OPENING TIP

- Fresno State enters a two-game home series with New Mexico on a three-game home winning streak. The Bulldogs are 5-1 at home this season.
- All-Mountain West candidate Orlando Robinson has six double-doubles this season (17.5 ppg/9.8 rpg).
- Three Bulldogs are averaging double-figures in scoring per game: Orlando Robinson (17.5 ppg), Deon Stroud (13.1 ppg) and Isaiah Hill (10.8 ppg).
- From Jan. 4-10, Fresno State won three consecutive MW games by at least 15 points or more for the second time since joining the conference in 2012.
- Fresno State head coach Justin Hutson, a native of Bakersfield, Calif., is in his third season back home in the San Joaquin Valley.
- Since joining the MW in 2012, Fresno State has won the 2016 MW tournament championship to earn the league's automatic bid into the 2016 NCAA Tournament and finished as high as second and no lower than seventh in the conference standings.

BULLDOG BREAKDOWN • SITUATIONAL NOTES TO WATCH

- During MW play, Fresno State is averaging 4.3 more offensive rebounds per game than its opponent (107 offensive rebounds to 68 allowed), including a +7.5 offensive rebounding/game edge at home in MW games (59 to 29).
- Fresno State is 45th in the nation in offensive rebounding (12.3/game) and 70th in rebounding margin (+4/game).
- Fresno State is 11-0 in Hutson's tenure when shooting 50 percent or better from the field (2-0 this season).
- Fresno State is 21-7 in Hutson's tenure when holding its opponent to under 40 percent from the field (4-1 this season).
- Fresno State is 17-2 in Hutson's tenure when scoring at least 80 points (3-0 this season).
- Fresno State is 28-8 in Hutson's tenure when allowing under 70 points (5-0 this season).
- Fresno State is 11-0 in Hutson's tenure when allowing under 60 points.
- Through games played on Jan. 26, Fresno State's Orlando Robinson was one of 24 players in the nation with six double-doubles and tied for the 16th-most in the nation.

PROTECTING THE YARD

- Fresno State enters the week with a 5-1 record at home this season.
- The Bulldogs have outscored their opponents by +16.5 points per home game with a +11.8 rebounding margin at the Save Mart Center this season.
- Fresno State is seeking its first four-game home win streak in MW play since winning its first five MW home games in 2017, the final five wins of a 13-game MW home streak spanning from Jan. 6, 2016 to Feb. 1, 2017.
- Fresno State is 193-86 (69.2 percent) all-time at the Save Mart Center.

FRESNO STATE HOSTS LOBOS FOR TWO-GAME SERIES

Fresno State (5-6, 3-6 Mountain West) opens a four-game homestand by hosting New Mexico (5-9, 1-9 MW) in a two-game series, which starts on Thursday at 8 p.m. PT (CBSSN) and wraps up Saturday at 4 p.m. PT (MWN). Both games will also be on 940 AM ESPN Radio.

SERIES HISTORY: FRESNO STATE VS. NEW MEXICO

This will be the 33rd and 34th meetings in the all-time series between Fresno State and New Mexico with the Lobos owning a 17-15 edge entering the series. Fresno State has won four straight contests against the Lobos played at the Save Mart Center and six of the last eight overall in the series. Since joining the MW in 2012, Fresno State is 8-9 against New Mexico, which includes a 3-1 record in Hutson's tenure.

ROBINSON: A DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE

Fresno State 7-foot sophomore forward Orlando Robinson has drawn inspiration from one of his former teammates - Nate Grimes - with a focus to also becoming a "double-double machine." Grimes, who is now playing professionally overseas for Kobrat (Finland), produced 25 career double-doubles (11 last season) over the course of four seasons playing for the Bulldogs (2015-20) and finished his collegiate career as the fourth-leading rebounding in MW history for most rebounds (445) in conference games. Entering the series, Robinson has recorded six double-double this season (11 in his Bulldog career). Robinson was the first Bulldog to have a double-double in four straight games since Dominic McGuire did so during the 2006-07 season (all four in March 2007). Robinson's last double-double came in a Jan. 8 win over SJSU.

HILL LOVING BEING BACK HOME IN THE VALLEY

Fresno State sophomore point guard Isaiah Hill, who is originally from Hutson's hometown of Bakersfield, has averaged 10.8 points and 3.5 assists per game in his first season back home in the Valley after starting his collegiate career at Tulsa. He ranks sixth in the MW in assists per game.

FRESNO STATE CONTENDING IN THE MOUNTAIN WEST

Since joining the Mountain West in 2012, Fresno State has won the 2016 conference tournament championship and finished as high as second in the regular season. The Bulldogs have finished no lower than seventh in league play in its first eight seasons in the Mountain West, which includes **four top four finishes in the past five seasons**. In the last five MW campaigns, the Dogs won an average of 11 MW contests per year, including twice going 13-5 against MW opponents, including Hutson's first season at Fresno State during the 2018-19 season.

THE RETURNING FOUR FROM LAST SEASON

Four returning letterwinners (**Jordan Campbell**, **Assane Diouf**, **Anthony Holland** and **Orlando Robinson**) are back for their sophomore seasons at Fresno State. Campbell began his collegiate career at Oregon State and Assane Diouf redshirted the 2018-19 season before making their Bulldog debuts last year. Holland (4.1 ppg/4.6 rpg) emerged as a critical piece of Fresno State's 2019-20 rotation, which saw the Riverside product play in 29 of the Bulldogs' 30 games - missing just a Jan. 22 road game at Colorado State due to injury. Robinson (12.2 ppg/6.6 rpg) led the team in scoring.

Fresno State played six freshmen during the 2019-20 season and led the Mountain West with those freshmen averaging a combined 101.7 minutes per game, which was nearly half of the Bulldogs' minutes per game average (49.8 percent). Fresno State's freshmen accounted for 3,050 of the team's 6,125 total minutes played (49.8 percent). Fresno State's Orlando Robinson (12.2 ppg) led the way for Fresno State's six freshmen, who had 1,002 of the Bulldogs' 2,075 points scored for an average of 33.4 points of the team's 69.2 points per game (48.3 percent). Robinson was the only Bulldog to play in all 30 games this past season. Three different freshmen scored at least 25 points in a game, including Robinson, who had 27 points in Fresno State's Dec. 28 nonconference home game against UC Riverside.

NEW ADDITIONS: OLDER TRANSFERS, TALENTED FRESHMEN

Fresno State fields a 14-man roster for the 2020-21 season, which includes 10 new players. Of those 10 additions, five of those newcomers are Division I transfers - junior guard **Junior Ballard (Cal Poly)**, fifth-year grad transfer guard **Devin Gage (DePaul)**, redshirt junior guard **Alec Hickman (UC Riverside)**, sophomore guard **Isaiah Hill (Tulsa)** and sophomore wing **Deon Stroud (UTEP)**. Fresno State has one additional Division I transfer - returning now sophomore guard **Jordan Campbell (Oregon State)**, who played in eight games for the Bulldogs last season - to feature a total of six Division I transfers on its roster. Fresno State will also infuse fifth-year senior forward **Christian Gray** back into its rotation. During Hutson's first season (2018-19), Gray played in 27 games and provided an important lift for the team in key games down the stretch. Both Gray and Hickman redshirted last season (2019-20) for development purposes. These newcomers are paired with sophomore guard **Kyle Harding (Allan Hancock College)** and three incoming freshmen **Leo Colimero (Wasatch Academy)**, **Braxton Meah (San Joaquin Memorial HS/Middlebrooks Academy)** and **Destin Whitaker (Romeoville HS)** to complete the 2020-21 roster.

THREE FIFTH-YEAR SENIORS FINISH CAREERS AS KEY PLAYERS

While the Bulldogs' freshmen earned nearly half of the Bulldogs' minutes last season, Fresno State fifth-year seniors New Williams (11.9 ppg), Nate Grimes (11.5 ppg) and Noah Blackwell (9.9 ppg) accounted for 40.5 percent (840 points) of the Bulldogs' scoring (2,075 points). Grimes was one of three MW players to average a double-double for the year. Williams became one of four players in MW history to make 10 made 3-point field goals in a game, which tied the program's record, and Blackwell closed his four-season collegiate career with a 2.1 assist-to-turnover ratio (301-141 A-TO).

ROBINSON BUILDING ON STRONG FRESHMAN CAMPAIGN

After starting all 30 games for the Bulldogs a season ago, **Orlando Robinson** has stepped into a larger leadership role for the Fresno State men's basketball team. The talented rising 7-foot sophomore forward and All-Mountain West candidate led the 'Dogs with 12.2 points and a 49.2 percent field goal percentage (127-258), along with a Fresno State freshman season record of 6.6 rebounds per game during the 2019-20 campaign.

Robinson, who is originally from Las Vegas, had five games with at least 20 points, which was the second-most by a Fresno State freshman in the last 15 seasons and one shy of current Los Angeles Clippers star Paul George's six 20-point performances during the 2008-09 season while playing for the Bulldogs. Robinson also recorded five double-doubles last season.

BULLDOG BONES

NEW ADDITIONS PLAYING MAJOR FACTOR IN ROTATION

Fresno State has eight brand-new players on its roster this season, along with two players who redshirted the 2019-20 season for a total of 10 newcomers. Those eight brand-new additions have produced 57.0 percent of the Bulldogs' scoring offense (337 of 591 points) with the four new Division I transfers (**Junior Ballard** - Cal Poly, **Devin Gage** - DePaul, **Isaiah Hill** - Tulsa and **Deon Stroud** - UTEP) accounting for 45.2 percent (267 of 591 points) of that overall total scoring. Hill and Stroud are each averaging 11 points or more per game through the first eight contests of the season.

CAMPBELL EMERGES AS TWO-WAY THREAT IN SJSU SERIES

Fresno State sophomore guard Jordan Campbell averaged 13.5 points and eight rebounds per game in the Fresno State's sweep of San Jose State, which included a career-high 16 points with nine rebounds, two blocks and two steals in the Bulldogs' 80-65 win over the Spartans on Jan. 10.

STROUD SOARING IN RETURN HOME TO THE 559

Fresno State sophomore guard Deon Stroud returned home to Fresno to play for the Bulldogs after beginning his collegiate career at UTEP. Stroud has averaged 13.1 and 3.6 rebounds points per game so far, including a season-high 22 points with five made 3-pointers in the Bulldogs' 80-65 win over San Jose State on Jan. 10. Stroud scored in double-figures in eight of the Bulldogs' first 10 games this season. Stroud's uncle is Cary Ray Harris, who is the program's fifth all-time leading scorer (1,584 points).

BULLDOGS OPEN WITH PAIR OF DOUBLE-DIGIT WINS

Fresno State opened the 2020-21 season with an 87-47 win over the William Jessup Warriors on Thanksgiving Eve at the Save Mart Center. Fresno State sophomore forward Orlando Robinson had 16 points with 10 rebounds, while sophomore guard Isaiah Hill also had 16 points and Deon Stroud added 13 points in their Bulldog debut. 24 days later, Fresno State defeated Fresno Pacific 78-65 on Dec. 19. Junior Ballard, who is originally from Stockton scored a team-best 17 points in his Bulldog debut. Robinson had another double-double with 14 points and 11 rebounds in the win over FPU.

TRANSFERS MAKE IMMEDIATE IMPACT IN OPENER

In the Bulldogs' season-opening 40-point victory, four Division I transfers and two junior college transfers combined for 64 of Fresno State's 87 points. Isaiah Hill (Tulsa) had 16 points, while Deon Stroud (UTEP) added 13 points. Jordan Campbell (Oregon State) scored 10 points, Kyle Harding (Allan Hancock College) tallied nine points and Christian Gray (Salt Lake CC) recorded eight points. Hill, Stroud and Harding went a combined 5-for-5 from beyond the 3-point line in the Thanksgiving Eve win.

THREE 7-FOOTERS IN THE POST: ROBINSON, MEAH & DIOUF

Fresno State features three 7-footers for the first time in program history with Orlando Robinson (7-0), Braxton Meah (7-1) and Assane Diouf (7-2). Fresno State is one of three teams (Utah State & East Carolina) in the nation this season with three 7-footers on its roster. Robinson, Meah and Diouf are three of the now six 7-foot or taller players to ever play for the Bulldogs (7-1: Neal McCoy, 1972-73; 7-0: Robert Upshaw, 2013 & Anthony Pelle, 1994-95).

A LOOK BACK AT THE BULLDOGS' MW ROAD STARTS

For the sixth time in the last seven seasons, Fresno State opened MW play on the road. In Hutson's tenure, the Bulldogs are 1-2 in MW openers – all three road games (a 73-53 win at San Jose State on Jan. 2, 2019, a 61-52 loss at San Diego State on Jan. 1, 2020 and a 75-53 loss at Colorado State on Dec. 28, 2020). Since joining the league in 2012, Fresno State is now 2-7 all-time in MW openers and 2-7 in MW road openers.

FIVE NONCONFERENCE GAMES POSTPONED

Fresno State had traveled to Stockton for a Nov. 27 road game but the game needed to be delayed and later postponed when it became clear Pacific was not going to receive their latest COVID-19 test results in time for a game to be played on Nov. 27. After returning from Stockton, Fresno State had to pause all athletic activity due to subsequent multiple positive cases of COVID-19 within the program, as recommended by the CDC and the Fresno County Department of Public Health. All scheduled contests from Nov. 30 through December 13 were officially postponed with additional details regarding whether they would be canceled or rescheduled still pending.

275 GAMES AND COUNTING AT THE SAVE MART CENTER

When the Bulldogs and Sunbirds met on Dec. 19, it was the 275th Fresno State men's basketball game at the Save Mart Center, which has been the home arena for the program since December 2003.

BULLDOGS CLOSELY CONNECTED WITH JALEN GREEN

Fresno State freshman center Braxton Meah (2018-19) and sophomore guard Deon Stroud (2016-17) are former teammates of Fresno native Jalen Green when playing for the San Joaquin Memorial High School Panthers. Green, who was a 2020 NBA G-League select team signee to its new NBA prep Ignite team, is widely considered a strong contender to be a potential 2021 NBA lottery pick. Meanwhile, Fresno State sophomore guard Isaiah Hill, who prepped at Liberty High School in Bakersfield - scored 45 points against Meah and Green in a showdown between LHS and SJM on Dec. 12, 2018, which the Panthers won 92-81.

FRESNO STATE PRODUCING NBA DRAFT LOTTERY PICKS, PROS

In the last 21 seasons, Fresno State has produced three NBA Lottery picks - Paul George (No. 10 overall in 2010), Melvin Ely (No. 12 overall in 2002) and Courtney Alexander (No. 13 overall in 2000) - while UNLV has two and San Diego State has one in that same 21-season span. Overall, Fresno State has had 31 players go on to play in the NBA, including 21 being selected in the NBA Draft with five first-round picks (four since 2000).

BULLDOGS REPRESENT FRESNO STATE IN THE NBA

Former Fresno State basketball players **Paul George (2008-10)**, **Tyler Johnson (2010-14)** and **Paul Watson (2013-17)** are three of the 31 former Bulldogs to have played in the NBA.

Paul George (Fresno State: 2008-10; No. 10 overall in 2010 NBA Draft)

Paul George is in his 11th NBA season and second with the Los Angeles Clippers, who recently extended his contract through the 2024-25 season. He was drafted 10th overall in 2010 by the Indiana Pacers (2010-17) and later played two seasons with the Oklahoma City Thunder from 2017-19.

George won a gold medal with Team USA during the 2016 Summer Olympics in Rio, is a six-time NBA All-Star, five-time All-NBA selection, including the 2018-19 All-NBA First Team, and four-time member of the NBA All-Defensive Team. George was named the NBA Most Improved Player in 2013 and finished third in the 2018-19 NBA's Most Valuable Player voting.

Tyler Johnson (Fresno State: 2010-14)

Johnson is in his seventh season in the NBA and enters his first full season with the Brooklyn Nets, after resigning with the team following a successful showing in the 2020 NBA Bubble. Johnson started his NBA career by playing over four and a half seasons for the Miami Heat before being traded to the Phoenix Suns in 2019.

Johnson scored 1,346 points during his four-year Fresno State career and ranks No. 17 all-time on the Bulldogs' all-time scoring list. Johnson was undrafted, but earned a roster spot with Miami after a strong showing during the NBA Summer League in 2014.

Paul Watson (Fresno State: 2013-17)

Watson signed a 10-day contract with the Atlanta Hawks on Jan. 6, 2020 and appeared in two games with the Hawks. Watson then signed a two-way contract with the Toronto Raptors on Jan. 15, 2020. He played in eight games for Toronto during the 2019-20 regular season, including six in the 2020 NBA Bubble in Orlando prior to the start of the 2020 NBA Playoffs.

Paul Watson was the 2013-14 Mountain West Freshman of the Year and a 2013-14 Freshman All-American. Watson represented Fresno State as one of the eight participants in the 2020 State Farm College Slam Dunk Championship during the 2017 NCAA Final Four weekend in Phoenix.

Justin Hutson, one of the West's best recruiters and a veteran of the Mountain West conference, is Fresno State's 19th head men's basketball coach.

Hutson, a native of Bakersfield, Calif., led Fresno State to a 23-9 record during his first season back home in the Valley to earn 2018-19 Joe B. Hall National Coach of the Year honors. The national award is presented annually to the top first-time head coach in NCAA Division I college basketball. Hutson returned to the Valley after serving as a rising Division I assistant coach for 10 seasons at San Diego State (2006-11, '13-18), two seasons at UNLV (2011-13), two seasons at Cal Poly (2004-06) and two seasons at CSU Bakersfield (1998-2000).

During the 2018-19 season, Fresno State ranked ninth nationally in 3-point field goals per game (10.7), 16th in total 3-point field goals and 24th nationally in both 3-point field goal percentage offense (342-897, 38.1 percent) and 3-point field goal percentage defense (225-735, 30.6 percent). The Bulldogs' defense also led the MW in steals (228, 7.1 steals per game) and turnovers forced (13.7 per game). Three Bulldogs earned All-MW honors and senior guard/forward Sam Bittner earned the program's first Academic All-American recognition. Fresno State was also one of two MW teams to go 7-2 on the road in conference play, which tied for the second-most MW road wins by a team in 20 seasons of MW basketball. Throughout the 2019-20 campaign, Hutson turned to a rotation, which featured six freshmen, who averaged a MW-leading 101.7 minutes per game and produced 33.4 points of the team's 69.2 points per game (48.3 percent of the total points). Freshman forward Orlando Robinson (12.2 ppg) led the squad in scoring.

During his time at San Diego State, Hutson helped elevate the Aztecs to a national program. In his first five seasons (2006-11), SDSU won three MW titles and earned postseason berths in each of those campaigns. In 2010-11, San Diego State won 20 straight games to begin the season, won the MW regular-season and tournament titles, and advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA tournament before finishing with a school-record 34 victories. SDSU ended the year ranked No. 6/11 nationally.

Upon returning to San Diego State, the Aztecs won the MW regular-season championship in 2014 and advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA tournament before finishing with a No. 13/12 national ranking. In the last four seasons, which have produced a pair of additional MW regular-season titles, the Aztecs appeared in the third round of the 2015 NCAA tournament, went to the semifinals of the 2016 NIT and won the 2018 MW Tournament to secure a NCAA Tournament first round appearance.

SDSU's defensive numbers also improved to an elite level when he decided to rejoin the Aztec coaching staff. As the defensive coordinator, San Diego State finished in the top 15 nationally in both scoring defense and field-goal percentage defense in his first four seasons back. San Diego State finished second in scoring defense in 2014 and 2015, third in 2016 and 15th in 2017. As far as field-goal percentage defense, the Aztecs were eighth in 2014, seventh in 2015, first in 2016 and eighth in 2017.

In his two years at UNLV, Hutson helped coach the Rebels to a pair of 25-win seasons and two NCAA appearances. He played a key role in helping UNLV bring in a highly regarded incoming class in 2012-13, which included the 2013 No. 1 overall NBA Draft selection, Anthony Bennett, a player Hutson recruited.

In both of his stints on the Montezuma Mesa, Hutson played a pivotal part in SDSU's recruiting efforts as the team's recruiting coordinator. He was the point person in recruiting future All-Americans and NBA Draft picks Kawhi Leonard, Jamaal Franklin and Xavier Thames, while also helping land D.J. Gay, who left SDSU as the school's all-time leader in career wins, and Chase Tapley, who was a four-year starter. More recently, Hutson led the charge in the Aztecs inking Malik Pope and Jeremy Hemsley. In a poll of Division I coaches conducted by ESPN's Jeff Goodman in the summer of 2013, Hutson was considered the eighth-best recruiting assistant nationally and the best on the West Coast. More recently, ESPN's Adam Finkelstein listed Hutson as a top up-and-coming recruiter (May 2014), while Miles Simon placed him on his west region ultimate coaching staff (May 2014).

Hutson is 25-6 all-time as a Division I head or assistant coach when coaching against one of his former teams.

Hutson also served as the head varsity coach at Bakersfield High where he led the Drillers to a CIF Central Section title and four appearances in the playoffs in four seasons. His 2004 team was ranked as high as No. 22 in the nation and fourth in California, while his 2003 squad finished the season with a 25-5 record and won the section title. As a collegiate player, Hutson enjoyed a storied career, winning two NCAA Division II championships at CSU Bakersfield. In the 1993 championship season, the Roadrunners were undefeated with a 33-0 record and followed that up with a 27-6 record during the 1994 season.

Hutson, who is married to San Diego State's head women's basketball coach Stacie Terry, earned his bachelor's degree in physical education in 1994 and a teaching credential in 1995 from CSU Bakersfield. He also received his master of arts in education from CSU Bakersfield in 2009.

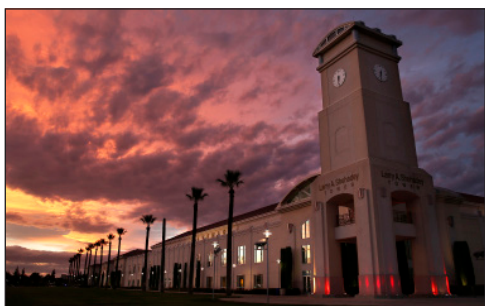

SAVE MART CENTER



Since 2003, the Save Mart Center has served as the home of the Fresno State men's and women's basketball programs. The arena is also the home venue for the Bulldogs' volleyball and wrestling programs and recognized around the nation as being one of the finest on-campus collegiate arenas. The Save Mart Center was named the No. 2 top collegiate venue by Pollstar in 2015, the leading trade publication for the concert and entertainment industry.

With its size, scope, unique architectural features and video, sound and telecom systems, the Save Mart Center serves as a major provider of entertainment and sporting events in the San Joaquin Valley. Seating capacity for the arena ranges from 15,000 to 18,000 seats, with 15,596 listed as the official number for basketball.

The Save Mart Center is a premier entertainment destination for headline events and tours. Designed by Sink Combs Dethlefs (Denver, Colo.), the Save Mart Center is approximately 450,000 square feet and contains 32 private suites, 1,000 Arena Builder seats (commonly referred to as "club seats"), a club level concourse, team locker rooms and athletics training facilities. The entire facility is approximately 48 acres and located off Shaw Avenue adjacent to Highway 168.

The total project value exceeded \$100 million and represented the largest privately funded project in the history of the California State University system. The Save Mart Center was financed through revenue from corporate sponsorships, private gifts, leasing of luxury suites, sale of Arena Builder and personal seat licenses, as well as revenue from advertising and signage agreements.

Next to the Save Mart Center is the West Complex, a \$17.6 million, two-story, 92,000-square-foot building which features the Student Recreation Center, the Lyles Center for Innovation and Entrepreneurship and the Leon and Pete Peters Educational Research Center.

The Save Mart Center has hosted four major collegiate sporting championships, which most recently came in March 2012 when Fresno State hosted an NCAA women's basketball championship regional for the second time. In March 2004, the facility served as the host site for the McCaffrey Western Athletic Conference Basketball Tournament. The following year, the Save Mart Center was the venue for the first and second rounds of the 2005 NCAA women's basketball championship. In 2007 and 2012, Fresno State was one of four schools that hosted the regional semifinals and championship games for the NCAA women's basketball tournament.

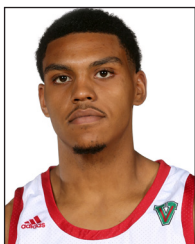
