LOBOS FROM DEEP

- In Mountain West play, the Lobos lead the conference by making 10.3 3-pointers per game and are third in the league at 37.3 percent from deep in Mountain West games
- The Lobos have made at least 10 3-pointers in four of their seven Mountain West games after reaching that mark just twice in 13 non-conference games
- New Mexico made double-digit threes in three straight games (Boise State, at Colorado State, at Wyoming) for the first time since 2018-19
- UNM has shot at least 40 percent from deep in eight games this season (only twice last season)
- Against Utah State on Jan. 8, UNM shot 17-of-34 from 3-point range, T-5th most threes in a game in program history
- Last season Makuach Maluach led the Lobos with 24 3-pointers, but four Lobos have already eclipsed that mark this season (Jenkins-41, Mashburn-34, Johnson-34, House-27)

- At FIU, he led a 10-win improvement in his first season as a head coach
- At Minnesota, he led a four-win improvement in his first season at the school

- New Mexico ranks 25th in the nation in adjusted tempo per KenPom at 71.4 possesions per game
- UNM has had at least 70 possessions in 15 of 20 games this season

- Since entering the Gophers' starting lineup late last season, Mashburn has averaged 16.2 points per game as a starter at both schools and has scored in double figures in 26 of those 28 games
- He was the first Lobo to score double figures in each of the first 10 games of the season since Kendall Williams in 2013-14
- · Mashburn has eight 20-point games this season

THAT'S HOW YOU MAKE AN ENTRANCE

- Jaelen House made a statement in his first game as a Lobo, scoring 30 points in the season opener vs. FAU on Nov. 10
- House's 30 points are tied for second most by a player in his first game for the Lobos
- He becomes the seventh Lobo in history to score 30 points in a season opener, the first to accomplish the feat since Lamont Long had 31 points in the 1997-98 season-opening win over USC
- House shot 10-19 from the floor, including 3-5 from deep, and was 7-10 from the line
- He drew 12 fouls in the game, the most by a Lobo in the three seasons that the NCAA has officially tracked the stat

- Jaelen House has already posted a pair of 30-point games this season
- He is the first Lobo to have multiple 30-point games in the non-conference portion of the schedule since Elijah Brown in 2015-16

KJ THE SUPER SUB

- KJ Jenkins is averaging 10.4 points per game this season
- He is the only player in the Mountain West this season to score at least 125 points without making a start

SINGLETON RETURNS

- Senior guard Saquan Singleton, the Lobos' top returning scorer/rebounder/assist leader, returned to lineup on Nov. 25 against UAB after missing eight weeks when a heart abnormality was discovered in October upon returning from an illness
- Singleton was one of two Lobos to start every game last season, averaging 8.0 points and 4.5 rebounds per game, while leading the team with 75 assists
- At Nevada, he scored a season-high 14 points on 6-7 FGs, matching his conference career high
- He missed the last three games with a toe injury

THREE CAPTAINS FOR 2021-22

- Three Lobos were voted tri-captains for the 2021-22 season: Saguan Singleton, Jamal Mashburn, Jr., and KJ Jenkins
- Singleton is the Lobos' top-returning scorer and rebounder, while Mashburn and Jenkins are in their first season at UNM after transferring from Minnesota and Kilgore College, respectively

HISTORIC OPENING NIGHT LINEUP

- In the season-opener against FAU, the Lobos started five newcomers in Jamal Mashburn, Jr., Jaelen House, Jay Allen-Tovar, Taryn Todd and Birima Seck
- It was the first time in school history that UNM's starting lineup in the season opener was comprised of five players who were not on the roster the year before

PITINO IN YEAR ONE

- · Richard Pitino is looking to continue a trend of successful first seasons at a school
- In his first season at FIU in 2012-13, the Panthers had a 10-win improvement from the previous year and their first winning season in 12 years
- In his first season at Minnesota in 2013-14, the Golden Gophers won the NIT and posted their first 25-win season in 17 years
- Pitino has already led the Lobos to more wins this season than the program had last year

YOU CAN GO HOME AGAIN

- The season opener against FAU was UNM's first regular season game in The Pit since Feb. 29, 2020, a span of 621 days
- It was the longest gap between home games for New Mexico since a 727 day gap from February 5, 1920 to Feb. 1, 1922 when the Lobos didn't field a team during the 1921 season
- The Lobos did not play a single game in the state of New Mexico during the 2020-21 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, playing 11 road games and 11 neutral site games
- New Mexico will play 18 regular season games this season at The Pit

LOBOS SIGN THREE FOR 2022

- New Mexico signed three players to its 2022 recruiting class
- Guards Braden Appelhans (Blue Springs, Mo.) and Donovan Dent (Corona, Calif.) and forward Quinton Webb (San Bernardino, Calif.) will join the Lobos this summer
- All three players are three-star recruits by 247Sports and Rivals and ranked among the top 300 players in this year's class
