NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

- New Mexico has posted a 22-1 record in regular season non-conference games over the past two seasons (13-0 last year, 9-1 this year)
- The Lobos' .957 win percentage in those games is T-3rd best record nationally (behind Arizona and Purdue, who are both undefeated in non-conference play the last two seasons as they play each other Saturday)
- With a win on Friday, UNM will post a 10-win non-conference season in consecutive seasons for the first time since a four-year stretch from 2010-13
- A win on Friday would also give the Lobos five non-conference wins away from home for the first time since 2012-13 (six non-conference wins away from home)

15 MINUTES (AND 4 SECONDS) OF FAME

- New Mexico's two preseason All-Mountain West guards Jaelen House and Jamal Mashburn, Jr. have missed a combined 10 games due to injury this season (House-5, Mashburn-5)
- The duo has only been on the floor together for a total of 15:04 this season (all in the season-opener vs. Texas Southern)
- The win over Pepperdine on Nov. 24 marked the first game of the Pitino era without either House or Masburn on the floor

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- New Mexico enters the game ranked in the top 40 of KenPom defensively efficiency at 96.3, its best rating since 2012-13 when it finished the year at 90.9
- UNM ranks 31st nationally in steals per game at 9.4 and 32nd nationally in turnovers forced per game at 16.1
- Against Santa Clara, the Lobos had 18 steals (T-4th most in school history vs. Division I opponent) and forced 26 turnovers (most by a UNM opponent since 2017-18)

LIFE IN THE FAST LANE

- New Mexico enters the game ranked ninth nationally in KenPom adjusted tempo, at 74.6 possessions per game
- It is the highest pace UNM has ever had since KenPom started tracking the stat in 1996-97
- The Lobos finished 17th in pace last season (71.6) and 22nd in 2021-22 (70.9)

SERIES HISTORY

- New Mexico leads 124-103 all-time (NMSU leads 61-48 in Las Cruces & 30-23 at Pan Am Center)
- The Lobos are looking for the series sweep for the 10th time in the past 25 years
- UNM has won the last two meetings in Las Cruces, 101-94 in 2021-22 and 78-77 in 2019-20
- The Lobos won this year's first meeting 106-62 on Dec. 2 at The Pit, the second largest margin of victory in series history (UNM won 86-38 in Albuquerque in 1964-65)
- The 1964-65 Lobos recorded the largest combined winning margin in season sweep in the series, winning by a combined 73 points (48 in Albuquerque / 25 in Las Cruces)

AGAINST CONFERENCE USA

- Tonight's game is the Lobos' third of three this season against a team from Conference USA
- The Lobos are 4-2 against CUSA teams under Richard Pitino, having defeating Florida Atlantic in the 2021-22 opener before losses to UAB and UTEP that season, a win over UTSA last year and victories over Louisiana Tech and New Mexico State this season

LAST TIME OUT

- New Mexico defeated Santa Clara 93-76 on Saturday in the Jack Jones Classic in Henderson, Nev.
- The Lobos had 18 steals and forced 26 Bronco turnovers
- Donovan Dent led UNM with 22 points, his second straight 20-point game
- Jemarl Baker, Jr. added 17 points on 4-6 shooting from three

THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT

- New Mexico is one of four teams in the nation with multiple true freshmen averaging double figure scoring (Kentucky-3, Baylor, New Mexico, VMI) as JT Toppin is at 12.7 ppg and Tru Washington is at 11.6 ppg
- Only six UNM true freshmen have ever finished a season averaging double figure scoring, the last coming in 2010-11 (Kendall Williams)
- Toppin became the first ever Lobo freshman to post consecutive doubledoubles with his performances against UT Arlington and Toledo in November
- Toppin (twice) and Washington (once) have combined to win three Mountain West Freshman of the Week honors this season

DENT DISHING IT OUT

- Donovan Dent is the only player in the nation with multiple games this season with 10 or more assists and no turnovers
- His two games of 10 assists/0 turnovers are tied for the most in a career by a Lobo (Marlon Parmer & Darrell McGee), but accomplished the feat in fewer career games
- He had a career-high 11 assists (and no turnovers) against Rice in the Ball Dawgs Classic on Nov. 22, the second-most assists in a zero turnover game in UNM history (T-most against a Division I opponent)
- He had 10 assists (and no turnovers) in the win over New Mexico State at The Pit on Dec. 2

YOU AREN'T ROBBING THE HOUSE, THE HOUSE IS ROBBING YOU

- Jaelen House has 18 steals in his four games this season, including his 18th game at UNM with at least four steals with six vs. Santa Clara
- His 104 steals over the past two seasons ranks fifth nationally
- He enters tonight's game 8th on UNM's career steals list with 172

TOPPIN HISTORIC DOUBLE-DOUBLES

- JT Toppin became the first Lobo freshman to post consecutive double-doubles with his performances against UT Arlington (15p/10r) and Toledo (27p/11r)
- He became the first Lobo true freshman to post a double-double since Hugh Greenwood had 10 points and 10 rebounds in a win at Boise State in 2011-12
- He is just the fifth Lobo freshman to have multiple double-doubles in a season, joining Kenny Thomas (7 in 1995-96), Mark Walters (2 in 2002-03), John Robinson II (2 in 1998-99, both points/assists) and Alan Dolensky (2 in 1980-81)

TRU FRESHMAN

- Tru Washington has scored in double figures in each of the last six games, the fifth-longest streak by a UNM freshman
- His 21 point performance in the first New Mexico State game was not only a career high, but marked the first 20-point game off the bench by a Lobo since KJ Jenkins scored 26 off the bench at UNLV in 2021-22

- Donovan Dent ranks ninth nationally in assists per game at 6.7
- JT Toppin ranks 57th nationally in blocks (5th among freshman nationally) at 1.8 per game
- As a team, the Lobos rank in the top 30 nationally in several categories: turnover margin (11th +5.4), scoring offense (17th 86.1 ppg), scoring margin (18th +17.9), fast break points (27th 15.9 ppg), assist/turnover ratio (27th 1.55) and free throw attempts per game (30th 24.6)

CAPTAINS NAMED

- Jamal Mashburn, Jr., Jaelen House and Jemarl Baker, Jr. were selected as the captains for the 2023-24 Lobos
- Mashburn is serving as captain for the third consecutive year, while House and Baker are captains for the first time in their career

HISTORIC SEASON-OPENING WIN

- New Mexico's 92-55 season-opening win over reigning SWAC Champion Texas Southern made history
- It was the third-largest margin of victory over the past decade for a seasonopening win against a team coming off a NCAA Tournament appearance (trailing only a 42-point win by Baylor in 2015-16 over Stephen F. Austin and a 40-point win by Villanova over Mount St. Mary's in 2021-22)
- It was UNM's largest margin of victory in a season opener against a Division I opponent since a 92-40 win over New Orleans in the 2011-12 opener
- The 37-point win was the Lobos' largest against a Division I opponent in any game since an 83-43 win over Arkansas-Pine Bluff in December of 2016

LOBOS PICKED THIRD IN MOUNTAIN WEST

- New Mexico was picked third in the preseason Mountain West poll
- It was the Lobos' highest projected finish since 2019-20 (when they were also selected third)
- San Diego State was picked to win the league, followed by Boise State, New Mexico, Nevada, Colorado State, UNLV, San Jose State, Fresno State, Utah State, Wyoming and Air Force

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- New Mexico had two players selected to the preseason All-Mountain West team as Jamal Mashburn, Jr. and Jaelen House were honored
- UNM was the only team to have two selections on the five-player team
- It was the first time two Lobos were selected preseason All-Mountain West since 2016-17, when Elijah Brown and Tim Williams were both honored
- Last season, Mashburn was a first-team All-Mountain West selection by the coaches and House was a first-team All-Mountain West selection by the media

ON THE AIR

- New Mexico will play at least 18 games this season on national television
- 17 of UNM's 18 Mountain West games are televised, meaning 35 of the last 36 conference games have been on TV (2nd most in the conference)
- The Jan. 13 game against San Diego State is on CBS, marking the first regular-season network television broadcast of Lobo basketball since hosting UNLV on CBS in 2011-12

LOBOS SIGN TWO

- New Mexico signed two players during the November signing period for the class of 2024
- Kayde Dotson, a guard from Beaumont, Texas, and Jovan Milicevic, a forward from Toronto, Ont. (playing high school basketball in Arizona), are both ranked among the top 250 players in the class

UP NEXT

- New Mexico will return home on Dec. 20 to host UC Irvine, currently the highest ranked KenPom team in the Big West (No. 73)
- The teams both went 3-0 earlier this season at the Ball Dawgs Classic in Las Vegas, but did not play each other in the event, which had predetermined matchups
- Game-time is 7 p.m. and the game will air on Mountain West Network and the Lobo Radio Network
