

LOBOS HOSTS WYOMING IN SEARCH OF 20th WIN OF THE SEASON

- UNM hosts Wyoming Tuesday night looking to snap a season-long three game losing streak
- UNM has already eclipsed its win total of 13 and its conference win total of five from last season
- With a victory, UNM would reach the 20-win milestone for the first time since 2013-14
- Tuesday's game marks a rematch of a game on New Year's Eve in Laramie where the Lobos posted a 76-75 victory

THE FIRST MEETING

- Then-No. 22 New Mexico defeated Wyoming 76-75 in Laramie on New Year's Eve
- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. had a game-high 20 points, including the go-ahead free throws in the final minute
- Josiah Allick had his first double-double of the season with 15 points and a career-high 15 rebounds
- · Jaelen House had 16 points, five assists and five steals

LOBOS LOOK TO REACH 20-WIN MILESTONE

 With a victory on Tuesday, the Lobos will reach the 20-win milestone for the 28th time in program history and the first time since going 27-7 in 2013-14

LAST TIME OUT

- New Mexico suffered an 89-77 loss at Air Force on Friday night
- The Falcons shot 66.0% from the field, the fifth-highest FG% by a UNM opponent in history
- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. scored 32 points to lead the Lobos, his second 30-point game of the year
 - · Javonte Johnson scored a season-high 16 points in his hometown

MOVING ON UP!

• The Lobos enter the week at No. 52 in KenPom, just off their season high of No. 42, their highest KenPom ranking since ending the 2014 season at No. 33

• UNM has moved up 242 spots from the final ranking of 2020-21, when Richard Pitino was hired

• New Mexico is the highest mover in KenPom during that time (since April 2021), as the three of the top four are from the MW

GET THE BALL INSIDE

• New Mexico has made it focus to get the ball inside this season, with just 27.2 percent of their field goal attempts this season coming from 3-point range, the 12th fewest rate nationally (national average is 37.4 percent)

• The Lobos are averaging 36.9 points per game in the paint (up from 28.4 points per game in the paint last season)

DRAWING FOULS

• New Mexico is one of the nation's best at getting to the free throw line this season, ranking 16th nationally with a 40.4 FTA/FGA percentage

• Overall, UNM ranks seventh nationally in free throw attempts per game (24.0) and seventh in the nation with 17.6 made free throws per game

• The Lobos rank 35th nationally with 21.6% of their points this season coming from free throws

• Three Lobos are among the top 150 nationally in drawing fouls, with Morris Udeze ranking 64th with 5.8 fouls drawn per 40 minutes, Jaelen House 94th at 5.5 fouls drawn per 40 minutes and Jamal Mashburn, Jr. 144th at 5.2 fouls drawn per 40 minutes

- New Mexico is one of 13 teams nationally (only Mountain West) to have made more free throws (439) than their opponents have attempted (438) this season
- The Lobos are averaging a +5.6 advantage in free throws made per game this season

THREE TOP SCORERS

• New Mexico has three of the top seven scorers in the Mountain West with Jamal Mashburn, Jr. leading the league at 20.0 ppg, Jaelen House fourth at 17.3 ppg and Morris Udeze seventh in the league at 15.4 ppg

• UNM is one of two schools in the nation with three players averaging 15.4 ppg (UNC, Toledo)

• Their combined 52.7 ppg is the highest for a Lobo trio since 1979-80 when Kenny Page (28.0 ppg), Everette Jefferson (16.5 ppg) and Jim Williams (10.7 ppg) combined for 55.2 ppg

THREE LOBOS "AT THE PEAK"

• Three different Lobos have been named Mountain West Player of the Week with Morris Udeze (Nov. 28), Jaelen House (Jan. 16) and Jamal Mashburn, Jr. (Jan. 23) all honored

• It marks the first time since 2012-13 that three different Lobos have received the honor as Tony Snell. Alex Kirk and Kendall Williams earned the recognition that season

• It is the first career Mountain West Player of the Week honor for all three, but Udeze did win Player of the Week honors in the American in 2020-21 at Wichita State

• Jamal Mashburn, Jr. has scored in double figures in 46 consecutive games, dating back to last season

• It is the fifth-longest double-figure streak in UNM history, and the longest by a Lobo in 32 years (Luc Longley's school record 61-game streak from 1989-1991)

 It is the second-longest active streak in the nation, trailing only Antoine Davis of Detroit who has scored in double figures every game of his career

MASHBURN'S 20-POINT GAMES

Jamal Mashburn, Jr. leads the Mountain West with 12 20-point games this season, including eight in conference play
He leads the Mountain West in scoring in conference games at 22.8

ppg, as he looks to become the sixth Lobo (fifth different player) to average at least 20.0 ppg in MW games

House was the only Mountain West player selected to the list and the first Lobo honored since Cameron Bairstow in 2013-14

· House is fourth in the MW in scoring, sthird in assists and ranks third nationally in steals

Jaelen House leads the Mountain West and ranks third nationally with 2.71 steals per game
His 65 steals this season puts him on pace to break Hunter Greene's single-season school record of 84 in 1986-87

- He has nine games this season with at least four steals
- He has three six-steal games this season (tied for most in a game this season in MW)
- · His 133 steals over the past two seasons ranks 15th on UNM's career list

THREE REACH 1K

· Jamal Mashburn, Jr., Jaelen House and Morris Udeze have all reached the 1,000 career point mark this year

 Mashburn scored his 1,000th career point (Minnesota and New Mexico combined) in the victory over Iona on Dec. 18, House scored his 1,000th career point (Arizona State and New Mexico combined) in the loss at Fresno State on Jan. 3, and Udeze scored his 1,000th career point (Wichita State and New Mexico combined) in the double OT loss at Nevada on Jan. 23 • One more Lobo could reach the 1,000 career point mark this season (Josiah Allick-924)

DOUBLE-DOUBLE UDEZE

· Morris Udeze leads the Mountain West with nine double-doubles this season, the most by a Lobo in a season since 2013-14 when Alex Kirk had 14

· Udeze enters the week with six double-doubles in conference play, twice the amount of any other player in the Mountain West

 From January 7-17, Udeze had four straight double-doubles, the longest streak by a Lobo since Joe Furstinger had four straight double-doubles in December of 2017

GOTTA GO TO MO

 Morris Udeze was dominant during November's Lobo Classic, earning tournament MVP honors and being named Mountain West Player of the Week

• Udeze averaged 22.3 points per game in the tournament on 66.7% (24-36) shooting from the floor and 90.5% (19-21) shooting from the free throw line, in addition to 7.3 rebounds and 2.3 assists per game

 In the win over Jacksonville State, he matched his previous career high with 22 points (9-11 FG) In the victory over Northern Colorado, he had career highs of 33 points and 14 boards, the first

33/14 game by a Lobo in 20 years and the only 33/14 game in the nation this season

LOBO FRONTCOURT HAS ITS "MOJO"

· New Mexico's frontcourt of transfers Morris Udeze and Josiah Allick have made an immediate impact this season

• They rank one-two in the conference in rebounding as Udeze leads at 8.7 rpg and Allick is second at 7.7 rpg

· New Mexico is one of four schools nationally to have its conference's top two rebounders (Arizona-Pac 12; Long Beach State-Big West; Western Carolina-SoCon)

MOUNTAIN WEST LEADERS

- New Mexico leads the MW in scoring offense at 81.6 ppg (16th nationally)
- The Lobos have the conference leader in scoring (Mashburn), rebounding (Udeze), steals
- (House), defensive rebounds (Udeze) and double-doubles (Udeze)

20-20 VISION

• The win over San Jose State on Jan. 17 marked the seventh time that Jamal Mashburn, Jr. & Jaelen House have both scored at least 20 points in the same game

 They are just the third Lobo duo over the past 40 years to have at least seven games with both scoring at least 20 points



ROAD WARRIORS

- New Mexico is 5-4 away from home this season, including a 4-4 record in true road games
- The Lobos are one of three teams in the nation with multiple top-20 NET (as of 2/13) road wins this season (Kansas State, Texas)

• New Mexico has already snapped Saint Mary's 23-game home win streak in November and San Diego State's 16-game home win streak in January

• The four road wins are already the most by UNM in a season since 2018-19 and look to win five true road games for the first time since 2016-17 with the next road win
