### LOBOS TRAVEL TO UNLY IN SEARCH OF FIRST MOUNTAIN WEST WIN

- New Mexico looks for its first conference win of the season as it visits UNLV on Tuesday night
- The Lobos are making their second of three trips to Las Vegas this season (Las Vegas Invitational, at UNLV, Mountain West Tournament)
- With tonight's game, New Mexico will be the first team to play three Mountain West games this
- Head Coach Richard Pitino will miss his second straight game due to COVID protocols

### **SERIES HISTORY**

- UNLV leads the all-time series 39-25, including a 23-11 edge in Las Vegas and a 19-9 advantage at Thomas & Mack
- The Runnin' Rebels have won the last six meetings, tying Utah State for the longest active win streak against the Lobos
- UNLV won both meetings last season in Las Vegas, winning 77-54 on Jan. 16 and 53-46 two days later
- The Lobos' last win in the series was a 91-90 home victory in 2018, completing a season sweep after winning 85-81 earlier that season at Thomas & Mack, their last road win at UNLV

### **WIN TOTAL ECLIPSED**

- The Lobos have already eclipsed last year's win total of six
- · Richard Pitino has eclipsed the previous year's win total in his first season at each school of his career (FIU, Minnesota, New Mexico)
- At FIU, he led a 10-win improvement in his first season as a head coach

### **LAST TIME OUT**

- The Lobos fell in overtime, 90-87, to Utah State on Saturday night at The Pit
- New Mexico was 17-of-34 from deep, T-5th most threes in program history
- Utah State rallied in the second hal after the Lobos led by 15 at the break
- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. set career highs of 29 points and eight assists
- Javonte Johnson scored a career-high 23 points on 7-of-9 3-point shooting, the most triples by a Lobo in a single game in three seasons

### **GETTING TO THE LINE**

- In 15 games this season, New Mexico has tied last season's mark of 255 made three throws (over a 22-game schedule)
- The Lobos enter the week fifth nationally in free throws made (All four team ahead of them have played more games than UNM )
- UNM is T-10th nationally in free throw attempts with 341
- The Lobos are 16th nationally with 22.1 percent of their scoring coming from the line
- UNM is making 17.0 FTs per game this season after making 11.6 FTs per game last year
- Seven of New Mexico's top eight scorers are shooting at least 72% from the line this season
- Jaelen House is second in the conference in free throw percentage at 85.3%

### **LOBOS FROM DEEP**

- Against Utah State on Jan. 8, UNM shot 17-of-34 from 3-point range, T-5th most threes in a game in program history
- The Lobos made 12 3-pointers against FAU and 10 vs. Grambing State and have already eclipsed last season's total of games with at least 10 3-pointers (two)
- UNM has made 124 three-pointers this season in 15 games, already eclipsing last year's total of 105 during a 22-game schedule
- Last season Makuach Maluach led the Lobos with 24 3-pointers, but three Lobos have already eclipsed that mark this season (Mashburn-28, Johnson-27, Jenkins-25)

### LIFE IN THE FAST LANE

- New Mexico ranks 14th in the nation in adjusted tempo per KenPom at 73.4 possesions per game
- UNM has had at least 70 possessions in 13 of 15 games this season
- The Lobos' have had nine 75 possession games this season

### **MAKE IT 80s NIGHT**

- 80 has been the magic number for the Lobos this season
- UNM is 6-1 this season when scoring at least 80 points (6-0 when scoring 80 in regulation) and 1-7 this season when scoring less than 80 points
- New Mexico is averaging 79.4 points per game this season (leads the Mountain West)

### **BLOCK PARTY**

- New Mexico leads the Mountain West with 5.3 blocks per game
- Individually, Jay Allen-Tovar is sixth in the conference at 1.5 per game
- The school record for blocks/game for a season is 4.1, set in 2015-16

### **MISSING LOBOS**

- UNM has had 17 man-games lost due to injury/illness this season (Kuac-9, Singleton-5, Jenkins-2, House-1)
- Emmanuel Kuac suffered a season-ending leg injury on Jan. 8 against Utah State

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. had four 25-point games in non-conference play, becoming the fifth Lobo in the last 40 years to post at least four 25-point games in a season in non-conference play
- His five 25-point games this season overall are the most by a Lobo since Elijah Brown had seven in 2016-17

### **MASHBURN SHINES AS A STARTER**

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. leads the team in scoring at 19.0 points per game and has scored in double-figures in 14 of 15 games this season
- Since entering the Gophers' starting lineup late last season, Mashburn has averaged 17.1 points per game as a starter at both schools and has scored in double figures in 21 of those 23 games
- He was the first Lobo to score double figures in each of the first 10 games of the season since Kendall Williams in 2013-14
- · Mashburn has seven 20-point games this season

### **THAT'S HOW YOU MAKE AN ENTRANCE**

- Jaelen House made a statement in his first game as a Lobo, scoring 30 points in the season opener vs. FAU on Nov. 10
- House's 30 points are tied for second most by a player in his first game for the Lobos
- He becomes the seventh Lobo in history to score 30 points in a season opener, the first to accomplish the feat since Lamont Long had 31 points in the 1997-98 season-opening win over USC
- House shot 10-19 from the floor, including 3-5 from deep, and was 7-10 from the line
- He drew 12 fouls in the game, the most by a Lobo in the three seasons that the NCAA has officially tracked the stat

- He has scored in double figures in seven games, including a career-high 23 points against Utah State

### **KJ THE SUPER SUB**

- KJ Jenkins is averaging 9.0 points per game this season
- He is the only player in the Mountain West this season to score at least 100 points without making a start
- · Jenkins has six double-figure scoring games this season, including two 20-point games'

### **SINGLETON RETURNS**

- Senior guard Saquan Singleton, the Lobos' top returning scorer/rebounder/assist leader, returned to lineup on Nov. 25 against UAB after missing eight weeks when a heart abnormality was discovered in October upon returning from an illness
- Singleton was one of two Lobos to start every game last season, averaging 8.0 points and 4.5 rebounds per game, while leading the team with 75 assists
- Singleton had 11 points, nine rebounds and five assists vs. UTEP
- At Nevada, he scored a season-high 14 points on 6-7 FGs, matching his conference career high
- In conference play, he leads the Mountain West with a 76.9 field goal percentage

### **THREE CAPTAINS FOR 2021-22**

- Three Lobos were voted tri-captains for the 2021-22 season: Saquan Singleton, Jamal Mashburn, Jr., and KJ Jenkins
- Singleton is the Lobos' top-returning scorer and rebounder, while Mashburn and Jenkins are in their first season at UNM after transferring from Minnesota and Kilgore College, respectively

### HISTORIC OPENING NIGHT LINEUP

- In the season-opener against FAU, the Lobos started five newcomers in Jamal Mashburn, Jr., Jaelen House, Jay Allen-Tovar, Taryn Todd and Birima Seck
- It was the first time in school history that UNM's starting lineup in the season opener was comprised of five players who were not on the roster the year before

### PITINO IN YEAR ONE

- Richard Pitino is looking to continue a trend of successful first seasons at a school
- In his first season at FIU in 2012-13, the Panthers had a 10-win improvement from the previous year and their first winning season in 12 years
- In his first season at Minnesota in 2013-14, the Golden Gophers won the NIT and posted their first 25-win season in 17 years
- Pitino has already led the Lobos to more wins this season than the program had last year

### **YOU CAN GO HOME AGAIN**

- The season opener against FAU was UNM's first regular season game in The Pit since Feb. 29, 2020, a span of 621 days
- It was the longest gap between home games for New Mexico since a 727 day gap from February 5, 1920 to Feb. 1, 1922 when the Lobos didn't field a team during the 1921 season
- The Lobos did not play a single game in the state of New Mexico during the 2020-21 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, playing 11 road games and 11 neutral site games
- New Mexico will play 18 regular season games this season at The Pit

### **LOBOS SIGN THREE FOR 2022**

- New Mexico signed three players to its 2022 recruiting class
- Guards Braden Appelhans (Blue Springs, Mo.) and Donovan Dent (Corona, Calif.) and forward Quinton Webb (San Bernardino, Calif.) will join the Lobos this summer
- All three players are three-star recruits by 247Sports and Rivals and ranked among the top 300 players in this year's class
