LOBOS ADD 18 MID-YEARS TO ROSTER

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. — University of New Mexico head football coach Danny Gonzales has announced 18 mid-year transfers to the 2023 football roster, all of whom are presently enrolled and in classes. The additions include 10 FBS transfers, one FCS transfer and seven junior college transfers.

The mid-year 2-4 (junior college) transfer signing period commenced on December 21 and lasted through last week. One more upcoming signing period, which will include high school student-athletes, is slated for Feb. 1-April 1, 2023.

The 18 incoming players join the previous list of 11 initial signees. Overall, the Lobos have picked up 18 new players on offense (eight receivers, four quarterbacks, two offensive linemen, two tight ends and two running backs) and 11 on defense (six safeties (some of whom can play corner), three linebackers and two defensive linemen). Of the 10 FBS transfers, three are from national runner-up TCU, and two are from UAB, including Blazer starting quarterback Dylan Hopkins.

“These additions significantly add to our football team,” said head coach Danny Gonzales. “Adding transfers from winning programs like TCU and UAB will be a benefit for us, and having 23 new players enrolled and in school getting the benefit of spring practice will really jump start us for 2023. We have already seen their work ethic in terms of lifting, running and meetings, and I’m really excited to get on the field with them.”

Gonzales added in talking about the highly-rater Perkins-McAllister and Bryson Washington, “To get two four-star recruits from high school that have played at the highest level will really bring a toughness and game-changing ability to our defense.”

- Ranked among the nation's Top 10 JUCO running backs (No. 6) by 247Sports.com.

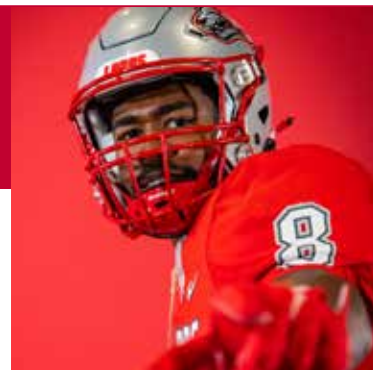

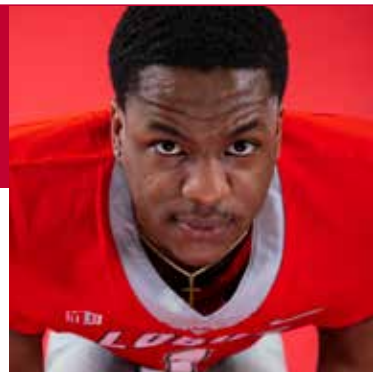

LOBOS INK 11 ON FIRST DAY OF NATIONAL SIGNING PERIOD

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. — University of New Mexico head football coach Danny Gonzales has announced 11 signees on National Signing Day, the first official day that student-athletes can sign GIAs and NLI's to play in the 2023 football season.

The NCAA approved the early signing period in 2017, which runs this year from Dec. 21-23. The mid-year 2-4 (junior college) transfer signing period also commenced today and lasts through Jan. 15, 2023, while the regular signing period is slated for Feb. 1-April 1, 2023.

Of the 11 initial signees, eight are slated for the offensive side of the ball, including two freshmen quarterbacks and four receivers. The Lobos also picked up a pair offensive lineman, one from the junior college ranks. All told of the initial 11 signees, eight are high school seniors and three are junior college transfers. UNM also signed three high school players from New Mexico. Seven of the 11 (Cook, Dampier, Miller, Moore, Murrell, Smith and Toilolo) will enroll in time for the 2023 Spring semester and participate in Spring practice.

"This is a terrific class and it should pay immediate dividends for us in 2023," said Gonzales. "There was great desire to be a part of what we are building, and not only do we have very talented players in this class, but we have a great students who consistently were at the top of their class academically. We have several joining us for spring football which will be a great benefit as well, and we once again have signed the best high school players in our state."

The last four New Mexico State Players of the Year have ended up with the Lobos under Gonzales in Isaiah Chavez (2019 Gatorade winner), Luke Wysong (2020 Gatorade winner), Zach Vigil (2021 Gatorade winner) and Evan Wysong (2022 MaxPreps winner).

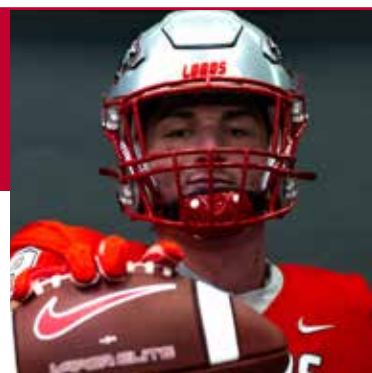
