#### LOBOS HOST NEW MEXICO HIGHLANDS IN PRESEASON FINALE

- New Mexico concludes its preseason schedule by hosting Division II New Mexico Highlands
- The game is the lone public exhibition for the Lobos this season
- The Lobos are playing their first opponent in The Pit since Feb. 29, 2020 (616 days ago)
- The Cowboys are playing their first game since Mar. 3, 2020 after having their 2020-21 season cancelled due to the pandemic

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

- In regular season games, UNM leads the series 25-4 (8-0 in The Pit)
- New Mexico has won all three previous exhibitions
- The Lobos have won the last 18 meetings (preseason & regular season) since a NMHU victory in Albuquerque in 1929
- In the last preseason meeting, in 2012-13, the Lobos won 92-70 as Alex Kirk had 16 points to lead UNM

#### PRESEASON HISTORY

- New Mexico is 62-6 all-time in preseason exhibitions (all at The Pit)
- Since 2004-05, when the NCAA prohibited exhibitions against non-collegiate teams, the Lobos are 25-1 in exhibitions, with the lone loss coming to BYU in 2017-18 in a fundraiser for Hurricane Harvey relief
- In the 25 exhibition wins against non-Division I colleges, the Lobos' average margin of victory has been 30.8 points with the closest margin being 11 points (80-69 vs. Rogers State in 2015-16)
- New Mexico did not play any preseason exhibitions last season
- The Lobos' last preseason exhibition was a 92-71 win over Eastern New Mexico in 2019-20

#### **YOU CAN GO HOME AGAIN**

- When the Lobos host Florida Atlantic in the season opener on Nov. 10, it will be UNM's first regular season game in The Pit since Feb. 29, 2020, a span of 621 days
- It is be the longest gap between home games for New Mexico since a 727 day gap from February 5, 1920 to Feb. 1, 1922 when the Lobos didn't field a team during the 1921 season
- The Lobos did not play a single game in the state of New Mexico during the 2020-21 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, playing 11 road games and 11 neutral site games
- New Mexico will play 18 regular season games this season at The Pit

#### YOU ARE NEW HERE. WE CAN SHOW YOU AROUND...

- With New Mexico playing the entire 2020-21 season away from home, the team enters this season with only three Lobos having played a game in The Pit: Jordan Arroyo, Emmaunel Kuac and Clay Patterson
- Those three players combined for only 138 career minutes on Bob King Court (68-Arroyo, 46-Kuac, 24-Patterson), scoring a combined 32 points in the building (13-Arroyo,11-Kuac, 8-Patterson) before this season

#### **TALENTED TRANSFERS**

- New Mexico added four transfers from power conference schools (ACC, Big East, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12, SEC) during the offseason, tied for most in the nation
- The Lobos added transfers from Arizona State (Jaelen House), Kansas (Gethro Muscadin), Minnesota (Jamal Mashburn, Jr.), and TCU (Tarvn Todd)
- Grand Canyon, Iowa State, TCU and Texas A&M also added four transfers from power conferences this offseason

#### **ALLOW MYSELF TO INTRODUCE ... MYSELF**

- The 2021-22 New Mexico roster includes nine new players
- The newcomers include four Division I transfers, two junior college transfers, two freshmen and one new walk-on
- The roster includes seven players who were on last year's roster

#### SOMEONE NEW WILL STEP UP

- With only seven returning players (five scholarship) this season, the Lobos will need to have new players step up to replace lost production
- Overall, New Mexico returns 42.4 percent of its scoring, 43.2 percent of its rebounds, 57.0 percent of its assists and 47.5 percent of its' minutes
- Currently, with Saquan Singleton and Valdir Manuel out, the five remaining returning Lobos accounted for 19.1 percent of scoring, 19.7 percent of rebounds, 24.5 percent of assists and 25.7 percent of minutes last season

#### **SINGLETON SIDELINED**

- Senior guard Saquan Singleton, the Lobos' top returning scorer/rebounder/assist leader is out indefinitely after a heart abnormality was discovered in late October upon returning from an illness
- Singleton was one of two Lobos to start every game last season, averaging 8.0 points and 4.5 rebounds per game, while leading the team with 75 assists

#### **THREE CAPTAINS FOR 2021-22**

- Three Lobos were voted tri-captains for the 2021-22 season: Saquan Singleton, Jamal Mashburn, Jr., and KJ Jenkins
- Singleton is the Lobos' top-returning scorer and rebounder, while Mashburn and Jenkins are in their first season at UNM after transferring from Minnesota and Kilgore College, respectively

#### **A NEW ERA**

- The Richard Pitino era of Lobo basketball begins this season
- Pitino, the 22nd coach in program history, is in his 10th season as a head coach, having spent the last eight years at Minnesota and previously one at FIU

#### PITINO IN YEAR ONE

- Richard Pitino is looking to continue a trend of successful first seasons at a school
- In his first season at FIŬ in 2012-13, the Panthers had a 10-win improvement from the previous year and their first winning season in 12 years
- In his first season at Minnesota in 2013-14, the Golden Gophers won the NIT and posted their first 25-win season in 17 years

#### **EIGHTH IN THE POLL**

- New Mexico was T-8th in the preseason Mountain West poll
- · Colorado State was picked as the preseason conference favorite

#### **UP NEXT**

- New Mexico opens the regular season on Wednesday as it hosts FAU at The Pit
- The Owls are the first of two first-time opponents on the Lobos' 2021-22 schedule (Norfolk State)
- The Lobos have won 18 straight season openers since dropping the 2002-03 opener to Cal
- Richard Pitino is 2-1 against FAU, going 1-1 when the head coach of rival FIU in 2012-13, and defeating the Owls in 2017-18 at Minnesota
