NEWS AND NOTES

T.Y.'S GOT YOUR BACK

- Taryn Young was the player of the weekend at the plate for the Lobos, hitting three home runs and recording seven RBI.
- Young tied her career high with two home runs in Friday's game, a two-run home run in the third inning after Andrea Howard was intentionally walked, and a solo home run to lead off the fifth.
- In Saturday's game, Young hit a three-run home run in the third inning after Ashley Archuleta was walked and Howard was intentionally walked.
- The outfielder had a 1.500 slugging percentage in the series.

WHY YOU GOTTA BE SO INTENTIONAL

- Andrea Howard has been walked a total of 17 times in the last two series, 16 of which were intentional.
- As a result, the outfielder has climbed from 118th (April 13) with 22 walks in 38 games (.58 walks per game) to 5th (April 25) in the NCAA ranks in walks per game (.89 walks per game) with 39 walks in 44 games.
- Howard's 39 walks are tied for the fourth-most walks in the NCAA with Oklahoma's Jocelyn Alo right behind her with 38 walks in 43 games.
- Nevada resorted to intentionally walking Andrea Howard seven times in the series (and walking her a total of eight times), while Fresno State walked Howard intentionally nine times.
- However, Fresno State did pitch to Howard twice in the series, with the Lobo hitting a two-run home run in the fifth inning of Friday's game. She had been walked intentionally her previous two plate appearances and then walked the next six times at the plate.
- Against Nevada, Howard was hit by a pitch before being intentionally walked twice and hit a fly out to center in her final at-bat on Friday. Howard was intentionally walked three times on Saturday with a grounder to third in the fifth inning. In Sunday's game, Howard was moved to the leadoff spot, and was walked intentionally in the first before hitting a two-run home run in the third, and was intentionally walked two more times.
- Howard's home run in the third inning went well over the wall in right field, tying the game at three and sparked to the Lobos to score five unanswered runs for the 6-3 win.
- In MW games, Howard has been walked 22 times, 17 times intentionally.

YEAR OF THE HOWARD

- Andrea Howard is having her best season as a Lobo with a career-best 51 hits, three triples, 16 home runs, 48 RBI, 39 walks, 113 total bases, .415 batting average, .919 slugging percentage and .552 on-base percentage.
- Her 16 home runs are the third-most home runs in a single season in program history. Her .919 slugging percentage is the best all-time in program history for a single season as is her .552 on-base percentage. Her .415 batting average is the fourth highest in a single season in program history.
- Howard ranks 10th in the NCAA in total bases and slugging percentage, 14th in home runs, 16th in RBI in addition to fourth in walks and fifth in walks per game.
- Twice this season, Howard has hit two home runs in a game (against Buffalo and at BYU in the first game), the fifth time hitting two home runs in a game in her career.
- Besides just hitting home runs, it is the timing of the hits, coming up clutch time and time again. The outfielder had a clutch two-run home run to tie the game at the top of the sixth against

Lamar, allowing the Lobos to extend the game to extra innings. The Lobos went on to win 6-4 in 12 innings. In the Dixie State Tournament, Howard hit a three-run home run in the third inning to tie the game against Wisconsin and tie the program record in career home runs with 39.

- She leads the conference in total bases, on-base percentage, slugging percentage, home runs, and walks, and is second in RBI and batting average and tied for second in hits.
- In conference games, she leads the conference in walks and is tied with Taryn Young and Briana Martinez for fifth with four home runs.
- Since Howard has been walked so frequently in the last six games, she no longer qualifies for the 2.5 ab/ game minimum to register on the MW batting leaders. However, her .394 batting average would have ranked third, her .879 slugging percentage would be third, and her .643 on-base percentage would lead the conference.
- Besides leading in home runs, Howard leads the Lobos in batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage, RBI, hits, doubles, triples, runs scored, walks and total bases.
- The Lobo outfielder also leads the team with 16 multiple-RBI games, with nine games of two RBI, five games with three RBI and one game with five RBI, and has 15 multiple-hit games with 12 games with two hits and two games with three hits.
- In the win against BYU, Howard accounted for five RBI, going a perfect 3-for-3 at the plate with a two-RBI single in the second, a two-run home run in the fourth and a solo home run in the sixth, while also walking in her first plate appearance.
- Howard enters the weekend with a 26-game on-base streak.

ONE FOR THE RECORD BOOKS

- Andrea Howard broke the program record in career home runs on Sunday, March 27 with a two-run home run, giving the Lobo 40 home runs. Since then, she has added on to the record with two home runs in the series with BYU, one at Colorado State and one against Fresno State.
- She now has 45 career home runs.
- Howard also set the program record for career total bases with 363 after her home run against Fresno State on April 17 and she is now second in career walks with 119.
- In addition, she is second all-time in career slugging percentage at .637, fourth in career runs-batted-in (138) and one behind third, fourth all-time in on-base percentage at .428, tied for sixth in career doubles (36) and tied for eighth in career triples (8).
- Her 22 walks in MW games are the fourth-most in a single season in MW history. She is one away from tying for second.
- She has played in 213 games, tied for seventh all-time in program history.

STRIKING FIRST

- The Lobos have scored 31 runs in the first inning, outscoring opponents 31-21.
- UNM is 19-7 when scoring first in a game and 13-6 when scoring in the first inning.
- The Lobos have scored 40 runs in the third inning for their highest run production by inning and is outscoring opponents 40-27 for their greatest run differential.
- In the game against North Dakota State, the Lobos scored five runs in the first inning, and against Tarleton, the Lobos plated five runs on five hits in the second inning to break open the game after scoring two runs in the first.

GET TRENDY

- The Lobos are also 11-2 when scoring 6-9 runs in a game, scoring nine runs against Ohio and eight runs twice (against Southern Utah and Tarleton). UNM is 3-0 when scoring 10+ runs, scoring a season-high 13 runs against NM State, 11 at UCSB and 10 against Maine.
- Other trends: UNM is 18-1 when the Lobos outhit their opponent, 12-3 when they don't make an error, 8-5 when hitting two or more home runs, 7-5 in one-run games and 6-2 in two-run games, and 14-1 when holding an opponent between 0-2 runs.
- Briana Martinez enters the series on a six-game hitting streak and Taryn Young enters on a four-game on-base streak.

GOING YARD

- The Lobos have 41 home runs to date this season, surpassing the total from last year's season (30), the 2019 season (34), 2018 season (33), 2017 season (28) and the home run total in 2016. The 2015 team hit 43 home runs, with the single-season team record 95 set in 2012.
- In the Fresno State series, a Lobo hit two home runs in a game twice (Briana Martinez Thursday and Ashley Archuleta Friday). As a team, UNM hit six home runs in the series.
- A Lobo has hit two home runs in a game six times this season.

NCAA RANKS

- The Lobos have several players ranked highly in the NCAA. Besides Andrea Howard, Amber Linton is 21st in saves (three) and 81st in strikeouts (130). Leslie Romero is ninth in sacrifice flies (five) and Peyton Robinson 28th in sacrifice bunts per game (0.20).

NO INTRO LEVEL HERE

- The Lobos added 10 newcomers in the offseason, with several called upon from game one that have become key players.
- New Mexico added a key transfer pitcher in Amber Linton (Indiana) with Linton proving to be a game-changer in the circle, and three freshmen infielders that started opening day in Emma Bramson, Ashley Archuleta and Olivia Birkinshaw.
- Archuleta has started all 44 games and is third on the team in batting average (.322) and doubles (six), second in on-base percentage (.412) and fourth in slugging percentage (.420). She is also second in hits (46) and total bases (60), third in walks (19) and runs scored (26) and fifth in RBI (18). The second baseman has 12 multiple-hit games (nine with two hits and three with three hits).
- The New Mexico native hit her first collegiate home run against Fresno State, a three-run home run in the second inning of Friday's game to put UNM 3-0, and hit her second home run on her next at-bat in the fourth inning.

NEWS AND NOTES

- In conference games, Archuleta is second in the conference in batting average (.396), third in on-base percentage (.482), ninth in slugging percentage (.563) and tied for fifth in hits (19).
- Bramson is second on the team in slugging percentage (.437) and tied for second in home runs (6) and in RBI (23) and third in total bases (52).

PITCH PERFECT

- The Lobos had two pitchers throw double-digit strikeouts three times, three times recorded a shutout and twice thrown a near no-hitter.
- Making her first appearance in the circle for New Mexico, Amber Linton threw 10 strikeouts against Pac-12 school Oregon State. Of the 10 strikeouts, half came in the final nine outs, with three in the seventh as the Lobos held a one-run lead. Holding on to a 3-2 lead in the seventh, two Beaver batters reached base, but Linton closed with three strikeouts to close the door for the Lobo win.
- Emma Guindon recorded a career-high 11 strikeouts and allowed just one hit with no walks in the 8-0, six-inning win over Southern Utah on Feb. 12. With a 3-0 lead, Guindon was efficient in the circle, retiring the side on three strikeouts (two looking) in the fourth and recorded three more strikeouts in the fifth. Guindon struck out her seventh batter in-a-row to start the sixth for her final strikeout of the game. Against SUU, of Guindon's 83 pitches, 58 went for strikes, and of Linton's 137 pitches on Friday, 89 went for strikes
- The last time a Lobo pitcher recorded double-digit strikeouts was in 2019, with the two double-digit strikeouts only the fourth time in the last nine years that a Lobo has struck out 10 or more batters. However, in that timespan, the Lobos have never had two pitchers record 10 or more strikeouts in a game in the same year.
- Guindon has a team-best 12-7 record with 2.44 ERA following 18 starts and 33 appearances, throwing five complete games, two shutouts, one save and three one-hitters.
- On the season, Linton carries a 3.76 ERA with 22 starts, 31 appearances, six complete games, and three saves. Linton has an 11-10 record.
- Linton and Guindon have thrown the most innings on the team with 130.1 and 129.1, respectively, with Guindon striking out 104 and Linton 130. Guindon has walked 40 batters while Linton has walked 57.
- As a pitching unit, the Lobos have combined for a 3.28 ERA, with 247 strikeouts to 108 walks, and has allowed 315 hits, 205 runs (139 earned). The Lobos are fifth in the MW in ERA, sixth in earned runs allowed and in walks allowed. They are first in batters struck out looking (84) and fewest home runs allowed (17).
- Linton is third in batters struck out and tied for the lead in batters struck out looking (48). Guindon is seventh in batters struck out and fifth in batters struck out looking (35). The duo are third and fourth in innings pitched with Guindon fifth in wins, seventh in ERA and ninth in opposing batting average (.238).
- In conference games, Guindon is eighth in the MW in ERA at 2.74 and tied for seventh in batters struck out looking. Linton is fifth in innings pitched (53.2), sixth in batters struck out (42) and tied for fifth in batters struck out looking (12). Linton is also first in fewest home runs allowed with one, while Guindon is tied for sixth at four.

THE HONOR IS ALL OURS

- The Lobos have won three MW weekly conference awards so far this season: one for pitcher, one for player and one for freshman.
- Amber Linton became the first Lobo to win MW Pitcher of the Week since Tess McPherson won back on Feb. 14, 2017.
- Linton earned the award following a dominating outing at the Lobo Classic in which the Lobo finished with a 0.98 ERA while making three appearances, two starts, throwing one complete game and earned a win and a save.
- Linton threw a team-high 14.1 innings and struck out 20, walking just four batters, and didn't allow a single extra-base hit in the 11 hits given up.
- After a 4-1 week at the Cardinal Classic, Emma Bramson and Andrea Howard have been named the Mountain West Freshman and Player of the Week, respectively, as announced by the conference on Tuesday.
- It is the second time that Howard has been selected for the player of the week honor and the first for the freshman Bramson.
- Howard had a sensational weekend at the plate, with a .471 batting average, a .941 slugging percentage, a .500 on-base percentage, finishing with eight hits, two doubles, two home runs, 16 total bases and eight RBI. Howard led the team in batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage, runs scored (five), hits, RBI, doubles, home runs and total bases.
- The Albuquerque native had multiple hits in three of the games, and went 3-for-4 in the extra-inning win over Lamar while also intentionally walked twice. Howard recorded three RBI in the 6-4, 12-inning win against the host Cardinals, had three RBI in the 9-1 (five innings) win over Ohio on Sunday and two RBI in the 4-2 win over Ohio on Friday.
- It wasn't just her efficiency at the plate that made Howard dangerous, it was also when she delivered her hits. Trailing 2-0 in the sixth in the second game against Lamar, Howard tied the game with a two-run home run which ultimately allowed the Lobos to go to extra innings. The outfielder was intentionally walked in the eighth and 10th inning and when she was pitched to in the 12th, hit a single up the middle that scored a run to make it 5-3 Lobos. UNM went on to win 6-4.
- Bramson was nearly as clutch, recording six hits and four RBI, while hitting .353 and having a .368 on-base percentage. The Valencia, Calif., native was 7-for-11 in advancing runners and had a hit in four of the games with two games with two hits.
- The infielder drove in the first run of the game in Friday's game against Lamar on a single up the middle, and in Saturday's game against Lamar, hit a sacrifice fly in the 11th inning to score a run, which proved crucial after Lamar scored in the bottom of the 11th.
- Against Ohio on Sunday, Bramson battled to draw a walk to start the second inning, working a full count on a nine-pitch at-bat where the freshman fouled off three-straight pitches and was behind 1-2 in the count. She eventually came around to score for the first run of the game to tie the game. In the next inning, the freshman single to right field to score Howard for the second run and in the fifth inning, Bramson ended the game with a single through the right side of the infield to score the ninth run of the game and pushed the Lobos into run-rule territory, effectively ending the game.
- On the weekend, Bramson was second on the team in hits and RBI, tied for second in total bases, third in batting average, and fourth in on-base percentage.

SETTING THE TONE IN WEEK 1

- During the opening weekend, the Lobos had four gritty performances against four quality teams, two of which were ranked in the top 10 in the country. The Lobos won their first two games in different fashions, the first a one-run game against a Power 5 school in Oregon State, and a run-rule win over Southern Utah with the offense outhitting the Thunderbirds 7-1. The Lobos fell 8-3 to No. 2 Alabama and took No. 9 Arizona to the brink in a 1-0 final.
- The three runs scored by UNM were the most runs scored against the Crimson Tide in the Candrea Classic and was just the second team to score a run against Alabama (Oregon State scored one). In addition, UNM had six hits in the game, the most hits allowed by Alabama on the weekend.
- In the circle, Emma Guindon threw another stellar game with a complete game against the Wildcats, allowing just one run and striking out two, while Ashlyn Roberts threw 5.0 innings of relief to start the day against Alabama, striking out two as well. Samantha Fohrman made her Lobo debut against the Crimson Tide, throwing 1.0 inning and allowing one run on one hit.
- Against Alabama, the Lobos got on the board in the top of the sixth on a solo home run to left by Taryn Young. Young also had a single in the third for UNM's first hit of the game. Trailing 8-1 in the top of the seventh, the Lobos continued to battle, scoring two runs. Peyton Robinson led off the inning with a single through the right side followed by a single by Andrea Howard. Leslie Romero advanced both runners on her at-bat and Emma Bramson brought the first run in on a single through the right side. A sacrifice fly to center by Briana Martinez allowed Howard to tag for the second run and for the final runs of the game.
- Reyan Tuck currently has a three-game streak of reaching base and a three-game hitting streak following the Candrea Classic, with Ashley

Archuleta, Janae Cameron and Olivia Birkinshaw having a one-game hit streak entering the Cardinal Classic.

- Leslie Romero led with four hits on the weekend and a .400 batting average, with Birkinshaw having a team-high .667 on-base percentage and Cameron having a team-best 1.333 slugging percentage following a two-run home run against SUU.
- The Lobos recorded three doubles and three home runs, scoring 14 runs on 20 hits. Nine players recorded at least one hit through the four games with six having multiple hits at the classic

UNTIL THE JOB IS DONE

- The Lobo softball team played in the third-longest game in program history on Saturday afternoon, going 12 innings before defeating host Lamar 6-4. It was the second-straight game against the Cardinals for the Lobos, with UNM winning 2-1 in the first meeting.
- It wasn't until the sixth that the Lobos broke through. Pinch hitting for New Mexico to start the sixth, Olivia Birkinshaw hit a triple to left field, and on the first pitch of the next at-bat, Andrea Howard tied the game with a home run to center for her second home run of the season. Lamar threatened to break the tie at the bottom of the inning with two runners in scoring position, but Emma Guindon (who entered in the fourth inning) recorded the third out on a swinging strikeout.
- Another run wasn't scored until the 11th inning, when after Tuck was placed on second to start the inning and moved to third on a wild pitch, Bramson hit a sacrifice fly to center that allowed Tuck to score. However, Lamar matched the run in the bottom of the 11th on a single up the middle to score its runner that was placed on second.
- The Lobos finally put the game away in the 12th with a sacrifice bunt by Broderick moving Janae Cameron over to third and a sacrifice fly to center by Young bringing Cameron in. Birkinshaw and Howard kept the inning going with consecutive singles to the outfield, with Birkinshaw scoring on Howard's hit. Romero brought in the third run of the inning on a double to center that scored Howard.
- Leading 6-3, Lamar added one final run on a grounder to second that moved the runner on second over and a wild pitch that scored the run. The Cardinals did have the tying run at the plate following a walk but a grounder to Ashley Archuleta at second ended the game.
- The Lobos used three pitchers in the game, with Samantha Fohrman going 3.0 innings before Guindon entered in the fourth and pitched 6.1 innings, with Amber Linton entering in the 10th to pitch the remaining 2.2 innings. Linton improved to 3-1 on the year with the decision.
- UNM struck out 10 batters with Guindon responsible for seven, Linton three and Fohrman one.

EMBRACE THE CHALLENGE

- New Mexico has a history of playing top teams in the non-conference season. Last season, the non-conference portion of the schedule was heavily loaded with Power 5 programs, including two Pac-12 schools and four Big 12 schools, and with two teams in the top four of the preseason ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 poll and four in the top 10, as well as two in the top four of the 2021 USA Today / NFCA Division I Top 25 Poll and three in the top six.
- This season, the Lobos opened the season against two top-10 teams in No. 2/2 Alabama and No. 9/11 Arizona, two teams that competed in the Women's College World Series last season.
- UNM has on the schedule three NCAA Tournament participants from a year ago in Arizona, Alabama and BYU and four Power 5 schools (Oregon State, Arizona, Alabama and Wisconsin) in the non-conference portion of the schedule, and has renewed the in-state rivalry series with New Mexico State with three games planned between the Lobos and Aggies.
- In the latest polls, UNM has faced two opponents ranked in the top 25 in the USA Softball poll and NFCA poll with a win over RV Oregon State, and faced a Wisconsin team that was receiving votes in the USA Today/ NFCA Coaches poll.

SOMETHING TO PROVE



- UNM was picked seventh in the Mountain West preseason poll.
- Last season, New Mexico won a Mountain West series for the first time since May 2018 (when UNM took two out of three against San Diego State) with a series win against Boise State. In addition, it was the first series win over Boise State since 2016.
- The Lobos ended the season winning four of their final five games and three of their final four series, including two of their final three series.

WELCOME BACK

- Three seniors decided to use their extra year of eligibility. Outfielders Andrea Howard and Taryn Young, as well as catcher Sydney Broderick, returns to the Lobos for one more year and add some stability to the outfield and behind the plate.
- Howard led the Lobos last season in batting average (.336), slugging percentage (.728), hits (42), RBI (33), home runs (12), total bases (91) and walks (21). The Lobo was also second in on-base percentage (.427) and tied for the team lead in triples (two). Further, the Albuquerque native led the Mountain West in home runs, was tied for first in slugging percentage and total bases, tied for second in walks and tied for third in RBI. In just MW games, led the conference in home runs (eight), was second in slugging percentage (.809), third in total bases (55) and tied for third in walks (12). She finished the season on a six-game streak of reaching base.
- In addition, the Lobos return Emma Guindon, Ashlyn Roberts and Brianna Sanchez in the circle, Peyton Robinson and Diamond Sandoval in the outfield and Briana Martinez and Rachael Hathoot in the infield. With the graduation of Cameryn O'Grady, Martinez has moved to shortstop.

SCOUTING UNLV

- UNLV enters the series 32-11 on the season, 10-5 in the MW, following a series win against Utah State. The Rebels won games one (6-0) and three (2-1) but lost the second game (3-2). UNLV has won every MW series this season except San Diego State, losing game one (2-0) and game three (7-6 in 11 innings).
- The Rebels share four non-conference opponents with UNM in BYU (won 5-3), New Mexico State (won 13-5 in six innings and 13-5 in five innings), Arizona (lost 7-2) and Dixie State (won 3-1 and lost 8-0 in five innings).
- UNLV leads the MW in overall batting average (.318) and on-base percentage (.413) and is second in home runs (52), total bases (570), walks (154), RBI (245), hits (348), runs scored (255) and slugging percentage (.522). The Rebels are third in ERA (2.78), opposing batting average (.232) and batters struck out (271).
- In conference games, UNLV leads in batting average (.299) and on-base percentage (.382) and is second in slugging percentage (.443), ERA (2.16) and opposing batting average (.222).
- UNLV has used four pitchers in the circle this season, led by Jenny Bressler's 35 appearances, 24 starts, 11 complete games and five saves. Bressler has allowed 114 hits, 50 runs (40 earned) and struck out 160 while walking 51. Alanna Thiede has appeared in 21 games with 12 starts and one complete game, throwing 68.0 innings. Thiede carries a 4.12 ERA with 66 hits and 44 runs (40 earned) allowed, while walking 28 and striking out 69. Jasmine Martin has a 4.20 ERA with 18 appearances, seven starts, four complete games and two saves. Martin has thrown 56.2 innings with 64 hits and 37 runs (34 earned) allowed. Martin has struck out 50 and walked 25.
- Individually, Sofia Morales leads the conference in overall batting average at .419 with April Visser second in on-base percentage (.522) and home runs (14), and third in slugging percentage (.800) and runs scored (39). Mia Trejo is third in RBI at 44 and tied for seventh in hits (47).
- In conference games, Visser is second in on-base percentage (.527) and tied for third in batting average (.390), home runs (five) and slugging percentage (.780).
- Jenny Bressler is second in the MW in ERA (1.78), batters struck out and opposing batting average (.198), but leads the conference in innings pitched (157.1) and wins (19). In conference games, she leads in ERA (1.10), innings pitched (70.0) and batters struck out (82).
- April Visser leads with 17 hits and five home runs and is tied for the team lead with 17 RBI in conference games.
