- New Mexico begins its 2021-22 season by hosting FAU
- Tonight marks the first regular season men's game in The Pit since Feb. 29, 2020 (621 days ago)
- The game is the official Lobo debut of head coach Richard Pitino and nine newcomers on the Lobo roster

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

- First all-time meeting between UNM and FAU
- The Owls are the first of two first-time opponents on the Lobos' 2021-22 schedule (Norfolk State)
- Richard Pitino is 2-1 against FAU, going 1-1 when the head coach of FIU in 2012-13, and defeating the Owls in 2017-18 at Minnesota

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- The Lobos ended the preseason with a 101-72 exhibition victory over New Mexico Highlands on Friday night at The Pit
- UNM opened the game on a 13-0 run and used a 16-0 run late in the first half to build a 58-33 halftime advantage
- Five Lobos scored in double figures, led by Javontè Johnson and KJ Jenkins each scoring 18 points, in addition to Jay Allen-Tovar (17 points), Jaelen House (12 points) and Jamal Mashburn, Jr. (11 points)
- Johnson posted a double-double, grabbing a team-high 11 rebounds to go with his 18 points

#### **UNM RUNS ON DUNKIN'**

- In the exhibition game vs. New Mexico Highlands, the Lobos had nine dunks
- The dunk parade was led by Jay Allen-Tovar's four, along with Emmanual Kuac (3), Jamal Mashburn, Jr. (1) and Birima Seck (1) joining the fun
- Last season, the Lobos had just 29 dunks total over a 22-game season

#### YOU CAN GO HOME AGAIN

- Tonight's season opener is UNM's first regular season game in The Pit since Feb. 29, 2020, a span of 621 days
- It is the longest gap between home games for New Mexico since a 727 day gap from February 5, 1920 to Feb. 1, 1922 when the Lobos didn't field a team during the 1921 season
- The Lobos did not play a single game in the state of New Mexico during the 2020-21 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, playing 11 road games and 11 neutral site games
- New Mexico will play 18 regular season games this season at The Pit

#### YOU ARE NEW HERE... WE CAN SHOW YOU AROUND

- With New Mexico playing the entire 2020-21 season away from home, the team enters this season with only three Lobos having played a game in The Pit: Jordan Arroyo, Emmaunel Kuac and Clay Patterson
- Those three players combined for only 138 career minutes on Bob King Court (68-Arroyo, 46-Kuac, 24-Patterson), scoring a combined 32 points in the building (13-Arroyo,11-Kuac, 8-Patterson) before this season

#### **TALENTED TRANSFERS**

- New Mexico added four transfers from power conference schools (ACC, Big East, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12, SEC) during the offseason, tied for most in the nation
- The Lobos added transfers from Arizona State (Jaelen House), Kansas (Gethro Muscadin), Minnesota (Jamal Mashburn, Jr.), and TCU (Taryn Todd)
- Grand Canyon, Iowa State, TCU and Texas A&M also added four transfers from power conferences this offseason

#### **ALLOW MYSELF TO INTRODUCE ... MYSELF**

- The 2021-22 New Mexico roster includes nine new players
- The newcomers include four Division I transfers, two junior college transfers, two freshmen and one new walk-on
- The roster includes seven players who were on last year's roster

#### POTENTIALLY HISTORIC OPENING NIGHT LINEUP

In the exhibition finale against New Mexico Highlands on Friday night, the Lobos started five newcomers in Jamal Mashburn, Jr., Jaelen House, Jay Allen-Tovar, Taryn Todd and Birima Seck
If New Mexico starts five newcomers tonight, it would mark the first time in school history that

UNM's starting lineup in the season opener would be comprised of five players who were not on the roster the year before

#### **SOMEONE NEW WILL STEP UP**

- With only seven returning players (five scholarship) this season, the Lobos will need to have new players step up to replace lost production
- Overall, New Mexico returns 42.4 percent of its scoring, 43.2 percent of its rebounds, 57.0 percent of its assists and 47.5 percent of its' minutes

• Currently, with Saquan Singleton and Valdir Manuel out, the five remaining returning Lobos accounted for 19.1 percent of scoring, 19.7 percent of rebounds, 24.5 percent of assists and 25.7 percent of minutes last season

#### **SINGLETON SIDELINED**

- Senior guard Saquan Singleton, the Lobos' top returning scorer/rebounder/assist leader is out indefinitely after a heart abnormality was discovered in late October upon returning from an illness
- Singleton was one of two Lobos to start every game last season, averaging 8.0 points and 4.5 rebounds per game, while leading the team with 75 assists

#### **AGAINST CONFERENCE USA**

- FAU is the first of three Conference USA teams on the Lobos' schedule this season (vs. UAB in the Las Vegas Invitational, home vs. UTEP)
- This season marks the second straight year UNM has opened the season against a Conference USA opponent (won last year's opener at Rice)
- This year is the first season since 2011-12 that the Lobos will play three different non-conference opponents from the same conference in the regular season (UNM played three Pac-12 opponents in 2011-12)

#### **THREE CAPTAINS FOR 2021-22**

- Three Lobos were voted tri-captains for the 2021-22 season: Saquan Singleton, Jamal Mashburn, Jr., and KJ Jenkins
- Singleton is the Lobos' top-returning scorer and rebounder, while Mashburn and Jenkins are in their first season at UNM after transferring from Minnesota and Kilgore College, respectively

#### **A NEW ERA**

- The Richard Pitino era of Lobo basketball begins this season
- Pitino, the 22nd coach in program history, is in his 10th season as a head coach, having spent the last eight years at Minnesota and previously one at FIU

#### **PITINO IN YEAR ONE**

- Richard Pitino is looking to continue a trend of successful first seasons at a school
- In his first season at FIŪ in 2012-13, the Panthers had a 10-win improvement from the previous year and their first winning season in 12 years
- In his first season at Minnesota in 2013-14, the Golden Gophers won the NIT and posted their first 25-win season in 17 years
