#### LOBOS HOST NORFOLK STATE IN NON-CONFERENCE FINALE

- New Mexico continues its six-game December homestand by hosting Norfolk State
- The Lobos look to win their seventh game of the season, which would surpass last year's win total of six
- A win would secure a winning non-conference record for the Lobos this season
- Norfolk State is the reigning MEAC Champion

#### SERIES HISTORY

- First meeting
- Norfolk State is the second of two first-time opponents on the Lobos' schedule this season (Florida Atlantic)
- The Lobos have won seven straight against first-time opponents, dating back to a loss to Maryland in the 2017 Emerald Classic in Florida
- Norfolk State is the first MEAC team to visit The Pit since North Carolina A&T in 2006-07

#### GETTING TO THE LINE

- The Lobos enter the week second nationally in free throws made with 216 (Portland has 236, but has played two more games than UNM)
- UNM is third nationally in free throw attempts with 286 (Lipscomb-291 in 13 games, Portland-290 in 14 games)
- The Lobos are eighth nationally with 23.3 percent of their scoring coming from the line
- UNM is making 18.0 FTs per game this season after making 11.6 FTs per game last year
- Each of New Mexico's top five scorers are shooting at least 75% from the line this season

- Led Minnesota to the 2014 NIT Championship
- Led Minnesota to two NCAA Tournament appearances
- 2017 Big Ten Coach of the Year
- 2017 NABC District 7 Coach of the Year
- 18 wins over ranked teams in eight seasons at Minnesota
- Led FIU to 10-win improvement and first winning seasons in 12 years in 2012-13 in first season as a head coach
- Five NCAA appearances in seven years as an assistant coach
- While on his father's staff at Louisville, the Cardinals reached the 2012 Final Four, the Elite Eight in 2008 and 2009 and won two Big East Championships
- While on Billy Donovan's staff at Florida, the Gators reached the Elite Eight in 2011 and won one SEC Regular Season Title
- He and father, Rick (Iona), are the only father-son duo to be current Division I head coaches

#### LAST TIME OUT

- The Lobos suffered a 90-72 loss to SMU on Sunday at The Pit
- The Mustangs led wire-to-wire as the Lobos were as close as eight in the second half
- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. scored 25 points to lead UNM, his fourth 25-point game of the season
- Jaelen House had 16 points and matched a career high with seven assists

#### WIN TOTAL MATCHED

- The Lobos have already matched last year's win total of six
- New Mexico set a program record for the earliest calendar date to match the previous year's win total with its sixth win on Dec. 9 (previous record was Dec. 10, set in 1943-44 when UNM matched its previous season's win total with its third victory of the season)
- With a win today, Richard Pitino will have eclipsed the previous year's win total in his first season at each school of his career (FIU, Minnesota, New Mexico)

#### LIFE IN THE FAST LANE

- New Mexico ranks fifth in the nation in adjusted tempo per KenPom at 74.3 possessions per game
- UNM has had at least 70 possessions in 11 of 12 games this season
- The Lobos' have had seven 75 possession games this season

#### NEWCOMERS IN THE SPOTLIGHT

- The newcomers have led the Lobos over the first 12 games, scoring 82.8 percent (800 of 966) of the team's points this season
- Newcomers have played 76.1 percent of the minutes this season
- Five newcomers started the opener vs. FAU, marking the first time in UNM history that the opening night starting lineup consisted of five players who were not on the roster the year before

#### MAKE IT 80s NIGHT

- 80 has been the magic number for the Lobos this season
- UNM is 6-0 this season when scoring at least 80 points and 0-6 this season when scoring less than 80 points
- New Mexico is averaging 80.5 points per game this season (2nd in the Mountain West)

#### BLOCK PARTY

- New Mexico leads the Mountain West with 5.5 blocks per game
- Two Lobos are in the top seven individually in the conference in blocks, both at 1.6 per game with Gethro Muscadin fifth at 1.58 per game and Jay Allen-Tovar seventh at 1.50 per game
- The school record for blocks/game for a season is 4.1, set in 2015-16

#### TALENTED TRANSFERS

- New Mexico added four transfers from power conference schools (ACC, Big East, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12, SEC) during the offseason, tied for most in the nation
- The Lobos added transfers from Arizona State (Jaelen House), Kansas (Gethro Muscadin), Minnesota (Jamal Mashburn, Jr.), and TCU (Taryn Todd)
- Grand Canyon, Iowa State, Siena, TCU and Texas A&M also added four transfers from power conferences this offseason

## MASHBURN'S 25 GAMES

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. has four 25-point games this season, becoming the fifth Lobo in the last 40 years to post at least four 25-point games in a season in non-conference play
- If he scores at least 25 points tonight, he would tie Lamont Long (1997-98) for second most in a non-conference season with five, trailing only Ruben Douglas (seven), who accomplished the feat in 2002-03 when he led the nation in scoring

## MASHBURN SHINES AS A STARTER

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. leads the team in scoring at 18.8 points per game and has scored in double-figures in 11 of 12 games this season
- Since entering the Gophers' starting lineup late last season, Mashburn has averaged 16.7 points per game as a starter at both schools and has scored in double figures in 18 of those 20 games
- He was the first Lobo to score double figures in each of the first 10 games of the season since Kendall Williams in 2013-14
- Mashburn has six 20-point games this season

## THAT'S HOW YOU MAKE AN ENTRANCE

- Jaelen House made a statement in his first game as a Lobo, scoring 30 points in the season opener vs. FAU on Nov. 10
- House's 30 points are tied for second most by a player in his first game for the Lobos
- He becomes the seventh Lobo in history to score 30 points in a season opener, the first to accomplish the feat since Lamont Long had 31 points in the 1997-98 season-opening win over USC
- House shot 10-19 from the floor, including 3-5 from deep, and was 7-10 from the line
- He drew 12 fouls in the game, the most by a Lobo in the three seasons that the NCAA has officially tracked the stat

## A HOUSE ON FIRE

- Jaelen House has already posted a pair of 30-point games this season
- He is the first Lobo to have multiple 30-point games in the non-conference portion of the schedule since Elijah Brown in 2015-16

## JAVONTE EN FUEGO

- Sophomore wing Javonte Johnson leads the Lobos in 3-point percentage (.486) this season
- He has scored 108 total points over the first 11 games of the season, eclipsing his point total from his entire freshman season (64)
- He has scored in double figures in six of the 12 games, including a career-high 16 points against Grambling State and UTEP

## SINGLETON RETURNS

- Senior guard Saquan Singleton, the Lobos' top returning scorer/rebounder/assist leader, returned to lineup on Nov. 25 against UAB after missing eight weeks when a heart abnormality was discovered in October upon returning from an illness
- Singleton was one of two Lobos to start every game last season, averaging 8.0 points and 4.5 rebounds per game, while leading the team with 75 assists
- Singleton had season highs of 11 points, nine rebounds and five assists vs. UTEP

### MISSING LOBOS

- UNM has had 17 man-games lost due to injury/illness this season (Kuac-9, Singleton-5, Jenkins-2, House-1)
- The SMU game on Dec. 19 was the first time season where every player has been healthy and available for the Lobos

### DECEMBER TO REMEMBER

- New Mexico plays its entire six-game December schedule at The Pit
- The six-game homestand is the team's longest since a six-game homestand in 2007-08
- This season marks the first time since 1957-58 that the Lobos will play the entire month of December at home

### THREE CAPTAINS FOR 2021-22

- Three Lobos were voted tri-captains for the 2021-22 season: Saquan Singleton, Jamal Mashburn, Jr., and KJ Jenkins
- Singleton is the Lobos' top-returning scorer and rebounder, while Mashburn and Jenkins are in their first season at UNM after transferring from Minnesota and Kilgore College, respectively

### LOBOS FROM DEEP

- In the season-opening win over FAU, UNM shot 12-of-23 from 3-point range, the first game over 50 percent from deep since against Grand Canyon on Dec. 17, 2019, a span of 47 games
- The Lobos made 10 3-pointers vs. Grambling State and have already matched last season's total of games with at least 10 3-pointers (two)

### HISTORIC OPENING NIGHT LINEUP

- In the season-opener against FAU, the Lobos started five newcomers in Jamal Mashburn, Jr., Jaalen House, Jay Allen-Tovar, Taryn Todd and Birima Seck
- It was the first time in school history that UNM's starting lineup in the season opener was comprised of five players who were not on the roster the year before

### PITINO IN YEAR ONE

- Richard Pitino is looking to continue a trend of successful first seasons at a school
- In his first season at FIU in 2012-13, the Panthers had a 10-win improvement from the previous year and their first winning season in 12 years
- In his first season at Minnesota in 2013-14, the Golden Gophers won the NIT and posted their first 25-win season in 17 years

### YOU CAN GO HOME AGAIN

- The season opener against FAU was UNM's first regular season game in The Pit since Feb. 29, 2020, a span of 621 days
- It was the longest gap between home games for New Mexico since a 727 day gap from February 5, 1920 to Feb. 1, 1922 when the Lobos didn't field a team during the 1921 season
- The Lobos did not play a single game in the state of New Mexico during the 2020-21 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, playing 11 road games and 11 neutral site games
- New Mexico will play 18 regular season games this season at The Pit

### LOBOS SIGN THREE FOR 2022

- New Mexico signed three players to its 2022 recruiting class
- Guards Braden Appelhans (Blue Springs, Mo.) and Donovan Dent (Corona, Calif.) and forward Quinton Webb (San Bernardino, Calif.) will join the Lobos this summer
- All three players are three-star recruits by 247Sports and Rivals and ranked among the top 300 players in this year's class

- New Mexico opens Mountain West play on Dec. 28 by hosting No. 21 Colorado State
- The game will tipoff at 9 p.m. MT and air on FS1

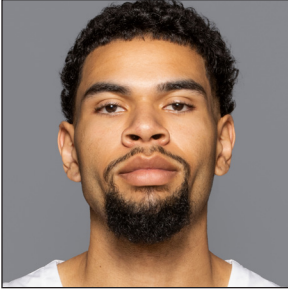
