Game Week Media Schedule

New Mexico Weekly Press Conference (and Lunch is we get super lucky)

In the fall, the New Mexico Weekly Press Conference is Tuesday from noon to 1 p.m. Coach Danny Gonzales is available at 12:15 p.m. after the other fall sport coaches. Audio and video clips are available from the UNM communications office, and also at www.golobos.com. The press conferences are also streamed on GoLobos.com by LoboTV. Please note that the Mountain West no longer conducts a football coaches teleconference. The press conference is on the third floor of the Tow Diehm Football Complex, and if all the COVID rules behave themselves and we get lucky, maybe there's food. Maybe.

Danny Gonzales Interview Opportunities

Coach Gonzales is available after practice on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday during game week. After road games, Coach Gonzales will be available via ZOOM (links will be sent to participating media).

New Mexico Player Interview Opportunities

All player interviews must be arranged through the UNM athletics communications office. In the fall, the main time for interviews is after practice. Wednesday is the last day for player interviews. For lengthier interviews, please call the communications office to arrange a better time that is more conducive to the interview. Generally, players are not off-limits unless they have done something that would cause them to well, be off limits. Player interviews can be arranged on Thursdays if needed, but generally I like to give them a break after Wednesday. The starting quarterback for the week will address the media on Tuesday prior to the press conference.

Postgame: The UNM locker room is closed. Requested players will be brought to the weight room in the Tow Diehm football building and outside the locker room for road games. UNM communications will have coach Gonzales and two players address the media, and other players that are needed for one-on-ones may be requested. The student-athletes will be available after the press conferences for one-on-one opportunities. For road games, we will have ZOOM press conferences. UNM media that isn't in the stadium, ZOOM links will be sent day of the game.

Wireless in the Press Box

The press box at University Stadium is fully equipped for wireless connections. Access is free, but those wanting access need their own internal or external wireless cards. Phone lines are available. The new wifi installed in 2019 has worked great and the password is located on the name cards in the press box. If you have been to the press box before, it's the same password because the Assistant A.D. for Communications doesn't remember how to change the password, much like his home internet.

On Game Day, the northeast box office at University Stadium opens four hours prior to kickoff, and the Lobo Ticket Office at University Arena opens three hours before game time. The northwest University Stadium box office opens 90 minutes before kickoff.

Lobo Talk & The Lobo Coaches Show

In the fall, host Robert Portnoy and coach Danny Gonzales discuss UNM football at Lobo Talk on Thursdays. The show airs from 7-8 p.m. from Salt Yard East. Fans can call 866-350-4309 to ask coach Gonzales a question. Also in the fall, the Lobo Coaches Show will be produced by LoboTV, with the show airing on Wednesday nights at 10 pm on My50-TV.

Game Credentials

Regular UNM media will receive game credentials prior to the start of the season. Season credentials doubles as a parking pass for the Baseball East lot across from the stadium (the one-year experiment of Baseball South was mercifully ended)

Visiting team media should request single-game credentials through their team's media relations office. Media passes work as parking passes for the Baseball South lots.

Media members not associated directly with a team can email requests via our media request link, which is located near the top of the football page on GoLobos.com under "Credential Request Form". It's hard to miss (yet it happens...)

For media members picking up credentials at will call without parking passes, it is located in the Northeast corner of the stadium by Gate 7 or 8. With parking passes credentials will be located at the University Drive entrance to the Baseball South lot with the parking attendant. This should allow you to get your credential without having to wait in line or deal with parking on the north side of the stadium.

Parking

Media parking is located across and just south of the stadium off University Drive. Media members can park in the Baseball East lot which is located next to University Drive. The Baseball East lot entrance is off University Drive south directly across from the Stadium West lot entrance, and it's the driveway between Santa Ana Star Field and the Davalos Practice Center. Reminder, you can only right turn into the parking lot.

Visiting Radio

The visiting radio booth is located on the fourth level of the main press box, next to the main media area.

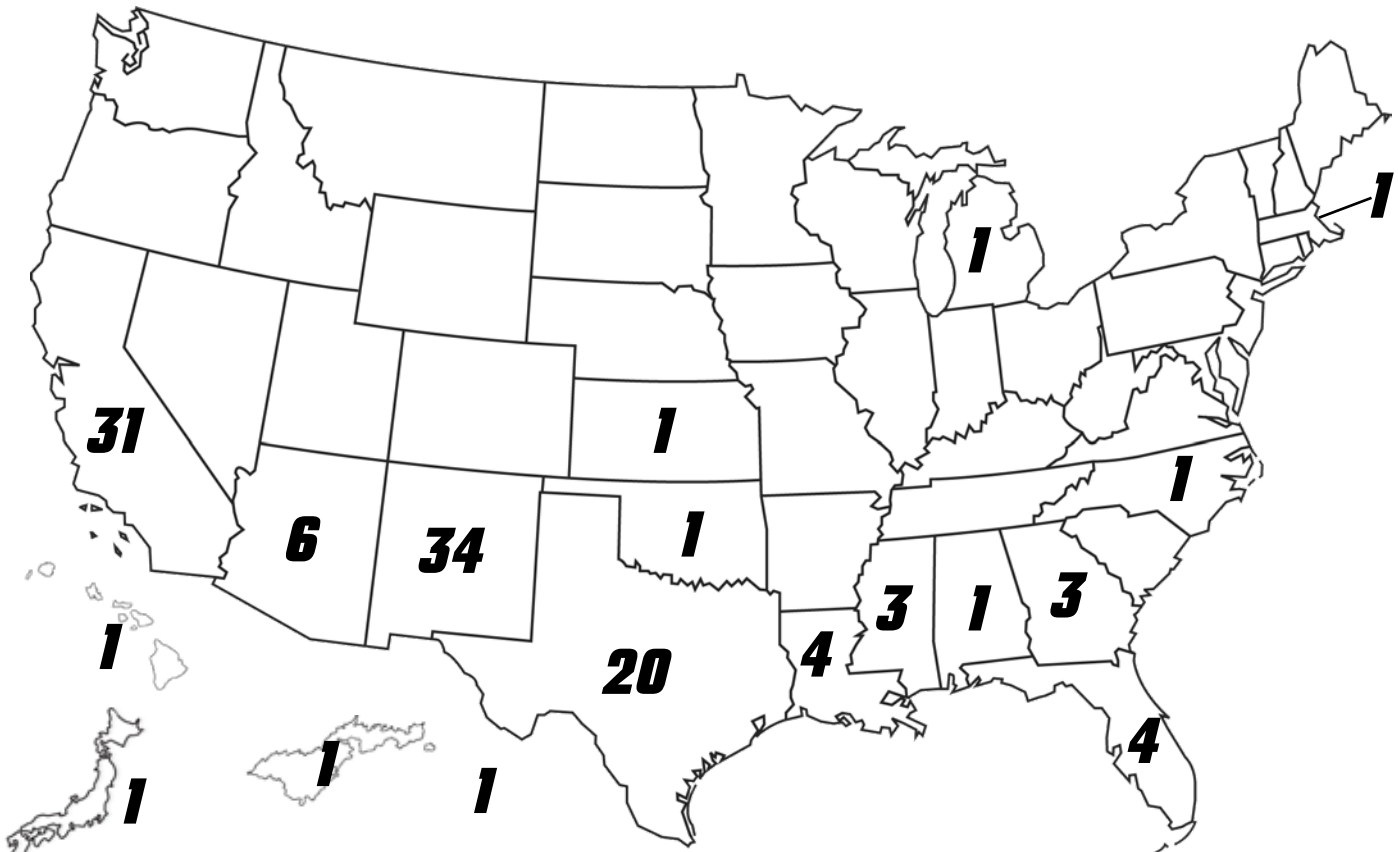

The Opening List

September 9 might seem early for a conference opener, and it is the earliest since the 2011 opener on September 3 against Colorado State. It's great to open at home, but UNM is looking to end a three-game Mountain West opening losing streak.

The bad news is New Mexico is just 6-17 all-time in Mountain West openers, but UNM is actually 3-4 in the last seven. The Lobos will be opening the conference play at home for the second straight year after four in a row on the road. The Lobos traditionally opened Mountain West play at home doing so every year from 2007 to 2014, but that was part of a nine-year losing streak in openers.

UNM has only opened with Boise State twice, but both were close games. The listing of all UNM's Mountain West opening games is the subject of a very apropos Opening List.

Shutout Shutout

OK, we knew that UNM's defense was better, and this year's version should be better than last year's version, but the defensive effort was better than advertised on Saturday night as the Lobos held a very good FCS offensive team in Maine to 0 points and seven first downs. We will get to the first downs in a minute, but the shutout was UNM's first in 81 games, since winning 66-0 over Mississippi Valley State on September 5, 2015.

Since the modern era of Lobo Football (since the end of World War II starting in 1946), over 87 seasons, New Mexico has only pitched a shutout in the opener four times, and Saturday's 41-0 whitewashing of Maine was just the second such shutout in the last 47 seasons, with just that Mississippi Valley State shutout in that time frame. The other two were a 29-0 win over Fresno State in 1975 and a 78-0 win over Northern Arizona in 1950.

However, in those 87 seasons, which encompass 853 games, the Lobos have only had a larger margin of victory in a shutout six times, and two of those were by a point (reminder, we missed an extra point Saturday or this is an even smaller list. It's still cool that fans haven't gotten to see performances like that very often, and those other six shutouts, all more than 41 points, are the subject of a very successful opening list:

All That Research Paid Off In Week One

UNM's Director of Communications Steve Kirkland did a massive revision of the Lobo Basketball Record book prior to the 2021-22 season. Not to be outdone, the Lobo Football Record Book received a major revision over the past summer, and one of the things that was researched were first down records, particularly a complete list of the most first downs in a game, and the fewest first downs allowed.

Hot damn, it paid off in week one. Maine didn't get a first down in the first half, and just seven for the entire game (three of which were gifted on personal fouls of unsportsmanlike conduct, pass interference and targeting).

Turns out, the seven first downs allowed is tied for the 11th fewest in school history, and it was the fewest since allowing six against Sacramento State on September 22, 2007. Here's that list, which took a while to figure out, so read it please.

Blackjack Baby

OK, we do go to Vegas, but not for three more weeks. Instead, this is about the 21 points UNM put up in the second quarter on Saturday. Listen, a lot of teams can score 21 in a quarter (it's already happened 44 times in the opening two weeks of the season). But for UNM, the 21 was significant. It was the most points in a quarter in the Danny Gonzales era, tying the 21 in the fourth quarter against Fresno State on December 12, 2020 in a game played in Las Vegas.

However, here's where the 21 points is important. That second quarter outscored each of the last 10 games of the 2021 season. In those 10 games, UNM never scored more than 17 points in a game, and that came in a 31-17 loss to UNLV. UNM's points in the last 10 games went as follows: 0, 13, 10, 7, 7, 14, 17, 7, 0, 10. UNM had six offensive touchdowns in the game against Maine, and had just eight in the final 10 games last year as UNM lost all of its quarterbacks to injuries.

Rush To Judgment

We would never ever rush to judgment, but New Mexico's rushing game looked pretty good on Saturday. In fact it was better than anything we saw in 2021, because the yardage showed it.

New Mexico rushed for 267 yards on the day (it was 273 until the team took a 6-yard loss on a knee at the end of the game) and that 267 was a bigger total than any game in 2021. The best New Mexico ever did last year was 260 yards rushing in a 31-17 loss to UNLV. That was the only game in 2021 that New Mexico rushed for over 200 yards as the next best was 188 against New Mexico State.

UNM's 267 yards rushing was the most since the finale of the 2020 season when the Lobos rushed for 299 yards against Fresno State on December 12 in a home game that was played in Las Vegas where UNM set up shop for 43 days to play the entire 2020 season.

It Was a Long Time Ago...

November 24, 1990 was a long time ago. Famed American composer Aaron Copland was still alive, as was Red Grange, Danny Thomas and Dr. Seuss. Singer Rita Ora wasn't born yet and Modern Family actress Sarah Hyland was born on that day.

That day was also Rocky Long's final game as the defensive backs coach at TCU, and it was forgetful for him, a 56-10 loss to Texas A&M. Long coached in the press box for that game. He then became the defensive coordinator at from 1991-95 at Oregon State, the DC at UCLA from 1996-97, the head coach at New Mexico from 1998-2008, the DC at San Diego State from 2009-2010, the head coach at SDSU from 2011 to 2019, and then the defensive coordinator back at New Mexico from then on. For every one of those games over those 32 years, totaling 373 games, was spent coaching on the sidelines.

That streak ended on Saturday as Long coached from the press box for the first time since November 24, 1990. For Coach Gonzales and Coach Long, they wanted for Rocky to be able to get a bird's eye view and call defenses and plays from the box, with the defensive being signaled in from the sidelines.

After shutting out Maine on Saturday, it's still be 32 years since Rocky Long saw his defensive allow a point from the press box.

Overall, UNM used 64 players on Saturday, meaning that 42.2% of the players in the game were making their Lobo debuts. Additionally, of the 64 players to play, 38 of them (59.3%) were freshmen or sophomores.

Just Keep Swimming

New Mexico went 3-9 in 2021, but that improved the win total from 2020. What's ever better is the amount of production and games played by UNM's young guns.

Due to COVID, UNM used 20 true freshman in 2020 and all of those seasons for those players effectively was like a redshirt season, even though a guy like Tavian Combs was listed as a true sophomore in 2021 and will enter 2022 as a junior.

Here are all the players returning that either started a game, or been a contributor during their first two seasons that still have as many as three years of eligibility remaining (the number in parenthesis is how many seasons of eligibility each player has left entering the 2022 season).

Neil Armstrong, Kathy Sullivan ... Alec Marengo?

There are many famous firsts in American history. Everyone knows who the first person to step foot on the moon was (spoiler alert, it's Neil Armstrong). Everyone should know who the first baseball player to hit 700 home runs was, because we all know Babe Ruth). Everyone should know who the first President of the United States was (I'm not dignifying that one ... you all know who it is).

Then there are the non-famous firsts. First female astronaut to walk in space? That's Kathy Sullivan. First child born in the American colonies? Virginia Dare in 1587. How about the first woman to receive a medical degree? That was Dr. Elizabeth Blackwell in 1849.

Well now there is another famous first that won't make a lot of waves, but it will around here, and that is Alec Marengo. He will go down in history as the first player to have a successful appeal of a targeting penalty. New in 2022, teams can appeal a targeting penalty to the NCAA, where it is ruled upon with a committee led by Steve Shaw, who oversees all officiating for football. That committee met and determined that Alec Marengo's targeting penalty didn't meet the criteria, and so his ejection and subsequent first half suspension against Boise State was overturned.

Can We Please Call Luke Wysong "Biff"?

Luke Wysong is part of a fun little family tree for Lobo Football with father Adam and his uncle Ben both former Lobos. Luke last year had a dazzling rookie campaign, where he led UNM in receptions and yards while also serving as the teams' leading punt returner and kickoff returner. He earned a slot on the All-Mountain West honorable mention squad for his punt returning prowess, but he could have honestly made it for all three.

UNLV's rookie quarterback Cameron Friel was named the Mountain West's Freshman of the Year, but there was certainly a case to vote for Wysong. Among all Mountain West freshmen, he finished first in receiving yards, receptions, receiving yards per game, kickoff returns and all-purpose yardage, and despite being a wide receiver he finished second in rushing yards.

Wysong had himself a game in the opener, leading UNM with 128 yards of all-purpose yardage, catching three passes for 51 yards, rushing six times for 43 yards and returning three punts for 34 yards. He also scored the first two offensive touchdowns of his career, one rushing and one receiving.

Luke has no relation to Harlan "Biff" Wysong, who pitched for the Cincinnati Reds from 1930-32, so the nickname is open.

Initially, We Like This Team

This feel unheard of, but on a roster of 115, there are nine guys on the team that use initials for first names. There are three CJs (CJ Montes CJ James, and C.J. Henry), two A.J.'s (A.J. Odums and A.J. Haulcy, and then JD Roberts, DJ Wingfield, J.C. Davis and OJ Bartley. It could be worse as Dennis Hayden goes by DJ, and Tristan White goes by TJ, but honestly, we didn't want to change those so close to the season.

Only The Young

Only the Young was recorded by Journey for its 1983 album Frontiers, but then pulled and eventually released on the VisionQuest Soundtrack, hitting No. 9. While New Mexico has some upperclassmen, they are truly a case of "Only the Young" New Mexico has 84 underclassman on a roster of 115. Now that isn't close to the most in the country, as Navy, Army and Nebraska have ridiculous roster sizes, so they each have over 100 underclassmen. UNM ranks 16th in terms of most underclassmen ... BUT If you go by percentage? UNM sits as the eighth-youngest team in the nation.

Lobos in the NFL

Jason Sanders **Miami Dolphins** **Kicker**
 Sanders is in his fifth season with Miami after getting drafted in the seventh round by Miami. Over his first four seasons he was 134-for-137 on extra points in his career and 100-for-120 on field goals, with a long of 56. He has hit 224 of 310 kickoffs for touchbacks. He was named to the PFWA 2018 All-Rookie Team and is Miami's all-time leader in field goal accuracy. He has four game-winning field goals in the final two minutes and in overtime, and he also has a touchdown reception in his career. He led the NFL in field goals and points in 2020.

Corey Bojorquez **Cleveland Browns** **Punter**
 Bojorquez is in his first season with Cleveland and one year with Green Bay and his first three with Buffalo. He spent the 2018 camp with New England after earning an invite to tryout camp and then getting signed to a free agent contract. He was snagged off waivers by Buffalo and started for three seasons. He then signed a free agent contract with the L.A. Rams, but was traded to Green Bay right before the 2021 season. He has played in 57 career games with a 45.5 career average. In 2020 Bojorquez led the NFL with a 50.0-yard average, just the fourth 50.0-yard average in NFL history. Last year his 82-yard punt was the longest in the NFL.

D'Angelo Ross **Miami Dolphins** **Cornerback**
 Ross is in his first season with Miami after spending two with New England. With the Patriots he saw action in three games in 2021, totaling three tackles.

Lobo Leaps and Bounds

It took all of two years, but Head Coach Danny Gonzales has turned the Lobo defensive unit into a major strength heading into the 2022 spring season and beyond. Last season UNM's defense, coordinated by Rocky Long, ranked 44th overall in total defense, a 57-spot improvement from 2020.

Overall, UNM allowed 363.1 yards per game, and that was the lowest total in 13 seasons, since the 2008 team allowed 335.8 yards per game. UNM ranked 44th overall, and the 2008 team ranked 45th. 2021's ranking was the best since 2007, when UNM ranked 13th in total defense at 319.9 yards per game.

The Lobos rushing defense stood at 143.2 yards per game, better than a 20-yard per game improvement from 2020, and it was the best rushing defense since 2008 when UNM ranked 26th at 122.3 yards per game. Passing-wise, UNM allowed just 219.8 passing yards per game to rank 54th, an incredible adjustment from 2019 when the passing defense allowed 321.4 yards per game and ranked 130th (last) in the FBS. It was UNM's best passing defense since 2010 when the unit ranked 53rd at 218.8 yards per game.

And UNM's passing defense goes back further than last year. If you count the final four games of the 2020 season, when UNM allowed just 750 passing yards (a 187.5 average after allowing 1,231 yards, or 410.3 per game over the first three), the Lobos have allowed just 211.8 yards through the air over the last 16 games.

The common denominators of course are Gonzales and Long, who were here in 2008. Here is the chart of UNM's defensive success this year, and UNM's defensive numbers and rankings going back to 2007. We will add a very early version of 2022 as well.

The Lobos defensively saw improvements not just in the yards and rankings as they had plenty of other major improvements. Along with the passing yards, the teams' passing efficiency defense was greatly improved as well. UNM opponents had a 131.99 passer rating, ranking 59th in the country. In 2020 UNM ranked 120th allowing opponents to pass at a 162.92 clip.

The Lobos also averaged 5.3 team tackles for a loss, besting the 4.6 last year, an improvement of 29 slots up to 81. UNM also improved 19 slots in both third-down defensive conversion percentage and total first downs allowed.

The Lobos individually had several big improvements, the biggest on special teams. Punter Aaron Rodriguez averaged 42.8 yards per punt, ranking 44th, one year after UNM averaged 40.4 yards per punt (Tyson Dyer) who ranked 72nd. Luke Wysong ranked among the national leaders in total kickoff returns (65th), punt return touchdowns (5th) and kickoff returns (54th). Joey Noble ranked fourth nationally in TFLs per game.

The Lobos saw most of that improvement despite seven starters playing on the same defense two years ago in 2019 (Langston Murray, Joey Noble, Reco Hannah, Devin Sanders, Corey Hightower, Jerrick Reed II and Donte Martin.)

UNM enters the 2022 season with returning starters Jake Saltonstall, Syaire Riley, Ray Leutele, Donte Martin, Ronald Wilson, Jerrick Reed II and Tavian Combs, plus plenty of other contributors and redshirts.

Interesting Stat

1

That's the number of times in 20 games in the Danny Gonzales era that the Lobos didn't open the game with the ball. UNM has elected to receive every time they have won the toss, and only Houston Baptist didn't defer when winning the opening coin toss.

Switch 'Em Up

For the second straight year, a graduate transfer will be the opening game starter as Miles Kendrick will take over the reins at QB1, meaning UNM will have a different starting quarterback for the opener against this year (and next year as Kendrick is in his final year of eligibility). In the last 12 seasons, only one time has UNM had the season opening game starter in back-to-back seasons, and that was in 2013 and 2014, when Cole Gautsche started both openers.

The Return of the Sand Beast

UNM's top two rushers from 2021 are no longer with the program, as Bobby Cole went the grad transfer route and Aaron Dumas went the regular ol' transfer route. However, UNM does return its No. 2 rusher from the 2020 season in Nate Jones. Nicknamed Sand Beast, Jones rushed for 232 yards and four touchdowns in the abbreviated COVID season in which he played in six games as a true freshman.

Jones sat out the 2021 season as a redshirt, working on the practice and scout squads and basically working his way back into the team after opting to leave after Spring practice in 2021 and then returning. Now, having done everything asked of the coaching staff, he joins a young but talented crew of running backs. Chad Alexander and Bobby Wooden are the veterans (although Wooden just started at running back last season and is a junior with three years of eligibility left). The Lobos also have a few highly touted newcomers in JC transfer Sherod White and Helix High sensation Christian Washington.

The Streak Restarts at One

The Lobos missed on extra point after its fifth touchdown, as George Steinkamp pushed his attempt wide to the right. It ended a streak of 42 straight made extra points that dated back to November 26, 2019. In that game, the Lobos actually missed three extra points, as Andrew Shelley missed the first one, Donovan Murphree then missed a second and had the third one blocked. Andrew Shelley made the final kick of the afternoon, the final point in a 38-25 loss.

Steinkamp in 2020 hit the first eight extra points of the season before Donovan Murphree hit the final 12. Andrew Shelley returned to the kicking role in 2021 and hit all 17 extra points last year. Steinkamp then hit the first four this year.

I Mean We Would Recommend Him

If you go to the Urban Dictionary (and be careful if you do...), it will tell you that "reco" is short for recommend. Certainly, Danny Gonzales would recommend that Reco Hannah play all the time. Hannah missed a good chunk of the 2021 season with an injury, and by the time he came back, the Lobos used him in just four games, so Hannah redshirted.

Now, as a redshirt senior, he made an impact twice, registering a solo sack and a fumble recovery. UNM was able to turn that fumble recovery into a score, and it marked the first time since the Wyoming game last year that UNM scored off a turnover.

Hannah, despite being a veteran of four seasons, the game on Saturday was just his 20th, and only the eighth in the last three seasons. This Friday's game with Boise State will mark the first time in his career that he will have started multiple games in the same season.

Series History vs. Boise State

Boise State has the all-time lead in the series 11-1, but that one was fun. The Lobos knocked off the Broncos 31-24 in 2015 to get bowl eligible for the first time in eight years, winning the game as a 30.5-point underdog, what at the time was the eighth-biggest upset in terms of the point-spread in NCAA history (according to Teddy Feinberg).

That game will live forever in Lobo lore due to the final wild play that saw Boise State lateral the ball all the way to the Lobo 4-yard line, where Austin Cottrell was tackled by Markel Byrd. Byrd would lose his life in a car accident about five weeks later, right after UNM's bowl game against Arizona.

In a nod to the traditions of the past, and a bridge between that past and the present, Gonzales talked with the owners (or in one case, family) of those retired numbers, and came up with a brilliant idea.



Two of those numbers are now officially "unretired", and those are 42, worn by Bobby Santiago, and 44, worn by Brian Urlacher. Santiago, someone Gonzales looked up to (and who still comes around to practices) was perhaps the greatest football player to come out of the metro area. So, each season, one metro area player will be selected to wear Santiago's 42. For the second straight year, Dion Hunter of Rio Rancho will wear Santiago's 42 (instead of his 41) Urlacher, the best football player to come out of UNM and a native of Lovington, was a ferocious defender who did it all. Hang Ten

Against Maine, the Lobos turned in 17 plays of 10 yards or more, which is nearly 20% of last season's entire total for the 2021 campaign. Last year UNM was one of two teams to not register 100 10-yard plays in the season. New Mexico had 99 plays of 10 or more yards over the 12-game season, and only Navy had fewer, with just 97.

Mathis Placed on NFF/College Hall of Fame Ballot

The National Football Foundation (NFF) & College Hall of Fame announced the names on the 2023 ballot for induction into the College Football Hall of Fame, including 80 players and nine coaches from the Football Bowl Subdivision and 96 players and 33 coaches from the divisional ranks. Among the nominees is former Lobo Terance Mathis, who will seek to become the second Lobo to earn enshrinement into the National Football Foundation (NFF) & College Hall of Fame.

Mathis lettered at UNM from 1985-87 and 1989, playing for Joe Lee Dunn and Mike Sheppard. He finished his career as the first player (and still the only player) in school history with 250 receptions, 4,000 receiving yards and 6,000 all-purpose yards. He still holds several school records, including career receptions (263), career receiving yards (4,254), single season receiving yards (1,315), career touchdown receptions (36), single-season touchdown receptions (13) and touchdown receptions in a game (3). Additionally, his five straight 100-yard receiving games still stands as a school record.

The announcement of the 2023 College Football Hall of Fame Class will be made in early 2023, with specific details to be announced in the future. Danny Gonzales, a native of Albuquerque who played football at Valley High School before playing for UNM and then serving as an assistant coach, has come home. Gonzales, who has taken part in bowl games in 14 of the past 16 seasons, enters his third season as the head coach of The University of New Mexico. Gonzales was hired on December 17, 2019. The announcement was made by Director of Athletics Eddie Nuñez at halftime of a Lobo men's basketball game, and then he was formally introduced at a press conference the next day in The Pit. The new Lobo head coach is certainly familiar with UNM, as a player, staff member and as a Lobo assistant coach, as well as through his time coaching against UNM. He joined his mentor and former coach Rocky Long as Lobo football players returning to coach their alma mater. In a 2006 article in the Albuquerque Journal, Long predicted that Gonzales would one day be the head coach of the Lobos.

Last year, Gonzales for the second straight season increased UNM's win total, including a win in his inaugural matchup with New Mexico State, winning 34-25. The Lobo defense made huge strides in 2021 as Gonzales works to get UNM back to the Lobo defenses of the 2000s. The Lobos ranked 44th overall in total defense, a 57-spot improvement from 2020.

Overall, UNM allowed 363.1 yards per game, and that was the lowest total in 13 seasons, since the 2008 team allowed 335.8 yards per game. UNM ranked 44th overall, and the 2008 team ranked 45th. The 2021 teams' ranking was the best since 2007, when UNM ranked 13th in total defense at 319.9 yards per game.

The Lobos rushing defense stood at 143.2 yards per game, better than a 20-yard per game improvement from 2020, and it was the best rushing defense since 2008 when UNM ranked 26th at 122.3 yards per game. Passing-wise, UNM allowed just 219.8 passing yards per game to rank 54th, an incredible adjustment from 2019 when the passing defense allowed 321.4 yards per game and ranked 130th (last) in the FBS. It was UNM's best passing defense since 2010 when the unit ranked 53rd at 218.8 yards per game.

And UNM's passing defense goes back further than just the 2021 season. If you count the final four games of the 2020 season, when UNM allowed just 750 passing yards (a 187.5 average after allowing 1,231 yards, or 410.3 per game over the first three), the Lobos have allowed just 211.8 yards through the air over the last 16 games. The 2021 season also saw UNM deal with adversity that most teams have never seen, losing so many quarterbacks during the year that the Lobos were forced to start a graduate manager at quarterback in the final game of the season.

Gonzales' first season in 2020 was like no other in the history of college football, and while sometimes that type of sentence can be hyperbole ... it's not. Gonzales, without a full spring season and coaching a team that spent what little time in the preseason practicing in groups of five or 10, was also faced with no home games in 2020 due to the global COVID-19 pandemic and the state of New Mexico health order that wouldn't allow for games. Gonzales was able to lead his team through the 2021 season, going 2-5 overall and in the Mountain West. Those two wins, despite the odds stacked against the Lobos, equaled the number of Mountain West wins over the previous three seasons combined.

The 2020 season saw UNM go through four starting quarterbacks, and a fifth who was injured prior to the start of the season. Gonzales proved his coaching mettle, utilizing 21 true freshmen during the season including a true freshman starting walk-on quarterback, just the third true freshman starting quarterback to start an FBS game since 2013. Gonzales also coached Lobo Football's first national award winner as Teton Saltes was named the winner of the Wuerffel Trophy for athletic, academics and community service.

The Lobos quickly established a reputation as a team that never takes plays off and has a hard-hitting, hard-nosed defense. He was rated an "A" hire for UNM by several preseason publications.

Gonzales came to UNM after spending the past two seasons at Arizona State as defensive coordinator, and the previous seven before that as safeties coach and defensive coordinator at San Diego State. In 2018, he was a nominee for the Broyles Award, given to the most outstanding assistant coach in college football.

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- New Mexico's defense was stellar, allowing just 118 yards of offense and only seven first downs, all of which came in the second half and the Lobos never let Maine get inside the 38-yard line as UNM pitched a 41-0 shutout in its season opener. The Lobo shutout was the first since a 66-0 win in the 2015 season opener against Mississippi Valley State.

While the defense was the story, the Lobos revamped offense was clicking all night. UNM put up six touchdowns on 12 possessions (not counting two end of half kneel-downs) and the Lobos totaled 437 yards with 267 yards on the ground and 170 through the air.

Miles Kendrick, starting his first game for UNM as a graduate transfer from Kansas, went 14-for-17 passing for those 170 yards with two touchdowns. He also added 40 yards rushing on 11 carries, and one would never know he suffered a broken leg in 2021.

After an opening quarter that saw Ronald Wilson turn in an interception on the first defensive play of the season and UNM allow just seven yards, the Lobos got themselves on the board in the second three straight drives. Sherod White, earning his first career start, earned a four-yard touchdown, breaking two tackles on the way to the end zone. Luke Wysong then finished off the next two drives, the first on a 13-yard run and the second on a 10-yard pass from Kendrick.

All the while, the Lobo defense was stymieing the Black Bears, who entered the game having won five of its last six and with a veteran offensive team. The Lobos didn't allow a first down in the opening half and just 44 yards, 22 of which came on one play.

In the second half, Maine picked up a few first downs, but UNM never let the Black Bears sniff anything close to the end zone. Reco Hannah picked up a fumble, his first career takeaway as part of a one and half sack night for him, but it was more a team effort. Five Lobos broke up passes and UNM had three sacks and five QB hurries as UNM harassed quarterback Joe Fagnano into a 12-for-27 day for 96 yards with an interception and a lost fumble and -23 yards rushing.

White made it 28-0 with a 3-yard run midway through the quarter, and after Hannah's fumble recovery, true freshman Jah'Mar Sanders scored on a 10-yard run on his first career play to make it 34-0.

Geordon Porter's 7-yard touchdown catch ended the scoring, and the night for Kendrick as well. From there, the only drama was would UNM's defense be able to maintain the shutout, and the Lobos were more than true to the task. Up 41-0 the Lobos turned in a quick three-and-out allowing just a yard. Maine had one more drive left in them and after moving the ball to near midfield, Fagnano threw incomplete with freshmen JD Roberts in his face, the last of UNM's five hurries.
