LOBOS HOSTS CSU PUEBLO IN EXHIBITION

- UNM makes its 2022-23 debut by hosting Division II CSU Pueblo in an exhibition contest
- The game is the lone public exhibition for the Lobos this season
- It is the first of 20 home games at The Pit for New Mexico this season
- CSU Pueblo was picked eighth in the preseason Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference poll

SERIES HISTORY

- In regular season games, UNM leads the series 1-0 (1-0 in The Pit)
- New Mexico defeated CSU Pueblo (then Southern Colorado) 97-71 at The Pit in 1982-83
- The teams have met once before in the preseason, prior to the 2015-16 season, an 96-84 Lobo victory as Cullen Neal scored 33 pts

PRESEASON HISTORY

- New Mexico is 63-6 all-time in preseason exhibitions (all at The Pit)
- Since 2004-05, when the NCAA prohibited exhibitions against non-collegiate teams, the Lobos are 26-1 in exhibitions, with the lone loss coming to BYU in 2017-18 in a fundraiser for Hurricane Harvey relief
- In the 26 exhibition wins against non-Division I colleges, the Lobos' average margin of victory has been 30.7 points with the closest margin being 11 points (80-69 vs. Rogers State in 2015-16)
- New Mexico defeated New Mexico Highlands 101-72 in last year's exhibition game, as Javonte Johnson and KJ Jenkins each had 18 points to lead five Lobos in double figures

MOVING ON UP!

- The Lobos enter the season ranked No. 138 in KenPom, up 156 spots from the final ranking of 2020-21, when Richard Pitino was hired
- New Mexico is the fourth highest mover in KenPom during that time (since April 2021)

PRESEASON POLL

- The Lobos were picked fifth in the preseason Mountain West poll, their highest selection in three years (third in 2019-20)
- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. was named to the five-player preseason All-Mountain West Team, the first Lobo selected since 2016-17 (Elijah Brown and Tim Williams)

TALE OF TWO OFFSEASONS

- The Lobos are returning nine letterwinners, including five starters from last season
- It is significant difference from the previous offseason when UNM returned six letterwinners (four scholarship) and one starter as Richard Pitino took over the program
- New Mexico returns nearly 84% of its scoring from last season, including its top five scorers by total points (Mashburn, House, Jenkins, Allen-Tovar, Johnson)
- UNM returns at least 76% of its rebounding, assists and minutes from 2021-22

CAPTAINS FOR 2022-23

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. and KJ Jenkins were selected as the captains for the 2022-23 Lobos
- Both are serving as captains for the second consecutive year

HOME SWEET HOME IN THE PIT

- Including the exhibition against CSU Pueblo, the Lobos will play 20 games at The Pit this season
- The 19 regular season home games are New Mexico's most since the 2004-05 season when the Lobos went 18-1 at The Pit
- The home schedule includes the return of the Lobo Classic (UNM's first home tournament since 2007-08)

HIGH SCORING DUO BACK

- With Jamal Mashburn, Jr. and Jaelen House returning, New Mexico is one of four Division I schools in the nation to have two 500-point scorers from last season return to the roster this season (North Carolina-3; Northern Colorado; Wyoming)
- Mashburn and House are the third-highest returning scoring duo in the nation at 35.1 combined points per game last season
- Mashburn and House are the second-highest returning scoring duo in New Mexico history, trailing only Elijah Brown/Tim Williams in 2016-17

ON THE AIR

- All 18 on New Mexico's Mountain West games this season will be televised nationally (all on FS1 or CBSSN)
- New Mexico and San Diego State are the only MW teams to have all conference games on national TV
- The last time every UNM conference game was on national TV was 2011-12
