LOBOS MEET NORTH DAKOTA STATE ON DAY TWO OF LOBO CLASSIC

- UNM looks to remain unbeaten by hosting North Dakota State on the second day of the Lobo Classic
- The Lobos are looking to start the season 5-0 for the first time since 2012-13 when they began the season with 12 straight victories
- New Mexico enters the day as one of 26 remaining undefeated teams in Division I

SERIES HISTORY

- First all-time meeting
- North Dakota State is the third of four first-time opponents for the Lobos this season (South Alabama, Jacksonville State, UTSA)
- The Lobos have won 10 straight against first-time opponents, dating back to a loss to Maryland in the 2017 Emerald Classic in Florida

LOBOS VS. BISON

LOBO CLASSIC HISTORY

- This year's event marks the 12th edition of the Lobo Classic, which previously was held at The Pit from 1988-1999
- The Lobos won the title in nine of the previous 11 events (San Diego won 1988, Texas Southern won in 1994)
- It is the first in-season tournament at The Pit since 2007-08 when UNM hosted the Travelers Classic with wins over Presbyterian, St. Bonaventure and Loyola Marymount
- The Lobos are looking for their first November tournament title since winning the Paradise Jam in the US Virgin Islands in 2012-13

LAST TIME OUT

- New Mexico improved to 4-0 with an 79-61 victory over Jacksonville State on Friday
- The Lobos opened the game on a 14-0 run and never trailed
- UNM led 42-21 at the half, its largest halftime lead against a Division I opponent in five seasons (at Colorado State in 2017-18)
- Morris Udeze led the Lobos with 22 points, matching his career high
- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. scored 12 points, his 25th straight game in double figures, the longest active streak in the Mountain West

MOVING ON UP!

- The Lobos are currently ranked No. 109 in KenPom, up 177 spots from the final ranking of 2020-21, when Richard Pitino was hired
- New Mexico is the fourth highest mover in KenPom during that time (since April 2021)

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

- The Lobos rank fourth in the nation in turnover percentage, with a turnover on just 12.1 percent of their possessions this season
- New Mexico ranks third nationally in assist/turnover ratio at 1.97 this season

A NEW LEADING SCORER

- With 22 points on Friday, Morris Udeze now leads the Lobos in scoring this season at 18.0 ppg
- It marks the first time in the Pitino era that UNM's leading scorer was not Jamal Mashburn, Jr. or Jaalen House

HOUSE SCORING AND ASSISTING

- Jaalen House has opened the season strong, both scoring and passing
- With 23 points and seven assists vs. Southern Utah and 21 points and seven assists vs. South Alabama, he was the first Lobo with consecutive 20pt/7asst games since Kendall Williams in 2013-14 (vs. Charleston Southern & UAB)

HOUSE IN RARE COMPANY WITH 7&6 ASSISTS & STEALS

- Jaalen House had seven assists and six steals in the season opener against Southern Utah
- Last year, he had seven assists and eight steals in the win over Grambling State, one of only 20 seven assist/six steal games in Division I in 2021-22, and the only one by a Mountain West player
- Since the start of 2018-19, House is one of 11 players nationally to have multiple 7&6 games against Division I opposition
- House's two career 7&6 games matches the total from every other Mountain West school combined over the last 13 seasons (since 2010-11) [UNLV with one, Wyoming with one]
- House's game against Grambling State last season was the first seven assist/six steal game by a Lobo since a Steve Logan had an eight assist/six steal game at San Diego State in 1993

20-20 VISION WITH MASHBURN & HOUSE

- The season opener marked the fifth time that Jamal Mashburn, Jr. & Jaalen House have both scored at least 20 points in the same game
- They are just the sixth Lobo duo over the past 40 years to have at least five games with both scoring at least 20 points
- House (20.7 ppg) and Mashburn (18.7 ppg) rank first and third in the Mountain West in scoring

LOBO FRONT COURT HAS ITS "MOJO"

- New Mexico's frontcourt of transfers Morris Udeze and Josiah Allick have made an immediate impact over the first three games
- Udeze leads the team in scoring at 18.0 ppg and leads the Mountain West in FG% shooting at 62.5%
- Allick ranks sixth in the MW in rebounding at 8.0 rpg and leads the team with four blocks

DENT WITH THE DISH

- Donovan Dent is tied for the national lead with an 9.0 assist/turnover ratio through the first four games (18 assists/2 turnovers)
- Dent had seven assists in each of the last two games, the most by a Lobo freshman against a Division I opponent since Drue Drinnon had seven against Central Arkansas in 2018-19
- His seven assists were the most by any Lobo off the bench since Vance Jackson had seven against Nevada in 2018-19

PRESEASON POLL

- The Lobos were picked fifth in the preseason Mountain West poll, their highest selection in three years (third in 2019-20)
- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. was named to the five-player preseason All-Mountain West Team, the first Lobo selected since 2016-17 (Elijah Brown and Tim Williams)

TALE OF TWO OFFSEASONS

- The Lobos returned nine letterwinners, including five starters from last season
- It is significant difference from the previous offseason when UNM returned six letterwinners (four scholarship) and one starter as Richard Pitino took over the program
- New Mexico returned nearly 84% of its scoring from last season, including its top five scorers by total points (Mashburn, House, Jenkins, Allen-Tovar, Johnson)
- UNM returned at least 76% of its rebounding, assists and minutes from 2021-22

HOME SWEET HOME IN THE PIT

- Including the exhibition against CSU Pueblo, the Lobos will play 20 games at The Pit this season
- The 19 regular season home games are New Mexico's most since the 2004-05 season when the Lobos went 18-1 at The Pit
- The home schedule includes the return of the Lobo Classic (UNM's first home tournament since 2007-08)

HIGH SCORING DUO BACK

- With Jamal Mashburn, Jr. and Jaelen House returning, New Mexico is one of four Division I schools in the nation to have two 500-point scorers from last season return to the roster this season (North Carolina-3; Northern Colorado; Wyoming)
- Mashburn and House are the second-highest returning scoring duo in the nation at 35.1 combined points per game last season
- Mashburn and House are the second-highest returning scoring duo in New Mexico history, trailing only Elijah Brown/Tim Williams in 2016-17

RETURNING VETERANS

- The Lobos returned nine letterwinners from last year's squad, their most returning players since returning 10 letterwinners in 2016-17
- New Mexico returned its leader in total points (Mashburn), rebounds (Allen-Tovar), assists (House), 3-pointers (Jenkins), blocks (Allen-Tovar) and steals (House)
- The only other year when New Mexico had its top performer in each of those categories return the following year came in 1996-97 when the 1995-96 leaders of Charles Smith (points, 3-pointers, steals), Kenny Thomas (rebounds, blocks) and David Gibson (assists) all returned

RETURNING SCORING

- In addition to its top five scorers returning, New Mexico added two transfers who averaged double figure scoring last season (Josiah Allick - 12.9ppg at Kansas City; Morris Udeze - 10.2ppg at Wichita State)
- When you combine the scoring average of the nine returning players (70.4 ppg) with the two transfers (23.1 ppg), the Lobos' roster features players who combined to average 93.5 points per game at the Division I level last season

ON THE AIR

- All 18 on New Mexico's Mountain West games this season will be televised nationally (all on FS1 or CBSSN)
- New Mexico and San Diego State are the only MW teams to have all conference games on national TV
- The last time every UNM conference game was on national TV was 2011-12

CAPTAINS NAMED

- Redshirt junior guard KJ Jenkins and junior guard Jamal Mashburn, Jr. were named the captains for the 2022-23 season
- Both are serving as a captain for the second straight season for the Lobos

TOPPIN SIGNS WITH UNM

- On Nov. 9, New Mexico signed forward Jady Toppin to a National Letter of Intent to join the Lobos in summer of 2023
- A 6-9 native of Dallas, Toppin helped Faith Family Academy of Oak Cliff to the 2022 Texas Class 4A state championship
- He is the No. 38 ranked power forward nationally and the No. 17 overall player in Texas by 247

- The Lobos conclude the Lobo Classic on Sunday by hosting Northern Colorado
- The UNM-UNC game is the second of the day at 5:30 p.m., with Jacksonville State and North Dakota State playing the first game of the day at 3 p.m.
