





DU on ALTITUDE: The Pioneers will six make appearances on Altitude TV. Todd Romero (Play-by-play) will be back for a sixth season.

Coach Billups and Denver scholar-athletes are available for interviews on non-game days following practice or through special arrangements with Chris Smith.

Post-game Interviews: Postgame interviews will be conducted at a designated site following a 10-minute cooling-off period. Denver head coach Jeff Wulbrun and selected players will be available for interviews. Media requests for both Denver and opposing coaches and players should be made to the DU men's basketball SID. Opponent requests will be forwarded to the visiting SID. The DU men's basketball locker room is closed to the media.

Camera Procedures: Photographers must work within the designated areas. Photographers may shoot from the right side of each end line of Hamilton Gymnasium. Requests to photograph from any other location must be made in advance to the University of Denver Athletic Media Relations Department. The University of Denver reserves the right to accept or reject credential requests.

Radio: All radio stations wishing to broadcast from Hamilton Gymnasium should contact the University of Denver Athletic Communications Office at least one week prior to the event. Space will be provided for the official radio station of the visiting team; others will be accommodated as space permits. Phone lines must be arranged for all stations in advance.

Directions to DU: Take I-25 to the South University Boulevard exit. Proceed south to the first stop light (Buchtel Boulevard). Go through the Buchtel Boulevard intersection to the next block south (Jewell Avenue). Take a right on Jewell and proceed west approximately one-half block to the east entrance to the Ritchie Center. Last Time Out

- Denver fell in San Marcos on Sunday to Texas State, 71-58.
- The Pioneers had three players in double figures in the loss.
- KJ Hunt had a game-high 14 points in the loss.
- Jordan Johnson added 11 points.
- DU had a season-high 22 turnovers in the loss.

About Denver

- The Pioneers are averaging 66.2 points per game this year, eighth in the Summit League.
- Denver is allowing 68.3 points per game on the season, fifth in the Summit League.
- DU is shooting 45.0 percent from the field, third in the Summit League this season.
- Denver is holding opponents to 44.5 percent shooting, sixth in the Summit League.
- The Pioneers rank fourth in the Summit League in steals per game, swiping 6.7 a night.
- Denver has been solid at rim protection, ranking second in the Summit League in blocks per game at 3.4.
- The Crimson and Gold rank fourth in the Summit League at getting to the line, attempting 176 free throws on the season.
- DU ranks fifth in the Summit League in 3-point percentage at 35.2 percent in 2020-21.
- The Pioneers rank third in the Summit League in 3-point defense, allowing just a 30.7 percent make rate.
- KJ Hunt leads the team in scoring at 16.2 points per game, good for sixth in the Summit League.
- Hunt ranks tied for fourth in the Summit League in assists per game, handing out 3.6 per night.
- Payton Moore leads the team in rebounding, ripping down 4.3 boards a contest.
- Tevin Smith ranks fifth in the Summit League in blocks per game, sending back 1.0 per night.

About New Mexico

- The Lobos are 5-4 on the year.
- New Mexico averages 82.0 points per contest, 36th in the NCAA.
- UNM gives up 79.1 points a night this year, 11th in the Mountain West.
- New Mexico is making 45.7 percent of its shots on the season.
- The Lobos are hitting 37.8 percent of their 3s in 2021-22.
- UNM is making 8.2 3s per game.
- New Mexico is averaging 12.3 assists per game on the season.
- The Lobos lead the Mountain West in blocks per game with a 5.2 average.
- Jamal Mashburn Jr. is the team's leading scorer with a 20.4 points per game average.
- Javonte Johnson leads the team in rebounding, pulling down 5.4 per contest.

• The Pioneers have made a 3-pointer in 467 straight games, dating back to Feb. 2, 2006.

Hunt(ing) Season

- Hunt has made an immediate impact for the Pioneers since arriving.
- Hunt also is second in the Summit League in points produced with 163.
- The junior has been efficient from the point guard position, posting an 18.1 player efficiency rating (PER).
- Hunt is the only player in the Summit League to average at least 16.0 points, 4.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists.

• Michael Henn really found a groove in a five-game stretch from Nov.17-

- The 6-foot-8 forward averaged 14.6 points and 4.4 rebounds.
- Henn was good with the shooting touch, shooting 49 percent from the field, 36 percent from 3 and 82 percent from the line.
- Henn has scored in double figures in all five games.

We Want To Be An Elite-Level Defensive Team

- Denver has been a tough team to beat when it dials up the defense.
- The Pioneers have a 3-2 (.600) record under Wulbrun when allowing fewer than 70 points in a contest.

Tev Time

- Freshman Tevin Smith made his anticipated collegiate debut on Nov. 9 against Regis.
- The Danville, Illinois native scored 11 points in the contest, which he also started.
- Smith showcased a variety of scoring from all three levels.

Made a Good First Impression

- Head coach Jeff Wulbrun got the result he was looking for in his coaching debut, knocking off Regis 68-65 on Nov. 9 in Hamilton Gymnasium.
- Wulbrun becomes just the third Pioneer head coach to win his debut game in the program's DI era (1998-present).

Start It Right at Home

- The Pioneers have done well in home openers the past four seasons.
- DU has won its last four home openers dating back to 2018.

Instant Impact

- Freshman Tevin Smith was named in the preseason as one of the top impact newcomers in the NCAA this by ESPN. com
- Smith, who hails from Danville, Ill., is the highest rated recruit to sign out of high school in program history.
- Smith was ranked as the No. 8 overall player in the state of Illinois last year and the No. 2 player at his position.

It's Time

- Head coach Jeff Wulbrun begins a new era for Pioneer Basketball.
- Wulbrun enters his first season in charge in 2021-22.
- Wulbrun spent the past seasons at Stanford as an assistant and associate head coach under Jerrod Haase.
- With Stanford, Wulbrun helped land back-to-back top-tier recruiting classes, including top-10 classes in 2017 and 2020.
- Prior to working at Stanford, Wulbrun was with Haase at UAB, where helped guide the team to an NCAA Tournament appearance and win in 2015, the first in a decade for the program.
- Wulbrun has also worked on a coaching staff at Virigina Tech (2011-12), Illinois State (1993-97) and California (1986-93).

Welcome to the New Age

- Denver features a whole new look in 2021-22 with nine new players.
- The Pioneers have added three graduate transfers in KJ Hunt, Payton Moore and Michael Henn.
- Hunt, a Little Rock, Ark. native, brings veteran experience after a tournament as the starting point guard at Morehead State last season.
- Moore joins the Crimson and Gold after spending the past three seasons at Rice University.
- Henn brings an outside shooting touch and size to the frontcourt, spending last season at Portland in the West Coast Conference.
- DU adds its first-ever JUCO All-American signing in Jordan Johnson from Hinds Community College.
- Johnson scored a team-best 20.8 points last year at Hinds CC while handing out 7.0 assists and was named NJCAA Second Team All-American.
- Denver adds five freshman in Coban Porter, Tevin Smith, Touko Tainamo, Felipe Motta and Pedro Lopez-Sanvicente.
- Porter comes from a basketball royality, with brothers Michael Jr. and Jontay playing the NBA.
- Smith, a Danville, Ill. native, is the highest rated recruit to sign with the Pioneers out of high school according a 247 sports.
- Tainamo brings a toughness and size down on the low block after playing in Helsinki, Finland, where he was the captain of the U20 National Team.
- Motta brings some shooting to the wing with a 6-7 frame after playing at the NBA Global Academy.
- Lopez-Sanvicente, all the way from the Canary Islands, Spain, brings typical european big-man play with shooting and passing skills.



JACKS MOVE BACK INTO TOP 10 IN MID-MAJOR POLL

South Dakota State moved up two spots and found itself back in the top 10 in the latest CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll, securing the No. 9 ranking. NDSU and Oral Roberts continued receiving votes.

BOMBS AWAY

The Summit League is home to the top two 3-point shooters in terms of make in Division I through the month of November. St. Thomas' Riley Miller leads all DI players with 35 makes, while South Dakota State's Noah Freidel is second with 34. Miller's makes have come in only seven games and he leads the country in average makes per game as well (5.0/g).

And, it's not just individuals lighting up the 3-point line early on. Oral Roberts leads all DI teams in makes per game at 13.7/g. The Golden Eagles made 19

in an 87-80 victory over Tulsa to reclaim the Mayor's Cup this past Monday. Junior Max Abmas led that charge for ORU, making 7-of-13 attempts to score a season-high 38 points.

NOTING THE PIONEERS

- The Pioneers dropped a pair of tight contests on the road, falling by a point to in-state foe Air Force before seeing Utah Valley rally to force overtime and eventually post a 77-68 victory.
- These were the first two games during a six-game road trip that will end Dec. 11 at Dixie State.
- K.J. Hunt continued his strong start to the season and has reached double figures in all eight games. He had 22 points in the loss to the Wolverines, which was his third 20-plus point game of the season.
- Graduate student Michael Henn is starting to settle in for the Pios. After scoring 30 points (7.5 ppg) in his first four games, the 6-foot-8 forward has dropped 54 (13.5 ppg) and reached double figures in each of the last four games.

JEFF WULBRUN HEAD COACH • FIRST SEASON CYPRESS, CALIF. CAL STATE FULLERTON (1984)

Head coach Jeff Wulbrun enters his first season as the leader of the men's basketball program in 2021-22.

Wulbrun, who owns nearly three decades of experience as a basketball coach, spent the past five seasons at Stanford. After serving the first two years as an assistant coach, Wulbrun was elevated to the James C. Gaither Associate Head Coach of Men's Basketball prior to the 2018-19 season.

Working directly with the Cardinal forwards and centers, post play has been one of Wulbrun's specialties for over 30 years. He has developed a plethora of All-Pac-12 performers at Stanford, including Reid Travis and Michael Humphrey, who formed one of the top tandems in the conference, Josh Sharma, who excelled at his highest level during his senior season, and Oscar da Silva, who has emerged as a player who can work both the low and high post and take his opponents off the dribble. All four players feature heavily in the Cardinal record books.

Wulbrun also oversees Stanford's scheduling, where he has secured home games against some of the top programs in the nation, with both North Carolina (2017) and Kansas (2019), among others, visiting Maples Pavilion. A force in recruiting, Wulbrun has helped Stanford land back-to-back top-tier recruiting classes, including top-10 classes in 2017 and 2020.

Stanford finished 20-12 overall in 2019-20, and remained solidly in contention for an NCAA Tournament berth throughout a season shortened by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Boasting the nation's No. 16-ranked scoring defense (KenPom No. 7), the Cardinal also shot its highest field goal percentage (.469) since 2003-04 and was led by junior Oscar da Silva (All-Pac-12 first team, 15.7 ppg, 6.4 rpg) and Tyrell Terry (All-Pac-12 honorable mention, 14.6 ppg, 4.5 rpg, 3.2 apg), who emerged as one of the nation's top freshmen.

The 2018-19 team won 15 games, and was led by NBA Draft choice KZ Okpala, who went to the Miami Heat. He joined over 30 players under Wulbrun that have gone on to professional careers, including NBA All-Stars Jason Kidd and Kevin Johnson. He also served as an assistant coach for the gold-medal-winning United States at the Maccabi Games in 2019 in Budapest, Hungary.

In Wulbrun's second season, Stanford won 19 games overall and returned to the postseason for the first time in three years. Stanford finished third in the Pac-12 standings and won 11 conference games in 2017-18, its best finish and most conference wins in 10 years. The '17-18 team posted its highest scoring average (75.9 ppg) in 16 seasons, and led the conference in rebounding (39.1 rpg).

Wulbrun has been a member of Haase's staff each of the last eight seasons at both Stanford and UAB. Wulbrun's relationship with Haase dates back nearly three decades when he first recruited and signed Haase as a member of the California coaching staff.

Over a successful coaching career that spans 30 years (20 years in college and 10 in high school), Wulbrun has helped guide three different collegiate programs – California, Illinois State and UAB – to the NCAA Tournament.

At each stop, Wulbrun has played a key role in bringing in highly-regarded recruiting classes, highlighted by top-10 classes at Stanford in 2017 and 2020, a top-30 class with the Cardinal in 2018 and a top-five class at California that included Haase and Jason Kidd. At UAB, Wulbrun was responsible for landing the top recruiting class in Conference USA. Known for identifying and recruiting international talent, Wulbrun has helped bring in top prospects from Australia, Germany and Lithuania to Stanford.

At UAB, Wulbrun was part of a coaching staff that guided the Blazers to 80 wins in the four-year span, including the 2016 Conference USA regular-season championship and the 2015 conference tournament title. In 2015, UAB earned its first NCAA Tournament berth since 2011 and captured the Blazers' first win in the NCAAs since 2005. The Blazers' 26 wins in 2015-16 were a school record. He recruited and helped develop UAB all-conference selections Chris Cokley and William Lee during his time with the Blazers. Lee finished his career as UAB's all-time leader in blocked shots (291) and Cokley completed his career third in UAB history in career scoring with 1,660 points.

Before reuniting with Haase at UAB, Wulbrun served on the staff at Virginia Tech (2011-12), Illinois State (1993-97) and California (1986-93).

A Cypress, California, native, Wulbrun was an assistant coach at California under Lou Campanelli for seven seasons, helping lead the Golden Bears to five postseason appearances. During his time in Berkeley, Wulbrun helped sign Haase out of South Lake Tahoe High School, along with Jason Kidd and Lamond Murray. Wulbrun also coached three-time NBA All-Star Kevin Johnson, who served eight years as the Mayor of Sacramento.

Wulbrun helped lead Illinois State to three postseason appearances, including the 1997 Missouri Valley Conference regular-season and tournament title and berth in the NCAA Tournament in his four seasons with the Redbirds. He was also was active in real estate sales and development in Illinois. He was appointed the Chief Operating Officer of Distinctive Designs, a residential construction company, in 1998.

During his seven successful years in the business world, Wulbrun also served as the head coach of Central Catholic High School in Bloomington, Illinois. He developed Central Catholic into one of the top high school programs in Illinois.

Wulbrun jumped back into collegiate coaching full time in 2011, working with Seth Greenberg at Virginia Tech for one season. He then reunited with Haase on his staff at UAB, when Haase was named the head coach of the Blazers in 2012.

Wulbrun holds a bachelor of arts in communications from Cal State Fullerton (1984). He and his wife, Jennie, are the proud parents of daughter, Kendall, and son, Jared. Kendall attended TCU, and is now the assistant director of admissions at Santa Clara University, and Jared attends Purdue University, where he is a member of the men's basketball team. Jennie works as a programs & events manager for the Positive Coaching Alliance.
