LOBOS HOST UTAH STATE IN MOUNTAIN WEST HOME OPENER

- New Mexico opens its Mountain West home schedule by hosting Utah State
- The last Mountain West game in The Pit was also against Utah State, a 66-64 victory on Leap Day (Feb. 29) in 2020 (a span of 680 days between conference home games)
- The Lobos have won eight straight Mountain West home openers (was not one in 2020-21, last loss in a MW home opener was 75-70 in 2011-12 to No. 16 San Diego State)

SERIES HISTORY

- Utah State leads 29-12 overall and 10-9 in Albuquerque
- New Mexico leads 5-3 in The Pit
- The Aggies are 10-8 vs. the Lobos since they joined the Mountain West in 2013-14
- Utah State won both meetings last season, played in Lubbock, Texas
- The Lobos' last win in the series came in the 2020 regular season finale, a 66-64 victory at The Pit (Jordan Arrovo is the only current Lobo to have played in that game; three current Aggies played in that game - Sean Bairstow, Brock Miller, Justin Bean)

WIN TOTAL ECLIPSED

- The Lobos have already eclipsed last year's win total of six
- · Richard Pitino has eclipsed the previous year's win total in his first season at each school of his career (FIU. Minnesota, New Mexico)

- Jaelen House led New Mexico with 18 points and six assists
- Jamal Mashburn scored 13 of his 17 points in the second half
- Saguan Singleton scored a season-high 14 points on 6-7 FGs, matching his Mountain West high

GETTING TO THE LINE

- \bullet The Lobos enter the weekend second nationally in free throws made with 243 (Lipscomb-258 has played two more games than UNM)
- UNM is fourth nationally in free throw attempts with 324 (only Pitt with 326 has more attempts with 14 games played this season)
- The Lobos are ninth nationally with 22.8 percent of their scoring coming from the line
- UNM is making 17.4 FTs per game this season after making 11.6 FTs per game last year
- Each of New Mexico's top seven scorers are shooting at least 72% from the line this season
- Jaelen House leads the conference in free throw percentage at 85.3%

LIFE IN THE FAST LANE

- New Mexico ranks 12th in the nation in adjusted tempo per KenPom at 73.5 possesions per game
- UNM has had at least 70 possessions in 12 of 14 games this season
- The Lobos' have had eight 75 possession games this season

MAKE IT 80s NIGHT

- 80 has been the magic number for the Lobos this season
- UNM is 6-1 this season when scoring at least 80 points and 0-7 this season when scoring less than 80 points
- New Mexico is averaging 78.9 points per game this season (2nd in the Mountain West)

BLOCK PARTY

- New Mexico leads the Mountain West with 5.5 blocks per game
- Individually, Jay Allen-Tovar is sixth in the conference at 1.5 per game
- The school record for blocks/game for a season is 4.1, set in 2015-16

MISSING LOBOS

- UNM has had 17 man-games lost due to injury/illness this season (Kuac-9, Singleton-5, Jenkins-2, House-1)
- The SMU game on Dec. 19 was the first time season where every player has been healthy and available for the Lobos

LOBOS FROM DEEP

- In the season-opening win over FAU, UNM shot 12-of-23 from 3-point range, the first game over 50 percent from deep since against Grand Canyon on Dec. 17, 2019, a span of 47 games
- The Lobos made 10 3-pointers vs. Grambing State and have already matched last season's total of games with at least 10 3-pointers (two)
- Four Lobos have made at least 20 3-pointers this season (only one Lobo reached that mark last season)
- UNM has made 107 three-pointers this season in 14 games, already eclipsing last year's total of 105 during a 22-game schedule

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. leads the team in scoring at 18.3 points per game and has scored in double-figures in 13 of 14 games this season
- Since entering the Gophers' starting lineup late last season, Mashburn has averaged 16.5 points per game as a starter at both schools and has scored in double figures in 20 of those 22 games
- He was the first Lobo to score double figures in each of the first 10 games of the season since Kendall Williams in 2013-14
- · Mashburn has six 20-point games this season

THAT'S HOW YOU MAKE AN ENTRANCE

- Jaelen House made a statement in his first game as a Lobo, scoring 30 points in the season opener vs. FAU on Nov. 10
- House's 30 points are tied for second most by a player in his first game for the Lobos
- He becomes the seventh Lobo in history to score 30 points in a season opener, the first to accomplish the feat since Lamont Long had 31 points in the 1997-98 season-opening win over USC
- House shot 10-19 from the floor, including 3-5 from deep, and was 7-10 from the line
- He drew 12 fouls in the game, the most by a Lobo in the three seasons that the NCAA has officially tracked the stat

SINGLETON RETURNS

- Senior guard Saquan Singleton, the Lobos' top returning scorer/rebounder/assist leader, returned to lineup on Nov. 25 against UAB after missing eight weeks when a heart abnormality was discovered in October upon returning from an illness
- Singleton was one of two Lobos to start every game last season, averaging 8.0 points and 4.5 rebounds per game, while leading the team with 75 assists
- · Singleton 11 points, nine rebounds and five assists vs. UTEP
- At Nevada, he scored a season-high 14 points on 6-7 FGs, matching his conference career high

THREE CAPTAINS FOR 2021-22

- Three Lobos were voted tri-captains for the 2021-22 season: Saquan Singleton, Jamal Mashburn, Jr., and KJ Jenkins
- Singleton is the Lobos' top-returning scorer and rebounder, while Mashburn and Jenkins are in their first season at UNM after transferring from Minnesota and Kilgore College, respectively

HISTORIC OPENING NIGHT LINEUP

- In the season-opener against FAU, the Lobos started five newcomers in Jamal Mashburn, Jr., Jaelen House, Jay Allen-Tovar, Taryn Todd and Birima Seck
- It was the first time in school history that UNM's starting lineup in the season opener was comprised of five players who were not on the roster the year before

PITINO IN YEAR ONE

- · Richard Pitino is looking to continue a trend of successful first seasons at a school
- In his first season at FIU in 2012-13, the Panthers had a 10-win improvement from the previous year and their first winning season in 12 years
- In his first season at Minnesota in 2013-14, the Golden Gophers won the NIT and posted their first 25-win season in 17 years
- Pitino has already led the Lobos to more wins this season than the program had last year

YOU CAN GO HOME AGAIN

- The season opener against FAU was UNM's first regular season game in The Pit since Feb. 29, 2020, a span of 621 days
- It was the longest gap between home games for New Mexico since a 727 day gap from February 5, 1920 to Feb. 1, 1922 when the Lobos didn't field a team during the 1921 season
- The Lobos did not play a single game in the state of New Mexico during the 2020-21 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, playing 11 road games and 11 neutral site games
- New Mexico will play 18 regular season games this season at The Pit

LOBOS SIGN THREE FOR 2022

- New Mexico signed three players to its 2022 recruiting class
- Guards Braden Appelhans (Blue Springs, Mo.) and Donovan Dent (Corona, Calif.) and forward Quinton Webb (San Bernardino, Calif.) will join the Lobos this summer
- All three players are three-star recruits by 247Sports and Rivals and ranked among the top 300 players in this year's class


