About the Cowgirls

Wyoming enters the week with a 2-5-0 overall and in MW action. The Cowgirls recorded a dominate 3-0 win over the Colorado State Rams on Saturday afternoon. Three Cowgirls, Indianna Asimus, Jamie Tatum and Savannah Warner, each recorded goals in the match. Asimus had the game winner in the 46th minute of the match.

Asimus and Warner lead the way with two goals and four points. Sophomore Jamie Tatum has a team-best nine shots followed by freshman Nikayla Copenhaver with five. Five Cowgirl team members each have a team-best one assist.

Junior goalie Hannah Lee has played in all seven matches in net, has 25 saves and a 1.25 goals against average. Sophomore Alex Daws has also played in seven matches and has 24 saves. Warner leads the way in minutes played with 639 followed by senior Elle Webber with 590 minutes on the season.

Scouting the Lobos

New Mexico enters the contest with a Mountain Division leading record of 7-1-0. Last time out, they defeated Air Force, 2-0 in Colorado Springs. Jaelyn Hendren was the lone goal scorer in the contest.

The Lobos are led by Gwen Maly and Alesia Garcia who have six goals apiece while pacing the way with 21 and 22 shots, respectively. Paris McKenzie has a team-best three assists. Emily Johnson has started in seven of eight matches in goal and has a 0.29 goals against average. As a team, they have recorded 20 goals 15 assists and 129 shots.

This will be the 33rd meeting between the two squads. New Mexico leads the series 18-9-5. The last time the two met was March 7, 2021 with the Lobos earning a 1-0 win in Laramie.

Scouting the Aggies

Utah State comes in to the contest with a 3-4-1 mark and currently sits in third in the Mountain Division. They will host the Colorado State Rams on Friday prior to facing the Cowgirls. Last time out, the Aggies defeated Air Force, 2-0.

Four Aggies have recorded two goals each on the year led by Kami Warner who also has two assists and six points. Marlie Niederhauser also has two goals and 13 shots. Ashley Cordozo has a team-best three assists and 21 shots. Diera Walton has played in all eight matches in net and has 42 saves plus a 1.09 goals against average.

This is the 17th meeting between the two teams. The series is tied at 7-7-2. The last time the two teams met was March 5, 2021 with the Cowgirls coming out on top with a 1-0 victory in Laramie.

Last Time Out: – In their only match of the week, the Wyoming soccer team (2-5-0, 2-5-0 MW) recorded a decisive 3-0 win over the Colorado State Rams (2-2-1, 2-2-1 MW) on Saturday afternoon.

It was a back and forth half to begin the match. Colorado State tried to strike early with a Gracie Armstrong shot that missed high. In the 12th minute, the Rams had another scoring opportunity after a Cowgirl foul which resulted in a penalty kick. Armstrong would give CSU a prime chance to score but the shot was blocked by goalie Hannah Lee. Shortly after, Liv Layton missed left of the goal as it remained 0-0. Wyoming had its first chance in the 23rd minute from sophomore Jamie Tatum. Each team had a look at the back of the net for the remaining 20 minutes of the half which wouldn't result in a score with the halftime score going 0-0. The Rams had five shots compared to two by the Cowgirls while CSU had three shots on goal compared to one by Wyoming.

In the second half, Wyoming came out quickly with an early strike. In the 46th minute, junior Indianna Asimus netted her second goal of the season with a low left shot which went past goalie Amelia Hammerle to put the Cowgirls up 1-0. Shortly after, the Rams had a good look at the goal with a chance by Layton that was saved by sophomore Alex Daws. The Cowgirls capitalized with an assist by Nikayla Copenhaver who reached the foot of sophomore Jamie Tatum that skirted past Hammerle to make it a 2-0 contest. It was the first goal of the season for Tatum. Colorado State responded with two quick shots by Armstrong which were saved by Daws. Wyoming continued to be aggressive and push the pace in the half. In the 57th minute following a free kick, junior Savannah Warner received a pass by Tatum that reached the back of the net giving the Cowgirls a 3-0 advantage. Despite being outshot the remainder of the half, the Cowgirls earned a hard fought 3-0 win over the Rams.

Tatum finished with a match-high three shots with two on goal. Three other Cowgirls recorded one shot each. Warner played 85 minutes from her defensive position followed by Elle Webber with 80 minutes. Lee recorded three saves in her 45 minutes of action while Daws scooped up a career-high seven saves. Wyoming recorded six shots and two corner kicks.

Soccer Coaches Pick Wyoming Seventh in MWC Poll: The University of Wyoming women's soccer team was picked to finish seventh with 57 points in the preseason Mountain West Coaches' Poll as voted on by the league's 12 head coaches, the conference announced on Thursday.

Boise State and San Diego State each earned 106 total points to tie for first in the poll. The Broncos received seven first place votes and the Aztecs garnered three. The two teams tied for the regular season title and met in the championship game with Boise State coming out on top. New Mexico, who got a first place vote, was picked third in the voting with 97 points. Fresno State finished fourth with 78 points followed by San Jose State with 74 points. Colorado State was selected sixth with 73 points and had one first-place nod. The Cowgirls were seventh with 57 points while Colorado College came in eighth with 53. UNLV, Utah State and Air Force were ninth, tenth and 11th, while Nevada was 12th.

Cuadrado with the win: Head coach Pete Cuadrado reached a milestone in his career during the 2018 campaign. With a 4-0 victory over Nevada (10/19/18), he became the all-time winningest coach in school history. His record at UW currently stands at 75-63-24 (.524) while his conference record is 42-38-10 (.522). He overtook former head coach Anne Moore who completed her coaching career at Wyoming with 63 wins.

Home Crowds at the Louis S. Madrid: Due to COVID and social distancing practices, the capacity of the facility is being limited to 300 fans.

The Number Seven: With their 1-0 win over Colorado State (10/26/18), the Cowgirls reached seven league wins for the season. It is the second most wins in conference play in the programs history. The record is eight wins which was set in 2014.

Home Cooking: Wyoming got it done at home in 2018. For the season, the Cowgirls finished undefeated with a 6-0-3 overall mark and 4-0-1 in conference action. The team has also only given up three goals at the Louis S. Madrid Sports Complex. It's the first time since the 2014 season that the team went undefeated.

2021 Cowgirl Soccer Notes/Bracket/All-Conference

Redshirt Freshman Jamie Tatum Named to the All-Newcomer Team: For the first time in her career, redshirt freshman Jamie Tatum was selected to the All-Newcomer Team as the All-Conference soccer selections were announced by the league office on Monday. It's the fourth year in a row that the Cowgirls have had an individual on the team.

Tatum, a 5-5, forward from Highlands Ranch, Colo., started in all 11 conference matches and 19 games overall during her first season on the pitch. She logged 953 minutes in MW action and 1,550 for the entire season. She finished league play with four goals, which was second on the team, plus a team high 29 shots with 16 on goal. Against UNLV, she finished with a career-high two goals including the game-winner. Overall, Tatum finished with a team-high six goals, 13 points and 54 shots.

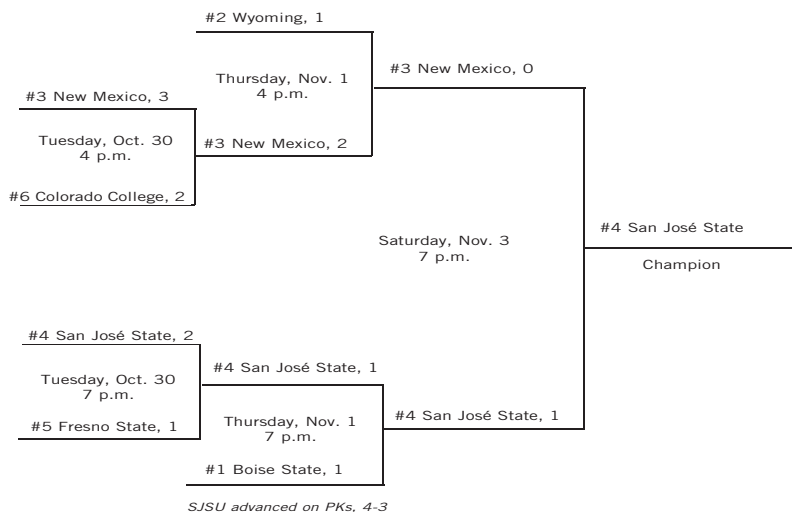

Pete Cuadrado

(TCU, '00)
University of Wyoming, Head Women's Soccer Coach

Pete Cuadrado enters his ninth season at the helm of the Wyoming Cowgirl soccer program. He was hired on January 17, 2012 and became the fourth head coach in school history.

While in Laramie, he has compiled a 73-62-24 overall record and 40-33-10 Mountain West mark. 15 Cowgirls garnered postseason honors including six First Team All-MW, one Second Team All-MW, two Honorable Mention All-MW honorees, four MW All-Newcomer selections, two Third All-Pacific Region and three Capitol One Academic All-District VII First Team selections.

During the 2019 season, UW posted an overall mark of 7-7-5 and a 4-5-2 record in the Mountain West. Redshirt freshman Jamie Tatum was selected to the All-Newcomer Team. Tatum finished with 54 shots, six goals and two game winning goals in her first season of play. Outgoing senior Michaela Stark finished her career with 13 goals, which is tied for tenth all-time, and fifth in game-winning goals with five. As a team, the Cowgirls recorded 29 goals, five ties and played in eight overtime games.

It was another record setting and many firsts in the programs history during the 2018 campaign. The team finished the season with a 12-4-4 overall record and 7-2-2 in the league to finish in a three way tie for first. With the victory over Colorado State, the Cowgirls earned a share of the

2018 Mountain West Title. It's the first time in school history that UW soccer has been a part of a league title. The 12 wins tied the most in program history and the seven league wins was second most in school history. It was the fourth time in Cuadrado's tenure that the program won 10-plus contests. The team went undefeated with a 6-0-3 record at the Louis S. Madrid, which was the first time since 2014. With eight shutouts on the year, equaled the mark from the 2015 and 2016 seasons, while 32 goals was second all-time. Taylor Burton garnered Mountain West Defensive Player of the Year and First Team All-MW honors. Annika Clayton was named Second Team while Savannah Warner earned All-Newcomer honors. With a 4-0 victory against Nevada, Cuadrado became the all-time winningest head coach in school history.

During the 2017 campaign, UW posted an overall mark of 8-9-1 and a 4-6-1 record in the Mountain West. Redshirt junior Brittney Stark was selected to the All-Newcomer Team. The Cowgirls made history in 2016, posting their third-straight season with at least 10 wins for the first time in program history. Wyoming finished the season 10-8-2 and earned its fourth-consecutive Mountain West playoff berth, one of only two schools in the conference to do so.

Cuadrado led the Cowgirls to a 10-6-4 overall record in 2015 and 6-4-1 record in the league. In 2014, he posted an 11-9-1 overall record. During the 2014 season, Cuadrado received MW Coach of the Year accolades by leading the Cowgirls to an 8-3 mark in league play and a second-place finish. He also coached Wyoming to a perfect 6-0-0 record at the Louis S. Madrid Sports Complex for the first undefeated home record in program history. He helped lead UW to 37 goals, the most in UW single-season history. Cuadrado led the Cowgirls to its second MW championship game after an overtime victory over New Mexico in the semifinals to tie UW's best season finish since 2011. Along with his Coach of the Year honor, the Cowgirls boasted Freshman Player of the Year, Offensive Player of the Year, a First Team All-MW and a Second Team All-MW selections. Other postseason individual honors were awarded such as Capital One Academic All-District VII First Team, a TopDrawerSoccer.com Top 100 Freshman, NSCAA Scholar All-West Region and All-Pacific Region Second Team honoree.

Among his accomplishments during his second year at UW were leading the program to 31 goals, the most at the time in UW regular season history. Cuadrado led Wyoming to a 2-1 victory over San Diego State, which was SDSU's first Mountain West regular-season loss since 2011. The Cowgirls also advanced to the quarterfinals of the Mountain West tournament for the second time in program history and earned Wyoming's first postseason win since 2011 after defeating UNLV 4-2 in penalty kicks during the first round.

During his first season in 2012, the Cowgirls scored 30 goals on the year and notched six goals in a match against Montana State-Billings, third-most in UW single match history in 2012. He also coached three first team All-MW selections in his first two seasons with Wyoming. Off the field the Cowgirls continued to make tremendous progress academically. The 2013 season saw 13 Cowgirls earn Academic All-Mountain West, as 12 were named during Cuadrado's first season in 2012.

Cuadrado joined the Cowgirl program after spending nine seasons as the head coach at North Dakota State University where he compiled a 93-62-18 record. During the 2011 season at NDSU, Cuadrado led the Bison to a school-record win total of 15. On their way to a 15-4-2 record, the Bison recorded 11 shutouts and posted a 7-1-1 mark in Summit League play. The Bison advanced to their third-straight Summit League tournament, advancing to the title game before falling to Oakland. He had two players earn postseason honors with one First Team All-Summit league and Defensive Player of the Year. He also coached the first player in NDSU history to a CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team honor.

The 2010 season was a historic season for NDSU and Cuadrado, earning the program's first Summit League tournament title and advancing to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in program history. After winning their Summit League semifinal game in penalty kicks, the Bison downed Western Illinois, 3-1, in the league title game. The victory earned NDSU a berth in the NCAA tournament against No. 9 Texas A&M. The Bison tied the Aggies, 1-1, before falling in penalty kicks. Cuadrado had two players selected to the All-Summit League First Team. NDSU finished the season 12-5-6 and 6-2-1 in the Summit League.

Cuadrado led his 2009 Bison team to a 10-8-2 record and a 7-2 record in conference play. The 7-2 conference mark gave the Bison their first-ever league title, sharing the title with IUPUI and South Dakota State. The Bison's first league title also earned them their first-ever Summit League Tournament bid. They finished the season leading the conference in goals, assists and points. Two Bison players also earned NDSU's first Summit League First Team All-Conference honors since joining the league in 2007.

During the 2008 season, his Bison struggled with injuries and went 5-8-1, but he became the winningest coach in NDSU history. In 2007, the Bison ended the season 11-7-1, finishing their first season in the Summit League with a 3-4-1 record.

Playing their final season in the United Soccer Conference in 2006, Cuadrado and the Bison posted a 13-7-1 record and finished runner-up in the USC Tournament. In their second season as an NCAA Division I school in 2005, the Bison won 11 games (11-5-3) with 10 shutout victories. For his role leading the Bison to an 11-win season, he earned Division I Independent Coach of the Year honors.

His first season at NDSU, Cuadrado guided the Bison to an 11-3-2 record which was a .750 winning percentage and the second highest in the history of Bison soccer.

Cuadrado was named head coach of the NDSU program in March 2003, after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at Illinois State University in Normal, Ill. Prior to ISU, he spent the 2000 soccer season as an assistant at Valparaiso University, in Valparaiso, Ind., while earning his master's in athletic administration. He completed his master's in May 2002. Throughout his time coaching he has been active in the Olympic Development Program (ODP). Cuadrado also has his USSF National "B" Coaching License, National Goalkeeping License and National Youth License.

Cuadrado played college soccer at Northeastern Illinois University for two seasons before transferring to TCU. He was a member of the Horned Frogs soccer program and earned his bachelor's degree in marketing in 2000.

2021 Cowgirl Soccer Assistant Coaches

Bob Casper

Associate Head Soccer Coach, Wis. Platteville, '03

Bob Casper completes his eighth season on the Cowgirl soccer coaching staff and third as associate head coach after joining in June of 2013. He came to UW from Ottawa University (Ottawa, Kan.), where he served for six years as the men's soccer head coach.

His primary duties include on field team training, recruiting and various administrative responsibilities for the program. In his six seasons at OU, Casper coached 30 All-KCAC selections, 12 KCAC Scholar Athletes, one KCAC Goalkeeper of the Year, one KCAC Freshman of the Year, one Region IV selection and three Daktronics NAIA Scholar Athletes.

In 2012, the Braves finished in the top half of the KCAC, finishing with an overall record of 12-6-1 and a conference record of 7-2-0. OU had six players named to the All-KCAC teams with Drinnan Sante earning the program's first KCAC Goalkeeper of the Year honor. The Braves finished the season ranked 30th in the NAIA in total shutouts (6), 33rd in total saves (115), 40th in shutouts per game (0.3), and 46th in saves per game (5.7). At Ottawa, he compiled a 50-56-7 overall record and 26-16-3 record in the Kansas Collegiate Athletic Conference.

Prior to Ottawa, Casper spent one year at Barton County Community College where he coached the women's team to a fifth-place finish in the Jayhawk Conference.

Before coaching at BCCC he was an assistant at Bemidji State, a NCAA Division II program in Minnesota. The year before Casper's arrival at Bemidji State, the team had a 5-13-1 overall record, but in his first season he helped BSU to a 10-10 record and fourth-place finish in the conference tournament. In his second season at BSU, the team finished 12-4-7 overall and placed second in the NSIC.

Casper earned a bachelor of science in social sciences with an emphasis in history from the University of Wisconsin-Platteville in 2003 and a master's degree in sports studies from Bemidji State in 2012. Casper was a four-year soccer letterwinner at UW-P and was involved in the Pioneer Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (PSAAC).

He has an NSCAA Regional Diploma/NSCAA State Goalkeeping Diploma (Level I), an NSCAA Advance National Diploma, NSCAA Premier Diploma and a USSF "D" License.

His wife, Kerry, coached softball at BSU from 2005-06, Ottawa from 2007-08 and Maple Woods Community College from 2010-11. Most recently, she served as an enrollment advisor at Ottawa from 2011-13.

Jessica Nei

Assistant Soccer Coach, North Dakota State, '08

Jessica Nei enters her first season in 2021 for the Wyoming soccer staff. She joins the program after five seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for the women's soccer program in 2019. The Rockets did not play in the fall and are expected to begin play in the MAC in February.

Nei a major part of the success of the program culminated, with Toledo claiming the Mid-American Conference title and making a league-best fifth appearance in the NCAA tournament in 2017. Focusing primarily with the goalkeepers and defenders, Nei's defensive group registered 21 shutouts since she joined the program.

In 2017, Nei mentored redshirt freshman goalkeeper Madison Perrin to MAC All-Freshman honors in her first year of action. Perrin was a key component to Toledo's championship run, playing every minute of the season while amassing 107 saves and five clean sheets. Perrin allowed just 33 goals and ended the year with a 1.37 GAA and .764 save percentage.

Additionally, senior defenders Chiara Paradiso and Regan Price were named to the all-tournament team following the Rockets' league-best fifth conference championship title. Paradiso was selected second-team All-MAC as well. Nei also previously mentored goalkeeper Sam Tionson, who earned MAC Defensive Player of the Week honors on Sept. 21, 2015 after blanking Northern Kentucky, 2-0.

Nei joined Toledo after serving as an assistant coach at Arkansas State from 2011-14. She helped the Red Wolves to their first winning season in school history in 2012.

While at ASU, Nei helped the Red Wolves achieve some of the best goalkeeping in the Sun Belt Conference. Arkansas State netminders ranked third in the league with 112 saves in 2013, and had a 1.38 goals against average in 2012, the second-lowest average in school history.

Individually, Nei helped mold Aja Aguirre into one of the most successful goalkeepers in Arkansas State history. Aguirre set the record for the lowest GAA (1.19) in 2012. In 2013, Nei coached Amanda Lee to the third-most saves in school history with 92, and the third-lowest goals against average at 1.34. Her 8.07 saves per match average is tied for the most in school history.

Before joining the Red Wolves, Nei spent three years at St. Cloud State University. During her three seasons with St. Cloud, she helped the Huskies to a 28-21-8 record, including two 10-win seasons and the first winning record in school history.

Along with her college coaching experience, Nei has held coaching positions with the Pacesetter Soccer Club, Tonka United Soccer Association, Becker Youth Soccer Club, Red River Soccer Club (now Tri-City Storm SC), and Central Minnesota Youth Soccer Association. Additionally, she has worked with the Olympic Development Programs in Minnesota, Arkansas, and Ohio South. Nei also holds a USSF "C" license and NSCAA Advanced National Diploma.

As a player, Nei was a goalkeeper for North Dakota State University (2003-07) and helped the Bison amass a 46-22-5 overall record. Nei earned a bachelor's degree with a double major in physical education and health education from NDSU in 2008, and received her master's in recreation and leisure administration from Toledo in 2016.
