TIPPING OFF

The Lobos continue their homestand with two games this week, starting with Abilene Christian.

It is just the second meeting between UNM and ACU, with the last game occurring in 1985 in Albuquerque.

ACU enters the game 4-3 on the season and is led in scoring by Maleeah Langstaff (13.9), one of two Wildcats to average 10-plus points per game. Madi Miller is averaging 11.9 ppg and leads the team with 15 three-pointers. Bella Earle leads in rebounds (7.3 per game) and assists (2.7 per game). Langstaff, Miller, Earle and Addison Martin have started all seven games for ACU this season.

Both ACU and UNM are prone to shooting three-pointers, with the Lobos attempting 26.5 three-pointers per game and the Wildcats 27.6 per game. ACU is 17th in the NCAA in three-point attempts per game and UNM 24th. ACU is shooting 25.9% (50-193) from three-point range with 45.5% of its shots from behind the arc, while UNM is shooting 28.8% (61-212) with 40.6% of its shots coming from behind the arc. The Lobos make 7.6 three-pointers per game compared to the Wildcats' 7.1 per game.

NEW MEXICO WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

**LAST TIME OUT**

In front of an announced crowd of 6,087, the Lobo women's basketball team led through the first quarter of Sunday's game against No. 14/13 Arizona and were within reach through the midway point of the third quarter before the Wildcats pulled away late in the 77-60 final.

Sunday's attendance with the largest for the program since March 7, 2019 against Wyoming, which had an announced attendance of 8,152.

Similar to last year's meeting in Tucson, Paula Reus led the Lobos in scoring with 14 points and a career-high 37 minutes on the court, joined in double figures by LaTascya Duff with 10 points. Two other Lobos were close to double figures in LaTora Duff (nine points) and Anyiah Augmon (eight points off of the bench). Shaiquel McGruder produced a game-high nine rebounds to go with six points and three blocks.

New Mexico took a 16-15 lead into the second quarter, with Reus scoring seven points on 3-4 shooting. The Lobos led for 5:47 of the quarter, with seven lead changes and one tie.

UNM stretched the lead to five at the start of the second quarter on a Reus layup and Amaya Brown steal that led to a layup, however Arizona answered to tie the game at 20. Another basket by Brown put UNM in front before the Wildcats went on a 7-0 run to take the 27-22 lead with 4:46 left in the quarter. The Lobos climbed back to get within one at 29-28 on an Augmon layup and LaTora fast-break layup off of an Augmon steal, although Arizona closed on a 7-2 run for a 36-30 halftime lead.

Both teams were unable to score at the start of the third, with LaTora opening the scoring on a layup at the 7:33 mark of the quarter. The Duffs continued to assert their presence on the offensive side with LaTascya hitting a three-pointer followed by another LaTora layup that again brought the Lobos within one at 38-37 with 5:52 to play in the quarter. Of note, New Mexico went on a 7-2 run over 4:08 of the third quarter to cut the score to one point. It was the closest the Lobos would get for the rest of the contest as Arizona pulled away on an 11-0 run to push the deficit to 12 and although the Lobos got back within single digits at eight on a McGruder jumper, Arizona led 54-43 through three.

The margin grew to as large as 19 in the fourth quarter with the Lobos cutting it to 13 at 70-57 with 2:50 left in the contest before the game concluded at 77-60.

Last week, LaTascya averaged 15.0 points per game with eight three-pointers, and was one of four Lobos to average double figures. Reus, McGruder and Brown all averaged 10.5 ppg. The Lobos were even on the week, scoring 132 points while giving up 132 points, outscoring their opponents in the first (32-29) and third (38-29) quarters.

On the week, McGruder averaged 11.5 rebounds per game, 10.5 points per game and 3.0 blocks per game.

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

In the 43 seasons and previous 1294 games of the Lobo women's basketball program, it was the first time that the Lobos have played consecutive overtime games. In the 2010-11 season, UNM had two, two overtime games in the span of three games.

IDENTITY THEFT

The Lobos have recorded 10 or more steals in seven games this season, recording a total of 99 for an average of 12.4 per game. UNM is 19th in the NCAA in steals per game.

UNM opened the season with 16 at Southern Utah, and followed that up with 10 against Houston, 14 at New Mexico State and 11 in the game against Arizona State. UNM had 19 steals with six players recording multiple steals and seven with at least one steal in the win against WNMU, had 12 in the game at Texas A&M-Commerce and 14 in the game at Nicholls.

Shaiquel McGruder and LaTascya Duff are tied for the team lead with 17 steals, with McGruder averaging 2.1 per game and LaTascya at 2.4 per game. Amaya Brown has 16 steals on the season, with LaTora at 15. Brown is averaging 2.0 steals per game and LaTora 2.1 per game.

Six Lobos have had multiple steals in multiple games. LaTascya has recorded at least one steal in every game she has played in with multiple steals in five. McGruder has had at least one steal in six games with multiple steals in five games. Vianè Cumber has recorded multiple steals in the three games, Brown has recorded multiple steals in five games with at least one steal in seven, and Nia Johnson has had two games with multiple steals.

The Lobos have four players in the top 10 in the MW in steals per game, led by LaTascya (tied for third at 2.4), LaTora seventh (2.1), McGruder eighth (2.1) and Brown tied for 10th (2.0).

B(LOCK) DOWN

UNM's defense has also recorded multiple blocks in each game and has

finished with at least five blocks in the last six games. Shaiquel McGruder leads with 23 blocks to date, with multiple blocks in the last six games.

The Lobos have 47 blocks and are 10th in the NCAA in blocks per game (5.9), leading the MW in the category. McGruder is sixth in the NCAA in blocks and eighth in blocks per game (2.9), leading the MW in both categories.

THREE FALLING

UNM built an identity last season as a three-point shooting team, and this year's team is trying to reclaim that identity. The Lobos have finished with 10-plus three-pointers in three games this season with a season-high 11 in the game against Texas A&M-Commerce and finished with nine in the wins against Western New Mexico and Nicholls.

UNM is averaging 7.6 made three-pointers per game with 40.6 percent of UNM's shot attempts three-pointers.

BENCH CONTRIBUTIONS

While the Lobos have started the same five every game but once this season, there has always been one player off of the bench that has stepped up when their number was called to enter the game.

In the game against Arizona, it was Anyiah Augmon with eight points on 4-5 shooting, three assists and a steal. Against ASU, it was Vianè Cumber who played a career-high 34:47 and scored eight points, with three steals and seven rebounds, and Cumber came through again at Texas A&M-Commerce with 15 points on 6-9 shooting.

Nia Johnson has been a consistent contributor off of the bench, scoring six points in four games and a season-high 18 points in the win against Western New Mexico and has provided sparks to the Lobo offense in each appearance. Johnson is averaging 7.0 points per game and has recorded a steal in four games.

BALANCED ATTACK

UNM has had a different leading scorer in six games this season in LaTascya Duff, Amaya Brown, LaTora Duff, Vianè Cumber, Shaiquel McGruder and Paula Reus. The game at Nicholls was the first time that there was a repeat leading scorer, with LaTascya scoring a game-high 20 points at Southern Utah and at Nicholls. Reus has also led the team in scoring twice, with 18 at Texas A&M-Commerce and against Arizona.

McGruder has reached double digits in seven games this season, with McGruder scoring 13, 11, 11, 24, 14, 10 and 15 and LaTora scoring double figures in five with 13, 14, 13, 13 and 15. LaTascya Duff has scored in double figures in five games, twice reaching 20 points (20, 10, 16, 20, 10) and Brown has reached double figures in four games (16, 11, 10, 15).

McGruder (13.0), LaTascya (12.6) and LaTora (12.1) are all averaging double-digit points per game.

LaTora Duff has finished with five rebounds six times this season, including in the last four games. Duff has recorded five boards in all but the New Mexico State game.

Duff also had a career-high five steals in the game at Nicholls.

IN EXCLUSIVE COMPANY

At the 9:18 mark of the 3rd quarter in Saturday's game against Houston, Shaiquel McGruder grabbed an offensive rebound, took a dribble to create space and banked in a shot. In doing so, she scored her 1001th-career point and became the 18th Lobo in program history to achieve 1000 points and 500 rebounds and the 25th Lobo to score 1000-career points.

She currently has 1086 points and 690 rebounds, ranking her 17th all-time in points and 34 away from 16th. When it comes to rebounds, McGruder is 11th in program history and is 11 away from 10th.

During her career, McGruder is shooting .603 from the floor and scored 73 points as a freshman, 215 points as a sophomore, 182 as a junior and 512 points last season. She's scored 104 points through the eight games this season.

Among MW players, McGruder is in the top 10 in scoring (tied for sixth), rebounds (fourth) and steals (eighth) and leads the conference in field-goal percentage (.613) and blocks (23, 2.9 per game).

CONSISTENT TORA DUFF

Returning for another season, LaTora Duff has been the floor general for the Lobos for the past three seasons, starting in every game she's played in. Prior to missing the WNMU game for a family matter, Duff had started in 60-straight games for the Lobos.

Duff has scored in double figures in five games, has finished with five rebounds in six games and recorded multiple steals in five of the games but has had at least one steal in all five with a career-high five at Nicholls, and has

played 30-plus minutes in six of the seven games she's played.

In the season opener against SUU, Duff played 24:43 and finished with 13 points, three three-pointers, five rebounds, three assists, a steal and a block. She followed that up with 14 points, seven assists, two steals and five rebounds in 34:39 against Houston. Against NMSU, Duff registered 40:44 of floor time, finishing with 13 points and two steals. Her stats were even more impressive against Arizona State, finishing with a double-double of 13 points and 10 assists along with three steals and five rebounds, playing in 42:14.

Duff is averaging 34.6 minutes, 12.1 points, 4.7 rebounds, 4.7 assists and 2.1 steals.

She currently has 303 career assists, 13th all-time in program history, and is 28 away from 12th. If she replicates her 192 assists from last season, Duff could climb into the top-4 in the record book.

Last season, Duff rarely left the court, averaging 33.3 minutes per game, on her way to earning honorable mention from the Mountain West.

The Lobo scored in double figures in 21 games with 20-plus points in three games, and led the Lobos in scoring in four games. She recorded a career-high 14 assists in the win at Utah State, finishing with a double-double with 13 points and finished with 10-plus assists in three games (12 against Prairie View and 13 against Grand Canyon).

In addition, she had two double-doubles on the season (17 pts, 12 assists vs. Prairie View and 13 points, 14 assists at Utah State) and three times came close to triple doubles (8 rebounds at Utah State and against Prairie View, 8 points, nine rebounds, 13 assists vs. Grand Canyon).

On the season, she totaled 192 assists, tied for fifth most in a single season in program history. She finished third in the MW in assists per game (5.11), sixth in assist/turnover ratio (2.24) and seventh in steals per game (1.61) in MW games. On the season, Duff was third in the MW in assists per game (5.3), sixth in assist/turnover ratio (2.13), 11th in steals per game (1.47) and made three-pointers per game (1.83) and 15th in scoring with 12.0 points per game.

Duff finished 34th in the NCAA in assist/turnover ratio, 23rd in assists per game and eighth in assists.

TRIPLE THREAT TAY

There is no one better in the MW and very few better in the country when it comes to three-pointers than LaTascya Duff.

The Arizona game was the 45th career game at UNM for LaTascya Duff with multiple three-pointers and the Nicholls game was the 16th time that Duff has scored 20 or more points as a Lobo.

She currently has a career three-point percentage of .402, fourth all-time in program history, and 167 career three-pointers, sixth all-time in program history, 19 away from fifth and 54 away from tying the program record.

The super senior is second in the MW in three-point field-goal percentage at .310 and in three-pointers per game at 2.6.

Duff made at least one three-pointer in all but one game last season and had a streak of 29 games with a three, the longest streak in program history, which ended in the Feb. 16 game against Utah State.

She finished with 97 three-pointers, the second most in a single season in program history, and made multiple three-pointers in 28 games, making a three-pointer in all but one game. In addition, she made five or more three-pointers in six games and four or more in nine games. She shot 42.7 percent from three-point range, the fifth-best percentage in a single season in program history.

Duff led the MW in three-pointers made, made per game (2.77) and in three-point field-goal percentage on the season. She also led the MW in three-point percentage (.422), made three-pointers (46) and three-pointers per game (2.56) in conference games.

Among the NCAA, Duff ranked seventh in three-pointers made, 13th in three-point field-goal percentage and 17th in made three-point field-goals per game.

In conference games, Duff averaged 11.4 ppg and shooting a conference-best 42.2% from three with a conference-best 46 three-pointers and 2.6 per game.

The threes continued to fall in the season opener, with the sharp shooter making four, including her first attempt of the game to open the scoring. She replicated that against Arizona State with four more and she finished with six three-pointers and 20 points against Nicholls.

ALL-AROUND AMAYA BROWN

Redshirt-senior Amaya Brown has been a bright spot for the Lobos in the eight games, showing her all-around ability to impact the game.

She has scored 10 or more points in four games this season and recorded multiple steals in five games, including a career-high five at Nicholls. She's led the team in rebounds twice and in scoring once.

In the game at NMSU, Brown finished with 11 points and seven rebounds, while also forcing three steals. Against Houston, she finished with a team- and career-high 16 points and team- and career-high 11 rebounds for her first career double-double, and added two steals, a block and went a career-best 8-for-8 from the free-throw line.

Brown is currently second on the team in rebounds (48, 6.0 per game) and is also averaging 2.0 steals per game and 8.4 points per game.

She has also been reliable at the free-throw line, going 8-8 against Houston and in the fourth quarter against the Aggies, Brown went 4-4, including two free throws that tied the game at 57. She's been perfect at the line in four games and is shooting 85.7% from the line, tied for second in the MW.

PRESEASON EXPECTATIONS

The Lobo women's basketball team was picked to finish second in the Mountain West predicted order of finish, with UNM also placing three on the preseason All-Mountain West team, as announced by the conference on Wednesday.

As a team, New Mexico received 264 points and two first-place votes, while Shaiquel McGruder was named to the All-Mountain West team, Amaya Brown was named Preseason Newcomer of the Year and Hannah Robbins was selected as the Preseason Freshman of the Year.

It is the second-straight season that the Lobos were picked to finish second in the preseason poll, with UNM finishing second in the conference last season, and the third time in head coach Mike Bradbury's tenure.

Brown joins LaTascya Duff in earning the preseason newcomer accolade, with Duff earning the honor in 2020-21. An Albuquerque native, Brown returns home to play for the Lobos after spending the last three years at Florida State. During her time with the Seminoles, the redshirt-senior played in 44 games and recorded 55 rebounds, 37 assists, 17 steals and six blocks.

Robbins is the first Lobo to be named preseason freshman of the year since N'Dea Flye in 2017, and the fourth overall, joining Mykiel Burleson in 2016 and Jannon Otto in 2015. Out of Phoenix, Arizona and PHH Prep, the Lobo guard averaged 16.5 points, 7.4 rebounds, 3.1 steals and 1.1 blocks per game as a sophomore and 16 points, eight rebounds, three steals and two blocks per game her junior year.

NOT SHAPING AWAY FROM EXPECTATIONS

UNM super senior forward Shaiquel McGruder was named to the preseason watch list for the 2023 Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year Award presented by Her Hoop Stats.

McGruder is one of 25 players on the preseason list, and joins Colorado State's McKenna Hofschild as representatives from the Mountain West.

It is the second preseason accolade for the Ohio native, who was named to the Mountain West preseason MW team on Oct. 12.

McGruder earned her first preseason conference honor after being named to the MW All-Conference and All-Defensive teams last season. Last season, the Ohio native led the conference in field-goal percentage, shooting 60.8 percent from the floor, and scored in double figures in 25 games with seven games with 20-plus points. Her .608 field-goal percentage is the second best in a single season in program history.

Defensively, she recorded multiple steals in 20 games, and at least one steal in 28 games including in every conference game but five. Additionally, she had at least one block in 23 games, including twice registering five blocks, a game with four blocks and five games with three blocks. She finished fourth in the MW in steals per game at 1.83 per game, as well as second in blocked shots and blocked shots per game with 49 and 1.36, respectively.

Last season, McGruder produced the best numbers in her career as a Lobo in points, rebounds, steals, blocks, assists, made three-pointers, made baskets and free throws. She also led the team in steals, rebounds and made baskets and was second in scoring.

This season, McGruder leads the team in scoring (13.0 ppg), rebounds (8.5 per game), and blocks (2.9 per game) and is shooting a team-best 61.3% from the floor.

PLANS CHANGE

In a decision made by coaches and players and their families, freshmen



Natalia Chavez and Hannah Robbins have decided for the time being to redshirt this season. Plans can change in that the redshirt could be pulled, but neither Chavez or Robbins have dressed in any games.

PRIDE OF NEW MEXICO

The Lobos have five New Mexico natives on the roster in freshmen Natalia Chavez and Jaelyn Bates, sophomore Vianè Cumber, redshirt-senior Amaya Brown, and while her hometown is listed as Phoenix, Arizona, Hannah Robbins was born in Albuquerque.

In addition, the Lobos have two New Mexico Gatorade Player of the Year winners in Brown and Cumber, with Brown winning in 2015-16 and 2017-18 and Cumber winning in 2019-20 and 2020-21.

The player who won in 2016-17: recently graduated Jaedyn De La Cerda, meaning the winner in five of the last seven years were Lobos.

LIKE FATHER, LIKE DAUGHTER

UNM has two players on the 2022-23 roster who are continuing the Lobo legacy as their fathers also played for New Mexico.

Hannah Robbins (Rob Robbins) and Amaya Brown (Greg Brown) look the create their own legacy in the Cherry and Silver, which the groundwork has already started before the season even tipped off as Robbins was named the MW Preseason Freshman of the Year and Brown the MW Preseason Newcomer of the Year.

Greg Brown played at UNM from 1992-94, leading the Lobos in scoring in 1993-94 in points (599, 19.3 points per game) en route to WAC Player of the Year. Rob Robbins played basketball at New Mexico from 1987-91. Robbins led the Lobos in three-point percentage in the 1990-91, 1988-89, 1987-88 seasons, in three-pointers in each of his four seasons and in free-throw percentage in the 1988-89, 1989-90 and 1990-91 seasons. Robbins is currently ninth in career scoring leaders with 1,739 points, averaging 13.1 points per game, and eighth in career field-goal leaders with 583 made baskets and a .464 field-goal percentage. He currently also holds the program record with consecutive made free throws with 52 during the 1989-90 season.

When Robbins signed last November, she noted her father in her reasons for wanting to become a Lobo. "Growing up in New Mexico, it has always been a dream to play in The Pit. The facilities along with the coaching staff are unmatched and I am extremely excited to follow in my dad's footsteps at UNM." Of note, Robbins wears #42, the number her father wore as a Lobo and is often referred to as Rob's daughter.

LOBOS GOING NATIONAL

The University of New Mexico women's basketball team will have two Mountain West games broadcast nationally on FS1 or CBS Sports Network, as announced by the conference on Wednesday.

The Lobos' home game against Air Force to open conference play has been moved from New Year's Eve to New Year's Day with a 2 p.m. MT tip time on CBS Sports Network, while their game at UNLV on Saturday, Jan. 14 was selected by FS1 for a 6 p.m. PT/ 7 p.m. MT tip time.

In total, the Lobos will be featured in half of the Mountain West women's basketball regular season games broadcasted nationally this season.

NON-CONFERENCE PREP WORK

The Southern Utah game marked the start of a challenging non-conference schedule as New Mexico has three Power 5 programs scheduled in Arizona State, Arizona and Mississippi State, although the Lobos have the benefit of home court against the Arizona schools. The Lobos also hosted Houston out of the American (a 68-61 win) and will face Old Dominion on a neutral court in December.

Three opponents (Arizona, Texas A&M-Commerce and Old Dominion) all finished with 20-plus wins last season with seven finishing with a winning record.

The Lobos will play six non-conference games on the road and seven games in The Pit.

REWRITE THE RECORD BOOK

The Lobos are coming off of a historic season, setting several program marks.

To start, the Lobos won 26 games, tying the program record for single-season wins. UNM has won 26 games just two other times in program history, the last time being the 2004-05 season (26-5). The other time was the 1997-98 season (26-7).

The Lobos went 17-1 at home, with the last time the Lobos had just one home loss was in that 2004-05 season, going 19-1.

Further history was made as a team last season, as the Lobos set the program

record for most three-pointers in a season with 346.

Individually, several Lobos are re-writing the record book with single-season stats. LaTascya Duff currently has made 92 three-pointers this season, tied for second all-time in single-season three-pointers. Her 42.2% accuracy from three ranks sixth in single-season percentage. Shaiquel McGruder has made 212 field-goals this season, fourth all-time and her field-goal percentage of 61.4% ranks second in single-season field-goal percentage. LaTora Duff has 188 assists this season, placing her sixth and four away from fifth.

In the WNIT win against Grand Canyon, the Lobos set some postseason records as well, with the 27 assists and 14 three-pointers setting the record. The 92 points were the second-most scored and the 34 made field goals tied the program record (last done against Rice in 2018). LaTora's 13 assists set the program postseason record and McGruder's six steals ranked second in individual steals in a postseason game. LaTascya's 27 points ranked as the third-most points scored by a player in a postseason game.

HISTORY MADE IN LOGAN

The Lobo women's basketball team put on a three-point clinic on Jan. 6 against Utah State, setting a program record with 21 made three-pointers in a 98-83 victory.

The previous record was 18, made against Illinois in 2017, which the Lobos already surpassed in the third quarter.

In addition, the 21 three-pointers also broke the MW record of 20, that was achieved three times previously- by Colorado State in 2016, Wyoming in 2010 and BYU in 2001. Of those, only one was against a MW school, Wyoming against Air Force in 2010.

LaTascya Duff and Jaedyn De La Cerda hit seven three-pointers each with De La Cerda finishing with a game-high 27 points and Duff with 24 points. LaTora Duff made three, three-pointers, finishing with 13 points, Antonia Anderson made two three-pointers and Viané Cumber and Kath van Bennekom each made a three. De La Cerda's seven tied her career high, while LaTascya's set a career high, besting the six that she made last year against Utah State. It also extended her three-point streak to 18 games and was her fourth game this season with 20-plus points.

Anderson made it officially the record with a three-pointer with 36 remaining in the third quarter, with the Lobos making seven three-pointers in the first, six in the second and six in the third quarter, shooting 66.7 percent in the second quarter and 60 percent from three in the third quarter.

LaTora also tallied a double-double with a career-high 14 assists to go with her 13 points for her second double-double of the season coming close to a triple-double with a team-high eight rebounds, and Anderson tied her season high with five blocks, the second time this season that the senior has blocked five shots in a game. It was also the third-straight game against the Aggies that the Lobos have neared the 100-point mark, scoring 93 points, 97 points and now 98 points in the last three meetings. In those three games, the Lobos made 15, 16 and 21 three-pointers.

KNOW YOUR OPPONENT

Abilene Christian enters the game 4-3, but 0-2 on the road. The Wildcats have alternated W-L in all seven games this season, with wins against Howard Payne (89-37), Southwest (NM) (77-36), Montana State (66-61) and Alabama State (78-67). Their losses have come against Rice (85-69), UTSA (76-70) and Louisiana (54-38).

The Wildcats are led in scoring by Maleeah Langstaff (13.9 ppg), one of two players in double figures (Madi Miller is at 11.9 ppg). Miller has led the team in scoring in the last three games with 20, 15 and 17 points. Bella Earle leads on the boards with 7.3 rebounds per game and in assists with 2.7 per game, while Langstaff leads in steals per game (1.3). Addison Martin leads with 1.3 blocks per game.

Langstaff, Miller, Martin and Earle have started all seven games for ACU with Zoe Jackson starting four and Aspen Thornton starting three.

As a team, the Wildcats are averaging 69.6 points per game, 7.1 made three-pointers per game, 7.0 steals per game and 3.9 blocks per game. ACU is 17th in the NCAA in three-point attempts per game at 27.6 with 45.5% of its shot attempts three-pointers and is shooting 25.9% from three (50-193).

Out of the WAC, ACU shares three opponents with UNM in New Mexico State, Southern Utah and Nicholls.

MIKE BRADBURY

RECORD AT UNM: 124-69 (7TH SEASON)
CAREER RECORD: 302-186 (16TH SEASON)

NOTEWORTHY :

- Named the sixth head coach in program history on March 31, 2016
- 26 wins this season tied for most wins in program history
- Led UNM to 25 wins in 2017-18; tied for second-most wins in program history
- Led UNM to 20+ wins in three seasons including 2021-22, and .500 or better in five
- Earned his 100th win at UNM on Nov. 30, 2021; only the second coach in program history to reach 100. Earned his 300th career win on Nov. 22, 2022 against Western N.M.

Mike Bradbury enters his sixth season as head coach for The University of New Mexico women's basketball team. In his previous five seasons at the helm, Bradbury has guided the Lobos to a 94-55 (.631) overall record. Twice in his tenure, in 2017-18 and 2018-19, the Lobos eclipsed the 20-win mark and totaled 49 victories over that time. The consecutive 20-plus win seasons under Bradbury are the first for the program since the 2007-08 – 2008-09 seasons.

In his most recent season at the helm of the Lobos, Bradbury led the Lobos to a Mountain West regular season championship, the first outright in program history and the first regular season title since the 2004-05 season. In addition, the Lobos were selected for the WNIT for the third time in four years.

The Lobos produced one of the most prolific offenses not only in the conference, but in the country, finishing among the top 25 in several categories. Among them, UNM finished fourth in the NCAA in made three-pointers per game (10.2), sixth in assist-turnover ratio (1.40), ninth in scoring offense (81.2 points per game), 14th in fewest turnovers per game (12.0) and assists per game (16.8) and 22nd in scoring margin (12.7). The Lobos led the Mountain West in scoring offense, scoring margin, assists per game, turnover margin, assist-turnover ratio and made three-pointers as well as second in field-goal percentage and steals per game.

UNM set a program record in scoring with 120 points against Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Dec. 17, 2020 and in the process, made 17 three-pointers, falling just one short of tying the program record. Further, the Lobos registered 90-plus points in five games and 80-plus points in 11 of the 20 games on the season.

Four Lobos finished the 2020-21 season averaging double figures in points per game with six players finishing in double figures in scoring in two games (the only times it has been accomplished in program history), five players in five games and four in seven games.

As a result of UNM's successful season, five players were named to the All-Mountain West Team with LaTascya Duff also earning the superlative of Sixth Person of the Year. Duff was just the second Lobo to win the sixth person award. Making the all-conference team for the first time were Duff, Jaedyn De La Cerda and Antonia Anderson, as well as Shaiquel McGruder earning all-defensive and Ahlise Hurst earning the honorable mention distinction.

In his third year at the helm, Bradbury continued to put his mark on the program while also continuing to bring Lobo women's basketball back to national prominence. Overall, Bradbury's 2018-19 team went 24-7 and earned a bid to the WNIT for a second-straight season. It marked the first time since the 2008-09 – 2009-10 seasons that the program made consecutive trips to the postseason.



After dropping a one-possession game to Auburn in the preseason WNIT, the 2018-19 Lobos ripped off 11-straight wins to tie the program record and were on the cusp of cracking the national top-25 rankings as well by receiving votes from the WBCA during that stretch. Bradbury would also receive an individual plaudit from the WBCA last season as he was named as one of 13 finalists for the 2019 United States Marine Corps/WBCA National Coach of the Year Award. Impressively, Bradbury was the only coach from a non-Power 5 conference to be a finalist.

In his time at UNM, Bradbury has coached 13 All-Mountain West performers with Cherise Beynon, Jayla Everett, Jaisa Nunn, Aisia Robertson and Richelle van der Keijl joining De La Cerda, Duff, McGruder, Hurst and Anderson in making the All-Mountain West Team. Tesha Buck, Mykiel Burleson and Nike McClure have also earned MW recognition with Buck being the 2017-18 Newcomer of the Year, Burleson being named to the All-Freshman team in 2016-17 and McClure landing on the All-Defensive team in 2018-19.

In terms of major individual awards, Bradbury has coached the league's Newcomer of the Year each of his first three seasons in charge of the Lobos with van der Keijl earning the award in 2016-17, Buck in 2017-18 and Robertson in 2018-19. Additionally, Bradbury has coached the MW Player of the Year in Nunn (2018-19) and the Freshman of the Year in Everett (2018-19) as well as Sixth Person of the Year in Duff (2020-21).

Further, a Lobo has been named Mountain West Player of the Week 11 times during his tenure.

In year two under Bradbury the Lobos had a breakout season, especially offensively as they ended the 2017-18 season averaging 80.4 points per game while also posting an impressive +9.7 scoring margin. Both marks led the Mountain West and the point-per-game total was 16th-best in NCAA DI last season.

A significant reason for the jump in offensive production was the fact that the Lobos were one of the most potent three-point shooting threats in the country. For the season, the Lobos attempted the eighth-most overall trifectas in DI hoisting 932 long distance shots. Successful 34% of the time, the Lobos made the 11th most 3's burying 319.

Prior to coming to Albuquerque, Bradbury built a successful nine year run as a Division-I head coach with stops at Morehead State (Morehead, Ky.) and Wright State (Dayton, Ohio). Most recently with the Raiders, Bradbury led his squad to five 20-win seasons, including each of his final three seasons. During that time, Wright State has amassed a 75-28 record, the best amongst the 13 Division I programs in the state of Ohio.

Overall at Wright State, Bradbury had five winning seasons, all of which were 20-plus win seasons, in six years- a feat made all the more remarkable as Wright State had just one winning season in the previous 22 before his arrival. In the previous 37 seasons of women's basketball at Wright State, the Raider program had tallied 20 wins just once before Bradbury led the team to 20 wins in five of his six seasons.

His most prominent three-year run at Wright State started in 2013-14, when the Raiders won a school-record 26 games on the way to a 26-9 season and the program's first-ever appearance in the NCAA Tournament. That season saw the Raiders

finish second in the Horizon League and win its first Horizon League Tournament. It also featured the program's first road win at perennial league power Wisconsin-Green Bay. Kim Demmings was named the Horizon League Player of the Year and Tournament MVP, and it marked the first time in school history the program had a pair of first team All-Conference selections.

He followed up that by earning Horizon League Coach of the Year in 2014-15 after a 25-9 season that saw his squad lose its Horizon League Preseason Player of the Year less than two minutes into the season opener. The Raiders just missed a second straight NCAA Tournament appearance, falling in overtime in the conference championship game. The team did make its first appearance in the Women's NIT as the league's automatic qualifier, and in 2015-16, the team made it back-to-back WNIT appearances after a 24-11 season, earning the program's first at-large bid.

Those three seasons are the three winningest seasons in the history of Wright State women's basketball.

In his first two seasons at Wright State, he led the team to a 20-13 campaign and a 21-13 mark and berths in the Women's Basketball Invitational, the first NCAA Division I postseason berths for the program. Overall, Bradbury has coached three Horizon League Players of the Year (all in his last three seasons), six first-team All-Horizon League players, three second-team members and four All-Freshman team members.

Prior to his time at Wright State, Bradbury was the head coach at Morehead State where he led the Division I program to a 50-44 mark in three seasons, including a watershed 22-11 season, which was the second-most wins in Morehead State history and the most wins by the Eagles in the previous 38 years.

At Morehead State he coached one Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Year, along with one first-team All-OVC pick (two seasons) and three second-team All-OVC picks.

Bradbury also spent time as an assistant coach at Xavier (2002-06), Cincinnati (1996-02), VCU (1995-96), East Tennessee State (1994-95) and Chattanooga (1991-94). In his 29 seasons as an assistant and as a head coach, Bradbury has had 27 winning seasons.

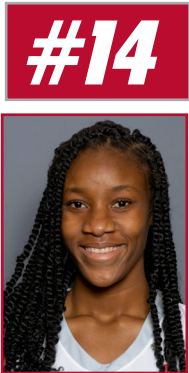
