- STEAL YOUR BASE
 Keyannah Chavez's three stolen bases against Tennessee State were the most for a Lobo in a single game since 2017, when D'Andra DeFlora had three against Santa Clara on 3/11/17.
 UNM's six stolen bases in the season opener were the most in a game since 2018, when UNM had six against Howard on 3/10/18. In addition to Chavez's three, Ashley Archuleta had two stolen bases and Katherine Brunner had one stolen base.
 The Lobos then stole seven bases against Marist on Feb. 16, the most in a single game for UNM since 2010.

- Ine Lobos then stole seven bases against Marist on Feb. 16, the most in a single game for UNM since 2010. •Emma Bramson and Elizabeth Baylor each stole two, with Sydney Carithers, DeNae Vasquez-Dickson and Archuleta each stealing one. UNM is 24-25 on the season in stolen bases with nine different players recording at least one. UNM successfully stole on its first 24 attempts, with the lone caught stealing in the Feb. 18 game against Marist. •Archuleta leads UNM going 6-6 with Bramson 4-4, Carithers 3-3, Baylor, Rachael Hathoot and Vasquez-Dickson 2-2 and Gabrielle Briones and Brunner 1-1. Chavez is 3-4 on the season. UNM is currently tied for seventh in the NCAA in stolen bases and 33rd in stolen bases per game (2.0). Archuleta is 24th in the NCAA in stolen bases.

KEY CONTRIBUTOR

- Keyannah Chavez had a sensational second week of the season, leading the Lobos with nine hits, two doubles, two triples, 15 total bases, and had a .833 slugging percentage and a .550 on-base percentage. Chavez closed the ACU Tournament going a combined 4-4 on Sunday with a double, a triple, a walk and one RBI, finishing with a 1.750 slugging percentage. Her 3-3 performance against Marist was her second three-hit outing of the season and her team-high fifth multi-hit game of the season.
- season. Chavez enters the weekend on a five-game hitting streak. The sophomore leads the team in batting average (.469), slugging percentage (.656), on-base percentage (.514), hits (15), triples (two) and total bases (21) and is tied for the team high in runs scored (seven) and doubles (two). She is also 6-11 (.245) with runners on, 11-15 (.733) in successfully advancing runners and 3-6 with runners in scoring position. Chavez is 33rd in the NCAA in hits, sixth in triples and 21st in toughest to strike out at 32.0. Among the MW, Chavez is fifth in batting average and hits, ninth in on-base percentage, 10th in slug-ging percentage, tied for first in triples and tied for sixth in total bases.

- GUEST APPEARANCE
 Freshman McKenna Guest has been a steady force in the circle for the Lobos, appearing in a team-high nine games, starting a team-high six games and throwing three complete games.

The Lobos scored three runs on two hits in the inning, with all three runs coming from runners who reached on free bases. The Lobos have drawn 31 walks, with Ashley Archuleta leading with eight, Katherine Brunner at four and Emma Bramson, Chloe Yeatts and Sydney Carithers walking three times each. Archuleta leads the MW in walks.

 A LOOK BACK AT 2023

 The Lobos made statistical improvements in Coach Nicole Dickson's first year at UNM, both in NCAA rankings and among program single-season stats.
 When it comes to program milestones:

 The .299 batting average was the best batting average since 2015 and tied the best batting average in the last 11 years. UNM's 231 runs were the most since 2016, the 399 hits were the most since 2016, the 309 hits were the most since 2016, the 300 hits were the most since 2016, the 300 hits were the most since 2017, the 14 triples were the most since 2010, the 214 RBI the most since 2013 as was the .368 on -base percentage. The 40 stolen bases were the most since 2013.
 UNM pitched 4 shutouts, the most since 2013 and turned 22 double plays, the most since 2015.

 UNM improved from 2022 to 2023 in 8 NCAA statistical categories:

 The Lobos in proved 141 spots in double plays turned per game (finished 27th with .44), improved 88 spots in triples per game (29th at .28), 87 spots in stolen bases per game (192nd at .80), 86 spots in batting average (45th at .299), 49 spots in stolen bases per game (192nd at .80), 86 spots in on-base percentage (68th at .368), 16 spots in shutouts (189 at 4) and 12 spots in slugging percentage (88th at .422).
 On opening weekend last season, UNM beat No. 19 Oregon State 8-0 in five innings for the first win against a ranked opponent since 2016 and the first run-rule of a ranked opponent since 2012.
 UNM had two players finish in the top 4 in the MW in batting average, with one returner in Rachael Hathoot (second at .396), and Hathoot also finished in the top 5 in the MW in hits (fifth at 59). Both Hathot and Ashley Archuleta were among the top 2 in triples with Hathoot leading with seven and Archuleta tied for second with five.
 The Lobos had two First Team All-Mountain West players in Archuleta and Hathoot, the second of Archuleta of the W

FRESH PERSPECTIVE

- The Lobos revamped their roster with 12 freshmen and a total of 15 newcomers. Of the freshmen, UNM added four pitchers, three outfielders, three utility players and two infielders.
- Innerders. UNM also added three transfers in junior catcher/ infielder Sydney Carithers, junior pitcher Emily Brouse and sophomore outfielder Taylor Morgan. Of the freshmen, Katherine Brunner has started all 12 games, eight games at third and four as the designated player. Macie Andrews has started four games, all in left, DeNae Vasquez-Dickson six games in left and Gabrielle Briones starting in one game at second. McKenna Guest leads the Lobos' pitching staff with six starts and nine appearances. Carithers has started 10 games at catcher.

- PLL FOLLOW YOU
 Sydney Carithers followed Coach Dickson to UNM after two seasons at SFA, where she played for Coach Dickson as a freshman.
 Her freshman season, Carithers played in 54 games with 52 starts, hitting .245 with a .338 slugging percentage and a .286 on-base percentage. She finished with 37 hits, six doubles, one triple and two home runs, recording 16 RBI.
 In her two seasons, she played in 105 games with 102 starts.

- AT THE CENTER OF IT ALL
 After starting all 50 games last season in left field, sophomore Keyannah Chavez has moved over to center.
 Chavez finished with 45 hits, seven doubles, 19 RBI and 19 walks and hit .315 with a .410 onbase percentage and a .364 slugging percentage.
 The Leander, Texas native led the team in walks and was second in runs scored (36) and tied for second in doubles. She was third on the team in on-base percentage and hits, fourth in batting average and had a 16-game streak of reaching base and a six-game hitting streak.
 Chavez finished the season with a four-game streak of reaching base and a two-game hitting streak.

- streak. She posted 12 multiple hit games and five multiple RBI games. Her freshman season, she was named MW Freshman of the Week twice (Feb. 21 and March 28) and MW Player of the Week once (March 28). This season, Chavez has six hits and is hitting .286, which included hitting a combined .714 with five hits in the first two games of the season.

 The Lobos are anchored in the middle infield with the stability and experience of Ashley Archuleta (second) and Rachael Hathoot (shortstop).
 Entering her junior season, Archuleta has played in 100 games with 96 starts at second.
 • The Rio Rancho, New Mexico native is coming off of her best season as a Lobo in terms of home runs (3), triples (5), batting average (.331), slugging percentage (.508) and RBI (25).
 • She finished the season on a 10-game hitting streak and had 13 games with multiple hits and eight games with multiple RBI.
 • In MW games, was second in hits (31), fifth in batting average (.437), sixth in slugging (.676), 10th in on-base % (.481)
 Hathoot started all 50 games last season at shortstop, but has started all 122 games during her three years. The redshirt senior has shown her versatility, playing 42 games at second and four as a catcher her sophomore season (2021) and 26 games at third her freshman season.
 • She is also coming off her best season as a Lobo with 59 hits, nine doubles, seven triples, 31 RBI, 91 total bases, 12 walks, 38 runs scored, a. 396 batting average, .452 on-base percentage and .611 slugging percentage.
 • She was 23-53 (.434) with runners in scoring position, 19-37 (.514) as the leadoff and 4-8 with bases loaded last season.
 • Her seven triples tied for the third most in a single season in program history, last done in 1998, It also ranked firth in the NCAA and her 0.14 triples per game ranked seventh.
 • Hathoot led the team in batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage, doubles, triples, runs scored and she tied for the team high in RBI
 • Her 59 hits were more than her freshman and sophomore season combined, as were her 91 total bases.

- TINE NUMBERS UNN was 14-6 when scoring in the first inning and 13-5 when scoring first last season. The Lobos were 11-3 when leading after one, 13-1 when leading after two and 12-1 when leading after three. As the game went on, the Lobos were 13-5 when leading after the fourth inning, 11-2 when leading after five and 12-0 when leading after the sixth inning. UNM was 19-4 when outhitting its opponent last season and had 22 games with double-digit

- hits and were 16-6 when reaching double figures. The Lobos have twice reached double figures in hits this season: UNM's win against Tennessee State where the Lobos finished with 12 hits, and 15 hits in the win against Marist on Feb. 16. UNM is also 3-0 this season when scoring at least six runs. If the Lobos can score in the first inning and hold a lead after the first inning, the Lobos are 2-1 when scoring in the first inning and 2-0 when leading after the first, second, third, fourth, fifth and sixth innings.

 UNM was picked eighth in the MW Preseason Coaches' Poll with 17 points and two points behind Utah State.

- **LAST ONE, BEST ONE FOR RACHAEL**After earning Mountain West All-Conference First Team last season, New Mexico shortstop Rachael Hathoot has been selected by the conference coaches to the All-Mountain West Preseason Team, one of 12 position players and the only Lobo to earn the preseason distinction.
 "Rachael is a top three player in the Mountain West Conference," commented head softball coach Nicole Dickson. "She is talented, competitive and has a high game IQ. She's been a leader and set the tone from day 1. Her mentality, work ethic and drive are consistent, and I believe her best softball is in front of her this season."
 Hathoot enters the season after hitting .414 with a .643 slugging percentage and a .468 on-base percentage in 22 MW games in 2023. Against conference eopponents, Hathoot recorded 29 hits, which included five doubles, four triples and a home run for 45 total bases and accounted for 19 runs and 13 RBI.
 The Albuquerque native led the Lobos in runs scored, was second in batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage, hits and total bases, tied for the team lead in triples and was third in runs batted in. Hathoot had nine multiple hit games with at least one hit in 18 conference games as well as seven MW games with at least one RBI and three games with multiple RBI.
 Among the MW, Hathoot finished tied for 13th in runs scored. In addition, Hathoot turned six double plays, tied for the second most among conference players, and was third in assists (54).

- IT STARTS IN THE CIRCLE
 From the time she was hired, Coach Dickson has repeatedly stated that success starts in the circle, and it starts with veteran returners Amber Linton and Taylor Snow.
 RHP Amber Linton appeared in a team-high 32 games and 25 starts, throwing 14 complete games and 158.2 innings last season. Linton led the MW with 164 strikeouts and 48 looking, while also leading in innings pitched. Her 14 complete games doubled her total from her sophomore season and in addition, she threw three shutouts and had 15 games with five or more strikeouts. Linton set a career high with 14 strikeouts at Utah State, one of three games that she finished with 10+ strikeouts. Her 164 strikeouts ranked 58th in the NCAA and were the fifth most in a single season in program history. history

- History.
 Her 7.24 strikeouts per game in 2023 was the single-season program record, breaking her own record of 6.97 she set in 2022.
 Linton enters her senior season needing 123 strikeouts to set the career record at UNM, with the Lobo recording over 150 strikeouts her first two seasons at UNM.
 On Linton, Coach Dickson commented that, "Amber has been grinding all offseason to expand her pitch resume. She is the veteran of the staff and she's going to get the ball. I believe she has a chip on her shoulder from last season- she's hungry to win and her work ethic backs it up. If she commands the zone and we play defense behind her, she has the ability to be one of the top three pitchers in the Mountain West."
 In her first season at UNM, RHP Snow appeared in 29 games with 14 starts, throwing two complete games. She finished with a 4.86 ERA, pitching 90.2 innings and allowing 83 runs (63 earned), 128 hits, striking out 28 and walking 29. Snow had the second-most appearances, starts, innings pitched and strikeouts on the pitchers, four of which are freshmen, in the offseason in McKenna Guest (RHP), Kenzie Jones (RHP) and Alina Ortiz (RHP) and Brooke Umali (LHP) and junior Emily Brouse (RHP), who previously played at Odessa.
 To date, Guest has made the most appearances with nine and thrown a staff-high 34.2 inning with six starts, three complete games and one save. The Lobos have used five pitchers with each pitcher recording at least one start. Guest (two) and Snow (one) have earned a win.

- D LET UP IN NON-CONFERENCE Entering her second season at UNM, Coach Dickson put together a schedule that includes seven teams that competed in the NCAA Tournament last season (McNeese, Cal, Louisiana, Marist, Minnesota, GCU, and San Diego State from the MW) with a team that advanced to the Super Regionals, 15 teams that won over 30 games and three teams that won over 40 games last season. The Lobos will face three Power 5 teams in Cal (Pac-12), Minnesota (Big Ten) and Texas Tech (Big 12).

- LIFE ON THE ROAD
 The Lobos have 13 of 54 total games at home.
 UNM's first 17 games of the season will be on the road, taking the Lobos to Louisiana and three times to Texas before the home opener on Feb. 28 against Texas Tech.
 Following the Feb. 28 home game, the Lobos don't have another home game until the MW series against UNLV starting on March 22, which includes a prolonged stay on the road with a tournament in Phoenix and the Lobos heading straight to Honolulu.

FIRST GAME, FIRST WIN
 Coach Dickson became just the second coach to win in their Lobo coaching debut, doing so with the largest margin of victory (+9) when UNM run-ruled Nicholls 12-3 in five on Feb. 9, 2023. Erica Beach was the other head coach to win in her first game (a 10-2, five inning win against Utah Valley on Feb. 12, 2011).

- ABOUT STEPHEN F. AUSTIN
 Stephen F. Austin enters the UNT Invite 2-8 on the season following a midweek split against Sam Houston State.
 Kelby Robbins leads the team with a .368 batting average, while Ellie Vance and Madison Nguyen lead with eight hits. Lexi Benson has driven in a team-high five runs and has walked a team-high seven times.
 In the circle, SFA has used five pitchers, led by five appearances from Alexis Tedford, who has thrown three complete games and made four starts. Aydenne Brown has also started four games, with Brooke Gainous starting in two, appearing in four and throwing one complete game. Telford has thrown a team-high S8. Joinnings, 10 innings more than the next pitcher on the staff, and has struck out 22 compared to eight walks.
 On the bases, SFA is 6-10, with Vance 2-3 and Kaylee Paul 2-2. Opponents are 13-18 in stolen bases.

- ABOUT NORTH TEXAS
 The Mean Green are 3-5 entering the weekend, 1-3 at home and have lost their last two following losses to Missouri (11-2 in five and 10-0) and a spli with South Dakota State (won 9-4 and lost 7-2) last weekend at home.
 UNT is led at the plate by Rylee Nicholson, who is hitting .333 with a .600 slugging percentage and .500 on-base percentage. She is one of seven players with a home run, one of seven players with a double and one of four players with both a double and a home run. Nicholson also leads with six stolen bases, going 6-6 while as a team, UNT is 10-11. Kat Ibarra leads with 10 total bases and six hits, which also includes a home run and double, while Tatum Sparks leads with five RBI.
 North Texas has used four pitchers this season, led by McKenzie Wagoner with five appearances, however, Sklyar Savage leads with 18.1 innings in four appearances and three starts. Mackenzie Childers has the best strikeout-to-walk numbers on the staff with 13 strikeouts to three walks.
 They were picked to finish third in the American preseason coaches' poll with 66 points and one first-place vote. UNT returns eight position players who started and three pitchers.

 Minnesota is 4-3 on the season with wins over San Diego State (5-3), UC Santa Barbara (8-5 and 4-3) and Georgia Tech (12-11).
 The Golden Gophers are led by Jess Oakland, who has a team-high 11 hits, which includes a team-high two home runs, as well as leading in batting average (.440), total bases (18), RBI (nine), slugging percentage (.720) and on-base percentage (.500). Breezy Burnett has accounted for half of Minnesota's six stolen bases, with four players stealing at least one base.
 Minnesota has had five pitchers appear in a game this season, led by six appearances by Sydney Schwartz. Bri Enter has made four starts with one complete game to lead the pitching staff and has thrown a team-high 21.0 innings with 13 strikeouts to three walks. Enter is 2-0 on the season, while Schwartz is 2-2 with one save.

HEAD COACH NICOLE DICKSON



Nicole Dickson enters her second season as head coach of the Lobo softball program in 2023-24. Hired on June 3, 2022, Dickson is the sixth head coach in program history.

The Lobos took significant statistical strides in her first year in Albuquerque, producing numbers that hadn't been achieved in several years. Of note, UNM's .299 batting average was the best since 2015 and tied the best average for the program in the last 11 years. The 399 hits and 231 runs scored were the most since 2015 and 2016, respectively, and the 214 RBI and .368 on-base percentage were the highest since 2015. The team's 14 triples were the most in a single season since 2010 and the Lobos' 40 stolen bases were the most since 2013. Defensively, the Lobos led the MW with 22 double plays, the most turned since 2015 and the four shutouts were the most since 2013.

Additionally, UNM jumped in the NCAA rankings from a season ago in eight categories: batting average (a ranking improvement of 86 spots), triples per game (88 spots), stolen bases per game (87 spots), runs (49 spots), on-base percentage (46 spots), slugging percentage (12 spots), shutouts (16 spots) and double plays turned (141 spots). The Lobos ranked 45th in batting average, 27th in double plays per game, 29th in triples per game, 68th in on-base percentage and 88th in slugging percentage.

It didn't take long to see the potential as with UNM's season-opening win over Nicholls, Dickson became just the second Lobo head coach in program history to win in their coaching debut, doing so with the largest margin of victory (12-3 in five innings). Three games later, Dickson and the Lobos made more history, beating No. 19 Oregon State 8-0 in five innings for UNM's first win over a ranked opponent since 2016 and UNM's first run-rule win over a ranked opponent since 2012.

During the season, Dickson guided the Lobos to their first series win over Nevada since 2015, UNM's 8-0 win over SJSU on March 25 was the first shutout against the Spartans since May 8, 2015, and the 12 runs scored against CSU on April 16 were the most runs the Lobos have scored against the Rams since April 15, 2016. In the March 19th win at Utah State, the Lobos finished with 18 hits, 15 runs and struck out 14 Aggies, with the 18 hits the most since 2018 and the 15 runs were the most since 2019. The 15 runs were the most against the Aggies since April 26, 2014, and the 14 strikeouts by Amber Linton were the most in a game by a Lobo since 2013.

Among the conference, UNM had players in the top four in the MW in batting average (Rachael Hathoot second at .396 and Peyton Robinson fourth at .380), two players in the top 5 in the MW in hits (Robinson fourth at 60 and Hathoot fifth at 59), two players in the top 2 in triples (Hathoot first at seven and Ashley Archuleta tied for second at 5) and had two MW Player of the Week, one Pitcher of the Week and two Freshman of the Week honors.

UNM produced two All-Mountain West First Team members in Archuleta and Hathoot, who each had their best seasons in a Lobo uniform.

Hathoot produced her best season as a Lobo with 59 hits, nine doubles, seven triples, 31 RBI, 91 total bases, 12 walks, 38 runs scored, a .396 batting average, .452 on-base percentage and .611 slugging percentage and her seven triples tied for the third most in a single season in program history, last done in 1998. Her 59 hits were more than her freshman and sophomore seasons combined, as were her total bases. Further, she had a career-best 15-game hit streak and career-best 20-game streak of reaching base, while also leading the team with 18 multiple hit games, five games with hree hits and had seven multiple RBI games with a career-best 014 bases. Further, she had a career-best 15-game hit streak and career-best 20-game streak of reaching base, MV, the Lobo led the MW in triples and assists (114), was second in fielding double plays, second in batting average, fifth in hits, eighth in slugging percentage and total bases and ninth in on-base percentage. Archuleta finished with 43 hits, four doubles, five triples (tied for the ninth most in a single season in program history) and three home runs, 25 RBI and 66 total bases, had a .508 slugging percentage and stolen bases.

In the circle, Amber Linton recorded a MW-best 164 strikeouts and set a program record in strikeouts per game at 7.24, besting her own program record of 6.97 she set in 2022. Her 14 complete games doubled her total from the previous year and she also registered 15 games with five or more strikeouts and three games with 10-plus strikeouts, an improvement over last season as well.

Nationally, Hathoot finished 53rd in the NCAA in batting average, fifth in triples and seventh in triples per game, Archuleta finished 28th in triples and 30th in triples per game, Robinson finished 30th in sacrifice bunts and Linton finished 58th in strikeouts.

"I am excited to have Nicole join the Lobo Family," said Vice President/Director of Athletics Eddie Nuñez at the time of her hire. "She has been highly successful at multiple levels and she has a history of building programs. Her vision for what Lobo Softball can be, and how to build it, is what we need to bring our program to a championship level."

Prior to arriving at UNM, Dickson spent six seasons as the head coach at Stephen F. Austin, with the Ladyjacks surpassing 30 wins in four of five seasons and were on pace for another stellar result in the shortened 2020 season with a 19-4 record. Through her six seasons, Dickson compiled a 169-123 record and was named the 2021 Southland Conference Coach of the Year.

Under her leadership, SFA had 20 all-conference selections, as well as two hitter of the year and pitcher of the year selections, a player of the year and a freshman of the year.

"I am grateful for the opportunity to join UNM Athletics," Dickson stated upon her selection as the new Lobo head coach. "I really value, and aligned with, the core values and vision for the program. Both Eddie Nuñez and Deputy A.D. for External Affairs Dave Williams are all in, and are willing to support the student-athletes to have a quality experience and want to see softball be successful. I loved the community and coaches and the beautiful campus sells itself.

"I am excited to work with the student-athletes and develop a competitive, hard-working culture focused on getting better every day. The goal is to compete for championships and represent the campus and community positively on and off the field."

In her last season at SFA, the Ladyjacks went 18-6 in conference play and 31-27 overall, winning the Southwest Division and advancing to the WAC Tournament final as the No. 2 seed. The Ladyjacks had three players make the All-WAC feam with Kassidy Wilbur claiming Pitcher of the Year. Wilbur struck out a conference-best 219 batters, holding the opposition to a .211 batting average while recording a WAC-high 37 appearances and tying the WAC lead in wins with 19. In her 18 complete games, she recorded a conference-high six shutouts.

Prior to that, the Ladyjacks won their second Southland Conference regular season title in 2021 with a 35-12 overall and 25-2 conference record, resulting in Dickson being selected Coach of the Year.

As a result of Dickson's and the Ladyjacks' success, three players were named to the 2021 NFCA All-Region Division I teams, with two first team selections and a third team selection. In addition, under her guidance, SFA had seven named to the all-conference teams that included the Southland Conference's Pitcher of the Year, Hitter of the Year and Player of the Year. Wilbur was also named Southland Conference Pitcher and Player of the Year in the league, the first time a Ladyjack has collected both honors simultaneously, as well as named a JWOS All-American Second Team.

Further, in 2021, the program set three program records. SFA's 25 league wins and just two conference losses were a program best, with the team setting another program record with 18 consecutive wins.

In the shortened 2020 season, Dickson and the Ladyjacks went 19-4 and set a program record with a then-13 consecutive wins with a NCAA Division I best nine true road wins. In the 2019, SFA went 36-23, compiling wins over Power Five programs Illinois, Mississippi State, Indiana and Baylor.

Before taking the helm at SFA, Dickson gained experience as the head coach at Tyler Junior College (2013-16) and a spent a year as the head coach at Paris Junior College (2012-13). Dickson got her start in coaching as a graduate assistant at Hardin-Simmons in 2008 before getting her first coaching job as an assistant coach at Howard College in 2010.

Dickson earned a B.S. in health and physical education from Eastern New Mexico in 2008 and earned a master's in sports management and kinesiology from Hardin-Simmons in 2009.

In addition, Coach Dickson's first win at SFA was against UNM (a 5-1 win on Feb. 17, 2017).
