- The Lobos are looking to remain unbeaten at home this season
- The teams have already played one common opponent this season, Colorado in Boulder, with the Bobcats losing in overtime, 94-90, in the season opener and the Lobos falling 87-76 to the Buffaloes four days later

- The Lobos took control in the second half after leading by four at halftime
- Jaelen House and Jamal Mashburn, Jr. led the Lobos with 18 points each

A HOUSE ON FIRE

- Jaelen House is second in the Mountain West in scoring at 23.3 points per game this season
- He posted a career-high 30 points in the season opener vs. FAU
- His 70 points are the most by a Lobo over the first three games of a season since 2013-14 when Cameron Bairstow scored 72 over the first three games
- · He also leads the conference in steals and is second in the conference in assists
- Over the first three games, House has drawn 25 fouls

THAT'S HOW YOU MAKE AN ENTRANCE

- Jaelen House made a statement in his first game as a Lobo, scoring 30 points in the season opener vs. FAU on Nov. 10
- House's 30 points are tied for second most by a player in his first game for the Lobos
- He becomes the seventh Lobo in history to score 30 points in a season opener, the first to accomplish the feat since Lamont Long had 31 points in the 1997-98 season-opening win over USC
- House shot 10-19 from the floor, including 3-5 from deep, and was 7-10 from the line
- He drew 12 fouls in the game, the most by a Lobo in the three seasons that the NCAA has officially tracked the stat

- **DOUBLE-FIGURE SCORERS**
- · Seven different Lobos have already posted a double-figure scoring game this season
- Not including freshmen, five Lobos have already set a career-high in scoring during the first three games of the season (House-30 vs. FAU; Mashburn-20 at Colorado; Muscadin-18 vs. FAU; Todd-16 vs. Grambling State; Johnson-16 vs. Grambling State)

LOBOS STEALING HEADLINES

- New Mexico has 30 steals over the first three games of the season
- The Lobos have already matched last season's total of games with double-figure steals (two)
- UNM's 12 steals at Colorado and 11 steals vs. Grambling State are the two-highest steal performances this season by Mountain West teams
- Prior to last week, it had been 18 years since a Lobo had at least seven steals in a game (Danny Granger had eight vs. Penn State in the 2003 Lobo Invitational), before it has happened in back-to-back contests (Taryn Todd 7 at Colorado, Jaelen House 8 vs. Grambling State)

TALENTED TRANSFERS

- New Mexico added four transfers from power conference schools (ACC, Big East, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12, SEC) during the offseason, tied for most in the nation
- The Lobos added transfers from Arizona State (Jaelen House), Kansas (Gethro Muscadin), Minnesota (Jamal Mashburn, Jr.), and TCU (Taryn Todd)
- Grand Canyon, Iowa State, TCU and Texas A&M also added four transfers from power conferences this offseason

LOBOS FROM DEEP

- In the season-opening win over FAU, UNM shot 12-of-23 from 3-point range, the first game over 50 percent from deep since against Grand Canyon on Dec. 17, 2019, a span of 47 games
- The Lobos made 10 3-pointers vs. Grambing State and have already matched last season's total of games with at least 10 3-pointers (two)

AGAINST THE BIG SKY

- Montana State is the only Big Sky opponent on the Lobos' 2021-22 regular season schedule
- The Lobos have won 22 straight games against Big Sky opponents since a loss to Northern Arizona in 1984-85

MASHBURN SHINES AS A STARTER

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. is second on the team in scoring at 17.3 points per game and has scored in double-figures in six straight games dating back to last season at Minnesota
- Since entering the Gophers' starting lineup late last season, Mashburn has averaged 14.5 points per game as a starter and scored in double figures in 10 of the 11 games

GETHRO SHINES IN DEBUT

- In the season-opening win over FAU, Gethro Muscadin took advantage of his first stretch of extended minutes in his career
- Muscadin had 18 points on 6-8 field goals and two blocks in 22 minutes of play
- In his freshman season in 2020-21 at Kansas, Muscadin appeared in 12 games, scoring just two points in 33 total minutes

ALLOW MYSELF TO INTRODUCE ... MYSELF

- The 2021-22 New Mexico roster includes nine new players
- The newcomers include four Division I transfers, two junior college transfers, two freshmen and one new walk-on
- The roster includes seven players who were on last year's roster

SOMEONE NEW WILL STEP UP

- With only seven returning players (five scholarship) this season, the Lobos will need to have new players step up to replace lost production
- Overall, New Mexico returns 42.4 percent of its scoring, 43.2 percent of its rebounds, 57.0 percent of its assists and 47.5 percent of its' minutes
- Currently, with Saquan Singleton and Valdir Manuel out, the five remaining returning Lobos accounted for 19.1 percent of scoring, 19.7 percent of rebounds, 24.5 percent of assists and 25.7 percent of minutes last season

SINGLETON SIDELINED

- Senior guard Saquan Singleton, the Lobos' top returning scorer/rebounder/assist leader is out indefinitely after a heart abnormality was discovered in late October upon returning from an illness
- Singleton was one of two Lobos to start every game last season, averaging 8.0 points and 4.5 rebounds per game, while leading the team with 75 assists
- Singleton was cleared to return to practice this week

HISTORIC OPENING NIGHT LINEUP

- In the season-opener against FAU, the Lobos started five newcomers in Jamal Mashburn, Jr., Jaelen House, Jay Allen-Tovar, Taryn Todd and Birima Seck
- It was the first time in school history that UNM's starting lineup in the season opener was comprised of five players who were not on the roster the year before

PITINO IN YEAR ONE

- Richard Pitino is looking to continue a trend of successful first seasons at a school
- In his first season at FIU in 2012-13, the Panthers had a 10-win improvement from the previous year and their first winning season in 12 years
- In his first season at Minnesota in 2013-14, the Golden Gophers won the NIT and posted their first 25-win season in 17 years

YOU CAN GO HOME AGAIN

- The season opener against FAU was UNM's first regular season game in The Pit since Feb. 29, 2020, a span of 621 days
- It was the longest gap between home games for New Mexico since a 727 day gap from February 5, 1920 to Feb. 1, 1922 when the Lobos didn't field a team during the 1921 season
- The Lobos did not play a single game in the state of New Mexico during the 2020-21 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, playing 11 road games and 11 neutral site games
- New Mexico will play 18 regular season games this season at The Pit

LOBOS SIGN THREE FOR 2022

- New Mexico signed three players to its 2022 recruiting class
- Guards Braden Appelhans (Blue Springs, Mo.) and Donovan Dent (Corona, Calif.) and forward Quinton Webb (San Bernardino, Calif.) will join the Lobos this summer
- All three players are three-star recruits by 247Sports and Rivals and ranked among the top 300 players in this year's class

EIGHTH IN THE POLL

- New Mexico was T-8th in the preseason Mountain West poll
- · Colorado State was picked as the preseason conference favorite

- New Mexico concludes its homestand on Monday against Western New Mexico
