### LOBOS OPEN HOMESTAND WITH NEW MEXICO STATE REMATCH

- New Mexico begins a six-game homestand by hosting New Mexico State
- The Lobos are looking to remain undefeated at The Pit this season
- UNM is looking to match its win total from last season

### **SERIES HISTORY**

- New Mexico leads the series 123-102
- The Lobos lead 74-41 in Albuquerque, including 38-17 at The Pit
- UNM has won the last three meetings, both in 2019-20 and last week in Las Cruces
- The Lobos are looking to sweep the season series for the 10th time this century (2001-02, 2004-05, 2008-09, 2009-10, 2012-13, 2014-15, 2015-16, 2019-20)
- UNM is looking to win both games when playing NMSU in back-to-back contests for the eighth time since 1950 (1968-69, 1995-96, 1996-97, 2004-05, 2008-09, 2010-11, 2012-13)

### **NEWCOMERS IN THE SPOTLIGHT**

- The newcomers have led the Lobos over the first eight games, scoring 83.8 percent (555 of 662) of the team's points this season
- Newcomers have played 78.3 percent of the minutes this season
- Five newcomers started the opener vs. FAU, marking the first time in UNM history that the opening night starting lineup consisted of five players who were not on the roster the year before

### **LAST TIME OUT**

- The Lobos won the first meeting of the back-to-back with New Mexico State, posting a 101-94 victory in Las Cruces on Tuesday
- The game included a 50-minute delay when the Pan American Center lost power
- Jaelen House scored a career-high 31 points to lead UNM
- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. scored 15 of his 19 points in the second half
- Jay Allen-Tovar had 15 points and a career-high 11 rebounds for his first career double-double
- The Lobos scored 100 points against the Aggies for the first time since 1993-94 and the first time in Las Cruces since 1976-77
- New Mexico became the first road team to score 100 in the Pan American Center since Boise State in 2008-09

### **EARLY-SEASON MILESTONE POTENTIAL**

- With a win tonight, the Lobos will win their sixth game of the year, matching last year's win total
- It would mark the earliest calendar date that New Mexico has ever matched the previous year's win total (current record is Dec. 10, set in 1943-44 when UNM matched its previous season's win total with its third victory of the season)

### **DOUBLE-FIGURE SCORERS**

- Seven different Lobos have already posted a double-figure scoring game this season
- Not including freshmen, six Lobos have already set a career-high in scoring during the first seven games of the season (House-31 at NM State; Mashburn-26 twice; Muscadin-18 twice; Todd-16 vs. Grambling State; Johnson-16 vs. Grambling State, Patterson-5 vs. Western NM)
- The Lobos have eight 20-point games this season (Mashburn-4, House-3, Jenkins-1) after having just seven all of last season

### **LOBOS STEALING HEADLINES**

- New Mexico leads the Mountain West with 61 steals this season
- The Lobos have already matched last season's total of games with double-figure steals (two)
- UNM's 12 steals at Colorado and 11 steals vs. Grambling State are the two-highest steal performances this season by Mountain West teams this season
- Prior to this season, it had been 18 years since a Lobo had at least seven steals in a game (Danny Granger had eight vs. Penn State in the 2003 Lobo Invitational), before it happened in back-to-back contests (Taryn Todd 7 at Colorado, Jaelen House 8 vs. Grambling State)

### **MAKE IT 80s NIGHT**

- 80 has been the magic number for the Lobos this season
- UNM is 5-0 this season when scoring at least 80 points and 0-3 this season when scoring less than 80 points
- New Mexico is averaging 82.8 points per game this season (2nd in the Mountain West)

### **TALENTED TRANSFERS**

- New Mexico added four transfers from power conference schools (ACC, Big East, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12, SEC) during the offseason, tied for most in the nation
- The Lobos added transfers from Arizona State (Jaelen House), Kansas (Gethro Muscadin), Minnesota (Jamal Mashburn, Jr.), and TCU (Taryn Todd)
- Grand Canyon, Iowa State, Siena, TCU and Texas A&M also added four transfers from power conferences this offseason

### THAT'S HOW YOU MAKE AN ENTRANCE

- Jaelen House made a statement in his first game as a Lobo, scoring 30 points in the season opener vs. FAU on Nov. 10
- House's 30 points are tied for second most by a player in his first game for the Lobos
- He becomes the seventh Lobo in history to score 30 points in a season opener, the first to accomplish the feat since Lamont Long had 31 points in the 1997-98 season-opening win over USC
- House shot 10-19 from the floor, including 3-5 from deep, and was 7-10 from the line
- He drew 12 fouls in the game, the most by a Lobo in the three seasons that the NCAA has officially tracked the stat

### A HOUSE ON FIRE

- Jaelen House has already posted a pair of 30-point games this season
- He is the first Lobo to have multiple 30-point games in the non-conference portion of the schedule since Elijah Brown in 2015-16

### **MASHBURN SHINES AS A STARTER**

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. leads the team in scoring at 20.4 points per game and has scored in double-figures in 11 straight games dating back to last season at Minnesota
- Since entering the Gophers' starting lineup late last season, Mashburn has averaged 16.9 points per game as a starter at both schools and has scored in double figures in 15 of those 16 games
- Mashburn has four 20-point games this season

### **GETHRO IN THE MIDDLE**

- Gethro Muscadin has made his mark this season for the Lobos after playing limited minutes last season as a freshman at Kansas
- Muscadin averaging 9.6 points per game and 4.9 rebounds per game
- He ranks in the top five in the Mountain West with 1.4 blocks per game
- The Lobos are 4-0 when Muscadin scores in double figures
- In his freshman season in 2020-21 at Kansas, Muscadin appeared in 12 games, scoring just two points in 33 total minutes

### **JAVONTE EN FUEGO**

- Sophomore wing Javonte Johnson leads the Lobos in 3-point percentage (.517) this season
- He has scored 80 total points over the first eight games of the season, eclipsing his point total from his entire freshman season (64)
- He has scored in double figures in five of the eight games, including a career-high 16 points against Grambling State

### **SINGLETON RETURNS**

- Senior guard Saquan Singleton, the Lobos' top returning scorer/rebounder/assist leader, returned to lineup on Nov. 25 against UAB after missing eight weeks when a heart abnormality was discovered in October upon returning from an illness
- Singleton was one of two Lobos to start every game last season, averaging 8.0 points and 4.5 rebounds per game, while leading the team with 75 assists
- · Singleton had eight points off the bench against UAB in his season-debut

### **MISSING LOBOS**

- UNM has had 14 man-games lost due to injury/illness this season (Kuac-6, Singleton-5, Jenkins-2, House-1)
- The Lobos have not had a game this season where every player has been healthy

### **DECEMBER TO REMEMBER**

- New Mexico plays its entire six-game December schedule at The Pit
- The six-game homestand is the team's longest since a six-game homestand in 2007-08
- This season marks the first time since 1957-58 that the Lobos will play the entire month of December at home

### **THREE CAPTAINS FOR 2021-22**

- Three Lobos were voted tri-captains for the 2021-22 season: Saquan Singleton, Jamal Mashburn, Jr., and KJ Jenkins
- Singleton is the Lobos' top-returning scorer and rebounder, while Mashburn and Jenkins are in their first season at UNM after transferring from Minnesota and Kilgore College, respectively

### **LOBOS FROM DEEP**

- In the season-opening win over FAU, UNM shot 12-of-23 from 3-point range, the first game over 50 percent from deep since against Grand Canyon on Dec. 17, 2019, a span of 47 games
- The Lobos made 10 3-pointers vs. Grambing State and have already matched last season's total of games with at least 10 3-pointers (two)
- UNM is fourth in the Mountain West in 3-point percentage at 39.1 percent

### **HISTORIC OPENING NIGHT LINEUP**

- In the season-opener against FAU, the Lobos started five newcomers in Jamal Mashburn, Jr., Jaelen House, Jay Allen-Tovar, Taryn Todd and Birima Seck
- It was the first time in school history that UNM's starting lineup in the season opener was comprised of five players who were not on the roster the year before

### **PITINO IN YEAR ONE**

- · Richard Pitino is looking to continue a trend of successful first seasons at a school
- In his first season at FIU in 2012-13, the Panthers had a 10-win improvement from the previous year and their first winning season in 12 years
- In his first season at Minnesota in 2013-14, the Golden Gophers won the NIT and posted their first 25-win season in 17 years

### **YOU CAN GO HOME AGAIN**

- The season opener against FAU was UNM's first regular season game in The Pit since Feb. 29, 2020, a span of 621 days
- It was the longest gap between home games for New Mexico since a 727 day gap from February 5, 1920 to Feb. 1, 1922 when the Lobos didn't field a team during the 1921 season
- The Lobos did not play a single game in the state of New Mexico during the 2020-21 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, playing 11 road games and 11 neutral site games
- New Mexico will play 18 regular season games this season at The Pit

### **LOBOS SIGN THREE FOR 2022**

- New Mexico signed three players to its 2022 recruiting class
- · Guards Braden Appelhans (Blue Springs, Mo.) and Donovan Dent (Corona, Calif.) and forward Quinton Webb (San Bernardino, Calif.) will join the Lobos this summer
- All three players are three-star recruits by 247Sports and Rivals and ranked among the top 300 players in this year's class

### **UP NEXT**

- New Mexico continues the homestand on Thursday as it hosts Denver
- The teams haven't met since the 1970-71 season
- From 1951-52 to 1968-69 the teams met twice a year, including 11 seasons (1952-62) when they both were members of the Skyline Conference
