### OPENING TIPS

• Utah State returns to Mountain West play at New Mexico on Saturday, Jan. 8, at 6 p.m.

• Utah State leads the all-time series against the Lobos, 29-12, and has won three straight and six of the last seven. The Aggies are the only team in the MW with a winning record inside The Pit (10-9).

• The contest features a pair of first-year head coaches in the MW in Utah State's **Ryan Odom** and New Mexico's Richard Pitino. Both are the sons of long-time collegiate head coaches Dave Odom (22 years) and Rick Pitino (34 years). The father/son connection even goes down to the players, as the Aggies' leading scorer, **Justin Bean**, is the son of Gordon Bean, who played at Idaho State. The Lobos are led by Jamal Mashburn, Jr., the son of former Kentucky All-American Jamal Mashburn.

• Both teams have only played one game since Dec. 22, each opening conference play with a loss.

• Utah State is shooting 48.2 percent (390-of-809) from the floor this year, the best mark since the Aggies shot 48.8 percent (941-of-1,928) during the 2009-10 season. USU has shot 50 percent or better from the floor in seven games this season.

• Utah State has scored 80 or more points in more than half of its games this season. The Aggies are a perfect 8-0 when scoring 80 or more points in a game.

• Utah State and New Mexico are two of the top-scoring teams in the MW as the Aggies rank fifth with 77.2 points per game, while the Lobos rank second with 78.9 points per game.

• Utah State is 9-1 on the year when three or more players score in double figures.

• Utah State is second in the nation in total assists this year with 276 and is third in the nation with 19.7 assists per game. The Aggies have recorded 20 or more assists in seven games this season.

• Utah State's roster features five players with 30 or more assists this season, led by junior guard **Rylan Jones** with a team-best 79.

• **Jones'** average of 5.6 assists per game is the most by an Aggie since **Kris Clark** averaged 6.4 dimes per game during the 2007-08 season.

• **Bean** and UNM junior guard Jaelen House make up two of the only three players in the MW this season to record multiple games with 30 or more points.

• **Bean** is the only player in the MW averaging a double-double this season (19.8/10.4) and leads the league in scoring (19.8), rebounding (10.4), field goal percentage (.652), double-doubles (9), defensive rebounds per game (7.36) and offensive rebounds per game (3.07).

• **Bean** is third in the nation in double-doubles (9), sixth in field goal percentage (.652), 10th in rebounds per game (10.4) and 12th in defensive rebounds per game (7.36), and 24th in scoring (19.8).

• **Bean** has been locked in from the floor this season as his 65.2-percent field goal shooting is tied for fifth in a single season in school history, while his 54.8-percent clip from behind the 3-point line is currently the best in USU history in a single season.

• **Bean's** 146 total rebounds this season matches the combined total of UNM's top-two rebounders in Javanté Johnson (76) and Jay Allen-Tovar (70).

## WIN THE HALF, WIN THE GAME

• Utah State is 7-1 this season when leading at the half.

## SCORING VICTORIES

• Utah State is 9-2 this season when scoring 70 or more points. USU is 8-0 when scoring 80 or more.

• Utah State is unbeaten this season (5-0) when its starting backcourt outscored the opposition's starting backcourt.

• Utah State is also unbeaten this season (5-0) when its bench outscored the opponent's reserves.

## BREAKING DOWN THE HALVES

### First Half

• USU scored a season-high 59 points in the opening half at Weber State, marking the most points over the opening 20 minutes for the Aggies since a 66-point first half against San José State on Dec. 28, 2019.

• During the opening 20 minutes, USU has scored 50 or more in two games and 40 or more in seven games this season.

• Utah State has held three opponents to fewer than 20 points in the opening half in three games this season.

### Second Half

• Utah State has scored as many or more points in the second half than all but two of its opponents this season.

## MILLENNIAL SCORERS

• Utah State entered the 2021-22 season with three players in pursuit of 1,000 points in their respective careers. Senior forward **Brandon Horvath** passed the mark in the season opener, scoring a team-best 19 points to increase his career total to 1,005.

• Senior forward **Justin Bean** became the 40th player in USU history to surpass 1,000 career points with a 14-point effort against Carroll College.

• Senior guard **Brock Miller** (956 points) will look to become the third 1,000-point scorer for the Aggies later this season.

## STARTING SCORERS

Utah State's offense has been paced by its starters this season as the starting 5 have accounted for 73.7 percent of the team's points.

## UTAH STATE GLASS EATERS

Utah State is 9-1 when winning the battle of the boards this season and 9-1 when recording more defensive rebounds than the opposition.

## CHANGING OF THE GUARD

• Utah State head men's basketball coach **Ryan Odom** began his tenure at the helm in Logan, being announced as the 20th head coach in USU men's basketball history on April 5, 2021.

• **Odom** is the only coach in NCAA men's basketball history to lead a No. 16-seed to a victory over the top seed in the NCAA Tournament.

## NATIONAL LEADERS

• Utah State is second in the nation in total assists this season, compiling 276 over the course of 14 games. The Aggies are third in the nation in assists per game, averaging 19.7 per contest.

• Individually, senior forward **Justin Bean** is third in the nation in double-doubles (9), sixth in field goal percentage (.652), 10th in rebounds per game (10.4) and 12th in defensive rebounds per game (7.36), and 24th in scoring (19.8).

• Junior guard **Rylan Jones** is 14th in the nation with 79 total assists and ranks 23rd in the nation with 5.6 per game.

## MOUNTAIN WEST LEADERS

• Utah State leads the MW in assists per game, averaging 19.7 per contest. The Aggies are also atop the league in 3-point field goals made (129) and total assists (276).

• Individually, **Bean** leads the league in scoring (19.8), total points (277), rebounding (10.4), total rebounds (146), field goal percentage (.652), total field goals made (107), double-doubles (9), defensive rebounds per game (7.36) and offensive rebounds per game (3.07).

• **Jones** leads the MW with 79 total assists.

## SHOOTING TO VICTORY

- Utah State is a perfect 8-0 this season when recording a better field goal percentage than its opponent.
- Utah State is 7-1 this season when recording a better 3-point field goal percentage than its opponent.
- Utah State is a perfect 5-0 this season when recording a better free throw percentage than its opponent.

## HEAD COACH RYAN ODOM

**Hampden-Sydney, 1996**  
**First Year (135-86, Seven Seasons)**

Ryan Odom was named the head men's basketball coach at Utah State on April 5, 2021. In all, Odom is 126-81 (.609) in seven years as a head coach and has 25 years of collegiate coaching experience.

Odom comes to Utah State after spending the past five years as the head coach at the University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC), leading the Retrievers to a 97-60 (.573) record, including a 50-29 mark in the America East Conference. In the 2018 NCAA Tournament, UMBC became the first-ever 16-seed to win a first round game as it posted a 74-54 win against top overall seed Virginia.

In his five years at UMBC, Odom coached three of the top four win-producing teams in school history and set a program record by winning 20 or more games in three consecutive seasons, including a school-record 25 victories during the 2017-18 campaign.

In 2020-21, Odom led UMBC to a 14-6 record, including a 10-4 league mark. Following the year, he was named the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 1 Co-Coach of the Year. Odom also earned America East Conference Coach of the Year honors after leading the Retrievers to a share of the regular-season title and the No. 1 seed in the America East Playoffs.

The 2018-19 Retrievers advanced to the championship game of the America East Tournament after posting a 21-13 record, including an 11-5 conference mark, for its third-straight 20-win season.

In his second year at UMBC, Odom and the Retrievers posted a 25-11 record, including a 12-4 league mark, to finish second in the America East and set a school record for wins. UMBC also won an America East Conference title at prohibitive favorite Vermont and followed that up by engineering the first victory by a No. 16 seed over a No. 1 seed in NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament history. UMBC overwhelmed the tournament's top overall seed, Virginia, 74-54, in Charlotte, N.C., earning an ESPY nomination for the "Best Moment" of the year. Following the season, Odom earned the 2018 Hugh Durham Award as the nation's top mid-major coach.

After taking over a program that finished 7-25 in 2015-16, Odom led UMBC to its first winning season since 2007-08 with a 21-13 record, as the Retrievers advanced to the semifinals of the 2017 CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT). UMBC finished the 2016-17 campaign as the nation's third-most improved team, with a +13.0 mark, behind only Minnesota and UCLA. Odom's team posted three wins in the CIT and became the first America East team to win three games in a postseason tournament.

At the end of the season, Odom earned the 2017 Joe B. Hall Award, which is presented annually to the top first-year coach in Division I.

Before serving as the head coach at UMBC, Odom was the head men's basketball coach at Lenoir-Rhyne (N.C.) University for one year (2016). The Bears (21-10) advanced to the NCAA Division II Regional Finals for the first time in school history and won 20 games in a season for the first time in eight years. Lenoir-Rhyne improved by 10.5 games from the previous campaign, led the nation in 3-point field goals made per game (12.4), and finished ninth in the country in scoring at 90.1 points per game.

Odom was also an assistant coach at Charlotte for five seasons (2011-15), including serving as the interim head coach for the final 19 games of the 2014-15 campaign. In 2013, he helped the 49ers earn a bid to the postseason NIT.

Prior to his tenure in Charlotte, Odom spent seven years (2004-10) on the coaching staff at Virginia Tech and was part of a Hokies' team that earned a berth to the NCAA Tournament in 2007 and beat Illinois in the first round.

Odom was also an assistant coach at American for three years (2001-03), at UNC Asheville for one season (2000) and at Furman for two years (1998-99). He also served as an administrative assistant at South Florida for one season (1997).

Odom graduated from Hampden-Sydney in 1996 with a bachelor's degree in economics and was a four-year starting point guard on the men's basketball team. He served as team captain his senior season and led Hampden-Sydney to an 80-30 record during his playing career, including two berths in the NCAA Division III Tournament. In addition, Odom finished his career as the school's all-time leader in 3-pointers made and placed fourth in assists.

Ryan is the son of Dave Odom, who retired in 2008 as the head coach at South Carolina. The elder Odom earned SEC Coach of the Year honors while at South Carolina in 2004 and ACC Coach of the Year honors in 1991, 1994 and 1995, while at Wake Forest.

Odom and his wife, Lucia, have two sons - Connor and Owen.


