### LOBOS HOST UTAH VALLEY IN THE OPENING ROUND OF THE 2023 NIT

- UNM makes its first postseason appearance in nine years when it hosts Utah Valley in the NIT
- The Lobos are looking for their first postseason victory since a first round win over Long Beach State in the 2012 NCAA Tournament in Portland
- The winner will play either Colorado or Seton Hall in the second round this weekend

### SERIES HISTORY

- First all-time meeting
- Utah Valley is the fifth first-time opponent for the Lobos this season (South Alabama, Jacksonville State, North Dakota State, UTSA)
- The Lobos have won 12 straight against first-time opponents, dating back to a loss to Maryland in the 2017 Emerald Classic in Florida

### NIT HISTORY

- The Lobos are making their 20th appearance in the NIT, its first since 2011
- New Mexico is 18-20 all-time in the NIT (15-6 in The Pit)
- UNM has won 10 straight NIT games in The Pit (since a 1989 quarterfinal loss to Saint Louis)
- The Lobos reached the 1964 NIT final in their first appearance, reached the semifinals in 1990, and reached the quarterfinals six other times (most recently in 2001)
- Richard Pitino won the 2014 NIT title in his first season at Minnesota

### SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

- First postseason appearance in nine years (since 2014 NCAA Tournament)
- First 20-win season since going 27-7 in 2013-14
- Eight Mountain West wins, most since a 12-6 record in 2017-18
- Won the Lobo Classic, first MTE title since winning the Paradise Jam in 2012-13
- Ranked 20th in KenPom offensive efficiency, highest since 7th in KenPom AdjO in 1997-98
- Nation's final remaining undefeated team after 14-0 start

#### MOVING ON UP!

- The Lobos enter the NIT at No. 52 in KenPom, just off their season high of No. 42, their highest KenPom ranking since ending the 2014 season at No. 33
- UNM has moved up 242 spots from the final ranking of 2020-21, when Richard Pitino was hired
- New Mexico is the highest mover in KenPom during that time (since April 2021), as the top three are all from the Mountain West
- UNM started this season ranked No. 138 in KenPom

#### GET THE BALL INSIDE

- New Mexico has made it focus to get the ball inside this season, with just 26.9 percent of their field goal attempts this season coming from 3-point range, the 11th fewest rate nationally (national average is 37.3 percent)
- The Lobos are averaging 36.4 points per game in the paint (up from 28.4 points per game in the paint last season)

#### DRAWING FOULS

- New Mexico is one of the nation's best at getting to the free throw line this season, ranking 21st nationally with a 39.5 FTA/FGA percentage
- Overall, UNM ranks sixth nationally in free throw attempts per game (23.7) and fourth in the nation with 17.6 made free throws per game
- The Lobos rank 29th nationally with 21.7% of their points this season coming from free throws
- Two Lobos are averaging over 5.0 fouls drawn per 40 minutes, with Morris Udeze at 6.0 (ranks 50th nationally) and Jaelen House at 5.5
- The Lobos' 781 free throw attempts are their most since 783 in 34 games of 2015-16

#### THREE TOP SCORERS

- New Mexico has three of the top seven scorers in the Mountain West with Jamal Mashburn, Jr. leading the league at 19.5 ppg, Jaelen House sixth at 17.0 ppg and Morris Udeze seventh in the league at 16.4 ppg
- UNM is one of two schools in the nation with three players averaging at least 16.0 ppg (Toledo)
- It marks the first time three Lobos have scored over 500 points in a season in program history
- Their combined 52.9 ppg is the highest for a Lobo trio since 1979-80 when Kenny Page (28.0 ppg), Everette Jefferson (16.5 ppg) and Jim Williams (10.7 ppg) combined for 55.2 ppg
- The Lobos are the first Mountain West team since Nevada (Kendall Stephens, Caleb Martin, Jordan Caroline) in 2017-18 to have three players score 500 points in a season

#### BEATING TOP SEEDS

- New Mexico has victories over four teams this year that were the No. 1 seed in their respective conference tournament (Iona, Oral Roberts, Saint Mary's, San Diego State)
- Those four victories tie Indiana and Saint Mary's for the most wins over conference top-seeds in the nation this season
- As part of their undefeated non-conference schedule, the Lobos defeated both Summit League Tournament finalists (champ Oral Roberts & runner-up North Dakota State), the Sun Belt runner-up (South Alabama), the WCC runner-up (Saint Mary's) and the WAC runner-up (Southern Utah)
- UNM had a 5-6 record against teams selected for the 2023 NCAA Tournament, their most wins against the field of 68 since 2012-13 (13 wins)

## THREE LOBOS NAMED ALL-MOUNTAIN WEST

- New Mexico tied a school record with three players named to the three All-Mountain West teams (also had three in 2004-05, 2009-10, 2012-13, 2013-14)
- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. became UNM's 17th all-time first-team All-Mountain West selection, and the first since Elijah Brown in 2015-16
- Jaelen House was named second-team All-Mountain West and the first Lobo since 2013-14 to earn MW All-Defensive Team honors
- Mashburn and House, both third-team selections last season, became the 12th and 13th Lobo to earn All-Mountain West Team honors multiple times
- Morris Udeze was named third-team All-Mountain West
- In the media All-Mountain West honors, House was first-team, Mashburn and Udeze were second-team and Udeze was the conference's Newcomer of the Year

## MASHBURN'S 20-POINT GAMES

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. leads the Mountain West with 17 20-point games this season, including 11 in conference play
- His 16 20-point games are most by a Lobo in a season since Elijah Brown had 18 in 2015-16
- Mashburn led the Mountain West in scoring in conference games at 21.0 ppg, becoming the sixth Lobo (fifth different player) to average at least 20.0 ppg in MW play
- His streak of six straight 20-point games earlier this season tied for the seventh longest in UNM history and the longest by a Lobo since Elijah Brown had a seven-game streak in 2015-16

## CONSISTENT MASH

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. had his streak of double-figure scoring snapped at 48 consecutive games with seven points at Boise State on Feb. 22
- It was the fifth-longest double-figure streak in UNM history, and the longest by a Lobo in 32 years (Luc Longley's school record 61-game streak from 1989-1991)
- It was the second-longest streak in Mountain West history, trailing only a 58-game streak by Brandon Heath of San Diego State

## THE 600 POINT CLUB

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. became the 16th player in school history to score over 600 points in a year
- He is the first to accomplish the feat since Elijah Brown in 2015-16
- Mashburn is just the 10th Lobo to score over 600 points in the regular season
- He enters tonight's game with 645 points, ninth most points in a season at UNM

## MASHBURN & HOUSE HIT 500 AGAIN

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. and Jaelen House have each scored over 500 points for the second consecutive season
- They have become the 13th and 14th players in program history to have consecutive 500-point seasons
- Mashburn is just the eighth Lobo to have consecutive 550-point seasons

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. became the 36th player in program history to score 1,000 points as a Lobo during the win over Air Force on Jan. 27
- He enters tonight's game with 1,227 career points, 23rd on UNM's all-time scoring list
- Jaelen House became the 37th player in program history to score 1,000 points as a Lobo during the win over Fresno State on Feb. 28
- He enters tonight's game with 1,053 career points, 32nd on UNM's all-time scoring list

## YOU AREN'T ROBBING THE HOUSE, THE HOUSE IS ROBBING YOU!

- Jaelen House leads the Mountain West and ranks third nationally with 2.65 steals per game
- His 82 steals this season puts him just two steals shy of Hunter Greene's single-season school record of 84 in 1986-87
- His 82 steals ranks second-most for a single-season in New Mexico history
- He has 10 games this season with at least four steals (T-2nd in the nation)
- He has three six-steal games this season (tied for most in a game this season in MW)
- His 150 steals over the past two seasons puts him 11th on UNM's career list

## 1,000 POINTS IS A FAMILY TRADITION

- When Jaelen House scored his 1,000th career point on Jan. 3, he became the fourth member of his family to reach the milestone
- He joined his father, Eddie, who scored 2,044 career points from 1997-00 and is still the all-time leading scorer at Arizona State; his grandfather, Henry Bibby, who scored 1,293 career points from 1970-72 while helping UCLA to three straight NCAA titles; and uncle, Mike Bibby, who scored 1,061 points during his two seasons (1997-98) as an All-American at Arizona

## HOUSE NAMED TO OSCAR ROBERTSON TROPHY WATCH LIST

- Jaelen House was one of 50 players named to the Oscar Robertson Trophy Watch List by the USBWA as top candidates for their national player of the year award
- House was the only Mountain West player selected to the list and the first Lobo honored since Cameron Bairstow in 2013-14

## BACK-TO-BACK 500/125 FOR HOUSE

- Jaelen House has become the first Lobo to have multiple seasons with at least 500 points and 125 assists
- House is one of six players nationally with 500p/125a in each of the past two seasons (Sincere Carry-Kent State, Taevion Kinsey-Marshall, Kendric Davis-SMU/Memphis, Trenton Massner-Western Illinois, Dayvion McKnight-Western Kentucky)
- House becomes just the third Mountain West player to have back-to-back 500p/125a seasons, joining Sam Merrill (Utah State) and Jimmer Fredette (BYU)

## THREE REACH 1K

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr., Jaelen House and Morris Udeze have all reached the 1,000 career point mark this year
- Mashburn scored his 1,000th career point (Minnesota and New Mexico combined) in the victory over Iona on Dec. 18, House scored his 1,000th career point (Arizona State and New Mexico combined) in the loss at Fresno State on Jan. 3, and Udeze scored his 1,000th career point (Wichita State and New Mexico combined) in the double OT loss at Nevada on Jan. 23
- Josiah Allick (996 career points) could reach the milestone tonight

## DOUBLE-DOUBLE UDEZE

- Morris Udeze leads the Mountain West with 14 double-doubles this season, the most by a Lobo in a season since 2013-14 when Alex Kirk had 14
- Udeze had nine double-doubles in conference play, one shy of Drew Gordon's school record of 10 double-doubles in regular season Mountain West play
- From January 7-17, Udeze had four straight double-doubles, the longest streak by a Lobo since Joe Furstinger had four straight double-doubles in December of 2017
- Udeze is the first Lobo to average a double-double in Mountain West games since Drew Gordon in 2011-12

### 30-30 CLUB

- Morris Udeze (two) and Jamal Mashburn, Jr. (two) each have multiple 30-point games this year
- It marks the first time two Lobos have had multiple 30-point games in a season since 1993-94 when Greg Brown had four and Marlow White had three
- If one other Lobo posts a 30-point game this season (Jaelen House had four last season), it would be the first time since 1997-98 that three different Lobos had a 30-point game in the same season (Lamont Long, Clayton Shields, Kenny Thomas)

### LOBO FRONT COURT HAS ITS "MOJO"

- New Mexico's frontcourt of transfers Morris Udeze and Josiah Allick have made an immediate impact this season
- They rank first and third in the conference in rebounding as Udeze leads at 9.3 rpg and Allick is third at 7.3 rpg
- Both Udeze and Allick have a pair of 15-rebound games this season after the Lobos went over three seasons without one
- The last time two Mountain West teammates had multiple 15-rebound games in the same season was UNLV's Brandon McCoy and Shakur Juiston in 2017-18

### GOTTA GO TO MO

- Morris Udeze was dominant during November's Lobo Classic, earning tournament MVP honors and being named Mountain West Player of the Week
- Udeze averaged 22.3 points per game in the tournament on 66.7% (24-36) shooting from the floor and 90.5% (19-21) shooting from the free throw line, in addition to 7.3 rebounds and 2.3 assists per game
- In the win over Jacksonville State, he matched his previous career high with 22 points (9-11 FG)
- In the victory over Northern Colorado, he set career highs of 33 points and 14 boards, the first 33/14 game by a Lobo in 20 years and the one of eight 33/14 games in the nation this season

### JENKINS FROM DEEP

- KJ Jenkins leads the Lobos in 3-point percentage this season at 44.9 percent (the 12th best percentage in school history)
- In Mountain West play, Jenkins shot 55.4% (31-56) from deep, the best 3-point percentage ever by a Lobo in Mountain West games (min 20 made 3FG) and the best by a Lobo in conference games since Royce Olney shot 59.3 (48-81) from deep in WAC games in 1997-98
- Of players who made at least 30 3FG in Mountain West games this season, only Jenkins (55.4%) and Adam Seiko of SDSU (53.0) shot over 50% from deep

### 20-20 VISION

- The win over Wyoming in the MW first round marked the eighth time that Jamal Mashburn, Jr. & Jaelen House have both scored at least 20 points in the same game
- That ties for the most games with two Lobos scoring 20 points over the past 40 years

### MOUNTAIN WEST LEADERS

- New Mexico leads the MW in scoring offense at 81.2 ppg (13th nationally)
- The Lobos have the conference leader in scoring (Mashburn), rebounding (Udeze), field goal percentage (Udeze), steals (House), defensive rebounds (Udeze) and double-doubles (Udeze)

### THREE LOBOS "AT THE PEAK"

- Three different Lobos were named Mountain West Player of the Week this season with Morris Udeze (Nov. 28), Jaelen House (Jan. 16) and Jamal Mashburn, Jr. (Jan. 23) all honored
- It marks the first time since 2012-13 that three different Lobos have received the honor as Tony Snell, Alex Kirk and Kendall Williams earned the recognition that season
- It is the first career Mountain West Player of the Week honor for all three, but Udeze did win Player of the Week honors in the American in 2020-21 at Wichita State

### THE LAST UNBEATEN

- The Lobos were the nation's final unbeaten team when they suffered their first loss of the season on Jan. 3 at Fresno State
- It marked the second time in four seasons that the Mountain West had the nation's final undefeated team (San Diego State in 2019-20)

### ROAD WARRIORS

- New Mexico is 7-7 away from home this season, including win five true road wins
- The Lobos are one of three teams in the nation with multiple top-15 NET (final selection ranking - 3/12) road wins this season (Kansas State, TCU)
- New Mexico has snapped Saint Mary's 23-game home win streak in November and San Diego State's 16-game home win streak in January
- The five road wins are the most by UNM in a season since 2017-18

### THE PIT IS ROCKING

- UNM has seen a 34% increase in attendance this season to over 11,600 per game and over 14,000 per game in Mountain West play
- New Mexico has drawn over 14,500 for seven games at The Pit, including five over 15,000
- The Colorado State game on Dec. 28 (15,215) was the first time over 15,000 attended a game at The Pit since 2015-16
- The UNLV game on Jan. 7 (15,424) was the first sellout at The Pit since 2014-15
- The San Diego State game on Feb. 25 (15,431) was the largest crowd since 2009-10 (season before renovations reduced the capacity)

### PITINO'S RANKED WINS

- With the victory at No. 23 San Diego State on Jan. 14, Richard Pitino continued a streak of defeating a ranked opponent
- Going back to his tenure at Minnesota, Pitino has coached his team to a win over an AP ranked opponent in nine straight seasons (since 2014-15)
- He is one of 14 coaches nationally to have accomplished that feat

### SECOND YEAR SUCCESS

- Richard Pitino has led the Lobos to 22 wins the season, tied for second most by a second-year UNM coach (Steve Alford won 22 games in his second season in 2008-09)
- He enters the NIT one win behind Bob King's record of 23 wins in his second season at UNM (King led the Lobos to a 23-6 record in 1963-64)

### WE'RE GOING STREAKING

- The Lobos opened the season with a 14-game win streak, not just their best start to a season since 1967-68, but tied for the third-longest overall win streak in program history
- It trailed only the 17-game streak to open 1967-68 and a 15-game streak in 2009-10, and matched the 14-game streak in 1977-78
- Dating back to the end of last season, UNM won 12 straight games at The Pit before the loss to UNLV, its longest home win streak since a 15-game home win streak from March of 2019 to January of 2020
- The Lobos' 14-game win streak was the longest win streak in Richard Pitino's career (eclipsing eight-game win streaks at Minnesota in February/March of 2017 and November/December of 2014)

### NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

- The Lobos went a perfect 13-0 in non-conference play
- It is the fourth time since 1931-32 (when UNM first joined the Border Conference) that the Lobos went undefeated in regular-season non-conference play (not including the 4-0 COVID-shortened non-conference schedule in 2020-21)
- The Lobos' 13 non-conference victories are their most in a season since going 13-2 in non-conference play in 2012-13
- New Mexico defeated three teams in non-conference play that are the No. 1 seed in their conference's tournament (Iona, Oral Roberts, Saint Mary's)

- A 6-9 native of Dallas, Toppin helped Faith Family Academy of Oak Cliff to the 2022 Texas Class 4A state championship
- He is the No. 38 ranked power forward nationally and the No. 17 overall player in Texas by 247
- Toppin has moved into the Rivals top 125 during his senior season

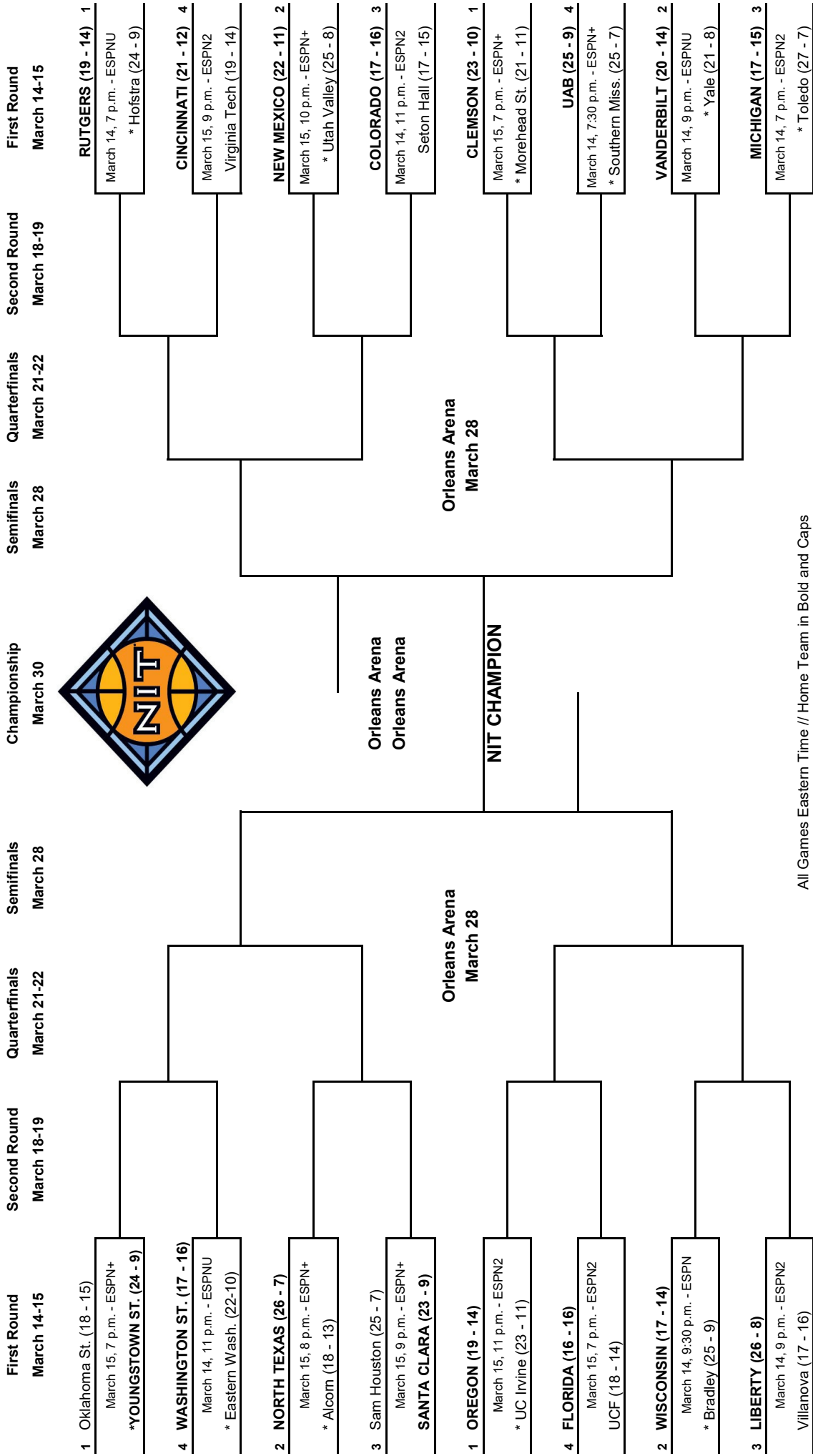
