Mountain West history with a .783 winning percentage (54-15) over his first two years in the league.

ABOUT SEAN BAIRSTOW

• **Bairstow** has family ties to both Utah State and the Mountain West as his sister, Stephanie, was a member of the USU women's basketball team from 2013-14, and his brother, Cam, was an all-conference performer at New Mexico from 2011-14.

• Made his first career start against the College of Idaho on Dec. 8.

• Has scored in double figures in two games this season, turning in 11 points against both the College of Idaho (12/8) and San José State (12/23).

ABOUT STEVEN ASHWORTH

• **Ashworth** originally signed with Utah State in 2017 and recently returned from an LDS Church mission in Indianapolis, Indiana.

• Led Lone Peak High School to back-to-back Utah 6A state title games, capturing the state championship as a senior.

• Named the Utah 6A MVP and to the GEICO National all-tournament team as a senior.

• Played alongside current NBA guard **Frank Jackson** at Lone Peak HS during his freshman and sophomore seasons.

ABOUT ALPHONSO ANDERSON

• **Anderson** was named to the 2019 Jamaica Classic all-tournament team after averaging 21.5 points, 5.0 rebounds and 1.0 steals per game against LSU and North Texas.

• Appeared in all 34 games during the 2019-20 season with four starts. Averaged 8.1 points and 3.7 rebounds per game in 17.9 minutes per contest.

ABOUT MAX SHULGA

• Member of both the U20 and U18 Ukrainian National team.

• Scored in double figures in all but two games during the 2019 U18 European Championships and finished the tournament averaging 13.3 points, 7.3 rebounds, 2.6 assists and 2.0 steals per game.

Off the bench, Miller's shooting improved from 34.6 percent from the floor and 29.1 percent from behind the 3-point line, to 41.7 percent from the floor and 44.4 percent from behind the 3-point line.

• **Miller** owns the school record for 3-point attempts in a game, shooting 19 against St. Katherine last season.

• **Miller** has scored in double figures in each of the last two games and is shooting 50.0 percent (6-of-12) from behind the 3-point line over the same two-game stretch.

ABOUT NEEMIAS QUETA

• **Queta** helped Portugal to the 2019 FIBA U20 Division B European Championship, finishing second in the tournament in blocks per game (2.0) and field goal percentage (.673), third in rebounds per game (11.0), 16th in points per game (14.3) and graded out as the most efficient player in the entire tournament.

• **Queta** rewrote the single-season block record at Utah State with his 84 blocks in 2018-19, shattering the previous single-season record of 59. Queta also recorded a MW freshman-record six blocks against Fresno State on Jan. 9, 2019. • **Queta** recorded his 100th career block against UNLV on Feb. 5, 2020, becoming the fifth Aggie in school history to record 100 or more blocks in a career. Queta ranks fourth all-time in USU history with 122 career blocks. Queta led the MW with 1.7 blocks per game in league play.

• **Queta** recorded six blocks in each game against San José State, matching the third-most in a single game in school history.

• **Queta** only needs seven more blocks to tie the all-time record in Utah State history of 155 set by Gilbert Pete over the course of the 1986-89 seasons.

• Named preseason all-Mountain West and to the initial watch lists of the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar and Wooden awards.

ABOUT ROLLIE WORSTER

• **Worster**, the two-time Gatorade Player of the Year in the state of Montana, was a two-sport athlete at Hellgate HS, earning first-team all-state honors in both basketball and football.

• **Worster** finished his prep career as the all-time leading scorer in Hellgate HS history, surpassing more than 1,500 points, and finished second in career assists and third in career rebounds.

• Also recruited to play collegiate football, being courted by several schools in the Big Sky Conference and Boise State.

• Sister, Shannon, was a member of Montana Western's NAIA National Championship team in 2018-19.

• **Worster** leads the Aggies with seven double-digit scoring outings this season.

ABOUT ZAHAR VEDISCHEV

• Member of the Russian National team at the U19 World Basketball Championships, scoring a team-high 24 points against the United States in the quarterfinals.

• Finished the tournament as the 10th-best scorer, averaging 16.5 points per game and scoring 22 or more points in each of his final three games

ABOUT JUSTIN BEAN

- **Bean** played the first seven games of the 2019-20 season with a mask to protect a broken nose he suffered during the second week of October. Bean also had oral surgery following USU's 81-73 victory over Montana State on Nov. 5 to repair two teeth that were damaged during the game against the Bobcats. Bean suffered a similar injury when not wearing a mouth guard against UTSA on Nov. 18. Bean had braces removed the third week of December, following corrective teeth work for the injuries.

- **Bean** was named the 2019 Jamaica Classic Tournament MVP after averaging a double-double of 14.0 points and 13.0 rebounds per game against LSU and North Texas.

- **Bean** is wearing the same number that his dad wore as a player at Idaho State.

- **Bean** finished the 2019-20 season averaging 11.9 points and 10.5 rebounds per game to become the first Aggie to average a double-double in a season since **Mike Santos** averaged 18.2 points and 11.3 rebounds per game during the 1976-77 season.

- **Bean's** 356 total rebounds during the 2019-20 season were the most since **Troy Collier** pulled down 357 rebounds during the 1963-64 season and ranked eighth in the nation.

- Named third-team all-Mountain West and a member of the MW all-defensive team in 2019-20.

- **Bean** is the only returning player in the MW who averaged a double-double last season, turning in 11.9 points and 10.5 rebounds per game. Bean was 17th in the nation with 16 double-doubles, matching the most by an Aggie since **Bob Lauriski** logged 16 double-doubles during the 1971-72 season.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Utah State leads the all-time series against the Lobos 27-12, including a 2-1 advantage on neutral courts.
- The Aggies' neutral court wins have come in the Mountain West Tournament quarterfinals each of the past two seasons.
- The Aggies and Lobos faced each other for 11 straight years from 1951-62. The teams met a single time in Albuquerque during the 1979-80 season, before squaring off in each of the last eight seasons as members of the Mountain West.
- The team with the lead at the half has gone on to win the game 12 of the last 16 times.
- Junior forward **Justin Bean** recorded the first double-double of his career against New Mexico, logging 14 points and 15 rebounds against the Lobos in the quarterfinals of the 2018-19 Mountain West Tournament.
- Bean** matched his series-record 15 rebounds against the Lobos in the Mountain West Tournament quarterfinals a season ago.
- Junior center **Neemias Queta** recorded a Mountain West Tournament-freshman record six blocks against the Lobos during the 2018-19 season.
- This season, **Queta** has more blocks individually (26) than the entire Lobo roster (22).
- Queta** recorded a career-high 10 field goals in the game against the Lobos on Feb. 20, 2019, leading to a double-double effort of 23 points and 10 rebounds.
- Queta** is averaging a near-double-double of 14.6 points and 9.8 rebounds per game, and adding 3.0 blocks and 2.2 assists per game, over the course of his career against New Mexico.
- Utah State scored a Mountain West series-record 91 points in the Mountain West Tournament Quarterfinals during the 2018-19 season.

HEAD COACH CRAIG SMITH

North Dakota, 1996
Third Year (212-102, Nine Seasons)

Since being named the 19th head men's basketball coach in Utah State history on March 26, 2018, Craig Smith has led the Aggies to a wealth of success over his first two years. The run has included back-to-back Mountain West Tournament Championships, a share of the 2019 Mountain West regular season title and back-to-back NCAA Tournament berths. Under Smith, Utah State has compiled an overall mark of 54-15, including a 27-9 mark in the Mountain West.

The Aggies have been especially strong at home under Smith, logging a record of 29-2 inside the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum, making Utah State one of just 13 teams in the nation with two or fewer losses at home over the last two years. USU has also recorded more points than any other two-year span in school history as his 2018-19 squad scored a school-record 2,753 points, with the 2019-20 team scoring 2,600 points, third-most in school history.

In all, Smith has 24 years of collegiate coaching experience, including nine years as a head coach, and has been to post-season play 12 times during his career, while winning four regular season and four postseason conference championships. As a head coach, Smith has been named conference Coach of the Year four times (2006, 2007, 2017, 2019) in addition to receiving the NAIA II National Coach of the Year Award in 2007, the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 12 Coach of the Year Award in 2017, and NABC District 17 Coach of the Year and USBWA District VIII Coach of the Year in 2019.

In his first year at the helm at Utah State, Smith led the Aggies to a 28-7 record, the most wins by a first-year head coach and the third-most wins overall in school history. USU advanced the NCAA Tournament, earning a No. 8 seed, the highest in program history, and logged school records of 2,753 points and 147 blocks.

Smith was equally as successful in his second year, guiding Utah State to an overall mark of 26-8, a second-straight Mountain West Tournament championship and an NCAA Tournament berth. The Aggies were one of just 12 teams in the nation to secure a tournament spot before the event was canceled because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Individually, players have thrived under Smith as Sam Merrill was the 2019 MW Player of the Year, the first player in MW history to earn back-to-back MW Tournament MVP honors, a two-time first-team all-MW selection and a 2019 AP honorable mention All-American. Neemias Queta was the 2019 MW Freshman of the Year, 2019 MW Defensive Player of the Year, two-time all-MW selection and two-time MW all-defensive team honoree. Justin Bean was most recently named third-team all-MW in 2020, along with earning MW all-defensive team honors.

The Aggies have also excelled in the classroom under Smith, earning an NCAA Division I-best seven NABC Honors Court accolades in 2020, while eight student-athletes have earned a total of 13 academic all-MW awards and six more have earned a total of nine MW scholar-athlete accolades.

Smith came to Utah State after spending four years as the head coach at the University of South Dakota, where he led the Coyotes to a 79-55 (.590) record, including a 38-26 (.594) mark in the Summit League. In his last two seasons at USD, he led the program to back-to-back postseason appearances (NIT, CBI) and a conference championship (2017), as the Coyotes produced a 48-21 (.696) record, including a 23-7 (.767) mark in league play.

During the 2017-18 season at South Dakota, Smith led the Coyotes to a 26-9 record, which is the second-most wins in school history, and its best record in their 10 years at the Division I level. USD also finished second in its conference during the 2017-18 campaign with an 11-3 mark and advanced to the championship game of the Summit League Tournament, followed by an appearance in the College Basketball Invitational, which was its second-straight postseason appearance. In all, USD did not lose back-to-back games once during the 2017-18 regular season.

Statistically, South Dakota led the Summit League and ranked 12th in the nation in scoring margin (+12.2 points per game) during the 2017-18 season, while also ranking first in the conference and 32nd nationally in field goal percentage defense (.409), and first in the conference and 36th in the nation in field goal percentage offense (.476). USD also ranked third in the Summit League and 35th in the nation in scoring offense (80.9 points per game) during the 2017-18 campaign, second in the conference and 30th in the nation in turnovers (11.1 per game), and second in the league and 20th nationally in turnover margin (+3.2 per game). The Coyotes also led the league and ranked 65th nationally in 3-point field goal percentage defense (.329) last season and were first in the conference in scoring defense (68.7 points per game), while also ranking second in the conference in both free throws made (555) and attempted (740).

Following the 2016-17 season, Smith was named the Summit League and NABC District 12 Coach of the Year as he led South Dakota to a 22-12 record, including a 12-4 mark in league play, to win its second-ever Division I conference championship. The Coyotes concluded the season by playing in the National Invitation Tournament.

During his four years as the head coach at South Dakota, Smith coached nine players who earned a total of 11 Summit League honors, including Matt Mooney, who was a two-time first-team all-league honoree and a two-time NABC All-District 12 team member.

Prior to being the head coach at South Dakota, Smith spent two seasons as an assistant at Nebraska (2013-14) and five seasons as an assistant at Colorado State (2008-12), helping the Cornhuskers to the 2014 NCAA Tournament and the Rams to the 2012 NCAA Tournament. While at CSU, Smith also helped the Rams advance to the 2010 CBI Tournament and the 2011 NIT.

Smith's other head coaching stint was at Mayville State University in North Dakota, where he compiled a 72-29 record in three seasons and three-straight NAIA II National Tournament appearances from 2005-07. The Comets were 1-25 the season before Smith's arrival and competed in the NAIA National Championship game in their third season under Smith.

After winning 17 games in his first season at Mayville State, the Comets set a school record for victories with 28 during the 2005-06 campaign, while winning the Dakota Athletic Conference (DAC) regular season and tournament championships. Mayville State advanced to the national quarterfinals before falling to the eventual national champions.

In 2007, Smith was named the NAIA II National Coach of the Year when the Comets defended their regular season and tournament titles and advanced to the National Championship game. It marked the first time any men's basketball team from North Dakota had ever played for a national title. Smith also earned DAC Coach of the Year honors in both 2006 and 2007.

Smith began his coaching career as an assistant at Mayville State during the 1996-97 season as he helped the Comets advance to the NAIA II Tournament. He then spent the 1997-98 season as a graduate assistant at Northern State in South Dakota, helping the Wolves to the Elite Eight of the NCAA Division II Tournament. He then spent three seasons as an assistant at Minot State in North Dakota, followed by three more seasons as an assistant at North Dakota State, where he began his affiliation with current Nebraska head coach Tim Miles. Following his three years as head coach at Mayville State, Smith worked under Miles at both Colorado State and Nebraska before becoming the head coach at South Dakota.

Smith is a Stephen, Minn., native and a 1996 graduate of the University of North Dakota, where he earned his bachelor's degree in secondary education. He then earned his master's degree in teaching and learning from Northern State, where he served as a graduate assistant for the 1997-98 season. The Wolves reached their first-ever Elite Eight that season.

Smith and his wife, Darcy, have three sons: Landon, Brady and Carson, along with a daughter, Lauren.
