### TIPPING OFF

Following two exhibition games to get their feet wet, the Lobos open the 2021-22 season at home against the Lamar Cardinals, the first of three home games to start the season.

New Mexico had a good showing in its first outing of the season, an exhibition win over Western Colorado, and finished the exhibition portion of its schedule against Eastern New Mexico, achieving its purpose of competing against another team in preparation for when the games count on the records.

Entering the 2021-22 season, UNM brings back its leading scorers in Jaedyn De La Cerda, LaTascya Duff, Anderson and Shaiquel McGruder and their top rebounders in Anderson, McGruder and De La Cerda. In addition, the Lobos return their leader in assists in LaTora Duff and McGruder, who led in blocks and steals.

Last year, the Lobos led the MW conference in scoring margin (11.2), assist/turnover ratio (1.38), assists per game (16.07)

and turnover margin (3.71), and finished second in offense at 77.8 points per game in conference games. Further, the Lobos were first in three-point field-goals made at 10.1 per game and second in field-goal percentage (.450).

Nationally, the Lobos finished with the fourth-most three-point field goals per game (10.2), sixth-best assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.40 as well as the ninth-best scoring offense in the NCAA, 14th in turnovers per game (12.0), 22nd in scoring margin (12.7) and 31st in turnover margin (4.25).

On the other side of the court, Lamar is coming off its lone exhibition, a win against Jarvis Christian College in which six of eight players finished in double figures. The Cardinals outscored Jarvis Christian 17-8 and 29-5 in the first two quarters, respectively, eventually winning 95-47.

### Learn As You Grow

While the Lobos return stability in four starters from a year ago, the makeup of the roster is extreme, comprised of five seniors, two sophomores and six freshmen who will be getting a quick introduction to the college game.

All six freshmen played significant minutes in the two exhibitions against Western Colorado and Eastern New Mexico with contributions from all six to build upon.

Freshman Paula Reus got the starting nod in both exhibitions, while the other five contributed off of the bench.

Vianè Cumber finished with a perfect 4-for-4 outing from three-point range for 12 points against Western Colorado and added 11 points against Eastern New Mexico, while Aniyah Augmon provided energy off the bench, grabbing eight rebounds and scoring eight points against the Greyhounds. Zeyno Seren increased her scoring from game one to game two, going 2-for-3 from the floor and hit her only three-point attempt of the game for five points, while grabbing a rebound and creating a steal. Mackenzie Curtis led all scoring in the fourth quarter against the Mountaineers with seven points on 3-for-4 shooting, and Rebeka Renczes went 1-for-2 from three and hit both her free throws against Western Colorado while recording a steal and a block.

### Start Fast and Keep on Pushing

New Mexico made its first five shots of the first game of the season against Western Colorado, including three, three-pointers, cruising to a 94-53 final score at The Pit.

After getting out to a 13-2 lead in almost two minutes of play, the Lobos continued to control the first quarter, holding the Mountaineers below 10 points while scoring 29 points. The Lobos went 4-for-7 from three and shot 58.8 percent from the floor, while holding Western Colorado to just 21.4 percent shooting from the floor and 0-for-9 from beyond the arc.

It was more of the same in the second quarter, with UNM hitting six of nine attempts from three and WCU going 0-for-3 from distance, and the Lobos hitting at a 71.4 percent rate from the floor to WCU's 33.3 percent from the floor, ultimately leading 57-22 at the half.

UNM shot 64.5% from the floor through the first two quarters and went 10-for-16 (62.5%) from three, including 6-for-9 (66.7%) from three and 10-for-14 (71.4%) from the floor in the second quarter.

### Balanced Attack

Much like their M.O. last season, the Lobos had balanced scoring in their first two appearances of the season with four double-digit scorers in both games, three of which made the list in both games.

Four Lobos finished in double figures against WCU with LaTora Duff and Shaiquel McGruder tallying 16 points, Jaedyn De La Cerda 13, and a perfect 4-for-4 outing from three-point range for freshman Vianè Cumber for 12 points. McGruder was one rebound shy of a double-double, while also accounting for two of UNM's five blocks in the game.

In the second exhibition against ENMU, De La Cerda led all scorers with 21 points, followed by 15 from fellow senior Antonia Anderson, 14 from LaTora Duff, and Cumber again reached double figures in scoring, hitting three, three-pointers and a layup for 11 points.

### Managing Expectations

After winning the Mountain West regular season in 2020-21 for the first time since 2004-05, the Lobos were picked to finish second in the preseason MW poll with 251 points and seven first-place votes.

It is the second time in head coach Mike Bradbury's tenure that the Lobos have been picked to finish second, with the last time occurring in 2019-20 when the Lobos earned three first-place votes and 280 points.

New Mexico finished above UNLV with the Rebels at 232 points and three first-place votes, and fourth-place Colorado State with the Rams earning 207 points and one first-place vote.

State and Colorado State with one each, San Diego State with two, UNLV at three, UNM with seven and Fresno State the preseason favorite with 13 first-place votes and 269 points.

In addition, senior Antonia Anderson was selected to the MW preseason all-conference team, one of five players to earn the distinction. For Anderson, the Cibola, Texas native is coming off of a campaign in which she averaged 12.1 points per game, 6.2 rebounds per game, 1.9 assists per game, 1.0 steals per game and 1.0 blocks per game and scored 10-plus points in 13 games with a career-high 29 points in the victory over UNLV on Jan. 17. Anderson led the team in rebounds and rebounds per game, was second in made field goals and blocked shots and third in total points.

In MW contests, she averaged 12.6 points per game and a team-high 6.6 rebounds per game, as well as led the conference in field-goal percentage with 49 percent. Further, Anderson was eighth in blocks per game at 1.07 and ranked in the top 15 in scoring, rebounding, field-goal percentage, blocked shots and defensive rebounds, resulting in her first all-conference honor in being named to the Mountain West all-conference team.

### Pride of New Mexico

The Lobos have two New Mexico natives on the 2021-22 roster with freshman Vianè Cumber and senior Jaedyn De La Cerda. In addition to being from New Mexico, the duo has something else in common: New Mexico Gatorade Player of the Year distinctions.

Cumber was named the 2019-20 and 2021-21 New Mexico Gatorade Girls Basketball Player of the Year after averaging 26.5 points, 9.3 rebounds, 2.2 assists and 1.5 steals her senior season and 22.4 points, 10.6 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 3.3 steals as a junior at Sandia High School in Albuquerque. Out of Roswell, N.M. and Roswell High School, De La Cerda earned the 2016-17 New Mexico Gatorade Player of the Year.

### Know Your Opponent

Lamar had six players score in double figures in its exhibition game against Jarvis Christian College in a 95-47 win.

Akasha Davis (19 points, 12 rebounds) and Anyssia Gibbs (12 points, 11 rebounds) recorded double-doubles, with Sabria Dean finishing with 19 points and a team-high eight assists. Malay McQueen scored 15 points, Angel Hastings recorded 11 points and four steals, to go along with 11 points from Michaela Wilson.

Last season, the Cardinals went 10-14, 9-6 in the Southland Conference, and were led by returners Wilson (12.0 ppg) and Bebe Galloway (6.8 rebounds per game). Wilson was second on the team in rebounds with 6.5 per game and Galloway and Wilson were the top-two blockers at 14 and 13 blocks, respectively. Lamar did lose its assist and steals leader in Jady Pimentel.

Lamar averaged 61.8 points per game in the 2020-21 season while allowing 67.5 points per game.

In its first year in the WAC, Lamar was picked to finish seventh in the media poll and eighth in the coaches' poll, while Wilson was named to the first team on both Western Athletic Conference Coaches' and Media Preseason All-WAC teams.

UNM and Lamar have four common opponents this season in Texas Tech, Prairie View A&M, Stephen F. Austin and New Mexico State.

### MIKE BRADBURY

**RECORD AT UNM: 94-55 (6TH SEASON)**

**CAREER RECORD: 272-172 (15TH SEASON)**

#### NOTEWORTHY :

- Named the sixth head coach in program history on March 31, 2016
- Led UNM to 25 wins in 2017-18; tied for second-most wins in program history
- Spent six years at Wright State (2010-16) and went 128-73 for the Raiders
- Most single-season wins in Wright State history (26)
- Five 20-win seasons at Wright State with five postseason appearances

Mike Bradbury enters his sixth season as head coach for The University of New Mexico women's basketball team. In his previous five seasons at the helm, Bradbury has guided the Lobos to a 94-55 (.631) overall record. Twice in his tenure, in 2017-18 and 2018-19, the Lobos eclipsed the 20-win mark and totaled 49 victories over that time. The consecutive 20-plus win seasons under Bradbury are the first for the program since the 2007-08 – 2008-09 seasons.

In his most recent season at the helm of the Lobos, Bradbury led the Lobos to a Mountain West regular season championship, the first outright in program history and the first regular season title since the 2004-05 season. In addition, the Lobos were selected for the WNIT for the third time in four years.

The Lobos produced one of the most prolific offenses not only in the conference, but in the country, finishing among the top 25 in several categories. Among them, UNM finished fourth in the NCAA in made three-pointers per game (10.2), sixth in assist-turnover ratio (1.40), ninth in scoring offense (81.2 points per game), 14th in fewest turnovers per game (12.0) and assists per game (16.8) and 22nd in scoring margin (12.7). The Lobos led the Mountain West in scoring offense, scoring margin, assists per game, turnover margin, assist-turnover ratio and made three-pointers as well as second in field-goal percentage and steals per game.

UNM set a program record in scoring with 120 points against Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Dec. 17, 2020 and in the process, made 17 three-pointers, falling just one short of tying the program record. Further, the Lobos registered 90-plus points in five games and 80-plus points in 11 of the 20 games on the season.

Four Lobos finished the 2020-21 season averaging double figures in points per game with six players finishing in double figures in scoring in two games (the only times it has been accomplished in program history), five players in five games and four in seven games.

As a result of UNM's successful season, five players were named to the All-Mountain West Team with LaTascya Duff also earning the superlative of Sixth Person of the Year. Duff was just the second Lobo to win the sixth person award. Making the all-conference team for the first time were Duff, Jaedyn De La Cerda and Antonia Anderson, as well as Shaiquel McGruder earning all-defensive and Ahlise Hurst earning the honorable mention distinction.

In his third year at the helm, Bradbury continued to put his mark on the program while also continuing to bring Lobo women's basketball back to national prominence. Overall, Bradbury's 2018-19 team went 24-7 and earned a bid to the WNIT for a second-straight season. It marked the first time since the 2008-09 – 2009-10 seasons that the program made consecutive trips to the postseason.

After dropping a one-possession game to Auburn in the preseason WNIT, the 2018-19 Lobos ripped off 11-straight wins to tie the program record and were on the cusp of cracking the national top-25 rankings as well by receiving votes from the WBCA during that stretch. Bradbury would also receive an individual plaudit from the WBCA last season as he was named as one of 13 finalists for the 2019 United States Marine Corps/WBCA National Coach of the Year Award. Impressively, Bradbury was the only coach from a non-Power 5 conference to be a finalist.

In his time at UNM, Bradbury has coached 13 All-Mountain West performers with Cherise Beynon, Jayla Everett, Jaisa Nunn, Aisia Robertson and Richelle van der Keijl joining De La Cerda, Duff, McGruder, Hurst and Anderson in making the All-Mountain West Team. Tesha Buck, Mykiel Burleson and Nike McClure have also earned MW recognition with Buck being the 2017-18 Newcomer of the Year, Burleson being named to the All-Freshman team in 2016-17 and McClure landing on the All-Defensive team in 2018-19.

In terms of major individual awards, Bradbury has coached the league's Newcomer of the Year each of his first three seasons in charge of the Lobos with van der Keijl earning the award in 2016-17, Buck in 2017-18 and Robertson in 2018-19. Additionally, Bradbury has coached the MW Player of the Year in Nunn (2018-19) and the Freshman of the Year in Everett (2018-19) as well as Sixth Person of the Year in Duff (2020-21).

Further, a Lobo has been named Mountain West Player of the Week 11 times during his tenure.

In year two under Bradbury the Lobos had a breakout season, especially offensively as they ended the 2017-18 season averaging 80.4 points per game while also posting an impressive +9.7 scoring margin. Both marks led the Mountain West and the point-per-game total was 16th-best in NCAA DI last season.

A significant reason for the jump in offensive production was the fact that the Lobos were one of the most potent three-point shooting threats in the country. For the season, the Lobos attempted the eighth-most overall trifectas in DI hoisting 932 long distance shots. Successful 34% of the time, the Lobos made the 11th most 3's burying 319.

Prior to coming to Albuquerque, Bradbury built a

successful nine year run as a Division-I head coach with stops at Morehead State (Morehead, Ky.) and Wright State (Dayton, Ohio). Most recently with the Raiders, Bradbury led his squad to five 20-win seasons, including each of his final three seasons. During that time, Wright State has amassed a 75-28 record, the best amongst the 13 Division I programs in the state of Ohio.

Overall at Wright State, Bradbury had five winning seasons, all of which were 20-plus win seasons, in six years- a feat made all the more remarkable as Wright State had just one winning season in the previous 22 before his arrival. In the previous 37 seasons of women's basketball at Wright State, the Raider program had tallied 20 wins just once before Bradbury led the team to 20 wins in five of his six seasons.

His most prominent three-year run at Wright State started in 2013-14, when the Raiders won a school-record 26 games on the way to a 26-9 season and the program's first-ever appearance in the NCAA Tournament. That season saw the Raiders finish second in the Horizon League and win its first Horizon League Tournament. It also featured the program's first road win at perennial league power Wisconsin-Green Bay. Kim Demmings was named the Horizon League Player of the Year and Tournament MVP, and it marked the first time in school history the program had a pair of first team All-Conference selections.

He followed up that by earning Horizon League Coach of the Year in 2014-15 after a 25-9 season that saw his squad lose its Horizon League Preseason Player of the Year less than two minutes into the season opener. The Raiders just missed a second straight NCAA Tournament appearance, falling in overtime in the conference championship game. The team did make its first appearance in the Women's NIT as the league's automatic qualifier, and in 2015-16, the team made

it back-to-back WNIT appearances after a 24-11 season, earning the program's first at-large bid.

Those three seasons are the three winningest seasons in the history of Wright State women's basketball.

In his first two seasons at Wright State, he led the team to a 20-13 campaign and a 21-13 mark and berths in the Women's Basketball Invitational, the first NCAA Division I postseason berths for the program. Overall, Bradbury has coached three Horizon League Players of the Year (all in his last three seasons), six first-team All-Horizon League players, three second-team members and four All-Freshman team members.

Prior to his time at Wright State, Bradbury was the head coach at Morehead State where he led the Division I program to a 50-44 mark in three seasons, including a watershed 22-11 season, which was the second-most wins in Morehead State history and the most wins by the Eagles in the previous 38 years. At Morehead State he coached one Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Year, along with one first-team All-OVC pick (two seasons) and three second-team All-OVC picks.

Bradbury also spent time as an assistant coach at Xavier (2002-06), Cincinnati (1996-02), VCU (1995-96), East Tennessee State (1994-95) and Chattanooga (1991-94). In his 29 seasons as an assistant and as a head coach, Bradbury has had 27 winning seasons.

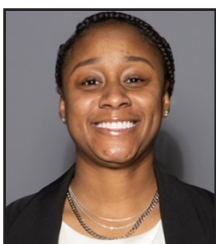
