.EADING OFF...

- New Mexico Baseball hits the road today for a midweek matchup with Arizona (13-13, 7-5 Pac-12) tomorrow at Hi Corbett Field in Tucson, Ariz. to open up a week off from Mountain West play.
- The Lobos (16-11, 7-5 MW) are looking to get back in the win column after losing both games of a doubleheader for the first time this season to drop a weekend series on the road at San Diego State (5-2, 6-8, 0-13). Entering last week as the Mountain West's leaders in nearly every offensive category after a week in which they averaged 13 hits and 12.75 runs per game, the Lobos were held to 4.3 hits and 3.67 runs per game in the weekend series despite defeating the Aztecs 5-2 in the series opener for their first win over SDSU since 2021. They were held hitless in a seven-inning loss in the finale for the first time since 1990.
- Tuesday's game is the first of four consecutive matchups with 2023 NCAA Regional qualifiers for UNM. The Lobos will return home to host 2023 WAC Champions Sam Houston for a threegame set April 5-7 -- UNM's final multi-game non conference series of the season.
- The Lobos found a penchant for the long ball in the month of March - after homering four times in their first eight games, they've connected on 30 for a total of 61 RBI in their last 19 games since March 1. UNM is 10-1 in games this season in which the Lobos hit multiple homers and are slugging a MW-best .516 as a team.
- In conference matchups, UNM is batting .313 as a team with an OPS of .946 while averaging 8.92 runs and 10.5 hits per game.
- On the season, UNM also ranks No. 5 in all of D-I college baseball in double plays per game



REGIONAL APPEARANCES

(1.1), No. 10 in team on-base percentage (.437), No. 12 in total doubles (68), No. 14 in base on balls (171), No. 21 in batting average (.316), No. 26 in runs scored (236), No. 28 in total hits (291) and No. 31 in slugging (.516) - the Lobos lead the Mountain West in all of those categories.

ALL-TIME SERIES

It's the third-straight season that the Lobos square off with Arizona and the fourth meeting in that span - UNM is 1-2 against the Wildcats in that span. Prior to that, the two teams hadn't faced each other since 2019

UNM Head Coach Tod Brown is a Tucson, Ariz, native and Arizona alum (1994) - A left-handed pitcher for the Wildcats from 1989-1994, Brown led the team to a Pac-10 Championship 1992. In 1993, he won six games and saved eight, setting a record with 35 appearances as Arizona fell one game short of the College World Series. Brown began his collegiate coaching career in 1999 as a volunteer assistant for Arizona, working with pitchers and catchers and coaching first base for the Wildcats, who qualified for an NCAA regional that season.

Brown is 2-12 against the Wildcats in his tenure as a head coach (North Dakota State, 2008-21; New Mexico 2022-present).

ON DECK

After hosting Sam Houston (17-12, 3-6 C-USA) this weekend, the Lobos head south to face in-state rivals New Mexico State (11-6, 1-5 C-USA) for the second time this season on Tuesday in Las Cruces.

MW AWARDS SWEEP

UNM swept the MW Weekly honors last Monday, with Jake Holland winning Player of the Week and Ryan Castillo winning Freshman & Pitcher of the Week for their respective performances over the weekend.

5 THINGS TO KNOW

UNM finished 2023 with the third-best team batting average (.328) in D-I and are batting .313 after last weekend. The Lobos improved from 21-33 in Brown's first season to 26-25 in '23, going from a 9.06 ERA as a team to a 5.95. UNM is 1-1 against Pac-12 foes this season, falling to OSU on opening day but defeating Arizona State on the road. The Lobos lead the MW in doubles, batting avg, HR, total runs, total hits, double plays and BB, ranking Top-30 in NCAA in all. Jake Holland was named MW POTW after a dominant weekend against SJSU (.727 avg, 4 HR, 2 2B, 14 RBI)

Holland led the Lobos with a .727 batting average and 2.000% slugging (2.750 OPS) with 14 RBI over three games last weekend, homering four times and hitting two doubles in the process. He batted .750 with runners in scoring position (6-for-8) and .667 in two-out situations (4-for-6) in that span. The senior catcher finished with multiple hits, runs and RBI in all three games, homering in each - Holland scored eight runs on the weekend, drawing three walks and only striking out once. He also started behind the dish in all three games, generating 25 putouts and three assists without any errors.

A weekend in review for the Orlando, Fla. native:

Led the Lobos with five RBI on a homer and two doubles in the series opener on Friday and homered twice in the series finale while racking up seven RBI to help the Lobos run-rule the Spartans, 17-4 in seven innings.

In a pivotal Game Two on Saturday the first game of the doubleheader - he got on the base paths all in all five at-bats via a home run, two singles, a walk and a HBP. His seventh-inning solo shot tied the game up at 4-all and his RBI base knock in the eighth put the Lobos up 7-5 — a lead they'd hold onto through nine.

Drove in the first run for the Lobos with a sac fly in Game Two on Saturday after they fell behind 3-0 early — he hit his third homer of the weekend for 3 RBI in the next inning to cap off a five-run frame that changed the complexion of the game entirely. Added his fourth no-doubter in the penultimate frame to yield three more runs and put UNM up by 13.

Castillo - a true freshman making just his fourth appearance of the season on Saturday – was a revelation in relief in Game Two, earning his first career win while notching career-highs in innings pitched (5) and strikeouts (7) without surrendering a single earned run. He retired 13 of 15 batters he faced, allowing only two hits without any walks. Entering the game in the third with runners on second and third and nobody out, Castillo allowed one unearned run on a sac fly and shut down the Spartans' bats the rest of the way - he struck out the side in order in the fifth and then two more to open the sixth and reach five batters struck out in succession before a grounder made it another

1-2-3 frame. Castillo used only 65 pitches over those five frames — 38 strikes — while inducing five arounders and one flyout.

MOUNTAIN WEST BY THE NUMBERS

- Through four conference weekend series, the Lobos have the third-best RPI in the MW (153) behind Air Force (114) and Nevada (123). Even after a tough finish to the weekend in San Diego, the Lobos sit in fourth place in the league standings, two games back of first-place Fresno State (19-8, 9-3) they are 5-5 in their last 10.

- At 16-11 overall, the Lobos have the second-most wins and second-best winning percentage (.593) in the conference behind Fresno State (19-8; .704). - In MW matchups only, UNM is batting a leaguebest .313 - they also lead the MW in slugging (.511) and on base percentage (.435), with the most efficient strikeout-walk ratio (55/54) in conference play.



(North Dakota State 2008-2021, UNM 2022-present) — he's one of only three UNM coaches to surpass 400 wins in their careers, trailing only Rich Alday (515-313 [1990-2007]) and Ray Birmingham (414-341 [2008-2020]) – the second and third-longest tenured Lobo Baseball coaches in program history – for the most career wins. Brown has posted a 63-69 record since becoming UNM's 12th Baseball coach in the summer of 2021 and is 404-419 (.491) in his career as a Head Coach.

SEEING DOUBLE

The Lobos have excelled at getting two for one this season, ranking No. 6 in NCAA D-I in total double plays (30) and No. 12 in total doubles (68). They rank No. 5 in double plays per game (1.11) and No. 16 in doubles per game (2.52), leading the MW in all four categories.

Jake Holland is tied the second-most two-baggers in the MW and No. 44 in NCAA D-I in doubles with 11, with Asby (10 doubles) at No. 84 in the nation and ranking among the Top 150 in the nation in doubles per game (0.37).

UNM ranks No. 2 in the MW in assists (294) and putouts (700), with Reed Spenrath ranking No. 3 in total putouts (200) and Devon Dixon ranking No. 3 in total assists (76) – Spenrath has been a part of 29 double plays (No. 1 in the MW), while Dixon has helped stitch 24 (No. 2 in the MW) with Chase Weissenborn pitching in on 14 (T-No. 5 in the MW) in just 13 games.

DIGGING THE LONG BALL

The Lobos found a penchant for the long ball in the month of March – after homering four times in their first eight games, they've connected on 30 for a total of 65 RBI since March 1. UNM is 10-1 in games this season in which the Lobos hit multiple homers and are slugging a MW-best .516 as a team. UNM is 12-4 in games in which the Lobos go yard at least once. The Lobos are slugging a MW-best .540 as a team after mashing 10 over four games last week.

Nine different Lobos have hit a homer this season for a total of 34 through 27 games – 24 have been at Santa Ana Star Field.

Jake Holland leads the Lobos with 10 homers and Will Asby has seven – Reed Spenrath has five, all of which have come in the last three weeks since hitting his first of the season on March 10 against UNLV. Devon Dixon hit his first homer of the season against Arizona State in Phoenix two weeks ago and followed with his second exactly a week later against NM State at home to lead four other Lobos – Tye Wood, Kyle Smith, Gene Truillo and Josh

– Tye Wood, Kyle Smith, Gene Trujillo and Josh McAlister – that have two each on the season.

HOLLAND AND ASBY BRINGING THE POWER

Jake Holland and Will Asby have combined for 17 o UNM's 34 homers with 21 doubles and 64 RBI between the duo so far this season - they tout the two highest slugging percentages on the team at .945 and .641, respectively. They both lead the tear in multi-RBI games with seven each. Holland won MW Player of the Week honors after batting for a .727 batting average and 2.000% slugging (2.750 OPS) with 14 RBI over three games last weekend, homering four times and hitting two doubles in the process. He batted .750 with runners in scoring position (6-for-8) and .667 in two-out situations (4-for-6) in that span. The senior catcher finished with multiple hits, runs and RBI in all three games, homering in each - Holland scored eight runs on the weekend, drawing three walks and only striking out once. He also started behind the dish in all three games, generating 25 putouts and three assists without any errors. He's now up to eighth multi-hit games and six multi-RBI games so far this season with 11 doubles (T-No. 1 in MW) and nine homers (T-No. 1 in MW) despite only starting in 16 of UNM's 24 games.

Batting .304 on the season, Will Asby leads the Lobos in multi-RBI games with seven and overall RBI with 31 (T-No. 1 in the MW, No. 55 in NCAA D-I) — he's been rung up the fewest times of any Lobo (Min. 2.5 AB/game) with a 11-16 strikeout to walk ratio.

The grad transfer by way of University of San Francisco has already driven in more runs in 27 games with the Lobos than he did all season across 38 appearances for the Dons in 2023 (26). He has also already matched his homer output from last season with seven bombs – the third-most in the league — and has hit two of UNM's three grand slams already this season, against UNLV on March 9 (W, 31-15) and New Mexico State on Tuesday (W, 14-4).

That 31-run game on March 9 was Asby's third game this season with four or more RBI; he drove in career-high nine runs that night, good for the second-most in a single game in program history. The Lobos matched the program record for single-game scoring with their 31 runs that night.

SPENRATH BACK TO FORM

– After mashing 19 homers in his first season in Albuquerque, Reed Spenrath was productive at the plate through his first 16 games (.300/.455/.483) but with just one thing missing – a home run. He finally broke through with his first of the year and the

– He's done so again four more times since then with two more multi-run homers against Arizona State (March 12) and Nevada (March 17) before hitting solo shots against New Mexico State (March 19) and San Diego State (March 28). UNM is 4-1 in games in which Spenrath hits a home run, and he's averaging 1.32 hits per game since hitting his first with seven multi-hit games in that span. Through seven weeks of Baseball, Spenrath has accumulated 22 RBI while hitting eight doubles and three triples, connecting on 33 hits and drawing 24 walks.

Spenrath has 10 multi-hit games and five multi-RBI games, starting all but one game at first while racking up 200 putouts and 17 assists. He's been a part of 29 of UNM's 30 double plays (No. 6 in NCAA D-I) this season.

Spenrath was named to D1Baseball.com's Top 50 first baseman rankings (No. 46) and Preseason All-MW ahead of this season. A first-team all-conference selection in his first season with the Lobos in 2023, Spenrath led the team and ranked second in the conference in 2023 with 19 home runs – the sixth-most in a single season in program history – to go with 65 RBIs. The 6'5" power hitter

also led the team and ranked third in the conference with 54 runs scored, batting .321 while reaching base at a clip of .421. He finished the season with 16 multi-hit games and 18 multi-RBI games.

– UNM's season-best streak of 10 straight games with double-digit hits came to an end on March 10 with an eight-hit outing against the Rebels. The Lobos finished with multiple doubles in each of their 12 consecutive home games from Feb. 22 to March 10, with six games of four or more two-baggers and two games with six.

UNM didn't hit a double in their loss to SDSU in Friday's Game Two for the first time this season – the Lobos have finished 19 games with multiple doubles in that span and nine with three or more. They've have now homered in six of their last eight games, with multiple in five of those games.
Josh McAlister (out with injury since March 3) extended his team-best on-base streak to 14 games since returning to action, with Will Asby reaching base in 10 consecutive games and Reed Spenrath doing so in nine. Four other Lobos – Chase Weissenborn (7), Konner Kinkade (4) and Luke Mansy (4) – all have active on-base streaks of at least four games.

and three of five or more - Asby also has seven multi-RBI games.

- Khalil Walker's 11-game hit streak from 2/22 to 3/15 was the longest by a Lobo this season. - Spenrath got aboard in 17 consecutive games to start the season - 20 if you count the end of the 2023 season - for UNM's longest streak of that variety this year. He did so despite going hitless in his first four games to start the season.

RETURN OF THE MAC

In the series finale with San Jose State, Josh McAlister made his first start at third base since exiting the Lobos' 9-6 win over Hofstra with injury on March 3 and showed little signs of rust, going 3-for-3 with three runs and three RBI. He finished a triple short of the cycle while drawing a walk, extending his team-best active on-base streak to 12 games. Last season at Ohio State, McAlister batted .200 with 18 RBI in 36 games played - through just 15 games in 2024 at UNM, he's batting .314 with 10 RBI. He'd started 12 of UNM's 13 games at the hot corner until his injury.

31-RUN MADNESS

The Lobos matched a program record set in 2004 with 31 runs scored in their series-clinching win over UNLV on March 9, racking up 29 hits and getting multiple RBI from six different Lobos in the process. Will Asby drove in a team-high nine runs - the second-most in a single game in program history and the most since 2010 - and Kyle Smith added six more. UNM's 29 hits in total are the most in a single game since 2010 and fourth-most in a single game in program history.

Asby was 2-for-2 with two doubles and 4 RBI in the first inning alone as the Lobos plated 20 runs in the first three frames. UNLV scored 15 runs in total and looked to get within striking distance late after plating eight between the fourth and sixth innings, but RHP Josh Barnhouse calmed things down in relief, allowing just one hit over 3 I innings of work while striking out four and walking two to calm things down and earn the first win of his UNM career.

SEASON-OPENING NOTES / EARLY RETURNS

- UNM looks to improve its standing in the Mountain West for a third consecutive season - the Lobos finished sixth (10-20 MW) in Brown's first season as head coach in 2022 and narrowly missed out on the conference tournament with a fifth-place finish (13-17 MW) in 2023.

- The Lobos' offense in 2023 was one of their most productive in recent memory - UNM's .328 team batting average was the third-best in the NCAA and best in the Mountain West, as well as the Lobos' best since 2013.

- UNM's 26-25 record in 2023 was the most wins since 2017 and first winning season since then (not counting UNM's 14-4 record in the canceled COVID season of 2020).

- Reed Spenrath was named to the Mountain West Baseball Preseason All-Conference Team, with the Lobos picked fifth in the preseason poll as voted on by the league's coaches. Spenrath was named to D1Baseball.com's Top 50 First Baseman rankings ahead of the season, coming in at No. 46 in the

nation. He was named one of three captains for this year's Lobos squad along with fellow seniors Chase Weissenborn and Brett Russell.

BROWN'S PROGRAM-BUILDING RESUME

- In his first five seasons as head coach at North Dakota State, Brown's teams improved their winning percentage in each season, going from 15-30 (.333) in his first season in 2008 to 40-20 (.667) in 2012 and finishing each of the next nine seasons above .400. The Bison reached the Summit League tournament eight times in that span, advancing to NCAA Regionals in 2014 and 2021.

 Brown coached the Bison to 40-win seasons in 2012 and 2021.

- In Brown's second season at UNM, the Lobos improved to 26-25 from 21-33 the year prior, with the highest team batting average since 2013 (.328) and lowest team ERA since 2016 (5.95).

- In 16 years as a D-I Head Coach, Brown has finished the season above .400 13 times and above .500 five times - the only three seasons in which he's finished below .400 were his first two years in

Fargo (2008, 2009) and his first season in Albuquerque (2022).

YOUR 2024 LOBOS ROSTER

- UNM's 2024 roster includes 16 returning players with 24 newcomers - the Lobos return seven position players who started at least 10 games in 2023 and losing six.

- Of the Lobos' newcomers, 8 are freshmen and 16 are transfers - 12 from junior colleges and four from four-year institutions.

- 29 players are upperclassmen - 13 seniors and 16 juniors - the most upperclassmen Brown has had on a roster in Albuquerque.

THE REMAINING SCHEDULE

- UNM's 54-game 2024 schedule, including 30 Mountain West Conference games, features five different teams that reached NCAA Regionals last spring - Oregon State, Texas Tech, Arizona, San Jose State and Sam Houston State - with 27 games against nine opponents that ranked in the Top 150 in the nation in last season's final RPI rankings.

TOD BROWN Head coach

Tod Brown was named the 12th Lobo Baseball Head Coach on June 17, 2021. He enters the 2024 season in his third year at the helm. In Brown's second season, the Lobos posted their best winning percentage in a full season since 2017 (.510), finishing fifth in the Mountain West standings (26-25, 13-17 MW) and leading the league in a variety of categories including team batting average (.328), runs (441), RBI (411), triples (24), home runs (87), slugging % (.559) and

on-base % (.406). UNM also improved from a 9.06 ERA as a team in Brown's first season to a 5.95 ERA — the program's lowest in a single season since 2016 — while averaging only 3.20 walks per nine innings, its fewest since 2014. Following the completion of that season, RHP Isaac Gallegos became the first UNM player coached by Brown to be selected in the MLB Draft, going in the 16th Round to the Atlanta Braves. The 2023 Lobos ranked in the Top 10 in the country in a variety of team statistical categories:

- No. 3 in Batting Average (.329)
- No. 9 in Double Plays per Game (0.94)
- No. 5 in Doubles Per Game (2.45)
- No. 10 in Runs per Game (8.60)
- No. 4 in Slugging Percentage (.560)
- No. 5 in Triples (24) and Triples per Game (0.47)
- No. 10 in Walks Allowed per Nine Innings (3.20)

Following the 2023 season, the Lobos also got three All-MW selections — first baseman Reed Spenrath was a first-team selection, while third baseman Dylan Ditzenberger and left fielder Lenny Junior Ashby were second-team selections. Ditzenberger went on to be named a CSC Academic All-American for his efforts on the field and in the classroom. Both UNM teams that Brown has coached (2022, 2023) have earned the ABCA Team Academic Excellence Award for their academic accomplishments.

In the 2022 season — Brown's first season in Albuquerque — UNM went 21-33 and finished sixth in the MW standings, with Lenny Junior Ashby and Jeffrey David named to the All-MW Second Team.

PRIOR TO UNM

Brown came to New Mexico after a successful 14 years and 341 wins with North Dakota State, where he currently sits as the second-winningest coach in program history and is the all-time leader in wins per season (24.4). In 2021, Brown led the Bison to the 2021 NCAA Tournament, winning its first Division I postseason game 6-1 over Mountain West opponent Nevada. In the same season, NDSU broke a school record with 20 Summit League victories, besting the previous record of 19 set by his 2017 team, and posted an overall record of 42-19. The Bison also led the nation with 25 road wins and set new school records in strikeouts (474) and putouts (1,567) in a single season.

Brown is no stranger to winning -- he owns the two highest single season win totals in NDSU history (42 wins in 2021, 40 wins in 2012), and the only two 40+ win seasons by the program. Brown also owns three of the top-five single-season win totals in NDSU history. Under Brown's leadership, NDSU has played in five Summit League champion-ship games, winning it outright in 2021 and 2014, and qualified for the league's baseball championship eight out of the last 11 years.

Brown took the helm of NDSU in 2008 and turned around a program that had faced three consecutive losing seasons, posting just 38 wins from 2005-07. In 2012, NDSU won a then-school-record 40 games, including an 8-2 win over a No. 5-ranked Arizona team that went on to win the 2012 College World Series. North Dakota State had a school-record .973 fielding percentage and posted a team ERA of 3.38, which was the program's lowest ERA in 37 years.

In 2016, the Bison posted a 29-25 overall record and set a new record for home wins at Newman Outdoor Field with 17 victories. In addition, North Dakota State set a new single season record in saves (17). NDSU defeated No. 19-ranked Minnesota on April 26 in Fargo, marking the second-ever win over an NCAA Division I top-25 opponent. In the Summit League, Brown has coached two Summit League Players of the Year, one Summit League Newcomer of the Year, 46 All-Summit League selections, 22 Summit

League Players of the Week, and 30 Summit League Pitchers of the Week. Under his leadership, Brown has also led players to two Collegiate Baseball Freshmen All-America selections and two College Baseball National Players of the Week.

Not only does Brown produce talent on the field, but also in the classroom. During his tenure at NDSU, Brown has had three NCAA Postgraduate Scholarship Winners, one Senior CLASS Award All-America, one CoSIDA Academic All-America Athlete of the Year, nine CoSIDA Academic All-America selections, 11 CoSIDA Academic All-District selections, one Summit League Scholar-Athlete of the Year, 16 Summit League Academic All-League selections, and was twice honored by NCAA with Public Recognition for perfect APR scores (2012-13 and 2015-16).

The Tucson, Ariz. native, was a left-handed pitcher for the Arizona Wildcats from 1989-94, leading the team in 1992 to a Pac-10 Championship. In 1993 he won six games and saved eight, setting a record with 35 appearances as Arizona fell one game short of Omaha. Brown then made a career out of coaching college ball in the northern tier of the country. He came to NDSU after eight seasons in Ohio as the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator for Bowling Green State University.

During this time, he recruited or helped develop eight players who have reached the major leagues, including former UNM pitching standout Jamie Vermilyea, who played for the Lobos from 2001-03. This list also includes Jay Flaa, who made his MLB debut this year, J.J. Hardy and pitcher Tim Wood from Sabino High School, in Tucson, Ariz., outfielder Shelley Duncan and pitchers Josh Pearce and Ben Diggins at the University of Arizona, and pitcher Burke Badenhop and outfielder Nolan Reimold from Bowling Green. After two years as the pitching coach at Sabino High School in Tucson, Ariz., Brown began his collegiate coaching career in 1999 as a volunteer assistant for Arizona. He worked with pitchers and catchers and was the first-base coach for the Wildcats, who qualified for an NCAA regional.

Brown was also a head coach for the San Francisco Seals of the California Coastal Collegiate League in the summer of 1999, compiling a 43-29 record and making a fourth-place finish in the National Baseball Congress World Series.

Tod and his wife Janet have a 23-year old son, Brooks, and a 20-year old daughter, Blake.



MICHAEL LOPEZ ASSISTANT COACH: PITCHING

Michael Lopez, who previously served as head coach at Howard Community College in Big Spring, Texas, joined the Lobos in the 2021-22 season as a pitching coach. Lopez joined the Lobo squad after spending two seasons at the helm of the Howard program, bolstering a 48-19 overall record.

In the second season with Lopez coordinating UNM's pitching, the team's ERA improved from

9.06 to 5.95 — UNM's lowest since 2016. UNM pitchers under Lopez also posted their lowest WHIP (1.59) since 2015 and fewest walks per nine innings (3.20) since 2014 in the process, with RHP Isaac Gallegos selected in the 2023 MLB Draft following the season's completion.

Under Lopez, two Howard Hawks were named to the 2021 All-Region V Baseball Team, including pitcher Kris Anglin, who led the league in strikeouts (103). Howard's Ethan Coombes was second in the league in strikeouts, retiring 82 throughout the season. Prior to becoming the head coach of the Hawks, Lopez spent three years as an assistant coach under previous head coach, Rob Martinez.

During his time at Howard College, Lopez worked primarily with the pitchers and served as the recruiting coordinator. He has had over 40 players sign with Division I

schools during his tenure, three players sign contracts with professional teams, and three players selected as NJCAA All-Americans.

Lopez originally came to Howard College after a one-year stint with a brand-new NAIA program, Marymount California University (MCU). During his one year at MCU, Lopez was named the associate head coach and helped with day-to-day recruiting. In the first year of the program, Lopez helped the Mariners win the CAL PAC Conference Championship and reach the 2016 West Grouping Championship. Lopez had three players selected to the 2016 All-California Pacific Conference Team while also coaching the CAL PAC conference player of the year and the CAL PAC Freshman of the year.

Prior to coaching at Marymount California University, Lopez was the volunteer assistant coach for two seasons at the University of Arizona under head coach Andy Lopez. Lopez assisted with the pitchers during practices and helped run the bullpen during games. Off the field, his job consisted of preparing scouting reports on opposing teams, directing the Andy Lopez Baseball Camp, and assisting with recruiting. Lopez's collegiate career in baseball includes four years (2009-2012) at the University of Arizona. Lopez was named captain of the 2012 team, which won the NCAA National Championship in Omaha, Nebraska.

Lopez graduated from The University of Arizona in 2013 with a bachelor's degree in family studies.



INATT RISDOM assistant coach / recruiting coordinator

Matt Risdon joined the Lobo Family in 2022 as a volunteer assistant coach, and he currently serves recruiting coordinator and assistant coach. Risdon was previously at Lenoir-Rhyne University for three seasons. Risdon was a Division I catcher at Western Illinois for two seasons and served on the coaching staff for the Fighting Leathernecks from August 2015-July 2019. Last season, Risdon-coached hitters posted

UNM's highest team batting average since 2013 (.328) — good for best in the conference and No. 3 in NCAA D-I — while leading the MWC in OPS, hits, runs, triples, RBI and home runs. The Lobos' .974 fielding percentage in 2022 was the second-best in program history and best in the MWC, and their 48 double plays turned was the most in the conference.

In 2022, Risdon helped Lenoir-Rhyne University to the best season in program history with a 46-13 overall record and a record 25 wins at home. The Bears would post a 19-game winning streak, the longest in program history, and were ranked as high as

No. 11 in the nation. The Bears would capture just the third SAC Tournament title in program history and advanced to just the second NCAA Tournament appearance in team history. Risdon was the catching coach and assisted with hitting and recruiting. In 2022 the Bears broke multiple offensive records such as: home runs, runs, RBIs, walks, HBPs, hits, as well as many other team records. The Bears season was capped off with their senior catcher, Nick Clarno, signing with the Atlanta Braves. Risdon began his coaching career as the Director of Baseball Operations with WIU in August 2015 and served in that role for one season before being named the program's graduate assistant. After finishing his Master in Sports Management in May 2017, Risdon earned the title of assistant coach and recruiting coordinator prior to the 2018 campaign. Risdon was primarily responsible for catchers and assisted with hitting and infielders while also serving as the third base coach. Risdon helped with defensive positioning and discussed hitting approach with players during game review. Risdon also helped with administrative duties such as: travel, team meals, fundraising, scouting, and monitoring student-athlete academic eligibility. Risdon played in 40 career games for Western Illinois. He earned his bachelor's degree in exercise science in 2015.



JUSTIN MITCHELL assistant coach: hitting

Justin Mitchell joined the Lobo Family in August of 2023 and he serves as assistant coach. He will handle UNM's catchers as well as hitting for head coach Tod Brown. Mitchell spent the 2023 season as a graduate assistant coach at K-State under Pete Hughes. The 2023 Wildcats went 35-24 and advanced to the semifinals of the Big 12 Championship. His G.A. stint came after he played one season at K-State, hitting .308 with five homers and 22 RBIs over 52 games, playing catcher as a grad transfer. Mitchell played four seasons at Oklahoma, where he graduated. Over his time he played in 116 games, hitting .261 with two homers and 38 RBIs. He recorded 991 career putouts as a catcher. He graduated from Oklahoma in 2022.
