### New Mexico Game Storylines

✓ Maine begins its 130th season of football when it travels for its first ever meeting with New Mexico. The contest will mark the furthest the Black Bears have traveled for a regular season game (2,458 miles) since taking on Hawai'i in 1990 (5,147). Maine is 63-59-5 all-time in its season openers. The Black Bears will be looking for their first road season opening win since defeating Norfolk State in 2013. This is Maine's first time opening its season at a Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) opponent since a 24-21 loss at UConn in 2016.

✓ Maine will be looking for its fifth win against a FBS opponent in school history. This will be Maine's 28th time in which it has matched up against an FBS program. The Black Bears have three wins against FBS opponents; a 35-10 win last season at UMass (2021); a 31-28 win against Western Kentucky in 2018, a 24-14 win over UMass in 2013, and a 9-7 triumph at Mississippi State in 2004. Maine is 4-23 all-time against FBS level programs.

✓ First-year head coach Jordan Stevens (Maine '10) takes on New Mexico in his first action as head coach of his alma mater. Maine returns 14 starters (8 Off./7 Def.) including quarterback Joe Fagnano, leading rusher Freddie Brock (720 yd/7 TDs), All-CAA tight end Shawn Bowman, and All-CAA center Michael Gerace. Maine also welcomes back four of its top six tacklers from a year ago including leading returner Adrian Otero (63 tkls). Fagnano enters the season ranked 11th on Maine's all-time passing yards list (3,424) and has been extremely efficient with just six interceptions in 408 career attempts.

✓ The Lobos, picked sixth in the six team Mountain West Mountain Division preseason poll, enter the season coming off a 3-9 campaign, 1-7 in Mountain West action. Led by third-year head coach Danny Gonzalez, a New Mexico alum, New Mexico looks to turn things around after finishing last in FBS in yards per game (235) in 2021 while averaging just 12.2 points. The Lobos will start Kansas transfer Miles Kendrick at quarterback. On defense, the Lobos allowed 28.4 points per game. The Lobos lost each of their top three rushers from a year ago along with starting QB Terry Wilson Jr. but return top receiver Luke Wysong. On defense, the Lobos welcome back top tackler Jerrick Reed II (89).

✓ The Black Bears return three starters on an offensive line which ranked third in the CAA and 22nd in all of FCS after allowing just 1.36 sacks per game. Since 2015, no CAA team has allowed fewer sacks than Maine. The Black Bears led the CAA and ranked third in the nation a year ago with just nine turnovers lost on the season.

## JORDAN STEVENS, HEAD COACH

Jordan Stevens ('10), was named the 37th head football coach at UMaine on Dec. 7, 2021.

Stevens, an All-CAA third team selection with the Black Bears before serving a four-year stint as an assistant coach at UMaine, returned home to Orono after spending the previous seven seasons on staff at Yale.

Stevens played for the Black Bears from 2006-2009 before mentoring Maine's defensive line in an assistant coaching role from March 2011 through February 2015.

A native of Temple, Maine, Stevens mentored nine All-Ivy League players and a pair of All-Colonial Athletic Association honorees during his 11-year assistant coaching career with Yale and UMaine. While at Yale, Stevens spent his first three seasons as the defensive line coach with the Bulldogs before being elevated to assistant head coach and co-defensive coordinator, working specifically with the linebackers, in Jan. 2018. After spending one season working with the linebackers, Stevens returned to his roots, switching back to mentoring the defensive line in a role he would serve from Jan. 2019 until the end of his stint with the Bulldogs.

Stevens served a key role in leading Yale to Ivy League titles in 2017 and, as the assistant head coach and co-defensive coordinator, again in 2019 as the Bulldogs finished both title seasons with a 9-1 mark. In 2017, Stevens helped mentor a defensive unit which led the Ivy League in total defense (302.8 yards per game allowed); scoring defense (15.6 points allowed); rushing defense (73.1 rush yards allowed); third down conversion percentage defense (29.9 percent); and tackles for loss (85). The Bulldogs' numbers were not just impressive against their Ivy League peers but also ranked in the top-10 in the nation in scoring defense, rushing defense, third down conversion percentage defense, and tackles for loss during the 2017 campaign.

The 2021 season saw Yale post some of its best defensive marks in recent history as the unit, under the guidance of Stevens as co-defensive coordinator, led the nation in third down conversion percentage defense (22.1), ranked ninth nationally in sacks per game (3.2/32 total), and checked in 23rd in all of the Football Championship Subdivision in rush defense after allowing just 117.1 yards per game on the ground.

Yale consistently progressed on the defensive side of the ball under Stevens' leadership. In his first season with the defensive line, the Bulldogs posted six sacks and 19 tackles for loss. Three years later, under the direction of Stevens, Yale turned those statistical numbers into 22.5 sacks and 44.5 tackles for loss as the Bulldogs would post 18 or more sacks in three of the last four seasons and 34 or more tackles for loss in four of the last five years.

Stevens began his coaching career at the University of Maine, serving two seasons as the assistant defensive line coach before a two-year stint as the lead defensive line coach at his alma mater in Orono. Stevens, who mentored NFL Draft Pick and two-time All-CAA selection Trevor Bates and All-CAA second team selection and Maine's career sack leader Michael Cole, helped guide the Black Bears to the NCAA FCS Playoffs in 2011 and to a CAA Championship and another trip to the NCAA FCS Playoffs in 2013. Maine's Black Hole defense was impressive during Stevens' time at UMaine, posting the top ranked scoring defense and red zone defense in 2012, the CAA's fourth ranked total defense in 2013, and the CAA's second ranked total defense, 16th in the nation, in 2014.

An All-CAA third team selection at defensive end, UMaine's Most Valuable Player, and a New England Football Writers FCS All-Star selection in 2009, Stevens enjoyed an impressive four-year career with the Black Bears. Stevens appeared in 45 games at UMaine while registering 184 tackles, 24 sacks, 16.0 tackles for loss, three pass breakups, three fumble recoveries, five forced fumbles, while logging a pair of safeties. In 2008, Stevens guided the Black Bears to an appearance in the NCAA FCS Playoffs.

Following his playing career with the Black Bears, Stevens participated in NFL Rookie Mini Camp with the Detroit Lions before signing with the Hartford Colonials of the United Football League for Mini and Training Camp in 2010.

Stevens earned his Bachelor of Science in Business Administration - Management from UMaine in 2010. A Mt. Blue high school graduate, Stevens and his wife, Ellen, have one daughter, Noella and son, Carson.

Maine is 0-1 all-time against Mountain West opponents after suffering a 44-3 loss at Hawai'i on Oct. 6, 1990 ... Maine is 4-23 all-time against FBS opponents ... The Black Bears earned their fourth ever win over an FBS opponent when they defeated UMass, 35-10, last season ... Maine has also scored FBS wins over Western Kentucky (31-28, 2018); UMass (24-14, 2013); and Mississippi State (9-7, 2004). This meeting marks Maine's 28th all-time game against an FBS opponent.

In over 680 instances in college football history, an FBS team has led an FCS opponent by more than 10 points and only five times have they lost the game. Maine has come back from down 10 twice to defeat an FBS team (down 21 at Western Kentucky in 2018, down 10 at UMass in 2021).

## Season Notes

### STEVENS AT THE HELM

- Jordan Stevens (Maine '10) begins his tenure as head coach of the Black Bears in 2022 after being named the 37th head coach in the program's 130 year history on Dec. 7, 2021.
- Stevens, who spent time on Maine's staff as an assistant for four seasons (2011-14) before a seven-year stint at Yale.
- Stevens was an All-CAA third team selection for Maine and racked up 184 tackles, 24 sacks, and 16.0 TFLs in 45 games for the Black Bears.

### NEW FACES

- The Black Bears feature six new faces on the coaching staff this season (Kugler - OL; Anthony Murray - DL; McEntire - DB; Walsh - STC/CB; Carey - OLB; Brown - RBs) while also seeing Coach Keyte in his first year as DC.

### CARRY THE MOMENTUM

- Maine ended the 2021 season by winning five of its final six games. Over the stretch, Maine held its opponents to 18.0 ppg, including limiting FBS opponent UMass to just 10 points as the Black Bears scored the victory over the FBS program, 35-10.

### SACK PREVENTION

- The Black Bears' pass protection ranked third in the league and 22nd nationally in 2021, allowing just 1.36 sacks per game.
- Maine has now surrendered just nine sacks over its last nine games.
- Maine held its opponent sack-less in five games last season, including in both of its FBS games (at Northern Illinois, at UMass).

### FAGNANO CLIMBING THE QB CHARTS

- Fagnano currently ranks 11th on Maine's all-time passing yards list at 3,424.
- Fagnano now stands just 1,069 yards away from matching Bob Wilder for 10th all-time (4,493).
- Fagnano has notched three 300+ yards passing performances in his career.

### FAGNANO EFFICIENTLY CONSISTENT

- Fagnano has been the definition of consistent through his time at

Maine with just **four** interceptions in 334 attempts to go along with a completion percentage of 62.7.

### RUSHING RETURN

- The Black Bears return their four top ball carriers from a year ago including Freddie Brock (132 attempts/720 yds/7 TDs) and Elijah Barnwell (117 attempts/514 yds/4 TDs).

### BROCK IN THE ENDZONE

- Freddie Brock has tallied a touchdown in each of his last six games and eight of his last nine.

### BLACK HOLE

- Maine's 'Black Hole' defense welcomes back including three-year starter Adrian Otero (27 straight starts, 63 tkls in 2021); last year's interception leader in Kahzir 'Buggs' Brown (3 INTs), and Khairi Manns who tied for the team lead with 3.0 sacks in 2021. Maine also features veterans Jamehl Wiley (26 starts) and Josh Lezin (15 starts) on its defensive front.

### PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- Graduate offensive lineman Michael Gerace was named to the CAA Preseason All-Conference Team. Gerace has started 35 games for the Black Bears, including 34 consecutive.
- Freddie Brock and Shawn Bowman each received CAA Preseason Honorable Mention nods.

### CAPTAINS

- Following a team vote, the Black Bears elected four captains for the 2022 fall season. Seniors Joe Fagnano and Michael Gerace each earned the honor for the second consecutive season while Adrian Otero and Shawn Bowman were each elected captains for the first time.

- Since the spring of 2019, Maine has added 24 transfers/graduate transfers to its roster.
