LOBOS MEET UAB TO OPEN LAS VEGAS INVITATIONAL

- New Mexico travels to Sin City for the Continental Tire Las Vegas Invitational at the Orleans Arena, playing UAB in the semifinals
- The Lobos enter the game on a three-game win streak
- UNM is looking for its first in-season tournament title since winning the 2012 Paradise Jam in the U.S. Virgin Islands

SERIES HISTORY

- New Mexico leads the series 1-0
- The only previous meeting came in the quarterfinals of the 2013 Charleston Classic, a 97-94 double overtime victory for UNM
- Kendall Williams had 29 points and 10 assists to lead the Lobos

NEWCOMERS IN THE SPOTLIGHT

- The newcomers have led the Lobos over the first five games, scoring 85.6 percent (368 of 430) of the team's points this season
- Newcomers have played 82.2 percent of the minutes during the first four games
- Five newcomers started the opener vs. FAU, marking the first time in UNM history that the opening night starting lineup consisted of five players who were not on the roster the year before

HIGH SCORING LOBOS

- New Mexico has scored at least 76 points in each of the first five games this season
- The Lobos rank second in the Mountain West in scoring an average of 86.0 points per game

- He and father, Rick (Iona), are the only father-son duo to be current Division I head coaches

LAST TIME OUT

- UNM improved to 4-1 with an 88-63 victory over Western New Mexico on Monday
- The Lobos took control with a 20-0 run in the first half
- KJ Jenkins led UNM with 20 points, the first Lobo to have a 20-point game off the bench in two seasons
- Jeremiah Francis III, making his first start of the season, recorded a career-high seven assists

VIVA LAS VEGAS!!

- UNM is making its first of three trips to Las Vegas this season (at UNLV, MW Tournament)
- The Lobos are 2-2 all-time at the Orleans Arena, reaching the championship game of the 2006 Las Vegas Holiday Classic (win vs. Wichita State/loss vs. Kansas State) and the championship game of the 2010 Las Vegas Classic (win vs. Colorado/loss vs. Northern Iowa)
- This season is the 26th straight year that the Lobos have played a game in Las Vegas

THANKSGIVING HOOPS

- UNM is playing on Thanksgiving for the third time in history in search of its first win
- The Lobos lost to Virginia Tech 92-72 on Thanksgiving in the 2016 Wooden Legacy
- The Lobos fell to Santa Clara 79-76 in overtime on Thanksgiving in the 2011 76 Classic

DOUBLE-FIGURE SCORERS

- Seven different Lobos have already posted a double-figure scoring game this season
- Not including freshmen, six Lobos have already set a career-high in scoring during the first five games of the season (House-30 vs. FAU; Mashburn-21 vs. Montana State; Muscadin-18 twice; Todd-16 vs. Grambling State; Johnson-16 vs. Grambling State, Patterson-5 vs. Western NM)

LOBOS STEALING HEADLINES

- New Mexico leads the Mountain West with 47 steals this season
- The Lobos have already matched last season's total of games with double-figure steals (two)
- UNM's 12 steals at Colorado and 11 steals vs. Grambling State are the two-highest steal performances this season by Mountain West teams this season
- Prior to this season, it had been 18 years since a Lobo had at least seven steals in a game (Danny Granger had eight vs. Penn State in the 2003 Lobo Invitational), before it happened in back-to-back contests (Taryn Todd - 7 at Colorado, Jaelen House - 8 vs. Grambling State)

TALENTED TRANSFERS

- New Mexico added four transfers from power conference schools (ACC, Big East, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12, SEC) during the offseason, tied for most in the nation
- The Lobos added transfers from Arizona State (Jaelen House), Kansas (Gethro Muscadin), Minnesota (Jamal Mashburn, Jr.), and TCU (Taryn Todd)
- Grand Canyon, Iowa State, Siena, TCU and Texas A&M also added four transfers from power conferences this offseason

LOBOS FROM DEEP

- In the season-opening win over FAU, UNM shot 12-of-23 from 3-point range, the first game over 50 percent from deep since against Grand Canyon on Dec. 17, 2019, a span of 47 games
- The Lobos made 10 3-pointers vs. Grambling State and have already matched last season's total of games with at least 10 3-pointers (two)
- UNM is second in the Mountain West in 3-point percentage at 40.0 percent

A HOUSE ON FIRE

- Jaelen House leads the Lobos in scoring at 19.5 points per game this season
- He posted a career-high 30 points in the season opener vs. FAU
- He also leads the conference in steals
- Over the first four games, House has drawn 26 fouls

THAT'S HOW YOU MAKE AN ENTRANCE

- Jaelen House made a statement in his first game as a Lobo, scoring 30 points in the season opener vs. FAU on Nov. 10
- House's 30 points are tied for second most by a player in his first game for the Lobos
- He becomes the seventh Lobo in history to score 30 points in a season opener, the first to accomplish the feat since Lamont Long had 31 points in the 1997-98 season-opening win over USC
- House shot 10-19 from the floor, including 3-5 from deep, and was 7-10 from the line
- He drew 12 fouls in the game, the most by a Lobo in the three seasons that the NCAA has officially tracked the stat

MASHBURN SHINES AS A STARTER

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. is second on the team in scoring at 18.4 points per game and has scored in double-figures in eight straight games dating back to last season at Minnesota
- Since entering the Gophers' starting lineup late last season, Mashburn has averaged 15.4 points per game as a starter at both schools and has scored in double figures in 12 of those 13 games

GETHRO IN THE MIDDLE

- Gethro Muscadin has made his mark this season for the Lobos after playing limited minutes last season as a freshman at Kansas
- Muscadin is third on the team in scoring at 12.6 points per game and leads UNM in rebounding at 6.0 per game
- He is T-1st in the Mountain West with 1.8 blocks per game
- The Lobos are 4-0 when Muscadin scores in double figures
- In his freshman season in 2020-21 at Kansas, Muscadin appeared in 12 games, scoring just two points in 33 total minutes

BIRIMA GRABS BOARDS

- Freshman Birima Seck has 21 rebounds this season and still has not scored a collegiate point
- He has the most rebounds in the nation this season by a player who has not scored (next high is 11 rebounds without a point)
- Seck grabbed a career-high 10 rebounds on Monday vs. Western New Mexico becoming the sixth player nationally to have a 0-point/10-rebound game this season

SINGLETON SIDELINED

- Senior guard Saquan Singleton, the Lobos' top returning scorer/rebounder/assist leader is out indefinitely after a heart abnormality was discovered in late October upon returning from an illness
- Singleton was one of two Lobos to start every game last season, averaging 8.0 points and 4.5 rebounds per game, while leading the team with 75 assists
- Singleton was cleared to return to practice on November 18

HISTORIC OPENING NIGHT LINEUP

- In the season-opener against FAU, the Lobos started five newcomers in Jamal Mashburn, Jr., Jaalen House, Jay Allen-Tovar, Taryn Todd and Birima Seck
- It was the first time in school history that UNM's starting lineup in the season opener was comprised of five players who were not on the roster the year before

THREE CAPTAINS FOR 2021-22

- Three Lobos were voted tri-captains for the 2021-22 season: Saquan Singleton, Jamal Mashburn, Jr., and KJ Jenkins
- Singleton is the Lobos' top-returning scorer and rebounder, while Mashburn and Jenkins are in their first season at UNM after transferring from Minnesota and Kilgore College, respectively

PITINO IN YEAR ONE

- Richard Pitino is looking to continue a trend of successful first seasons at a school
- In his first season at FIU in 2012-13, the Panthers had a 10-win improvement from the previous year and their first winning season in 12 years
- In his first season at Minnesota in 2013-14, the Golden Gophers won the NIT and posted their first 25-win season in 17 years

ALLOW MYSELF TO INTRODUCE ... MYSELF

- The 2021-22 New Mexico roster includes nine new players
- The newcomers include four Division I transfers, two junior college transfers, two freshmen and one new walk-on
- The roster includes seven players who were on last year's roster

YOU CAN GO HOME AGAIN

- The season opener against FAU was UNM's first regular season game in The Pit since Feb. 29, 2020, a span of 621 days
- It was the longest gap between home games for New Mexico since a 727 day gap from February 5, 1920 to Feb. 1, 1922 when the Lobos didn't field a team during the 1921 season
- The Lobos did not play a single game in the state of New Mexico during the 2020-21 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, playing 11 road games and 11 neutral site games
- New Mexico will play 18 regular season games this season at The Pit

AGAINST CONFERENCE USA

- UAB is the second of three Conference USA teams on the Lobos' 2021-22 schedule
- New Mexico downed FAU 99-92 in the season-opener on Nov 10
- UNM will also host UTEP on Dec. 12
- The Lobos are playing three different teams from the same league in the non-conference schedule since 2011-12 when they played three Pac-12 opponents

LOBOS SIGN THREE FOR 2022

- New Mexico signed three players to its 2022 recruiting class
- Guards Braden Appelhans (Blue Springs, Mo.) and Donovan Dent (Corona, Calif.) and forward Quinton Webb (San Bernardino, Calif.) will join the Lobos this summer
- All three players are three-star recruits by 247Sports and Rivals and ranked among the top 300 players in this year's class

EIGHTH IN THE POLL

- New Mexico was T-8th in the preseason Mountain West poll
- Colorado State was picked as the preseason conference favorite

- New Mexico will conclude the Continental Tire Las Vegas Invitational on Friday against either San Francisco or Towson
- The championship game will be 9:30 pm MT on FS1 and the consolation game will be 7:00 pm MT on FS2




