- ▶ New Mexico concludes its preseason schedule Wednesday with an exhibition contest against Division II New Mexico Highlands
- ▶ It is the second of two exhibitions for UNM against teams from the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (won 83-65 vs. CSU Pueblo on Thursday)
- ▶ The Lobos and Cowboys are playing in the preseason for the first time since 2021-22, a 101-72 UNM victory at The Pit
- ▶ New Mexico earned votes in the preseason Associated Press poll for the first time since the 2014-15 season
- ▶ The Lobos are 28-0 in exhibitions against non-Division I schools

LOBOS CONCLUDE PRESEASON WITH SECOND OF TWO EXHIBITIONS

- New Mexico concludes its preseason schedule on Wednesday night with an exhibition contest against Division II New Mexico Highlands
- It is the second of two exhibitions for UNM against teams from the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (UNM defeated CSU Pueblo last week)
- The Lobos and Cowboys are playing in the preseason for the second time in three seasons
- NMHU was picked 10th in the preseason RMAC poll

SERIES HISTORY

- New Mexico and New Mexico Highlands are meeting for the fifth time in an exhibition (also played 29 times in the regular season)
- Overall, UNM has a 29-4 edge in the series (25-4 regular season, 4-0 exhibitions)
- The last four meetings have been exhibitions, most recently a 101-72 UNM win in 2021-22
- The Lobos have won the last 19 meetings (four exhibition, 15 regular season), with the Cowboys' last win in the series coming in 1929 (31-30 at UNM)

EXHIBITION HISTORY

- New Mexico is 65-6 all-time in preseason exhibitions (all at The Pit)
- Since 2004-05, when the NCAA prohibited exhibitions against non-collegiate teams, the Lobos are 28-1 in exhibitions, with the lone loss coming to BYU in 2017-18 in a fundraiser for Hurricane Harvey relief
- In the 28 exhibition wins against non-Division I colleges, the Lobos' average margin of victory has been 30.3 points with the closest margin being 11 points (80-69 vs. Rogers State in 2015-16)

LAST TIME OUT

- New Mexico opened the preseason with an 83-65 victory over CSU Pueblo on Oct. 26 at The Pit
- Donovan Dent led the Lobos with 26 points and six assists
- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. added 18 points and freshmen JT Toppin and Tru Washington scored 16 and 11 points, respectively, in their first appearance at The Pit
- The Lobos had 13 blocks, led by four from Toppin

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- New Mexico had two players selected to the preseason All-Mountain West team as Jamal Mashburn, Jr. and Jaelen House were honored
- UNM was the only team to have two selections on the five-player team
- It was the first time two Lobos were selected preseason All-Mountain West since 2016-17, when Elijah Brown and Tim Williams were both honored
- Last season, Mashburn was a first-team All-Mountain West selection by the coaches and House was a first-team All-Mountain West selection by the media

EVERY GAME IS A CHALLENGE

- In the preseason KenPom rankings, every one of the Lobos' opponents is ranked in the top 225 in the nation, making UNM the only team in the nation to not play a team ranked 226 or worse
- The Lobos' lowest ranked opponent is Wyoming at No. 214
- UNM's lowest non-conference opponent is UT Arlington at No. 209, making the Lobos one of six teams nationally to not play a team ranked 210 or higher during their non-conference schedule
- Only three UNM opponents are ranked outside the top 200 of the preseason KenPom rankings (Texas Southern - 206; UT Arlington - 209; Wyoming - 214)

LOBOS PICKED THIRD IN MOUNTAIN WEST

- New Mexico was picked third in the preseason Mountain West poll
- It was the Lobos' highest projected finish since 2019-20 (when they were also selected third)
- San Diego State was picked to win the league, followed by Boise State, New Mexico, Nevada, Colorado State, UNLV, San Jose State, Fresno State, Utah State, Wyoming and Air Force

CAPTAINS NAMED

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr., Jaelen House and Jemarl Baker, Jr. were selected as the captains for the 2023-24 Lobos
- Mashburn is serving as captain for the third consecutive year, while House and Baker are captains for the first time in their career

WHO IS BACK?

- New Mexico returns six letterwinners from last season, including two All-Mountain West guards in Jamal Mashburn, Jr. and Jaelen House
- Sebastian Forsling, who has started 13 games over his first two seasons, returns, as does Donovan Dent, who started two games last season as a freshman
- Braden Appelhans is a redshirt freshman after playing just 10 games last season due to injury, while Quinton Webb sat out all of last season as a redshirt

WHO IS NEW?

- New Mexico added eight new players to the roster, five transfers and three freshmen
- Two transfers, Nelly Junior Joseph (Iona, MAAC) and Isaac Mushila (Texas A&M-Corpus Christ, Southland), were first-team all-conference selections at their previous schools last year
- Two additional transfers, Jemarl Baker, Jr. (Fresno State) and Mustapha Amzil (Dayton) were starters at their previous school
- Deraje Agbaosi, who played the last two seasons at North Alabama, joined the Lobos as a non-scholarship player
- Tru Washington and JT Toppin are both four-star recruits and formed one of the highest-rated recruiting classes in UNM history
- Shane Douma-Sanchez, a two-time New Mexico Mr. Basketball, joined the program as a non-scholarship player

FOUR FOR 500

- New Mexico is the only team in the nation to have four players on their roster who scored at least 500 points last season (Jamal Mashburn, Jr. and Jaelen House return, Nelly Junior Joseph and Isaac Mushila scored 500+ last year at their previous schools)
- UNM is one of three schools nationally to return two 500+ scorers from their roster last season, joining Creighton (Trey Alexander, Ryan Kalkbrenner) and North Carolina (Armando Bacot, RJ Davis)
- The Lobos are one of 11 schools nationally to add a pair of 500+ scoring transfers to their roster this season (Alabama, Florida, Illinois, Kansas, LSU, South Carolina, St. John's, TCU, Tennessee, Xavier), and the only one outside of a power conference

500 BACK-TO-BACK

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr. and Jaelen House return after posting 500 point seasons for the second straight year
- Their combined 35.0 ppg last season makes them the third-highest returning duo in UNM history, trailing only Elijah Brown and Tim Williams in 2016-17 and their total the previous season

POLL POSITION

- New Mexico received one vote in the preseason Associated Press poll, marking the first time since 2014-15 that UNM received votes in the preseason rankings
- Two UNM opponents (Saint Mary's, San Diego State) were ranked in the preseason poll, while Boise State also received votes

ON THE AIR

- New Mexico will play at least 18 games this season on national television
- 17 of UNM's 18 Mountain West games are televised, meaning 35 of the last 36 conference games have been on TV (2nd most in the conference)
- The Jan. 13 game against San Diego State is on CBS, marking the first regular-season network television broadcast of Lobo basketball since hosting UNLV on CBS in 2011-12

UP NEXT

- New Mexico will open the regular season Nov. 6 by hosting reigning SWAC Champion Texas Southern
- Game time at The Pit is 7:30 p.m. and the game will air on the Mountain West Network
- The game follows the UNM women's team's season opener, also against Texas Southern, at 5:00 p.m.
