TIPPING OFF

The season continues for The University of New Mexico Lobos after earning an automatic bid to the WNIT. UNM drew the Fort Worth region, and will face the undefeated California Baptist in the first round. In the Lobos' portion of the bracket are San Francisco (15-10) out of the West Coast Conference and Houston (16-7) out of the American, with Arizona State, Rice, Fresno State and Missouri as the other teams in the region.

Statistically, UNM is one of the top teams in the field, entering as the 10th-best scoring offense, averaging 81.0 points per game, third in made threes per game (10.3) and eighth in assist/turnover ratio. Additionally, the Lobos are 21st in scoring margin (13.6), 18th in assists per game (16.7) and 28th in field-goal percentage (.450).

The Lobos have four players averaging double figures in scoring, led by LaTascya Duff with 14.6, followed closely behind by Jaedyn De La Cerda (14.3). Ahlise Hurst (12.6) and Antonia Anderson (12.5) round out the double-digit scorers.

CBU is very similar statistically to the Lobos on offense with four scorers averaging

double figures, led by 13.5 by Caitlyn Harper. Britney Thomas (13.1), Ane Olaeta (11.7) and Nicole Avila-Ambrosi (10.9) are the other three.

The Lancers are a strong all-around team, averaging 21.0 assists per game and are similar to the Lobos in their field-goal and three-point percentages at 43.8 percent and 33.5 percent, respectively. They make 9.6 threes per game and average 77.7 ppg. Defensively, Cal Baptist is averaging 43.4 rebounds per game, 9.5 steals per game and 5.5 blocks per game.

Out of the WAC, CBU won both the regular season and conference tournament but were ineligible for the NCAA automatic bid as the Lancers are in year three of the four-year transitioning to DI.

UNM and CBU share one common opponent this year in San Diego State, with the Lancers winning 75-71 in their third game of the season. The Lobos defeated the Aztecs 84-48 and 65-48 in their two-game series.

This will be the first meeting between the two programs.

We'll Keep On Fighting 'Til the End

The resiliency of the Lobos this season has not been a secret. After 80-plus days of living and playing on the road, the Lobos hosted Colorado State in two must-have games against the top team in the conference standings entering the series, their only two home games this year.

UNM won the first game after leading from start to finish, but the second game was a fight to the finish after Colorado State opened the fourth on a 14-4 run to tie the game at 58-all with 5:37 left in the game. UNM relied on its grit and as the Lobos have done all season their ability to handle adversity, closing on a 13-4 run in the final stretch for the 71-62 victory to sweep the Rams and win the Mountain West regular season championship. It was the first for the program under head coach Mike Bradbury, the first outright MW championship and the first in 16 years when UNM split the title with then-MW school Utah.

In the MW quarterfinal, Air Force cut the lead down to two five separate times in the third quarter, but the Lobos pushed back to build back their lead to 10 after finishing the quarter on an 8-0 run that made it 49-39. In the semifinal, after Fresno State went back up by four at 50-46 with 2:29 left in the third quarter, the Lobos scored the next seven points on a LaTascya Duff three, a Duff fast-break layup off an Ahlise Hurst steal and a Hurst layup off of a LaTora Duff rebound. UNM outscored Fresno State 15-8 in the third to take the lead into the final 10 minutes, with nine off of turnovers and eight coming on fast-break opportunities.

The Lobos have won five of their last six games, playing the final four games of the regular season in the span of a week (Sunday, Monday, Thursday, Friday) and final six games in 11 days (Feb. 23 to March 5). Counting through the conference tournament, UNM played a total of eight games in 15 days.

Award Season is Good to the Lobos

Days after winning the Mountain West regular season championship, The University of New Mexico women's basketball team had five players earn a spot on the 2020-21 All-Mountain West Women's Basketball Team.

As voted on by the conference coaches, LaTascya Duff earned the superlative of Sixth Person of the Year as well as a spot on the all-conference team. Joining the junior guard on the all-conference team were seniors Jaedyn De La Cerda and Antonia Anderson, while junior forward Shaiquel McGruder made the all-defensive team.

Junior Ahlise Hurst was named to the honorable mention list.

Going 11-3 in conference, the Lobos were led in scoring by Duff, who averaged 13.9 points with a team-high 194 points scored. The Samson, Ala., native made a team-high 38 three-pointers and led the Mountain West in three-point field goal percentage at 41.3 percent in conference games. Duff averaged 2.71 threes per game and had four conference games in which she finished with six made threes.

In addition, Duff shot 42.5 percent from the floor and scored in double figures in nine conference games, including four 20-plus games with a season-high 31 points coming at Air Force on Feb. 23.

Further, Duff averaged 2.0 assists per game, 3.3 rebounds per game and had a 2.2 assist/turnover ratio and was twice named the Mountain West Player of the Week this season.

Duff is just the second Lobo to win the sixth person award.

Anderson earns her first all-conference honor after a senior season in which she averaged 12.6 points per game and a team-high 6.6 rebounds per game in conference play. The Cibola, Texas native led the MW in field-goal percentage at 49.0 percent and was eighth in blocks per game with 1.07. Anderson was ranked in the top 15 in scoring, rebounding, field-goal percentage, blocked shots and defensive rebounds.

The senior finished with double figures in scoring in nine conference games including a career-high 29 points in the win over UNLV and posted two

double-doubles with a 10 point, 11 rebound performance against Colorado State and a 14 point, 10 rebound effort at Air Force. Further, Anderson was credited with four assists in four different conference games.

De La Cerda also earns her first all-conference honor following a 13.2 point per game and 5.0 rebounds per game conference season. The New Mexico native finished with double figures in points in 11 games including three 20-plus point games with a season-high 28 points at UNLV.

McGruder averaged 5.6 rebounds per game, 1.5 steals per game and 1.1 blocks per game to earn her first all-defensive team distinction and her first conference postseason honor. The junior posted at least one block in 12 conference games including four blocks at UNLV and recorded at least one steal in 12 conference games with four versus Fresno State. Further, McGruder has finished with a block in the last eight conference games.

In the last game of the regular season against Colorado State, McGruder grabbed a season-high 15 rebounds and twice has finished with nine rebounds.

Earning honorable mention, Hurst had an all-around junior season, averaging 13.6 points per game, 2.6 rebounds per game, 2.8 assists per game and 1.4 steals per game against conference opponents.

Hurst was a threat from distance, making an average of 2.5 threes per game, which ranked second among all conference players, and shot 31.9 percent from range to rank second in the conference, finishing behind Duff in both categories.

The junior made at least one three in all but one game, highlighted by five three-pointers in the season finale against Colorado State. Hurst finished with double figures in scoring in 10 of the 12 conference games she played in.

Hurst also ranked in the top 15 in steals per game, points per game and assists per game.

Balanced Attack

Four Lobos are averaging double figures in points per game.

Following a combined 51-point performance from LaTascya Duff against Air Force and a combined 53-points at Utah State, Duff now leads the Lobos in points per game at 14.6 with Jaedyn De La Cerda second at 14.3 ppg after scoring 23 points in the semifinal against Fresno State. Ahlise Hurst is averaging 12.6 points per game after averaging 17.0 ppg versus CSU, and Antonia Anderson is averaging 12.5 points per game.

This season, the Lobos have had six players finish in double figures in scoring in two games (Arkansas-Pine Bluff and Sam Houston State), had five players in double digits in five games (Midwestern State, Nevada Dec. 31, Fresno State Jan. 28, Utah State Feb. 28 and Colorado State March 4) and four in seven games (Nevada Jan. 2, San Diego State Feb. 3 and 5, Air Force on Feb. 23, Utah State on March 1, Air Force on March 8 and Fresno State on March 9.)

On any given night, a different Lobo can step up to lead the team, as shown by Anderson's career-high 29 points at UNLV, LaTascya Duff's 31 points at Air Force, 28 points at Arkansas-Pine Bluff and Utah State, or her 25 points in the second Utah State game, or Hurst (20) and De La Cerda (21) posting team highs in the two games at Nevada and 23 points in the MW semifinal.

LaTascya Duff has led the Lobos in scoring in a team-high seven games this season, while tying for the team high in another. Hurst has led the team, or tied for the team high in five games.

Showing Range

On the season, the Lobos are averaging 10.3 made three-pointers per game, which is the third best in the NCAA and leads the MW, and have attempted 577 three-point attempts with 195 makes (.338).

Twelve times this season, the Lobos have made 10-plus three-pointers in a game with a season high of 17. UNM is 10-2 when making 10 or more threes in

a game.

LaTascya Duff leads the Lobos with 50 made threes, shooting 42.4 from three-point range, and has made six three-pointers in four games this season.

In the Utah State series, UNM set a season high in three-point field goal percentage, making 14-of-29 for 48.3 percent, and made the second-most threes in a game this season with 15 in Sunday's game.

In the Feb. 3 game at SDSU, the Lobos found their stride in the final two quarters, going 5-for-7 in the third quarter and 6-for-8 in the fourth quarter, with LaTascya Duff finishing 6-for-9 with five-straight made threes.

UNM hit 17 three-pointers at UAPB, one shy of tying the program record, with nine coming in the first two quarters. Seven different Lobos made a three-pointer, led by LaTascya Duff going 4-of-5 from behind the arc.

On Dec. 31, UNM hit 14 threes at Nevada with four Lobos hitting three, three-pointers (Hurst, both Duff sisters and De La Cerda).

The Lobos caught fire early on from behind the arc at Midwestern State to open the season, hitting eight three-pointers in the first two quarters. De La Cerda and Hurst accounted for three each, with Hurst going 3-for-4 from distance. While the Lobos cooled off in the second half, UNM finished with 13 three-pointers with five different players hitting at least one.

Double Trouble

The season has demonstrated that LaTora and LaTascya Duff are trouble for opponents to account for.

To date, they have combined for 433 points, with LaTascya leading the team with 277 points, and filled the stat sheet with a combined 112 assists, 126 rebounds and 41 steals.

LaTascya leads the team in points per game (14.6), three-pointers made (50) and free-throws made (51), with LaTora leading in assists (74) and is third in steals (25).

LaTascya entered the season being named the Mountain West Preseason Newcomer of the Year, and leads the MW in three-point field goals made per game (2.7), three-point field goal percentage (.413), is ninth in scoring.

LaTora is eighth in the MW in assists per game (3.5) and fourth in assist/turnover ratio (1.8).

LaTascya was named MW Player of the Week for the second time this season after Duff scored 20-plus points in each of the four games including a season-high 31 points, averaging 26.0 points per game, shooting 61.8 percent from three-point range and 55.7 percent from the floor. Duff made 21 threes between the four games, including three games of making six three-pointers. Duff has made six three-pointers in three of last four games and in four of last six games.

Throughout the four games, Duff had an all-around solid performance, leading the Lobos in scoring with 104 points and in steals (nine) and was tied for second in rebounds (16) and third in assists (12). Duff averaged 2.3 steals per game, 4.0 rebounds per game and 3.0 assists per game.

Duff's 104 points fell just short of the school record for most points in four consecutive games (106 achieved by Abby Garchek in 1997) and was just shy of the most points in three consecutive games with 79 points (record is 83 points by Cherise Beynon in 2018).

On Dec. 21, LaTascya was named the MW Player of the Week for her performance at Arkansas-Pine Bluff, finishing with 28 points on 10-for-11 shooting from the floor and 4-for-5 from three-point range.

Among the Best

The Lobos have scored 90-plus points in five games this season, including in both games at Utah State, as well as a program-best 120 points at Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Dec. 17, and 80-plus points in 10 games. The Lobos have scored

1539 points, an average of 81.0 points per game, which leads the MW and is 10th in the NCAA.

UNM is third in the NCAA in three-point field goals per game (10.6), eighth in assist/turnover ratio at 1.36, 18th in assists per game (16.7), 21st in scoring margin (13.6), 28th in field-goal percentage (.450), 32nd in three-point field goals made (195) and 34th in three-point field goals attempted (577) and 36th in turnover margin (3.89).

In MW games, UNM led the conference in scoring margin (+11.21), assists per game (16.1), turnover margin (+3.71), assist/turnover ratio (1.38), and three-point field goals made (10.1). UNM is second in scoring (77.8), field goal percentage (.450), third in steals per game (8.1) and fourth in three-point field goal percentage (.335), free-throw percentage (.721) and fourth in blocked shots per game (3.64).

Individually, LaTascya Duff is 22nd in the NCAA in three-point field-goal percentage (.424) and 37th in three-pointers made per game (2.6), with Antonia Anderson 74th in the NCAA in field goal percentage (.492), leading the conference in all categories. Jaedyn De La Cerda leads the conference in free-throw percentage at 87.7 percent, ranking 18th in the NCAA.

Fast Starts

The Lobos are outscoring their opponents in the every quarter, with the largest margin occurring in the second quarter (396-314, 82). UNM is outscoring its opponents 754-598 (margin of 156 points) in the first two quarters.

Against Air Force in the quarterfinal, the Lobos held the Falcons to eight points in the first 10 minutes, getting out to a 23-8 lead through the first quarter.

In the first game of the CSU series, UNM got out to an 18-9 lead in the first quarter, and UNM outscored Utah State 19-7 in the first quarter and 34-12 in the second quarter in the first game of the series to take a 53-19 lead into the break.

In the first game of the UNLV series, the Lobos led 21-9, and in the second game led 21-13 through the first quarter.

In the first game of the Nevada series, the Lobos shot 60.0 percent from the floor (50.0% from three) to get out to a 28-8 first quarter lead, which turned into a 52-25 halftime score.

In the game at UAPB, UNM got out to a 17-0 lead en route to a 32-8 first quarter lead and a 63-27 halftime score.

In the first game at Midwestern State, the Lobos took a 25-6 lead into the second quarter that grew to a 49-25 halftime lead.

Except For That Third Quarter

While the Lobos have had fast starts, games like the series at SDSU provided the exception to the norm. The Lobos trailed the Aztecs at the end of the first and second quarters in both games, but the second half was all UNM, especially those third quarters.

UNM outscored SDSU 36-10 in the third quarter of Wednesday's game, going 14-of-17 (82.4%) from the floor and 5-for-7 (71.4%) from behind the arc. Ahlise Hurst single-handedly outscored SDSU in the quarter 13-10. In Friday's game, the Lobos outscored the Aztecs 22-9, shooting 7-of-11 (63.6%).

In the first game at Air Force, the Lobos outscored the Falcons 28-13 to turn an eight-point deficit into a 62-55 lead, and continued to hold the Falcons to under 15 points in the fourth quarter with 11 points.

In the March 1 game at Utah State, UNM outscored USU 29-8 in the third quarter.

In the semifinal against Fresno State, the Lobos outscored the Bulldogs 15-8 in the third to turn a halftime deficit into a 53-50 lead at the end of the third.

UNM has scored 405 points in the third quarter, the highest point production

per quarter, and is 15-1 this season when leading after the third quarter. UNM is outscoring its opponents 405-324 (margin of 81) in the third.

Pride of Roswell

The only New Mexican on the roster, Jaedyn De La Cerda is representing the Land of Enchantment well.

In her senior season, De La Cerda is second on the team in points (272) and third in rebounds (97) and is averaging 14.3 ppg and 5.1 rpg.

In the last game, De La Cerda scored a game-high 23 points, 12 of which came in the fourth quarter, accounting for 12 of UNM's 19 points in the quarter on 4-of-5 shooting and 2-for-3 effort from behind the arc. The senior finished with five three-pointers in the game, and 8-of-13 overall.

Further, down the stretch in UNM's win over Fresno State, De La Cerda made a layup and four free-throws to tie, and later give UNM a two-point lead.

In the third quarter of the second game at UNLV on Jan. 17, De La Cerda was a force, going 5-for-5 from the floor with 4-for-4 from three, for 14 points.

In leading the Lobos at Nevada on Dec. 31, she nearly recorded a double-double with a game-high 21 points and a team-high nine rebounds while also dishing out five assists.

In the game at UAPB, De La Cerda was a stat stuffer, finishing with a career-high 11 rebounds, 13 points, a game-high six assists and game-high three steals.

In the fourth quarter of the game against Sam Houston State, De La Cerda stepped up to lead the Lobos to victory, tallying 13 of the team's 34 points and going a perfect 7-for-7 at the free-throw line. The senior also grabbed three offensive rebounds which led to six second-chance points.

Steal the Show

In eight games this season, the Lobos have recorded 10-plus steals, with the Lobos 7-1 in those instances.

Led by four steals from LaTora Duff, the Lobos registered a to date season-high 13 steals in the season opener against Midwestern State. UNM turned those steals into nine fast-break points and finished the game with 27 points off of turnovers.

Senior Showcase

Jaedyn De La Cerda and Antonia Anderson have made an impact in the scoring and rebounding columns this season, with De La Cerda finishing in double figures in scoring in eight of the last nine games and Anderson in seven of the last nine games. Anderson recorded her first double-double of the season in the win over Air Force and another one in the first game against Colorado State (10 points, 11 rebounds), and in the last Utah State game, De La Cerda finished with 22 points with Anderson at 19 points.

De La Cerda (272 points, 14.3) and Anderson (237 points, 12.5) are second and third, respectively, in points and points per game on the team and first (Anderson, 6.4) and third (De La Cerda, 5.1) in rebounds per game on the team.

Limit the Opponent

In the opening quarters in seven of UNM's games, the Lobos have held their opponent below 10 points.

In the last game against Air Force, UNM held the Falcons to just eight points on 3-of-11 shooting and 0-for-4 from three.

In the first game against CSU, the Lobos held the Rams to nine points with just three made baskets and 0-for-6 from three.

Against Utah State on Sunday, the Lobos held the Aggies to seven points in the first quarter, holding USU to 0-for-7 from three and 2-of-16 (12.5%) from the floor.

At UNLV on Jan. 15, the Lobos held the Lady Rebels to nine points in the opening quarter on 22.2% shooting from the floor and just one made three.

In UNM's first game at Nevada, the Lobos held the Wolf Pack to eight points on 3-of-13 shooting (23.1%) and two free throws.

In the first quarter against Midwestern State, the Lobos held the Mustangs to just six points, all coming from the free-throw line. The Mustangs went 0-for-7 from the floor and 0-for-2 from behind the arc. In addition, UNM didn't allow any offensive rebounds by Midwestern State in the first quarter, limiting the possession and any opportunities for MSU to get second-chance points.

UNM scored the first 17 points in the game at Arkansas-Pine Bluff to finish the first quarter ahead 32-8. UAPB went 4-for-17 from the floor and 0-for-3 from three.

In the third quarter of the last game at SDSU, UNM held SDSU to just nine points in the quarter and held the Aztecs to 10 in the third quarter of the first game.

Know Your Opponent

Out of the WAC and located in Riverside, Calif., California Baptist is 24-0 on the season and 14-0 in conference play, averaging 77.7 points per game while allowing 59.3 points per game. The average scoring margin is 18.4.

CBU went 10-0 on the road and 2-0 in neutral games this season.

The Lancers are led in scoring, rebounds and blocks by Caitlyn Harper, with the redshirt-sophomore forward scoring 13.5 points per game, 183 rebounds and 31 blocks. Ane Olaeta leads in steals (53, 2.3 per game) and assists (175, 7.6 per game).

CBU has four players averaging double figures, with Harper, Britney Thomas (13.1), Olaeta (11.7) and Nicole Avila-Ambrosi (10.9). Thomas leads in field-goal percentage (.643) with Sydney Palma leading in three-point percentage (.462) and made threes (36).

As a team, the Lancers have made 230 three-pointers on 687 attempts (33.5 percent).

Of note from CBU's website, California Baptist is the first program to go undefeated in the regular season and win a conference tournament since UConn did it in 2018. Only Baylor, Notre Dame, UConn and now CBU have accomplished this since 1998.

NOTEWORTHY :

Mike Bradbury enters his fifth season as head coach for The University of New Mexico women's basketball team. In his previous four seasons at the helm, Bradbury has guided the Lobos to a 79-50 overall record. Twice in his tenure, in 2017-18 and 2018-19, the Lobos eclipsed the 20-win mark and totaled 49 victories over that time. The consecutive 20-plus win seasons under Bradbury are the first for the program since the 2007-08 – 2008-09 seasons.

In his third year at the helm, Bradbury continued to put his mark on the program while also continuing to bring Lobo women's basketball back to national prominence. Overall, Bradbury's 2018-19 team went 24-7 and earned a bid to the WNIT for a second-straight season. It marked the first time since the 2008-09 – 2009-10 seasons that the program made consecutive trips to the postseason.

After dropping a one-possession game to Auburn in the preseason WNIT, the 2018-19 Lobos ripped off 11-straight wins to tie the program record and were on the cusp of cracking the national top-25 rankings as well by receiving votes from the WBCA during that stretch.

Bradbury would also receive an individual plaudit from the WBCA last season as he was named as one of 13 finalists for the 2019 United States Marine Corps/WBCA National Coach of the Year Award. Impressively, Bradbury was the only coach from a non-Power 5 conference to be a finalist.

In his time at UNM, Bradbury has coached eight All-Mountain West performers with Cherise Beynon, Jayla Everett, Jaisa Nunn, Aisia Robertson and Richelle van der Keijl making the All-Mountain West Team. Tesha Buck, Mykiel Burleson and Nike McClure have also earned MW recognition with Buck being the 2017-18 Newcomer of the Year, Burleson being named to the All-Freshman team in 2016-17 and

McClure landing on the All-Defensive team in 2018-19.

In terms of major individual awards, Bradbury has coached the league's Newcomer of the Year each season in charge of the Lobos with van der Keijl earning the award in 2016-17, Buck in 2017-18 and Robertson in 2018-19. Additionally, Bradbury has coached the MW Player of the Year in Nunn (2018-19) and the Freshman of the Year in Everett (2018-19).

In year two under Bradbury the Lobos had a breakout season, especially offensively as they ended the 2017-18 season averaging 80.4 points per game while also posting an impressive +9.7 scoring margin. Both marks led the Mountain West and the point-per-game total was 16th-best in NCAA DI last season.

A significant reason for the jump in offensive production was the fact that the Lobos were one of the most potent three-point shooting threats in the country. For the season, the Lobos attempted the eighth-most overall trifectas in DI hoisting 932 long distance shots. Successful 34% of the time, the Lobos made the 11th most 3's burying 319.



Prior to coming to Albuquerque, Bradbury built a successful nine year run as a Division-I head coach with stops at Morehead State (Morehead, Ky.) and Wright State (Dayton, Ohio). Most recently with the Raiders, Bradbury led his squad to five 20-win seasons, including each of his final three seasons. During that time, Wright State has amassed a 75-28 record, the best amongst the 13 Division I programs in the state of Ohio.

Overall at Wright State, Bradbury had five winning seasons, all of which were 20-plus win seasons, in six years - a feat made all the more remarkable as Wright State had just one winning season in the previous 22 before his arrival. In the previous 37 seasons of women's basketball at Wright State, the Raider program had tallied 20 wins just

once before Bradbury led the team to 20 wins in five of his six seasons.

His most prominent three-year run at Wright State started in 2013-14, when the Raiders won a school-record 26 games on the way to a 26-9 season and the program's first-ever appearance in the NCAA Tournament. That season saw the Raiders finish second in the Horizon League and win its first Horizon League Tournament. It also featured the program's first road win at perennial league power Wisconsin-Green Bay. Kim Demmings was named the Horizon League Player of the Year and Tournament MVP, and it marked the first time in school history the program had a pair of first team All-Conference selections.

He followed up that by earning Horizon League Coach of the Year in 2014-15 after a 25-9 season that saw his squad lose its Horizon League Preseason Player of the Year less than two minutes into the season opener. The Raiders just missed a second straight NCAA Tournament appearance, falling in overtime in the conference championship game. The team did make its first appearance in the Women's NIT as the league's automatic qualifier, and in 2015-16, the team made it back-to-back WNIT appearances after a 24-11 season, earning the program's first at-large bid.

Those three seasons are the three winningest seasons in the history of Wright State women's basketball.

In his first two seasons at Wright State, he led the team to a 20-13 campaign and a 21-13 mark and berths in the Women's Basketball Invitational, the first NCAA Division I postseason berths for the program. Overall, Bradbury has coached three Horizon League Players of the Year (all in his last three seasons), six first-team All-Horizon League players, three second-team members and four All-Freshman team members.

Prior to his time at Wright State, Bradbury was the head coach at Morehead State where he led the Division I program to a 50-44 mark in three seasons, including a watershed 22-11 season, which was the second-most wins in Morehead State history and the most wins by the Eagles in the previous 38 years.

At Morehead State he coached one Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Year, along with one first-team All-OVC pick (two seasons) and three second-team All-OVC picks.

Bradbury also spent time as an assistant coach at Xavier (2002-06), Cincinnati (1996-02), VCU (1995-96), East Tennessee State (1994-95) and Chattanooga (1991-94). In his 28 seasons as an assistant and as a head coach, Bradbury has had 26 winning seasons.
