NEWS AND NOTES

THAT'S HOW YOU START A SEASON

The Lobos opened their season with a pair of four-set wins over Nevada (32-34, 25-21, 25-23, 25-20) and (25-18, 25-15, 17-25, 25-23). In the final set on Saturday, the Lobos rallied with a 7-1 run to turn a 22-18 deficit into a 25-23 win to clinch the match.

UNM received contributions from several players making their first appearances in a Lobo uniform. Kali Wolf proved the moment wasn't too big, finishing with a match-high 18 kills on Friday and match-high 20 kills on Saturday including eight in the final set, and 15 digs and 14 digs, respectively, for two double-doubles in the series.

The freshman was one of three Lobos to finish with double-digit kills and one of three Lobos to finish with double-doubles. Kara Erfurth accounted for a matchhigh 53 of the team's 56 assists on the afternoon to go along with 10 digs. Uxue Guereca recorded her second double-double of the weekend with 11 kills and a team-high 18 digs and Reno native Kaitlynn Biassou tallied 16 kills in the match.

Erfurth tallied 53 assists in both matches, with Saturday's tally outnumbering Nevada's team total.

At the net, junior middle blocker Avital Jaloba posted a match-high five assisted blocks and at the service line, three Lobos- Alena Moldan, Erfurth and Guerecahad two aces.

AND THEY ARE ONLY FRESHMEN

Following their first two collegiate matches in a Lobo uniform, freshman Kali Wolf was named MW Offensive Player of the Week, while redshirtfreshman Uxue Guereca was named the MW Defensive Player of the Week.

It is the first time since 2017 that the Lobos have swept the weekly conference award, with the only other time being Oct. 30, 2017 with setter Sarah Lobo and libero Ashley Kelsey.

Wolf is also the first freshman to win the offensive weekly honor since Lobo won it in 2017. Guereca is the first UNM freshman to win defensive player of the week since the conference awarded both a defensive and offensive player in 2015.

The honors come after Wolf led the Lobos with 38 kills and 42 points on the weekend, an average of 4.75 kills per set and 5.25 points per set, which was also the best among all Mountain West players in both categories.

Wolf finished with two double-doubles in her first two collegiate matches, including a match-high 20 kills on Saturday and a match-high 18 kills on Friday as UNM won both matches in four sets at Nevada. Further, Wolf posted a match-high 22 points on Friday and team-high 20 points on Saturday. Wolfs 20 kills on Saturday were the most kills recorded by any player on the weekend and her 18 kills on Friday were tied for the third most among the conference. Further, her 22.0 points were tied for the most points recorded in a match in the conference.

The outside hitter was instrumental in the Lobos' rally in the fourth set on Saturday, accounting for eight kills in the final set to propel the Lobos to the win.

Wolf tallied two kills as the Lobos fought back from down 14-9 to 14-13. After UNM trailed 22-18, the freshman had four kills in UNM's 7-1 run to win the set 25-23, including the point to bring UNM within one at 22-21, the kill to tie the set at 23 and the point to win the set and the match. In addition to recording a double-double on Friday with 18 kills and 15 digs, the Minnesota native served up a team-high three aces and added an assist. Two of those aces came on three straight points in the second set that pushed the Lobo lead to 20-15 as part of a 4-0 run. In the third set, Wolf recorded the final point in a close 25-23 set, one of seven kills Wolf tallied in the third set, with three of those kills tying the set.

On the defensive end, Guereca led the Lobos with 32 digs, and added four assisted blocks. The redshirt-freshman had a team-high 18 digs with two assisted blocks on Saturday and 14 digs and two assisted blocks on Friday.

Kara Erfurth had 53 assists in both matches, averaging 13.25 per set, while also being one of three Lobos who finished with three aces. Erfurth had more assists in Saturday's match than Nevada's four players who recorded an assist combined (53-48).

TALK ABOUT STATS

UNM was among the best in the Mountain West in the opening weekend in several statistical categories.

The Lobos lead the conference in assists with 114 (14.25 a/s), kills with 120 (15.0 k/s) and digs with 140 (17.5 d/s) and are third in hitting percentage (.249).

Kali Wolf leads the MW in kills and kills per set and points (42) and points per set (5.25), with Kaitlynn Biassou tied for fifth in kills per set (3.75) and fourth in points per set (4.5) but third in overall points (36). Kara Erfurth leads the conference in assists (106) and assists per set (13.25) and Uxue Guereca is tied for fourth in digs per set with 4.0 but third in overall digs (32).

Among the NCAA, UNM is second in assists per set, eighth in kills per set and 26th in team attacks per set (39.12). Individually, Erfurth leads the NCAA in assists per set with Wolf 11th in the NCAA in attacks per set (12.88),14th in kills per set and 18th in points per set.

SECOND GO AROUND

Jon Newman-Gonchar and staff enter their second season at The University of New Mexico and are coming off of an 11-19 record and an eighth-place MW finish in year one.

Last season, the Lobos lost to the Cowgirls in their only meeting. After dropping the first set 25-17, the Lobos won the next two sets 25-21 and 28-26 before Wyoming forced a fifth set with a 25-20 win. In the fifth set, the Cowgirls narrowly edged out the Lobos 17-15 to win the match.

INTERNATIONALLY KNOWN

Volleyball is a worldwide sport and the 2020-21 Lobo roster certainly proves the boundless limits. The Lobo roster spans from down the road in Los Lunas, N.M. (Hayley Torres) to California to Nevada to Texas to Minnesota and beyond the United States. UNM has three international student-athletes on its roster in Avital Jaloba (Israel), Milica Djukic (Serbia) and Uxue Guereca (Mexico).

In total, there are five players from Texas, three from Calfornia, two from Minnesota, one from Nevada and New Mexico and the three above mentioned international players.

2021 OUTLOOK

SETTERS: UNM brought in reinforcements with the signing of freshman Kara Erfurth, who brings a wealth of experience at the high school and club level. At the time of her signing, Newman-Gonchar noted that Erfurth comes in ready from the start. At Rouse High School, Erfurth averaged 9.1 assists per set and finished her high school career with 2,548 assists. In her final year, she tallied 1,404 assists and averaged 10.3 assists per set and the year prior, registered 1,136 assists and 8.0 assists per set. In January 2021, the Lobos benefited from a second setter joining the team in Riley White.

With the graduation of Maddie Freiwald, UNM was left with just one setter on the roster in Jaclyn Inclan, who led the pair with 662 assists (5:-64 assists per set and 53% of the team's total assists). Freiwald provided a compliment with 421 assists (4.17 assists per set) and accounted for 23 aces on the service line. Inclan appeared in 230 sets and 59 matches, starting in 34 matches with 28 coming last season. Inclan recorded 20-plus assists in 18 matches, 30-plus in seven matches and a season-high 42 in the second match of the season against Grand Canyon. Paired with 274 digs, Inclan led the Lobos with 13 double-doubles. The Arizona native accounted for 1,182 assists (5.14 assists per set) and 424 digs.

Without Freiwald or Inclan on the roster, this will be the thinnest position for the Lobos this season with two on the roster and limited on the end of the collegiate experience scale.

MIDDLE BLOCKERS: The middle blocker position might be the strongest position on the floor for the Lobos with two of the four players at the position having extensive collegiate experience.

UNM bolstered the position group in the offseason with transfers Milica Djukic and Avital Jaloba, who each cross the six-foot threshold at 6-0 and 6-2, respectively, to add depth and experience. The Lobos signed 6-2 Emma Smith out of Woodlands, Texas and Elizabeth Woods joined mid-year from Rowlett, Texas for long-term stability at the position.

However, the Lobos took an unexpected hit with the transfers of Yasmin Tan and Rachel Murphy as Murphy emerged as the leader in the middle for the Lobos in 2019 with a team-high 120 total blocks (11 solo and 109 assisted) for an average of 1.19 blocks per set after starting in 27 matches and appearing in 101 sets. Against Kansas State, Murphy finished with three solo blocks and registered a career-high 10 total blocks at Boise State with nine assisted. Beyond her blocking presence, Murphy was fourth on the team in kills with 123 and in points at 190.5 points with a career-high 14 kills versus Wyoming.

Tan also eclipsed the 100-block mark with 108 total blocks, eight solo and 100 assisted, starting in 27 matches and playing in all 115 sets. Three times last season, the Australia native recorded a career-high eight block assists (at Nevada, at Utah State and against San José State).

Adding to the mix are two new Lobos who come with international and collegiate experience in Jaloba and Djukic. Jaloba spent the last two seasons at Arizona State, coming off of a sophomore season with the Sun Devils in which she finished with 54 blocks after playing in 72 sets in 25 matches. In four different matches, she tallied five total blocks. Internationally, Jaloba has competed for the Israeli women's national team since 2013. Additionally, Djukic spent the last two seasons at Colby Community College in Kansas, recording 118 total blocks (12 solo) as a freshman and 115 total blocks (19 solo) as a sophomore, averaging 1.22 blocks per set each season. Djukic added over 150 kills each year with 208 kills and 172 kills, respectively. For her Jayhawk West/Region VI Division I First Team in 2019 and All-Jayhawk West/Region VI Division I Second Team in 2018.

Rounding out the blockers are freshmen Smith, who at 6-1 will be among the tallest on the roster, and Woods, who as a result of the season postponement to spring, joined the team in lanuary and is eligible to play this season. In Smith's senior season at Oak Ridge High School, she collected 74 total blocks, 26 solo, and added 124 kills with a .247 hitting percentage. Standing at 6-2, Woods was a dual-sport athlete at Sachse HS, playing both basketball and volleyball.

OUTSIDE HITTERS: The outside hitter corp took the hardest hit of all the position groups with the graduation of Lauren Twitty and Tai Bierria, the top-two point getters in 2019 and regulars in the starting lineup, and the retirement of Danica Rowan. Twitty led with 421.5 points behind 352 kills and Bierria finished with 349.0 points on 302 kills and the duo posted the two-highest total attacks on the team. Rowan appeared in 27 matches and 83 sets, finishing with 97 kills in 2019. The 2019 team captain recorded a career-high 12 kills at Utah State and hit. 706 (12-0-17) for a career-high 13.5 points in the match.

However, Kaitlynn Biassou proved to be a key contributor in her rookie season with 293 kills, averaging 2.66 kills per set, and finished with 335.0 points, an average of 3.05 points per set. She is the lone returner who saw the court in 2019 at the outside hitter position.

The Lobos strengthened the group by signing four to the position with Kali Wolf, Hayley Torres, Abby Thigpen and Tori Tua, with Tua standing at 6-5 and Wolf at 6-2 and Tua the tallest on the team.

Wolf had a decorated career at Waconia High School in Minnesota, setting the all-time career leader in kills and digs with 1,440 kills and 1,346 digs. She was ranked the No. 1 player by Minnesota PrepVolleyball in 2018, was named all-conference the past three years, earned all-conference honorable mention in 2016 and 2015 and was named to the Star Tribune All-Metro Third Team in 2018 and Star Tribune All-Metro Second Team in 2019. Additionally, Wolf was named all-state first team in 2019 as well as AVCA High School All-Region for Region 7 in 2019.

Torres enters as a junior after playing the last two seasons at MiraCosta College in California. In her two years with the team, the Las Lunas native earned CCCAA All-Conference First Team both years and finished with 572 kills and 665.0 points. Her sophomore season, Torres accounted for 347 kills (3.65 k/s) and 402.0 points (4.2 points per set) but also added 283 digs (2.98 d/s) and 32 service aces.

Torres and Wolf have already been acclimated to the Lobo program after enrolling in the Spring 2020 semester.

The newest Lobo to the group is Thigpen, who stands just below six-feet but has been tauted by head coach Jon Newman-Gonchar as an "explosive attacker with a great arm".

In addition, also making a debut will be Uxue Guereca who used a medical redshirt in 2019 and comes in highly regarded after playing for the Mexican National Team since she was 15.

LIBEROS: Youth will be prevalent with the three liberos on the roster in Chloe Clark, Alena Moldan and Jazlynn Soriano.

Working in UNM's favor however is sophomore Moldan, who enters the season having started every match and played in every set in 2019. Moldan led the Lobos with 422 digs (3.67 d/s), reaching double figures in the category in 22 matches and posted 20-plus digs in five matches. In addition, the Minnesota native was third in assists (98) and from the service line was fourth on the team in aces with 22. Clark saw the court in 50 sets throughout 17 matches and tallied 13 digs, two service aces and one assist in her freshman season.

Joining the cadre will be Soriano, who completed her high school career with 446 digs including 371 as a junior and played 147 sets.

NEWCOMERS: "We accomplished the mission we set out on over a year ago," said Newman-Gonchar. "To recruit the very best people we could to represent our great city of Albuquerque, to give this great state of our a program to be proud of, and most importantly to represent our Lobos with the utmost pride and with the highest level of integrity. Each of the athletes we bring in are hungry to leave their mark on our program.

"We feel it is not only an incredibly talented class, it also provides us an enormous amount of depth and our Lobo fans are going to love watching this group of powerful, strong, and passionate women play."


